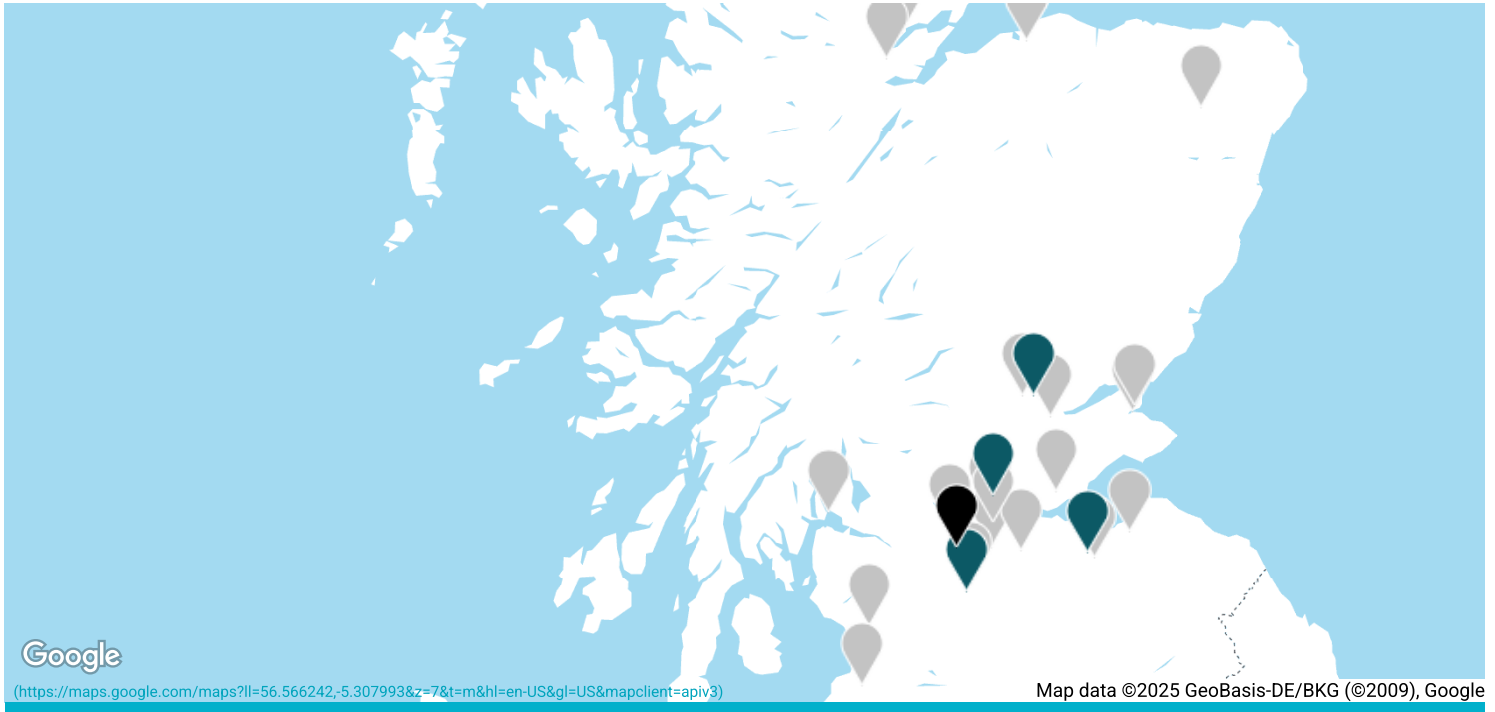




Glenmavis

Glenmavis in North Lanarkshire is the combination of several hamlets. It developed as a mining town. It used to have the Glenmavis Liquefied Natural Gas Storage facility.

