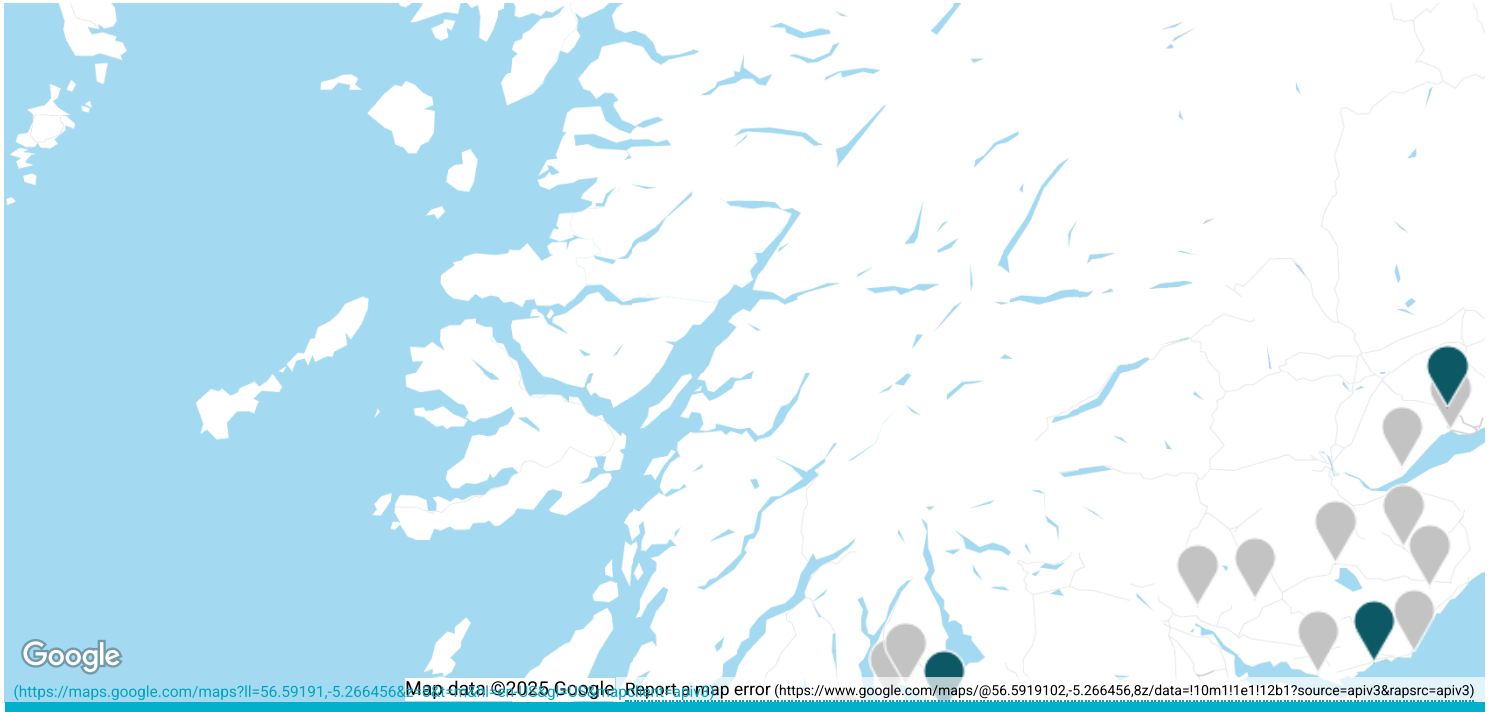




Fenwick

EAST AYRSHIRE

POPULATION **1,107**

Fenwick is in East Ayrshire. It was a Covenanter stronghold with a rural economy in historic times. It was a shoemaking and weaving village in the 18th century distinguished by its early development of a weavers' cooperative. It is now bypassed by the trunk road but was formerly a coaching stop on the Glasgow Kilmarnock road. Today it is a local service centre with small businesses.

