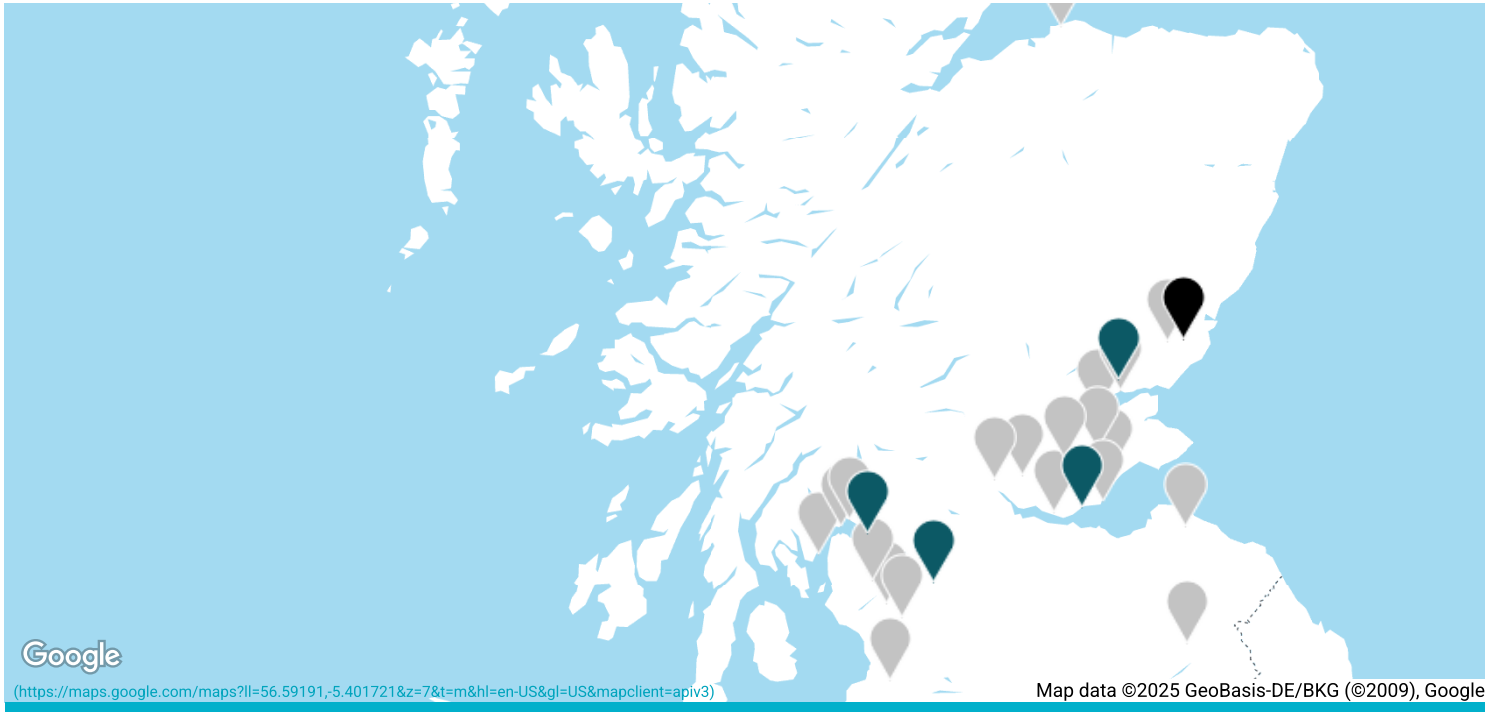

Friockheim is in Angus whose origins lie in the flax industry. Activities realte to agriculture. Some additional housing for local workers has been built.

