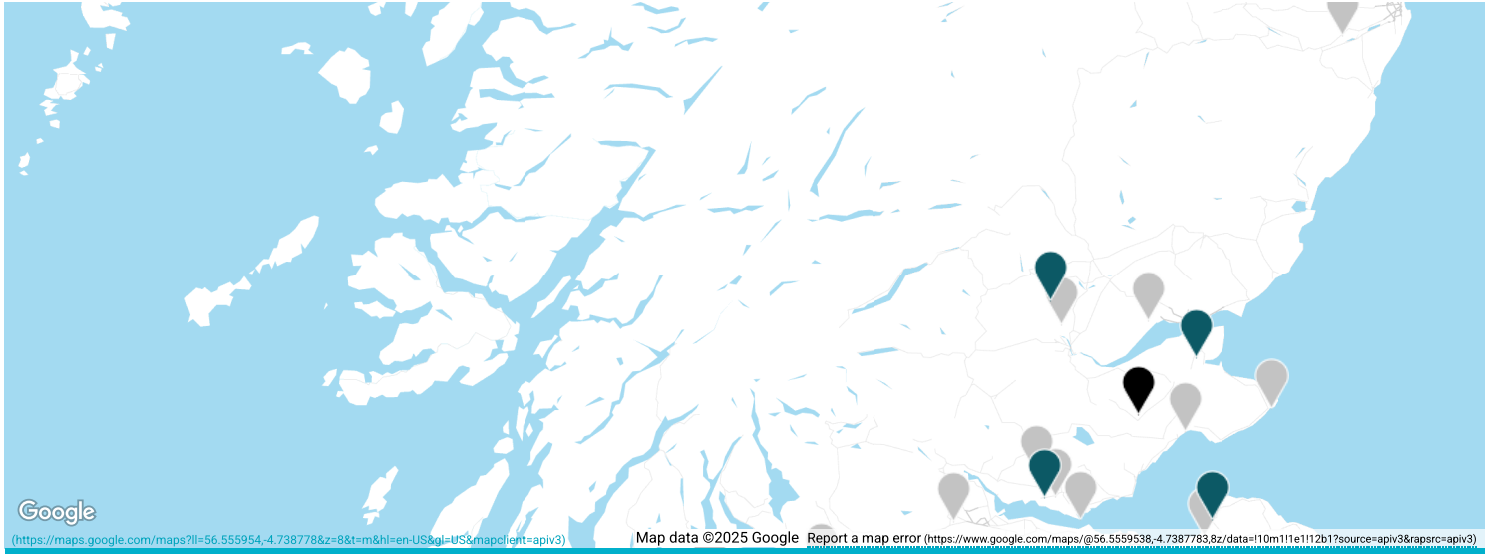

Freuchie is in Fife. Historically those banished from the Royal Court at Falkland were sent to Freuchie. Today it retains small local businesses and is a local residential and service centre.

