Golspie in Sutherland is in Highland. Golspie was a fishing village which expanded after the 1745 to house those who had been evicted from crofts. It is now a tourist town and local service centre.

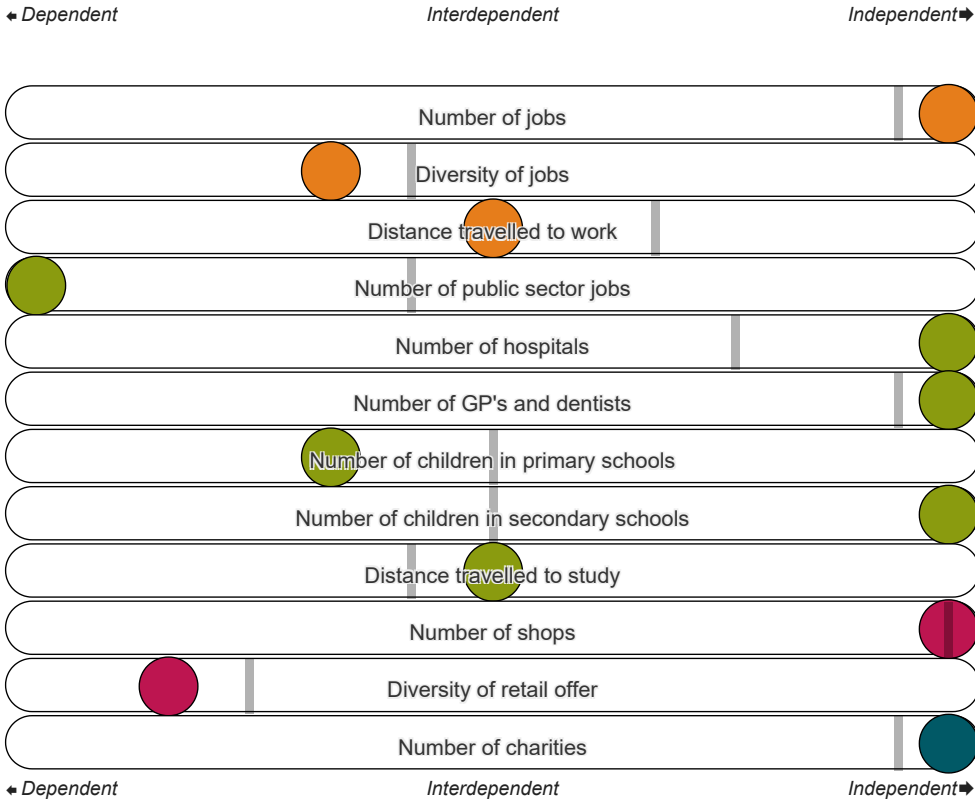
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Golspie is an interdependent to independent town.

Its most similar towns are [Aviemore](#), [Dufftown](#), [Langholm](#), and [Pitlochry](#).

Inter-relationships



Golspie is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Golspie is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of hospitals, and children in secondary schools. Golspie differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs.