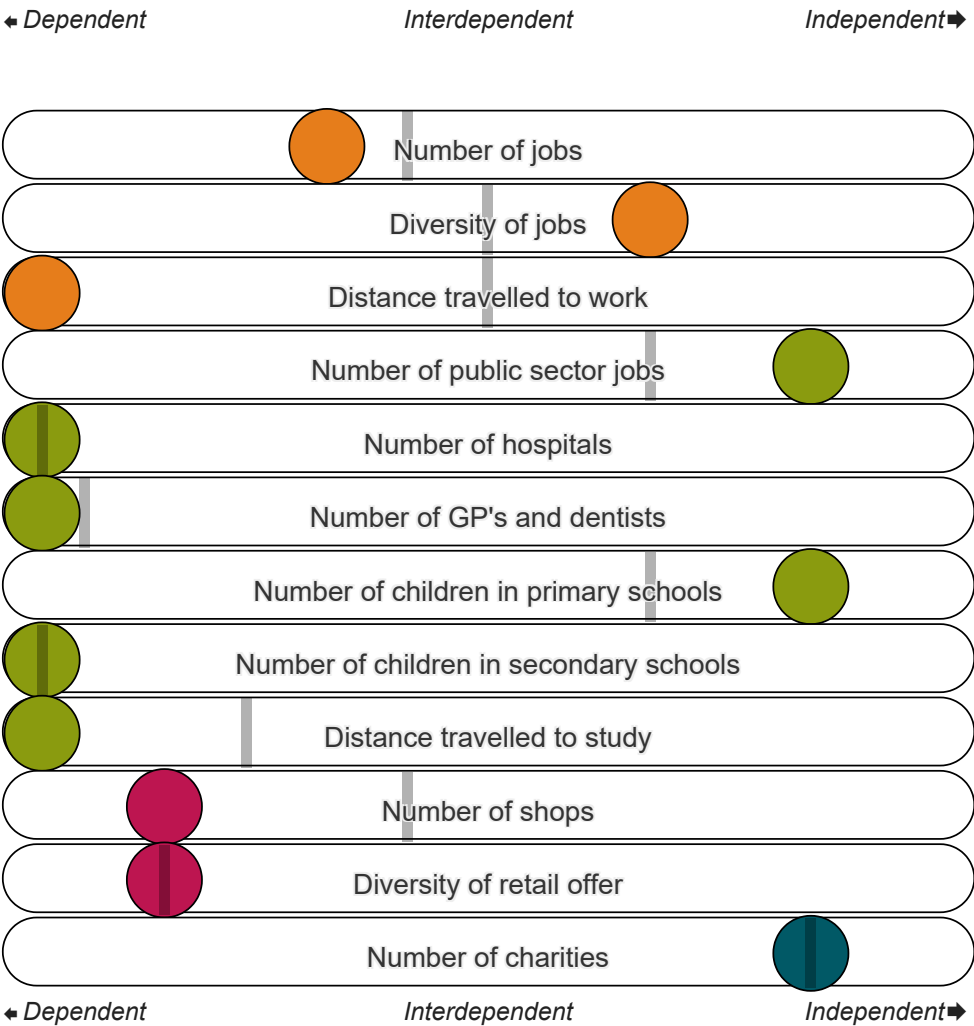
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

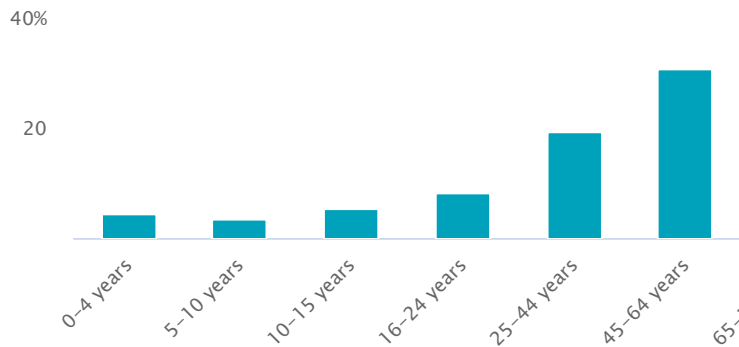
Friockheim differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

