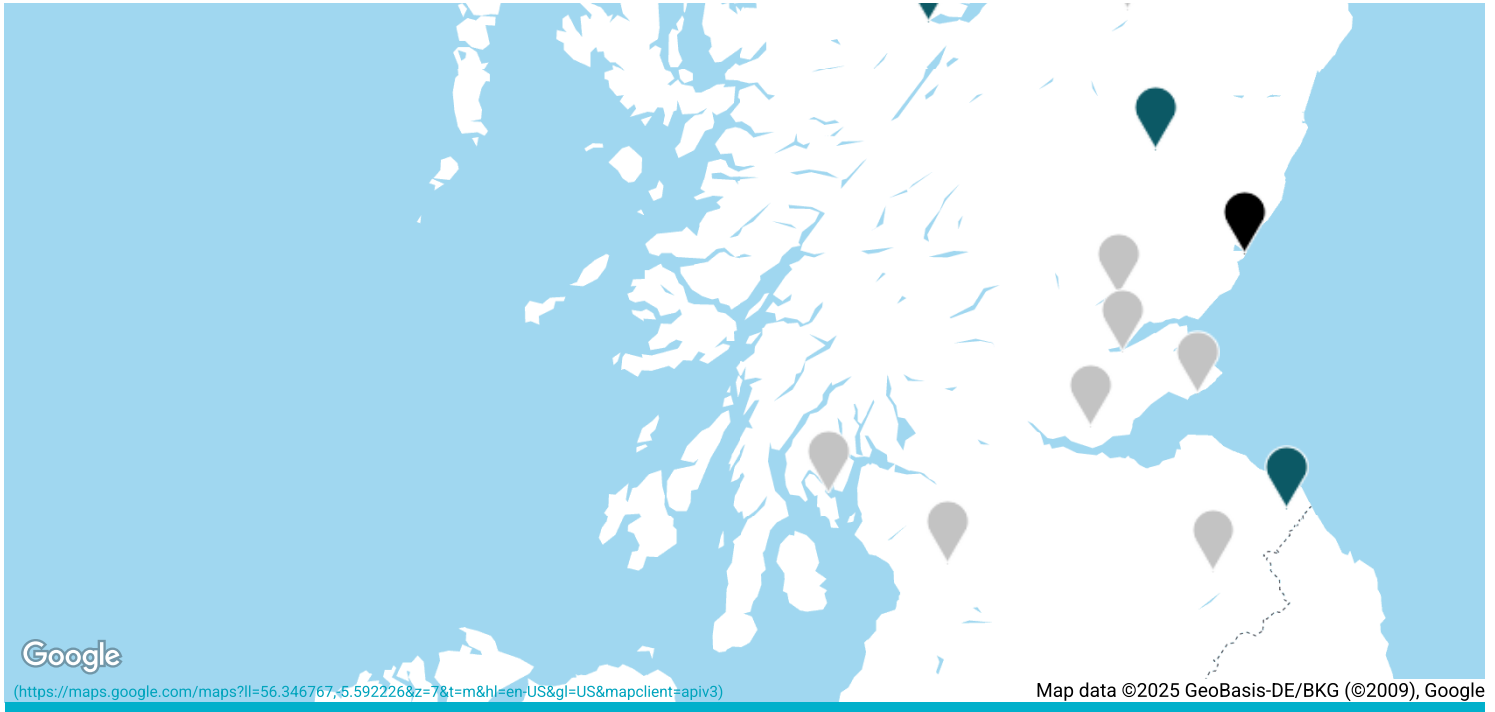




Ferryden and Inchbraoch

Ferryden and Inchbraoch is in Angus. It is the settlement on the south side of the Esk by Montrose. It has its origins as fishing village . The harbour expanded into a major port with the expansion of the oil industry.

