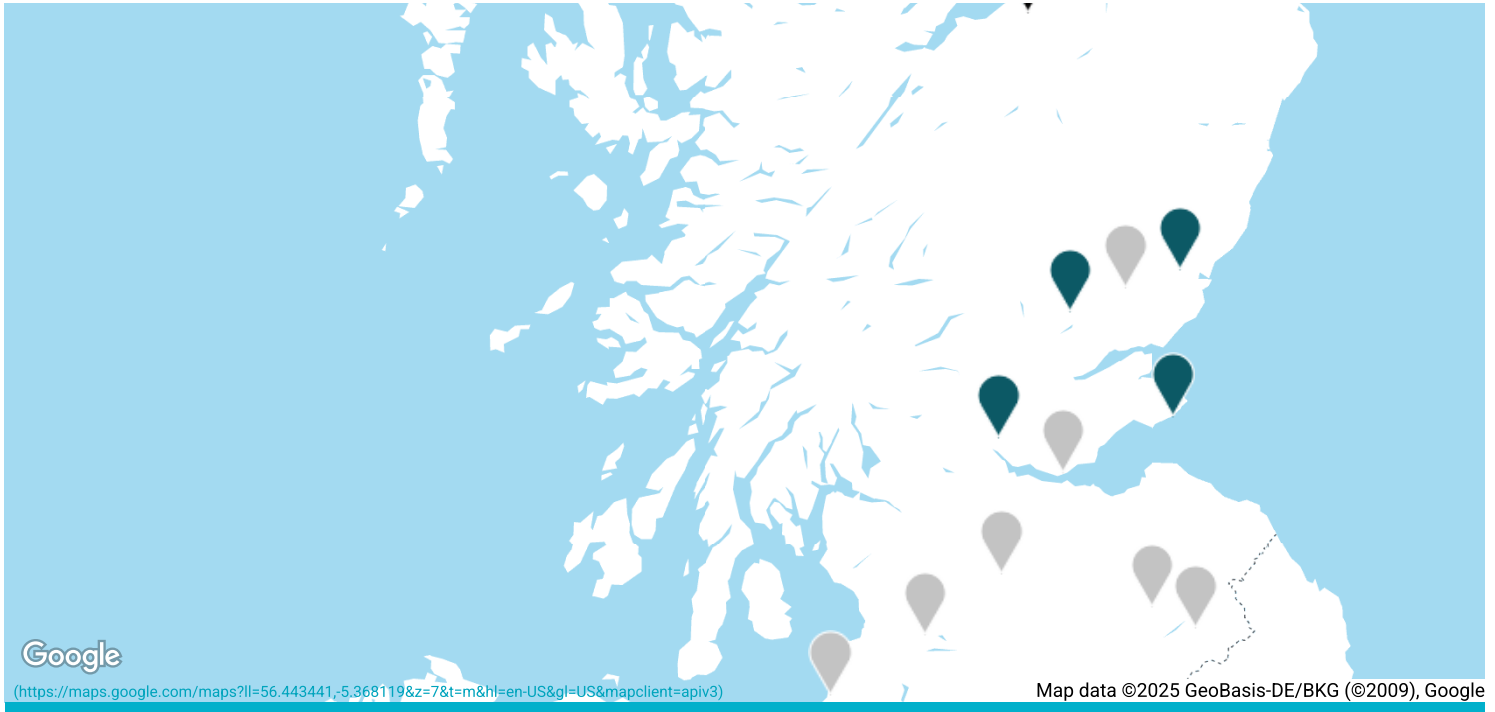

Forres is in Moray. It is a medieval town and has based its local economy on its role as a market town.