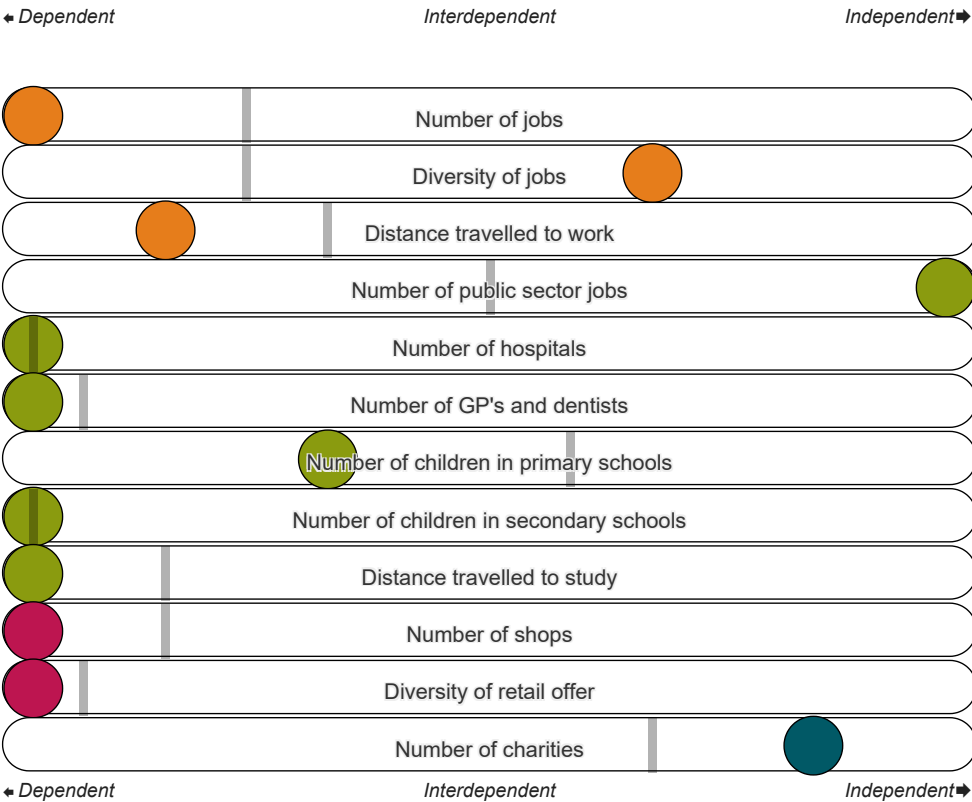
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Freuchie is a dependent to interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Freuchie is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Freuchie is grouped with 19 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Freuchie differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