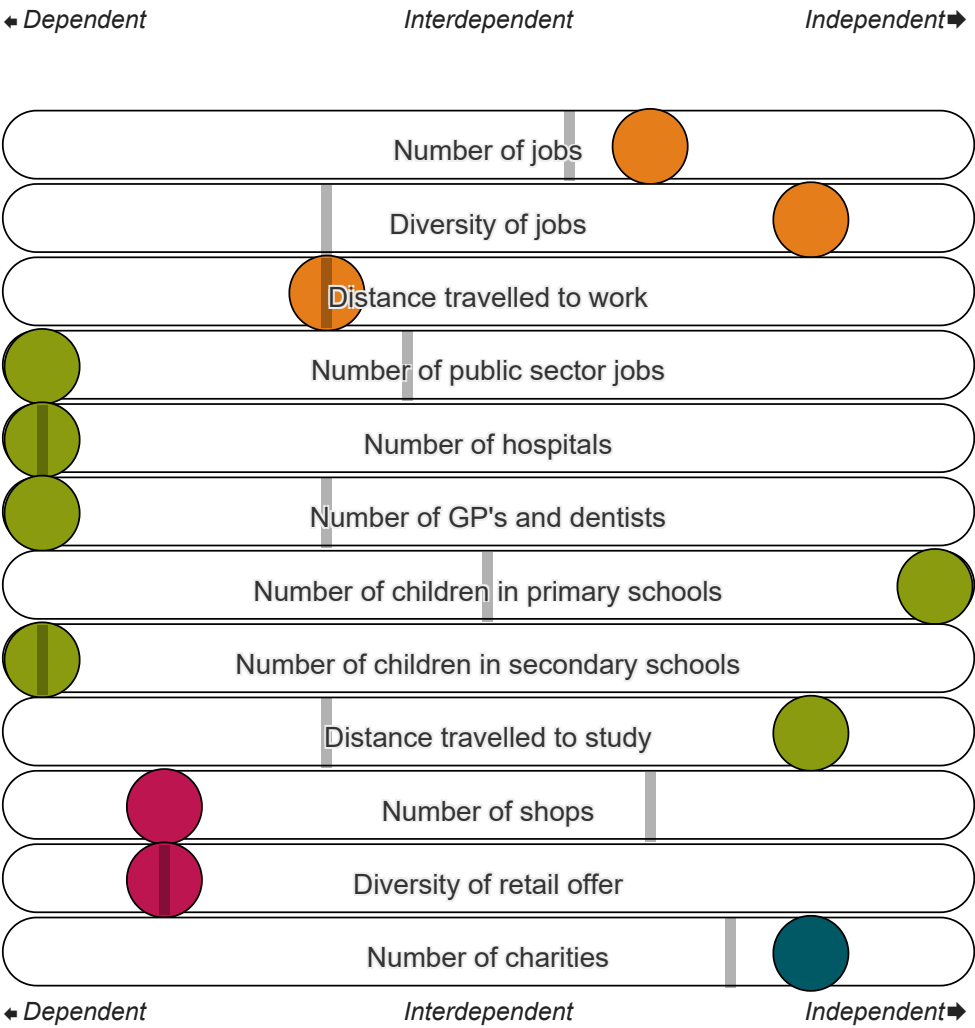
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Ferryden and Inchbraoch is an interdependent to dependent town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Ferryden and Inchbraoch is grouped with 15 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