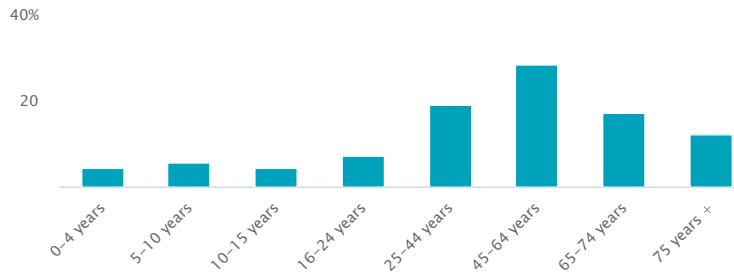

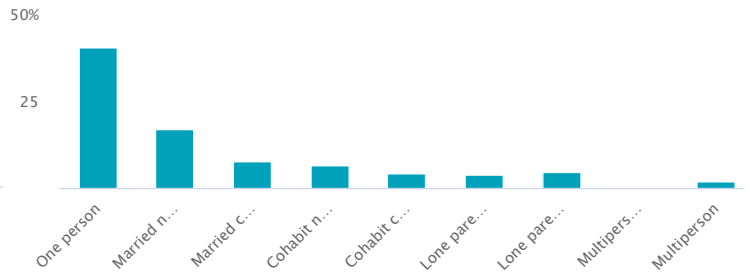

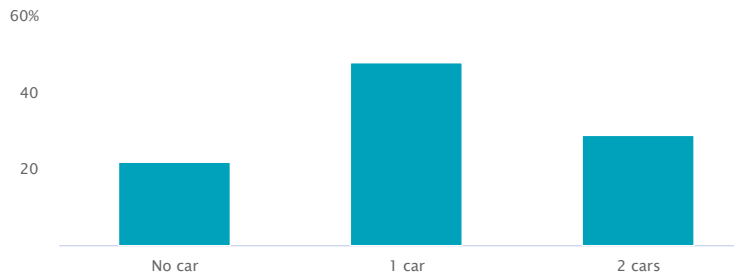

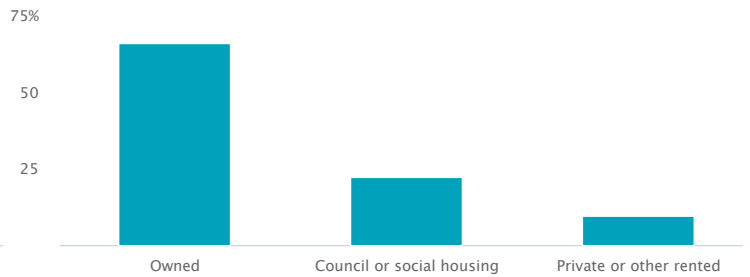
Household composition

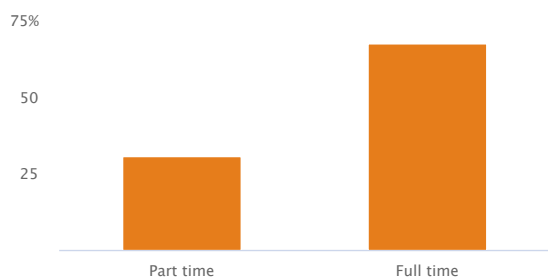

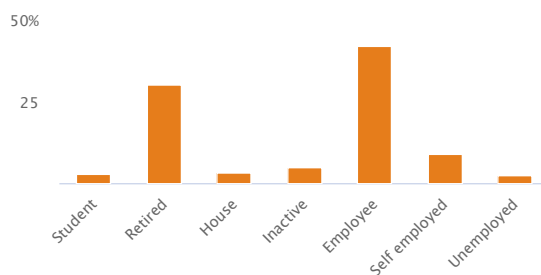
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



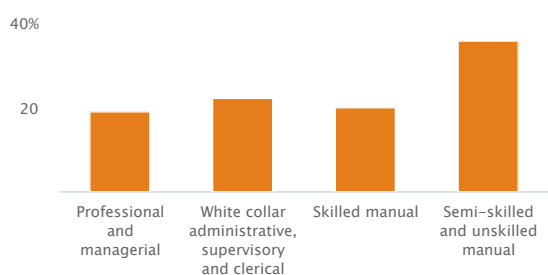
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

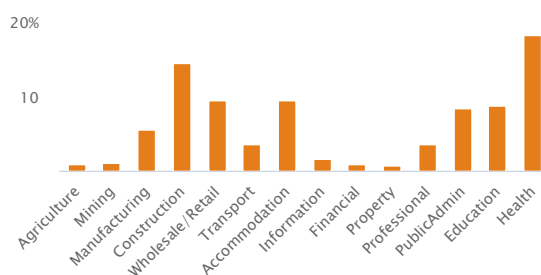

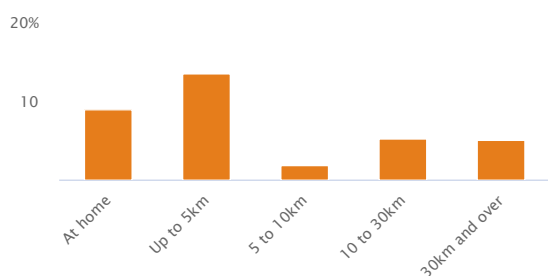
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

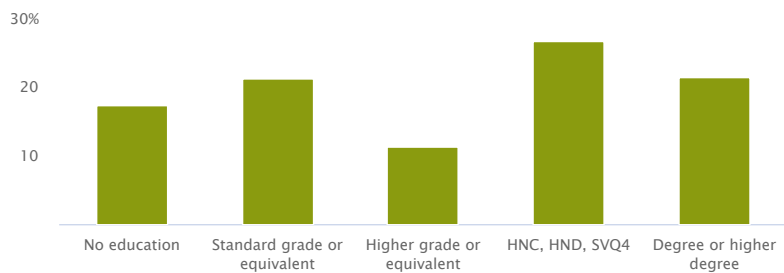


Distance travelled to work

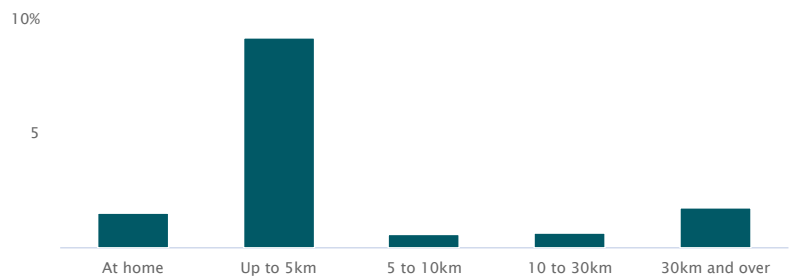