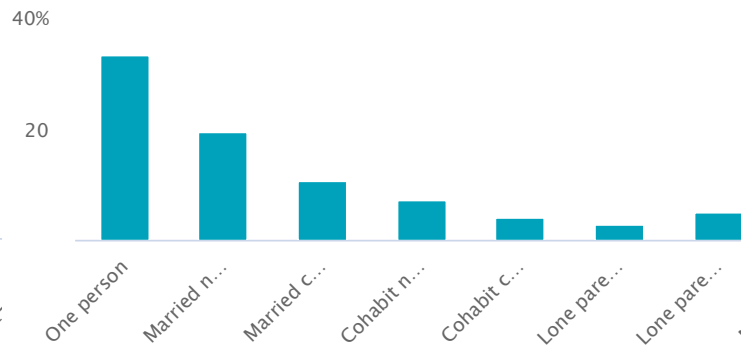

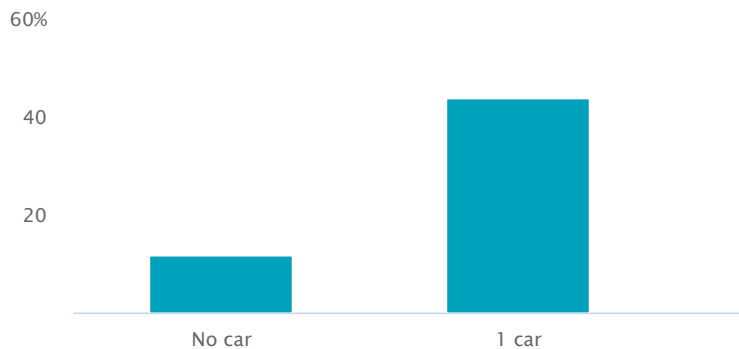
Age



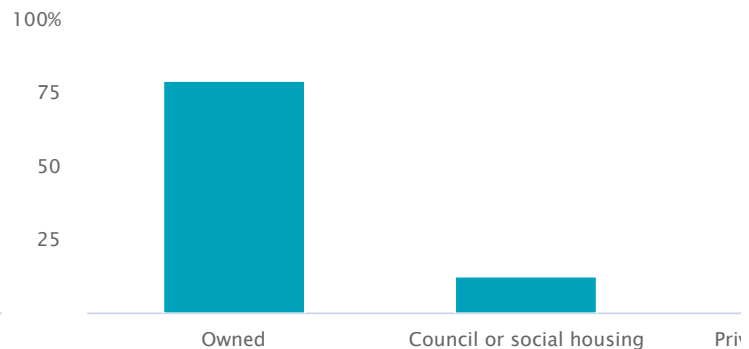
Household composition

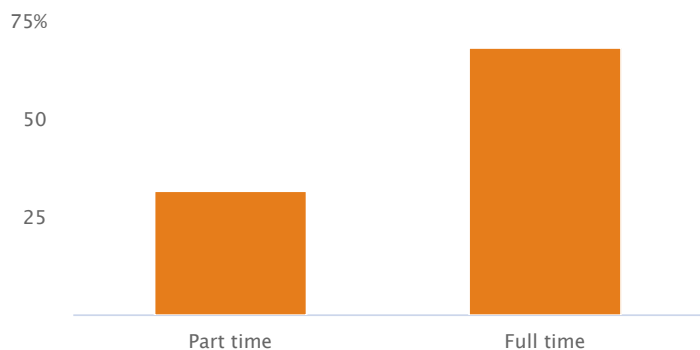

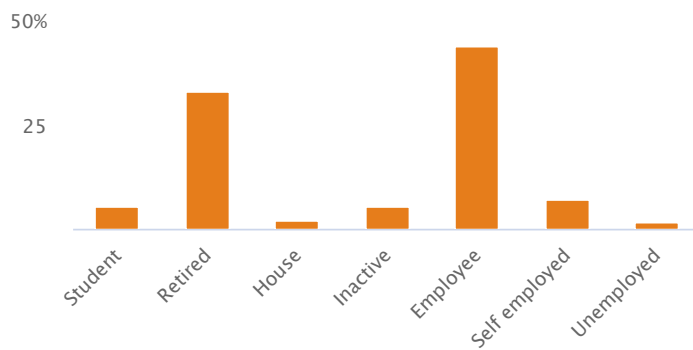
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



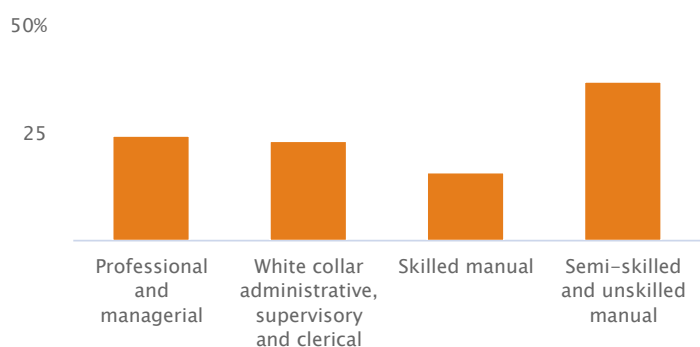
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