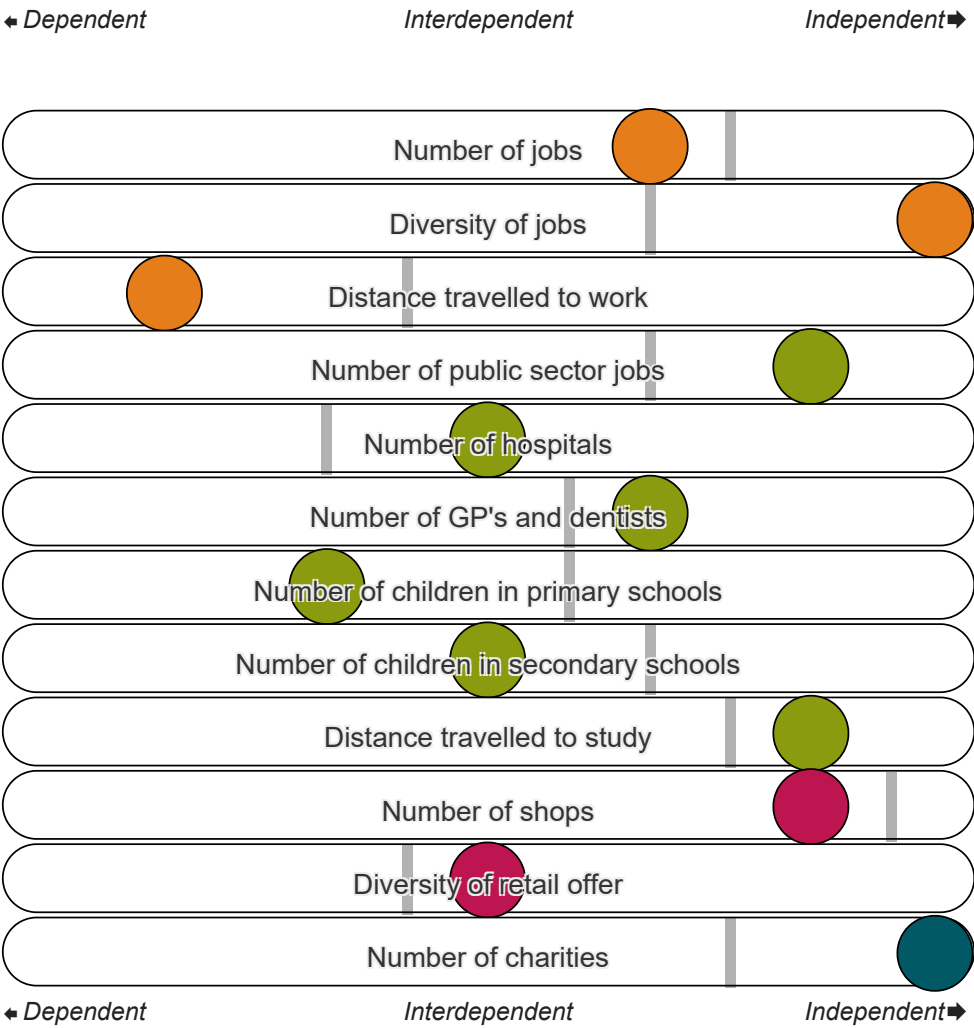
In this medium town, population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Forres is an interdependent to independent town.

Forres is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Forres is grouped with 11 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and children in primary schools. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Forres differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