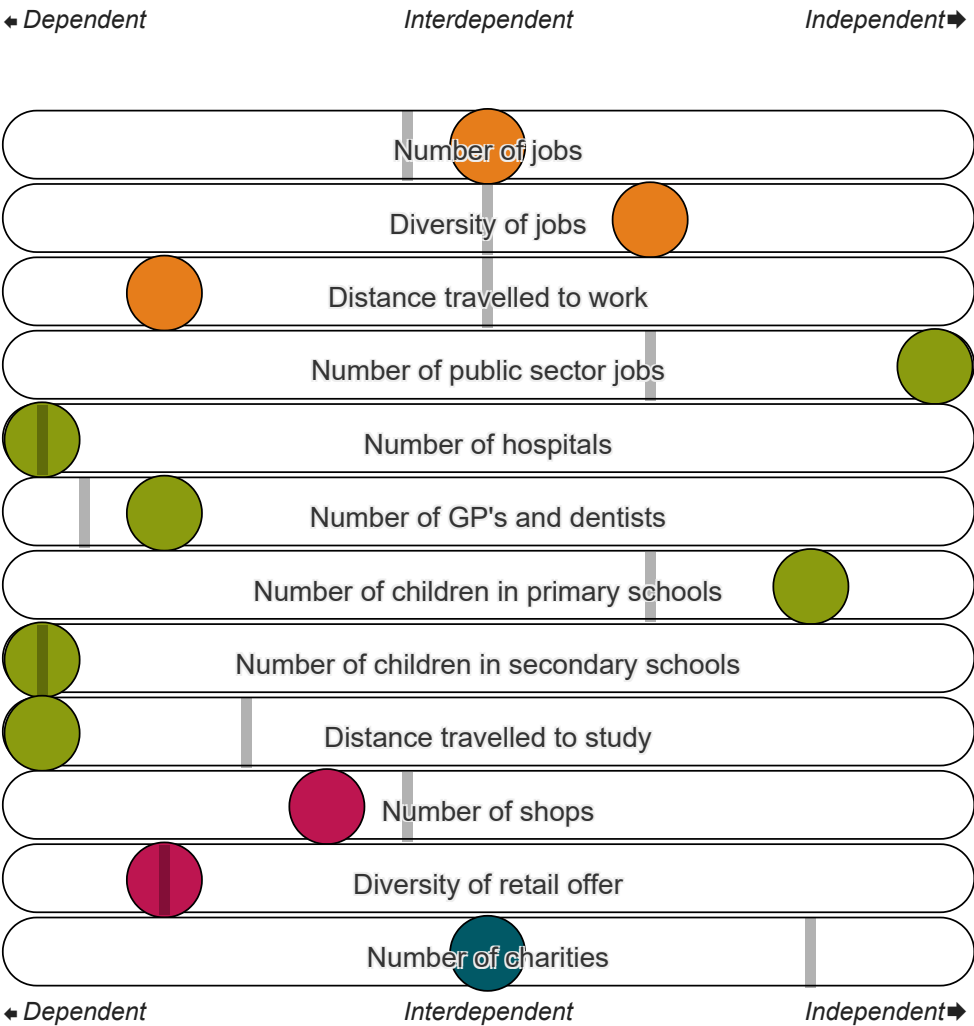
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Fenwick is an interdependent to dependent town.

Fenwick is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Fenwick is grouped with 24 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and public sector jobs. Fenwick differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