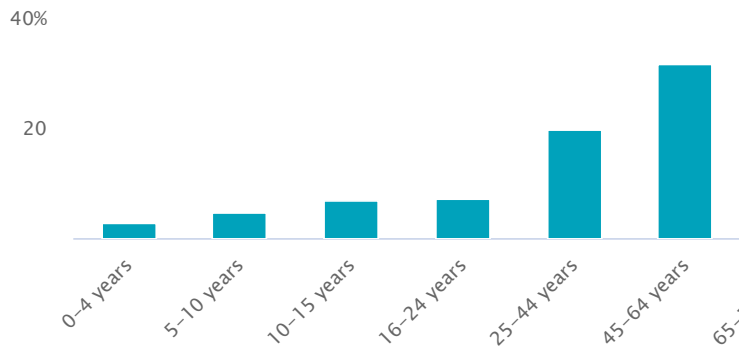

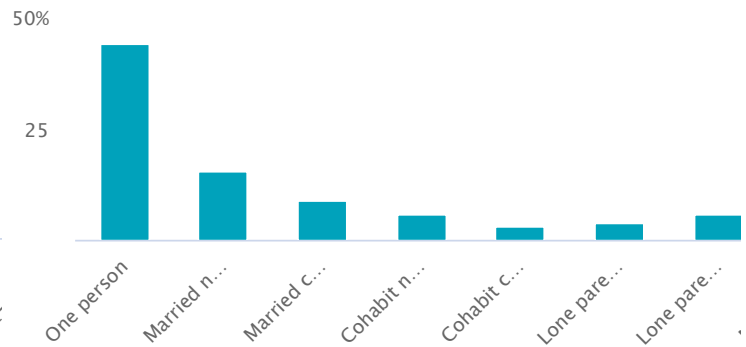

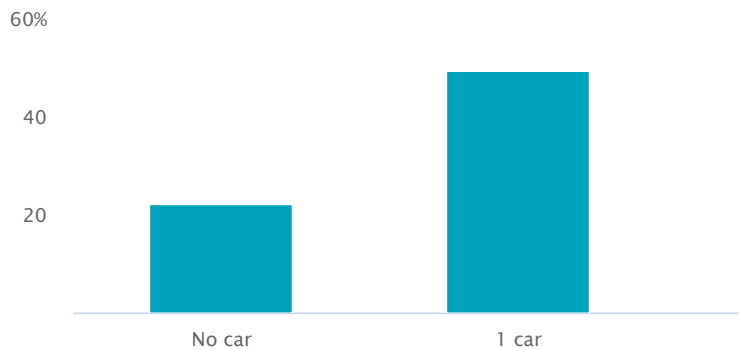

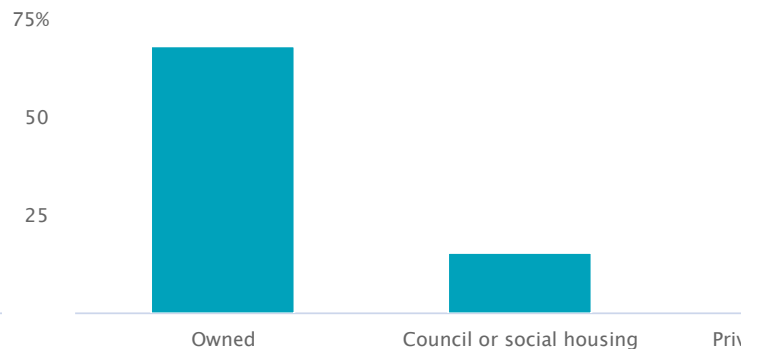
Household composition

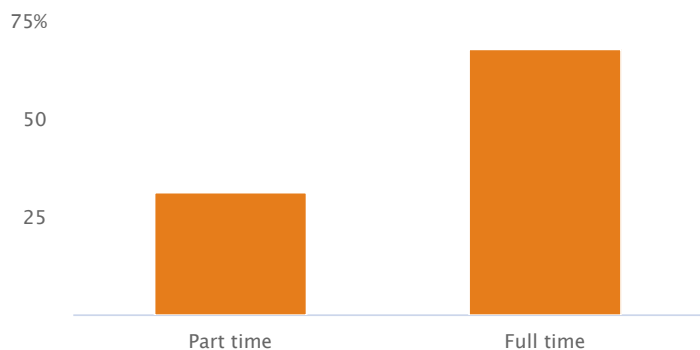

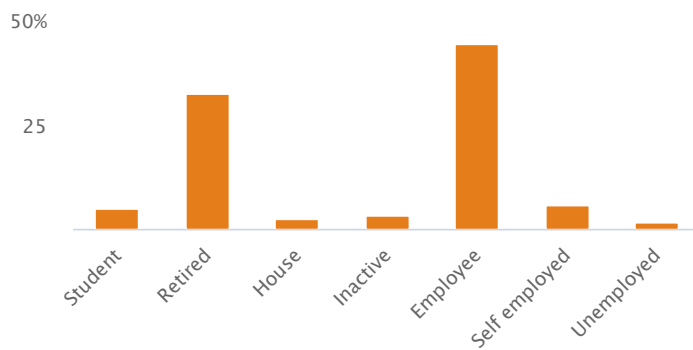
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



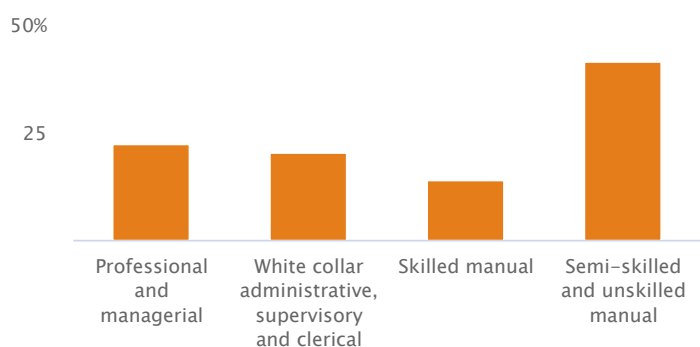
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