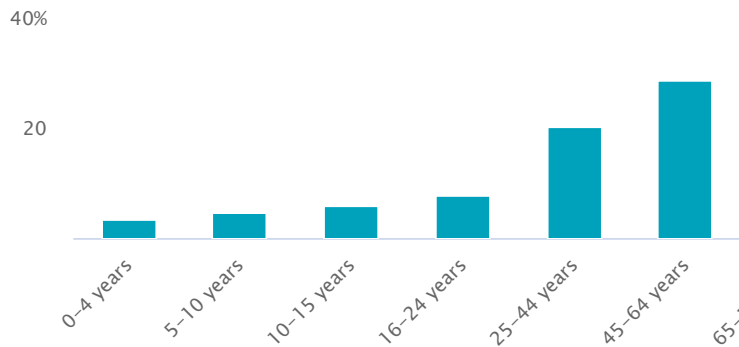

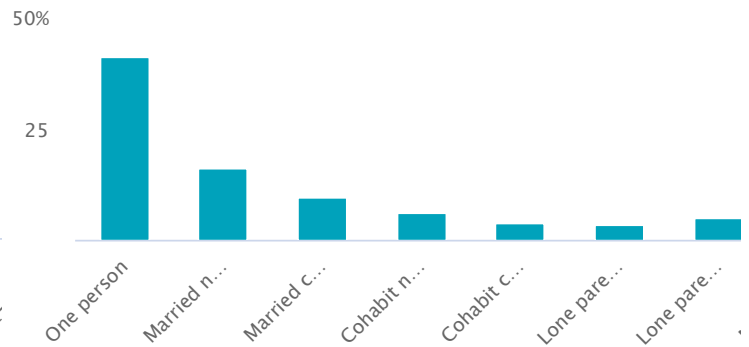

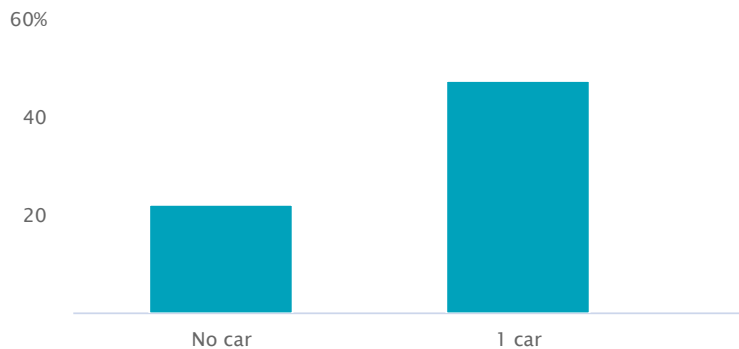

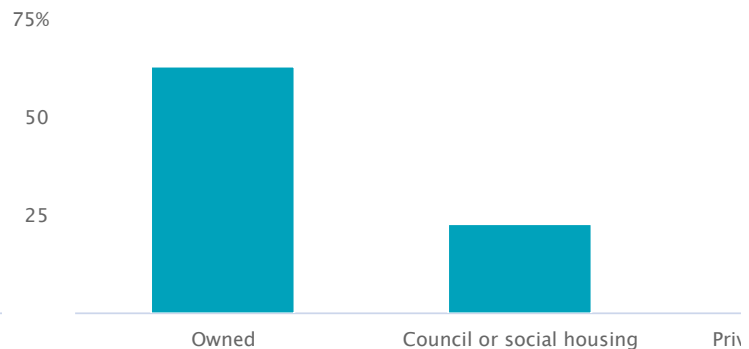

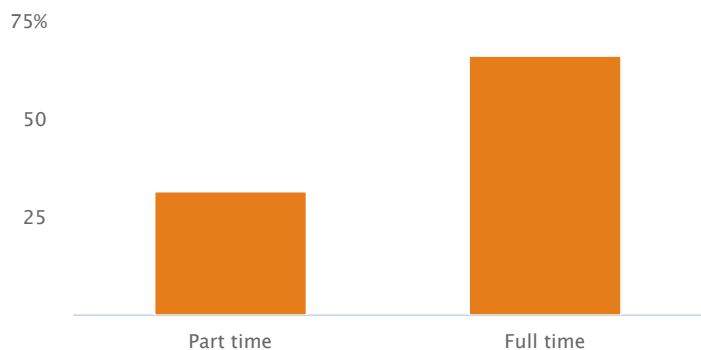

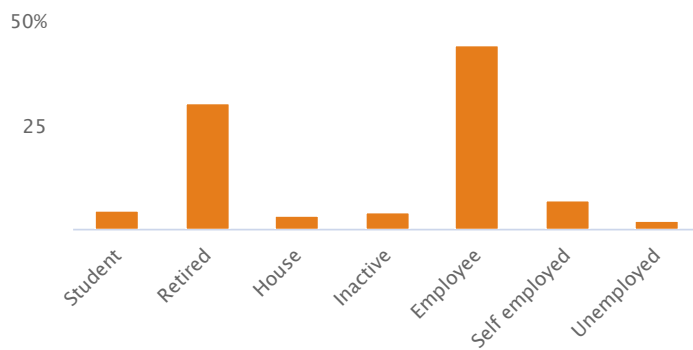
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



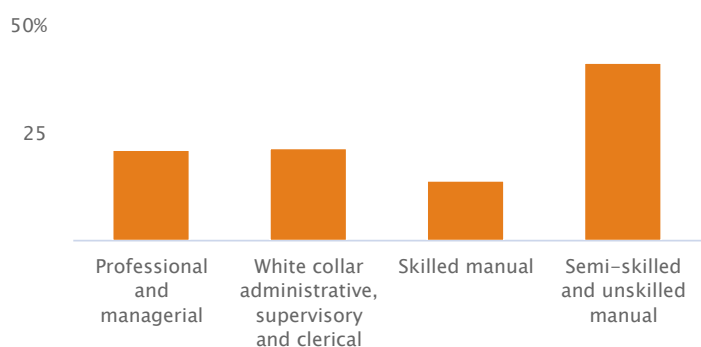
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

