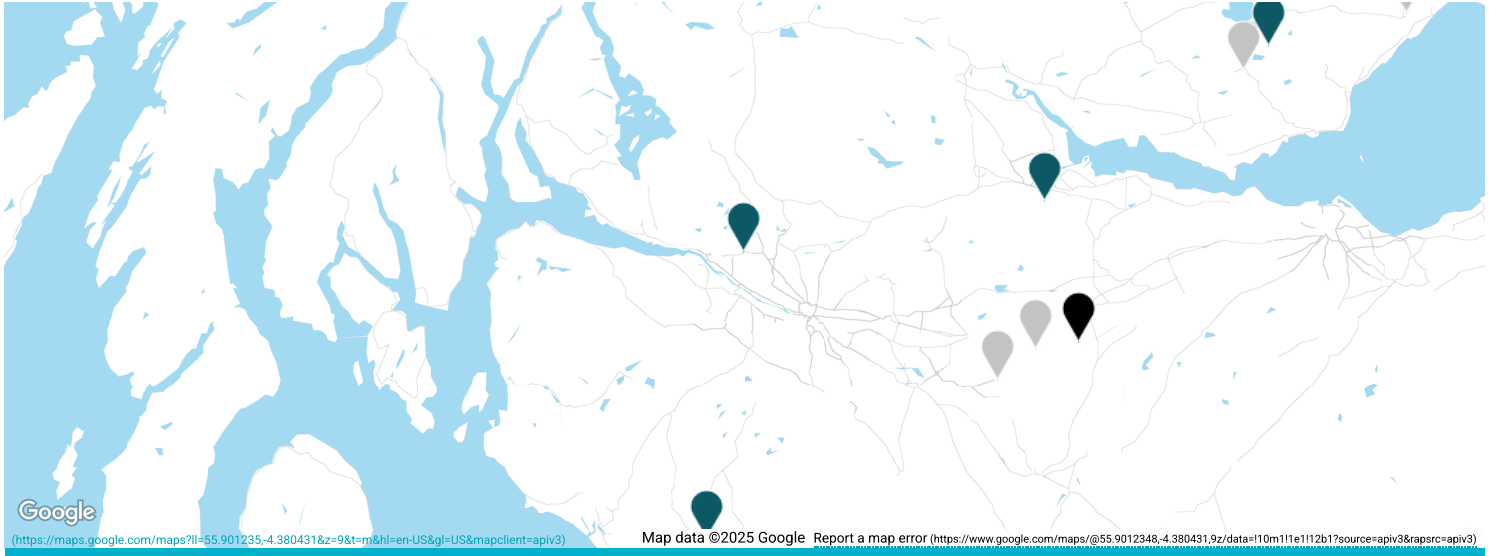




Fauldhouse

Fauldhouse in West Lothian was a coal mining town. Mining developed in the 18th century and ironstone and whinstone were locally quarried. The mines closed in the mid 20th century but some quarrying remains.