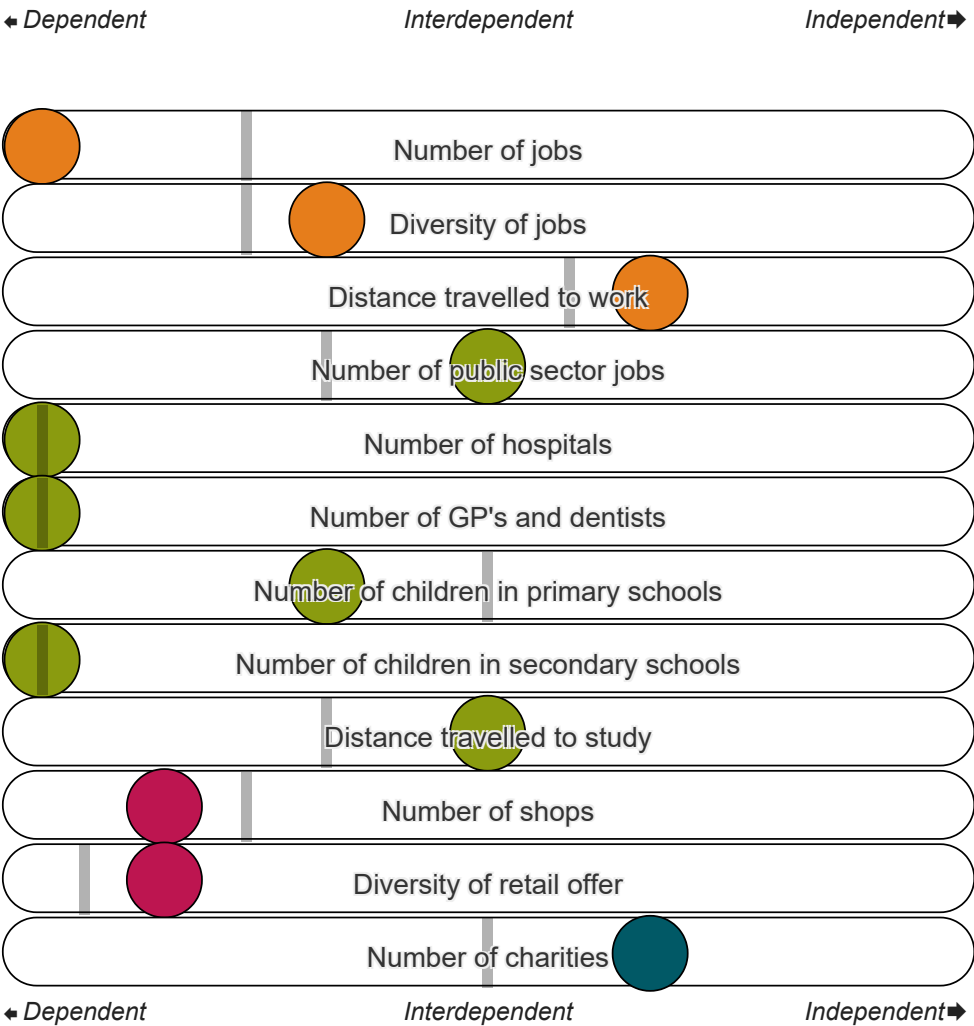
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Glenmavis is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Glenmavis is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

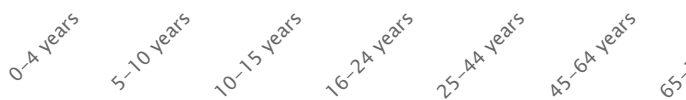

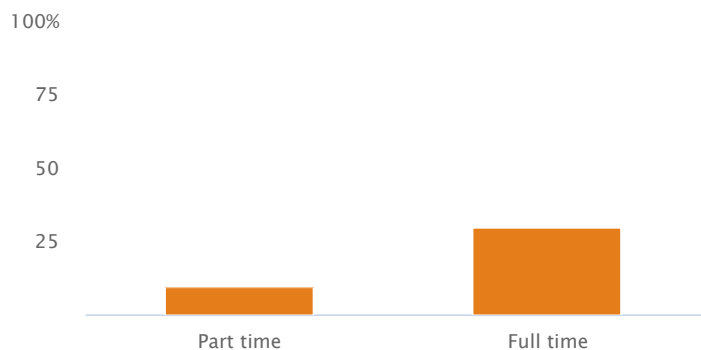

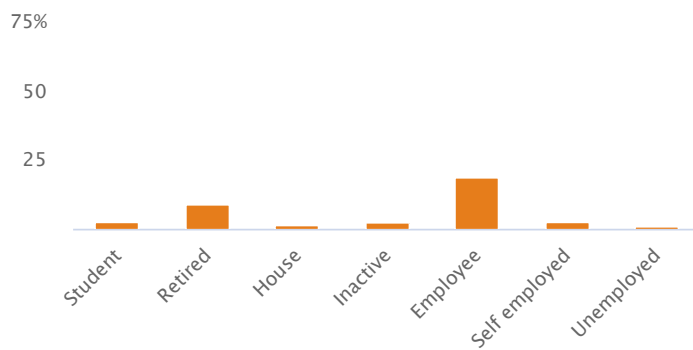
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