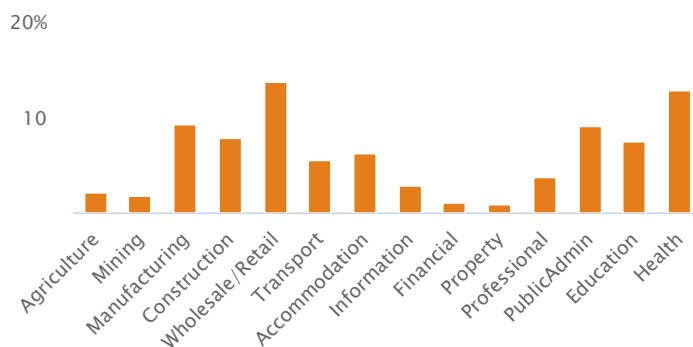

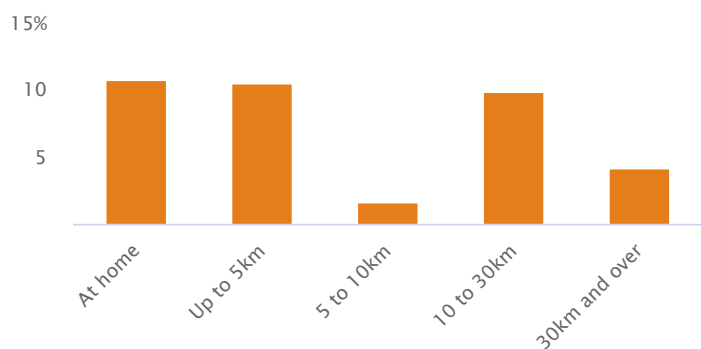
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

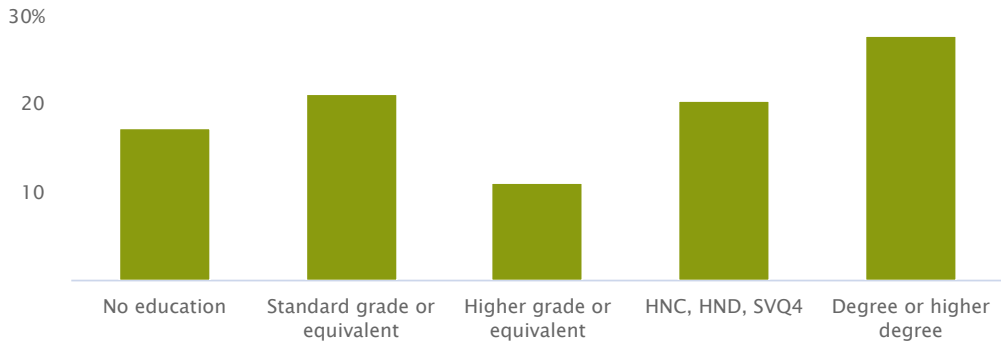


Distance travelled to work

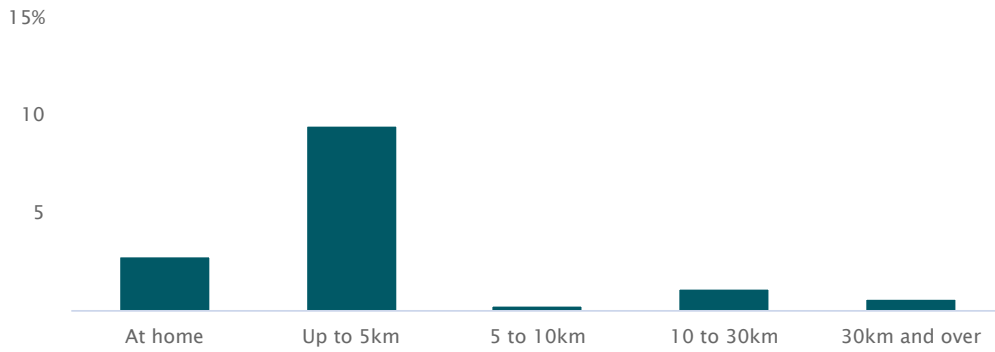