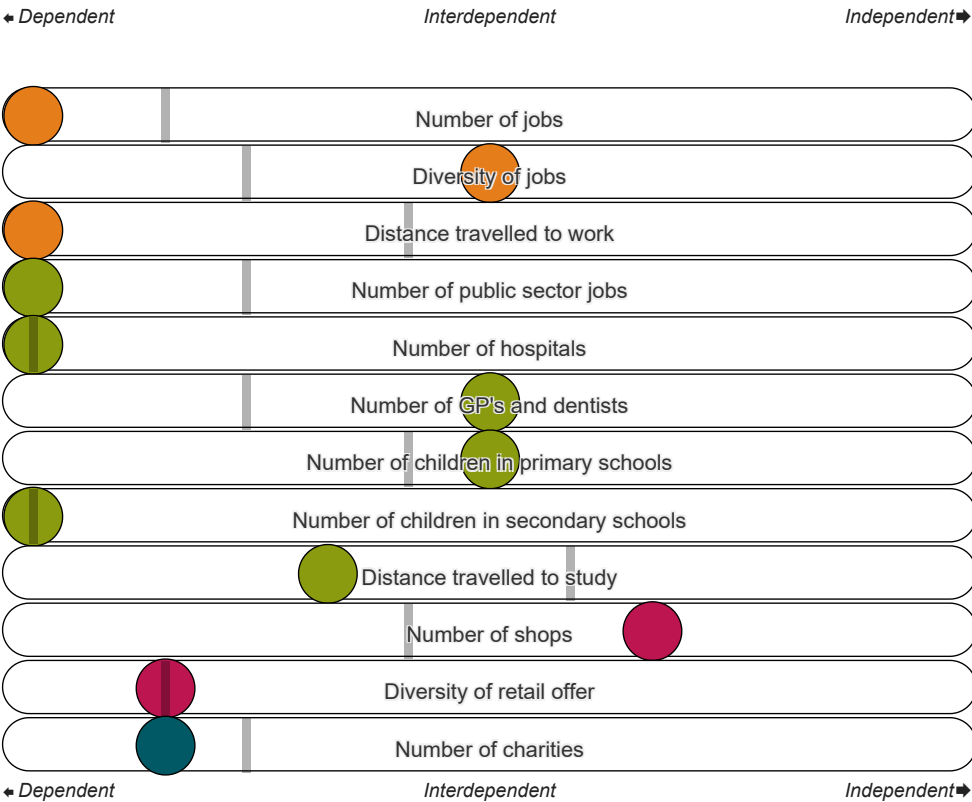
In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Fauldhouse is a dependent to interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Fauldhouse is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Fauldhouse is grouped with 8 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of shops, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Fauldhouse differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