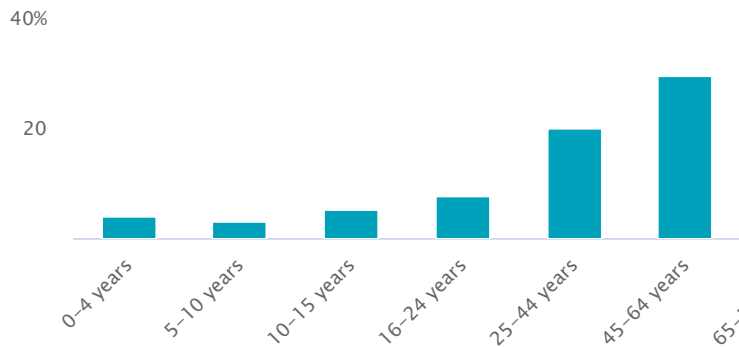

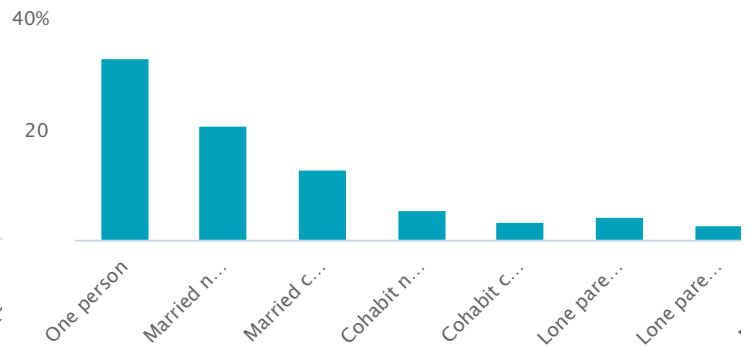

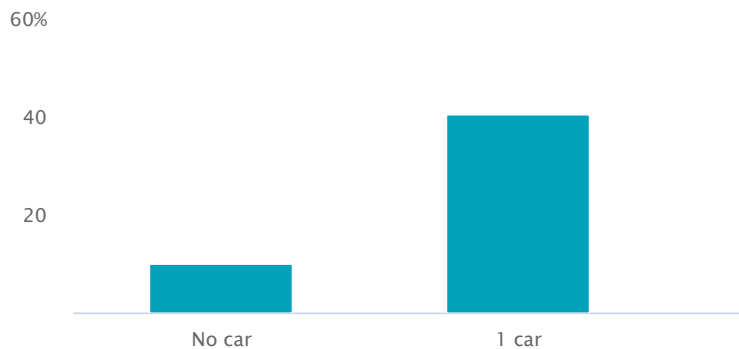

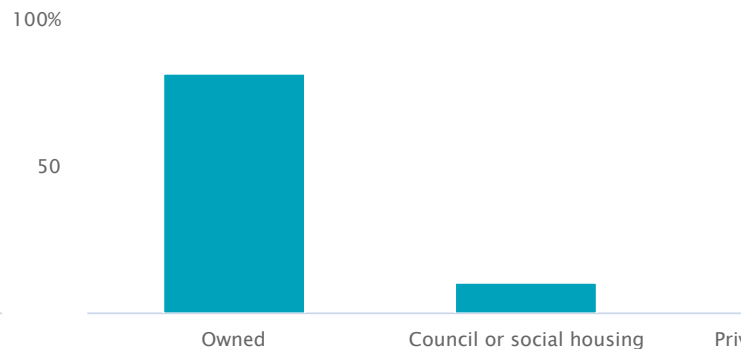
Household composition

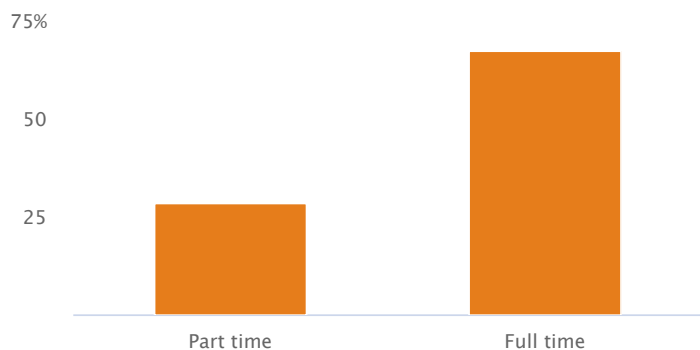

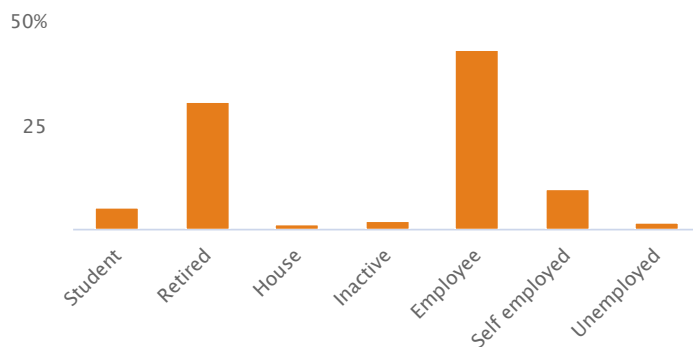
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



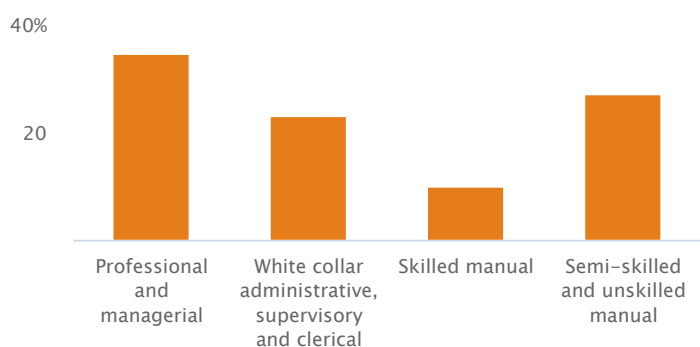
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