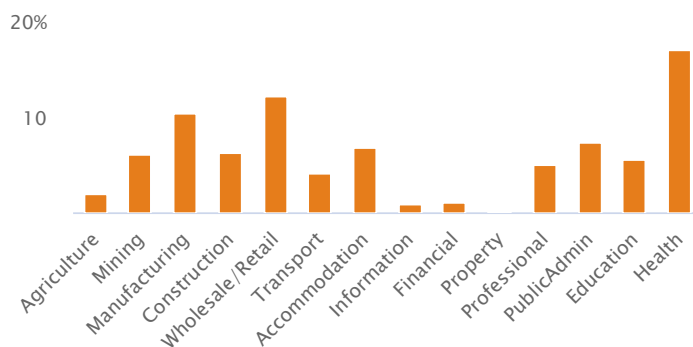

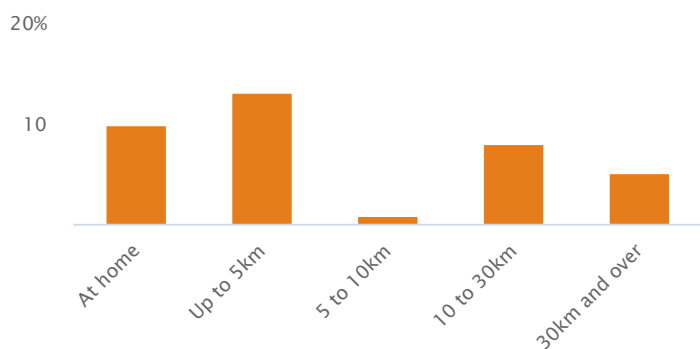
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

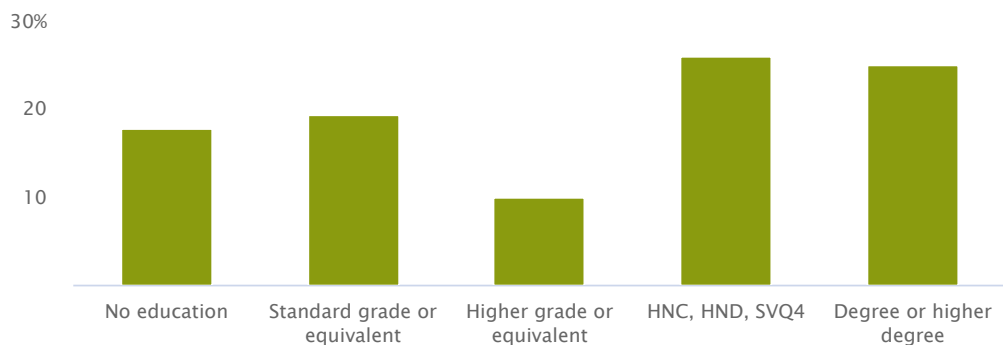


Distance travelled to work

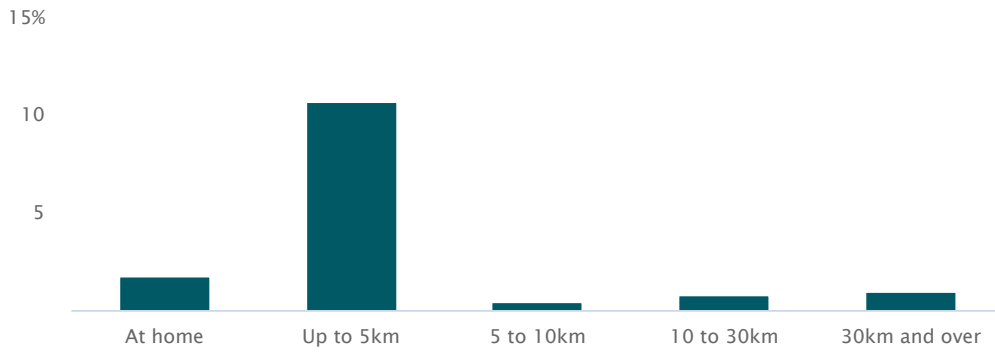