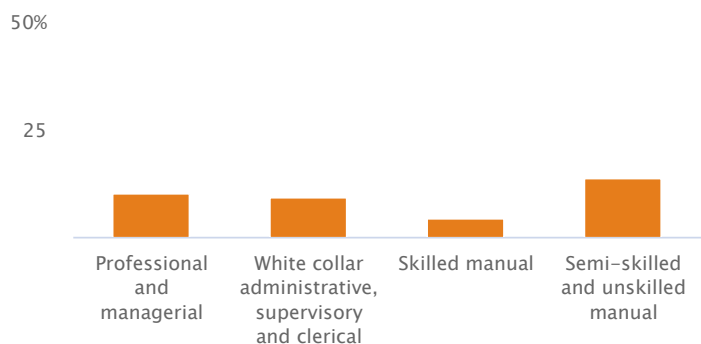
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

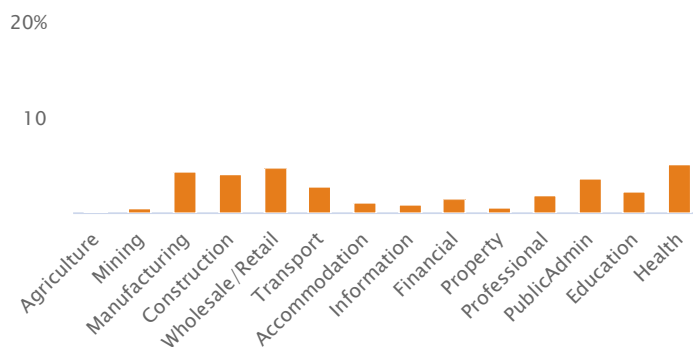


Social Grade

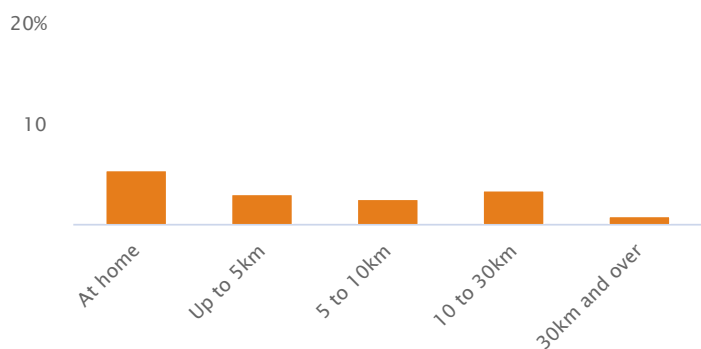
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

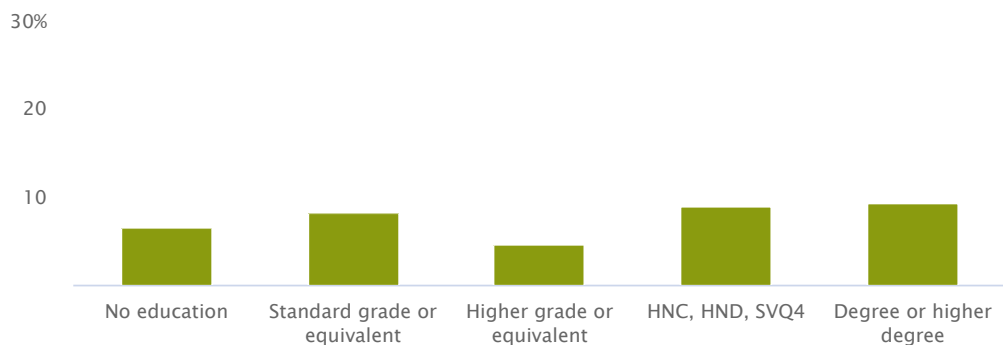


Distance travelled to work

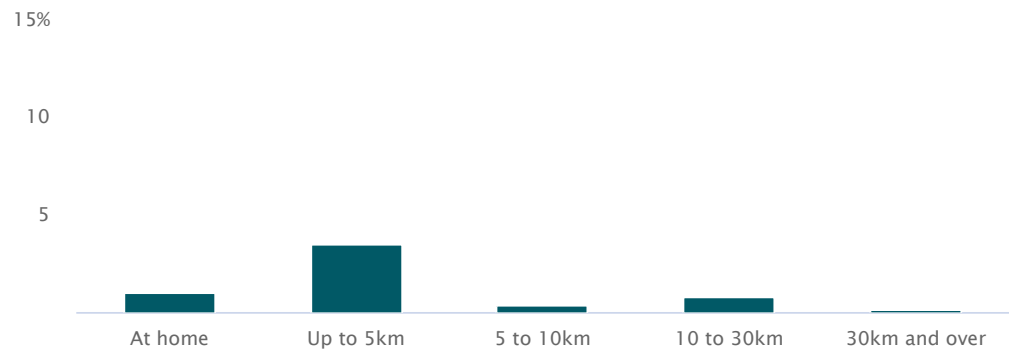
