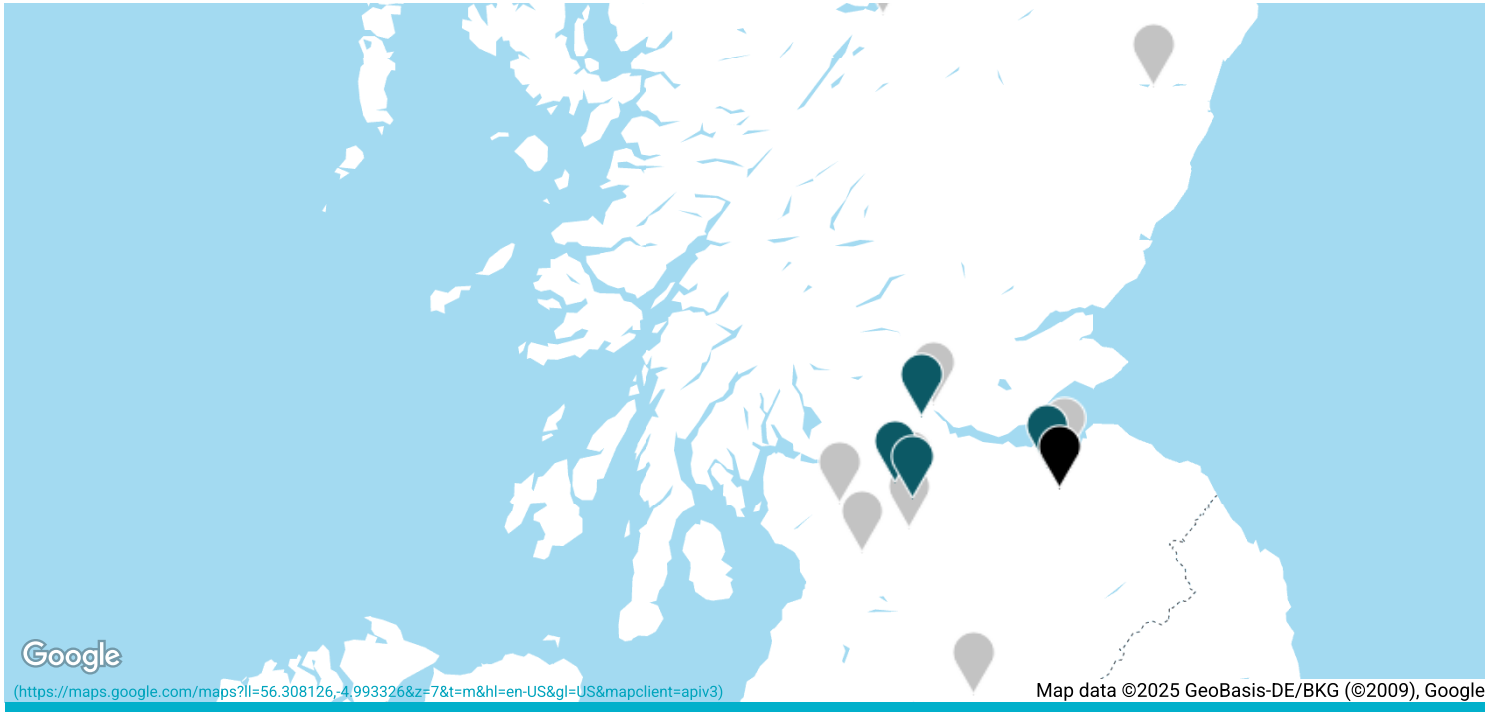




Gorebridge

Gorebridge is in Midlothian. In the 19th century coal, lime and gunpowder came from Gorebridge. Mining continued until the 1960s. In the 1950s the town was extended with new public housing. With the re-opening of the Borders railway and new private housing it is now a popular commuter settlement.