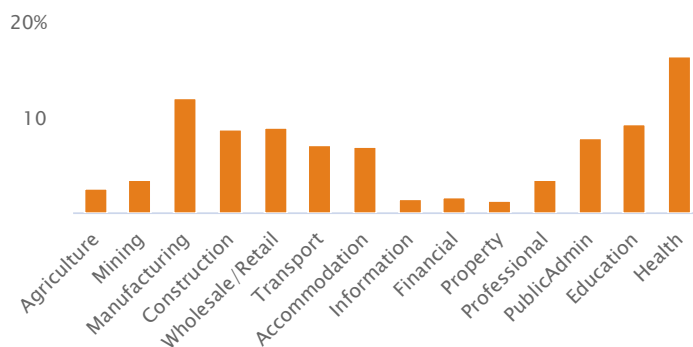


Social Grade

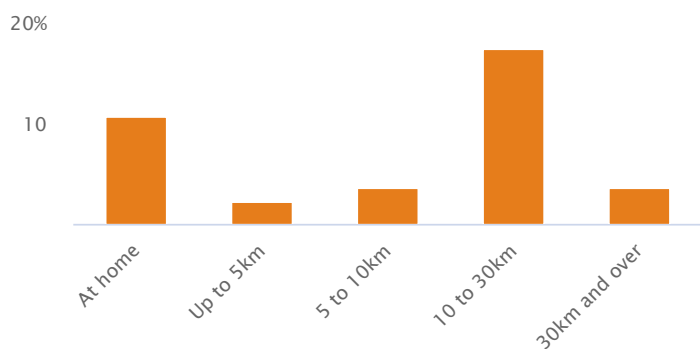
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

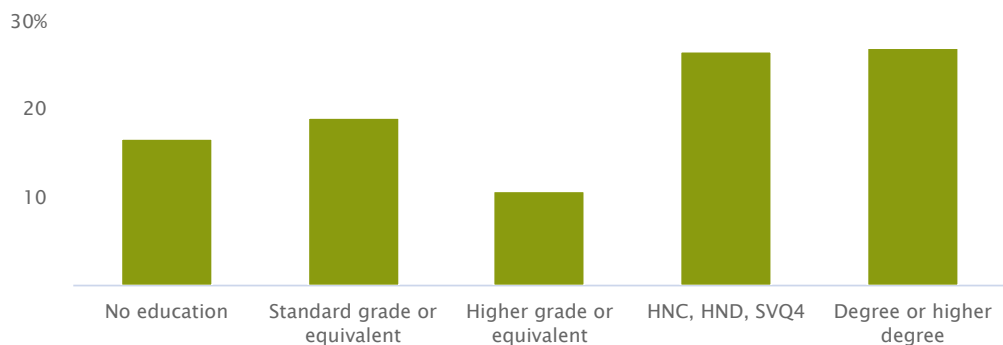


Distance travelled to work

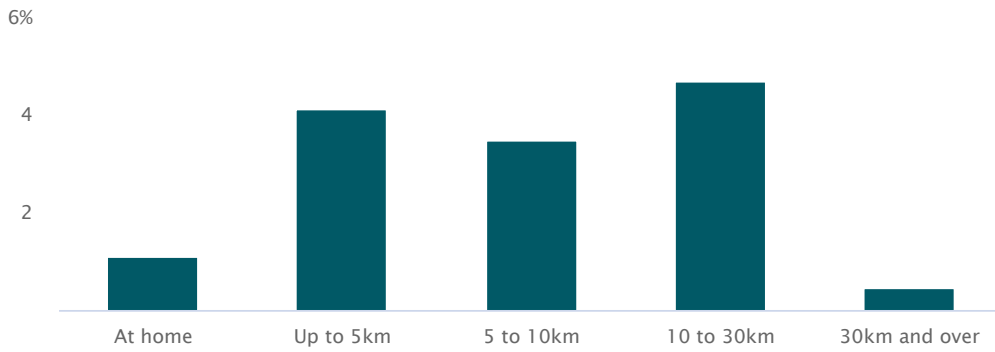