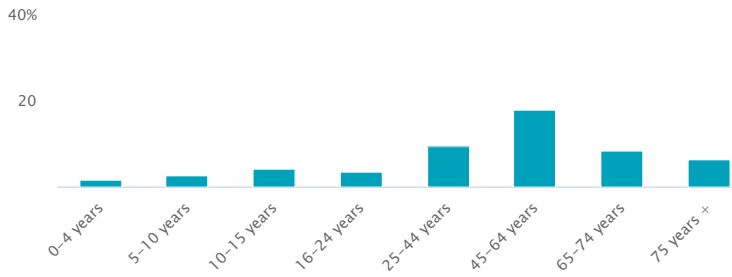

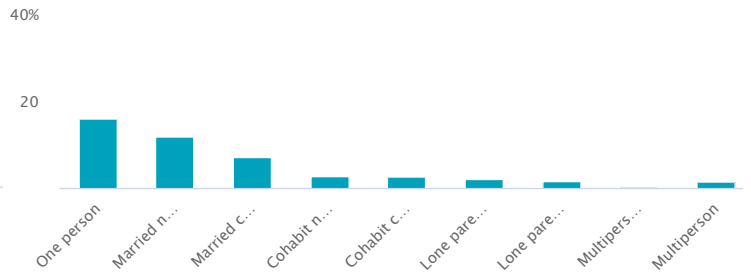

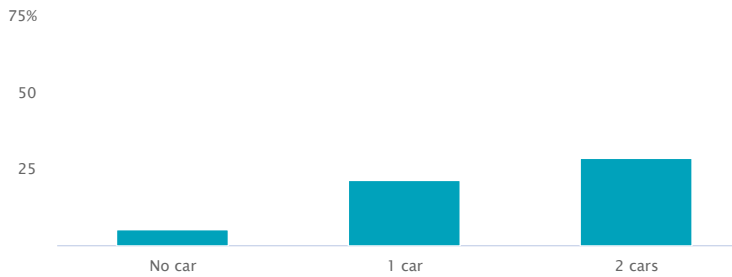

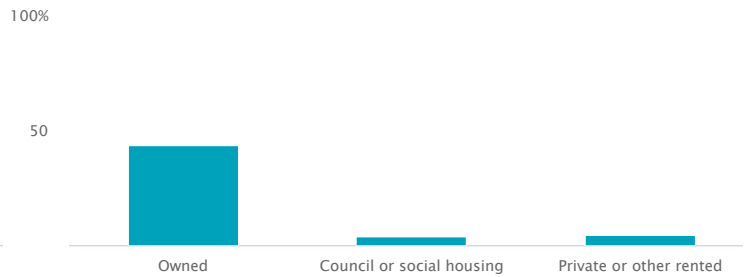
Household composition

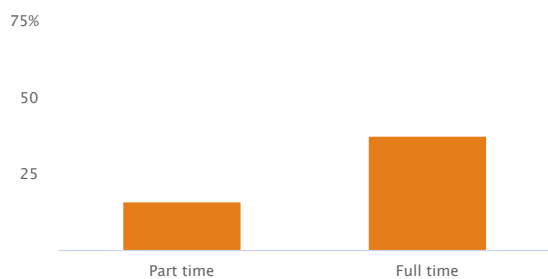

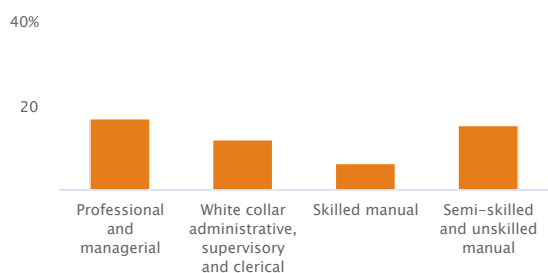
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



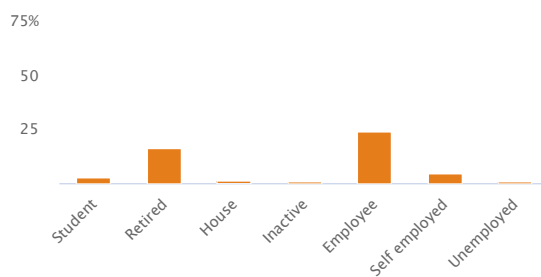
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)

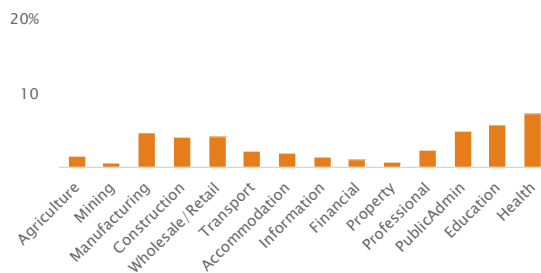

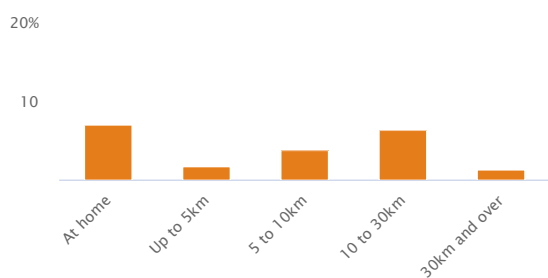

Sector Diversity

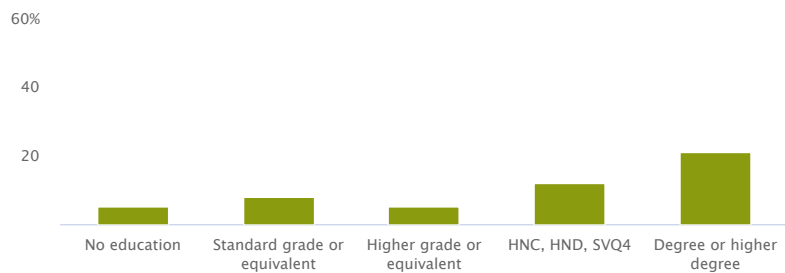


Distance travelled to work

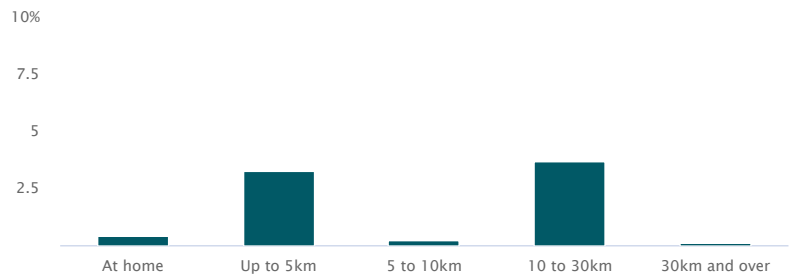