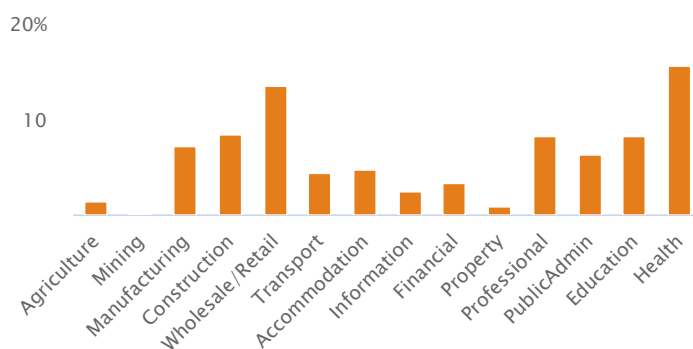


Social Grade

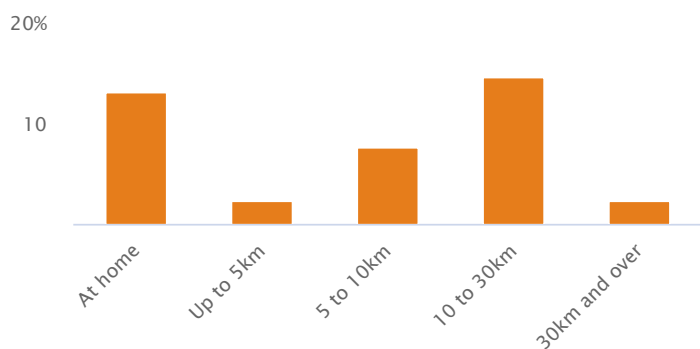
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

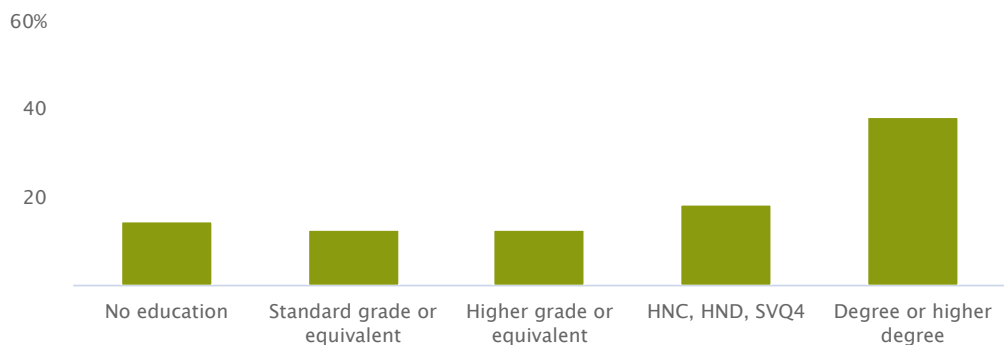


Distance travelled to work

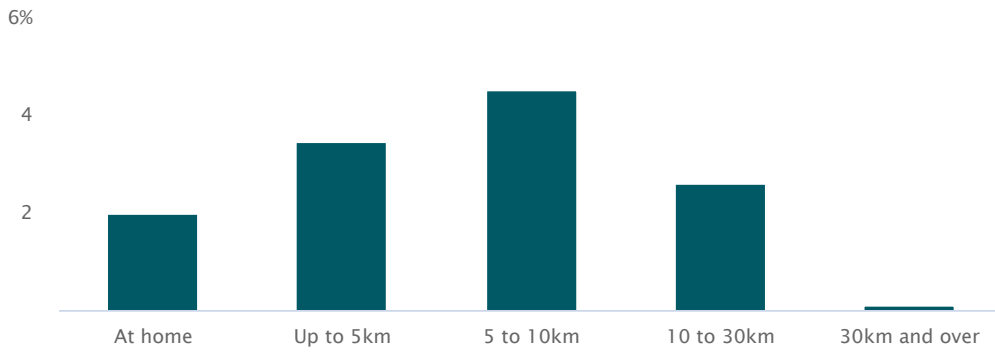