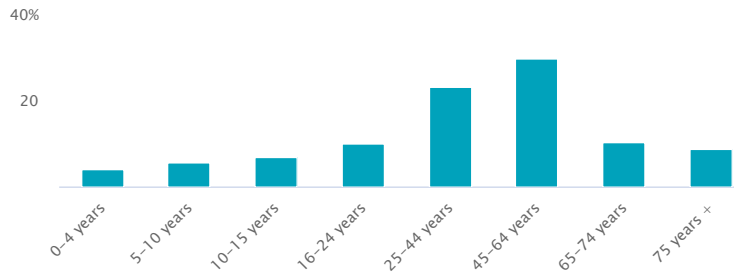

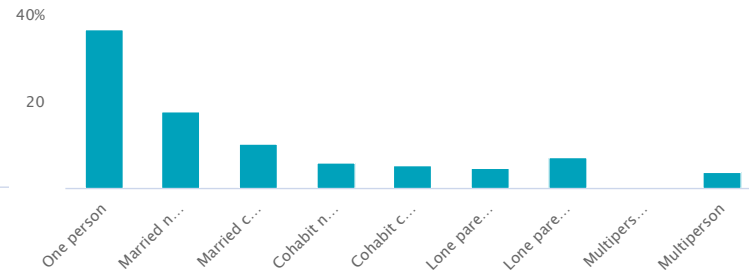

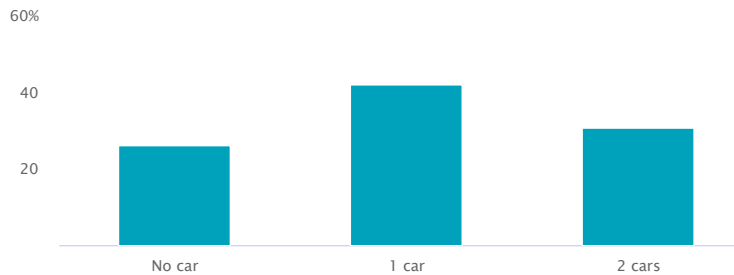

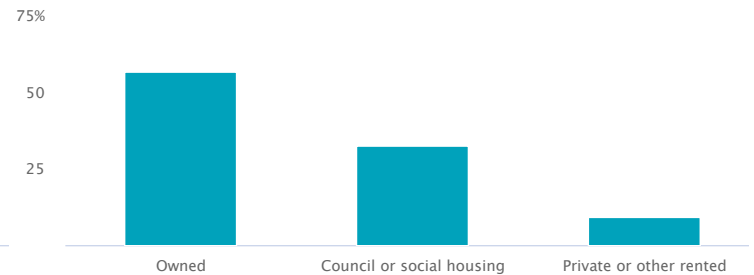

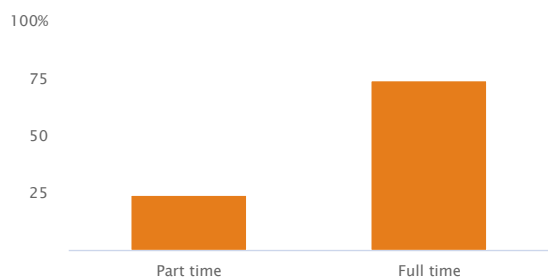

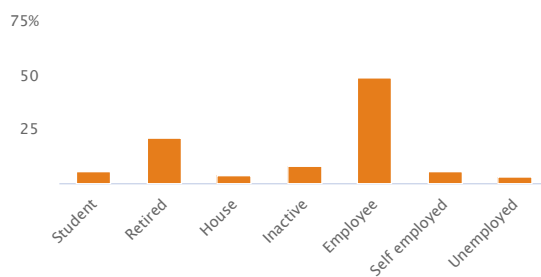
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



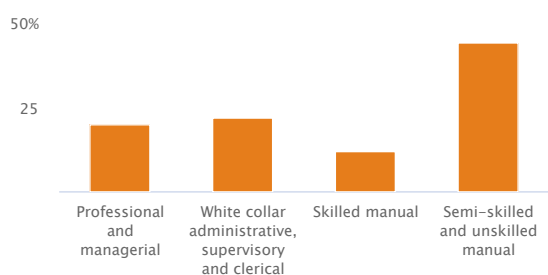
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

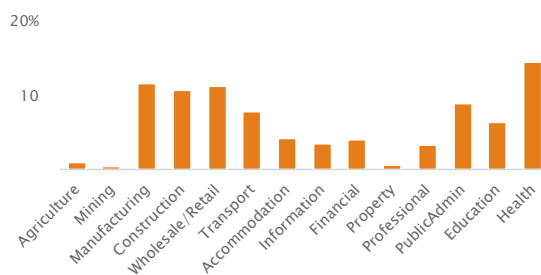


Social Grade

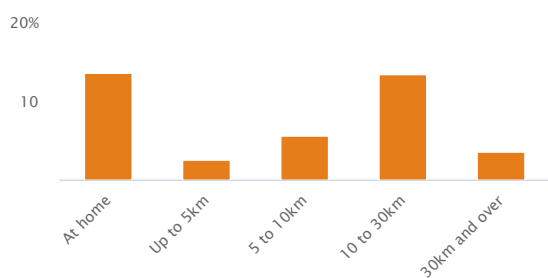
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

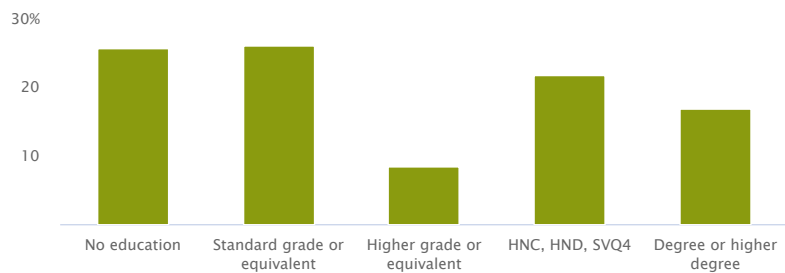


Distance travelled to work

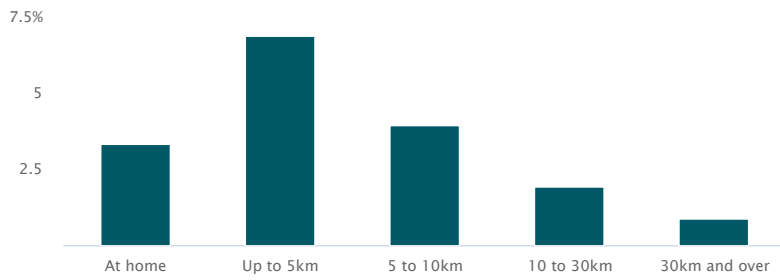