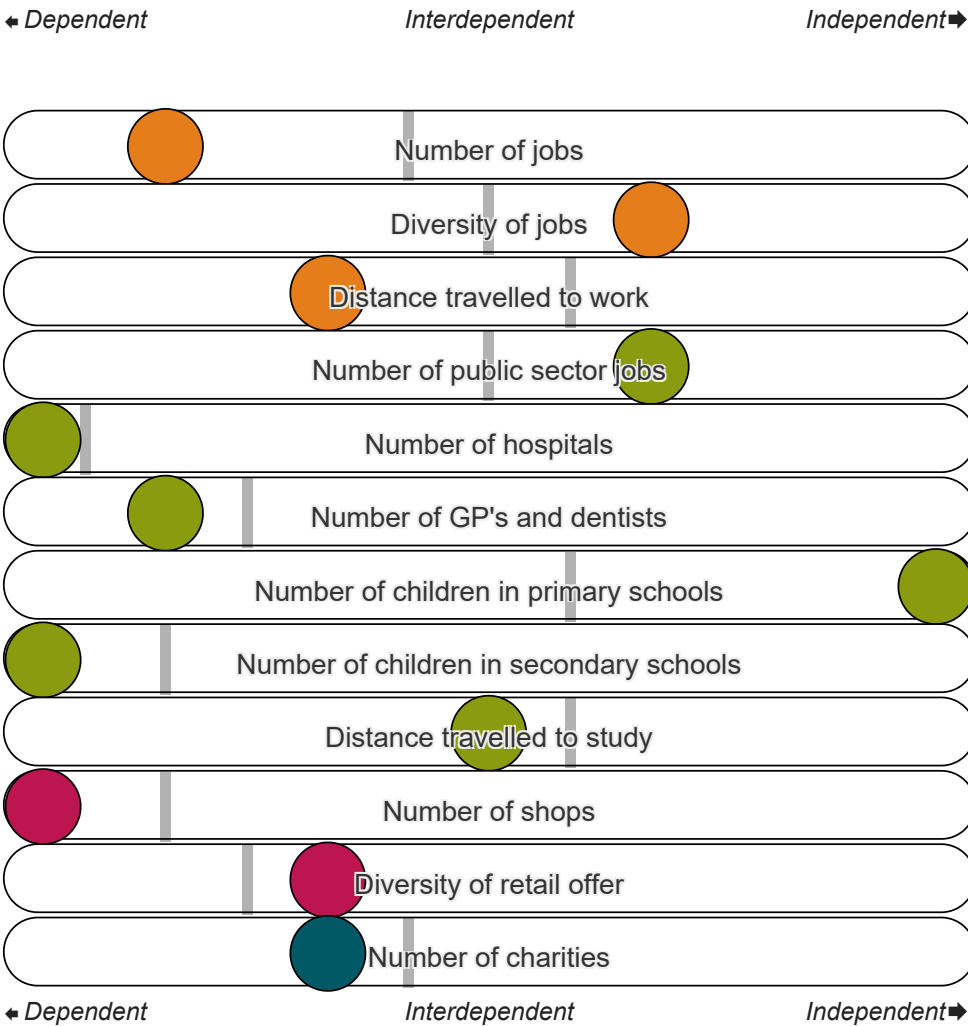
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Gorebridge is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Gorebridge is grouped with 14 other towns. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Gorebridge differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

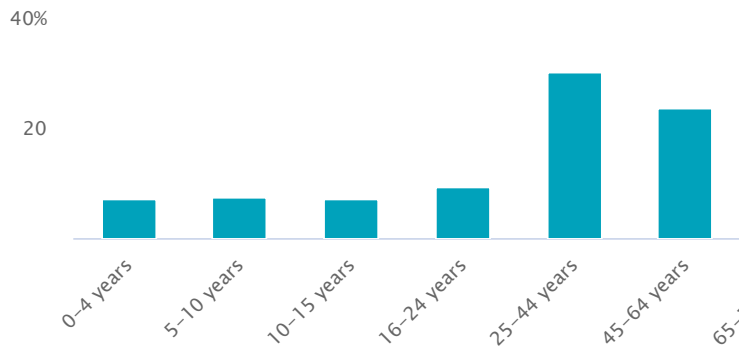

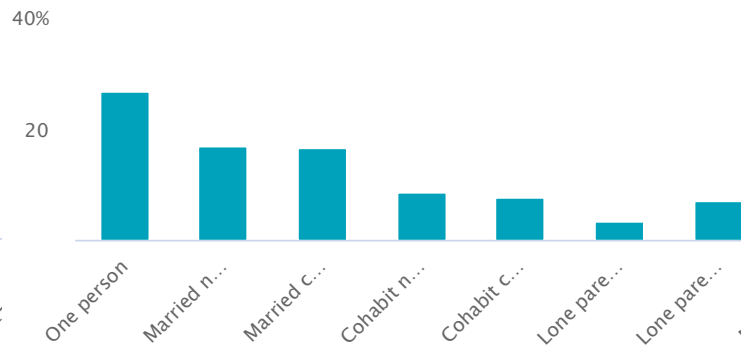

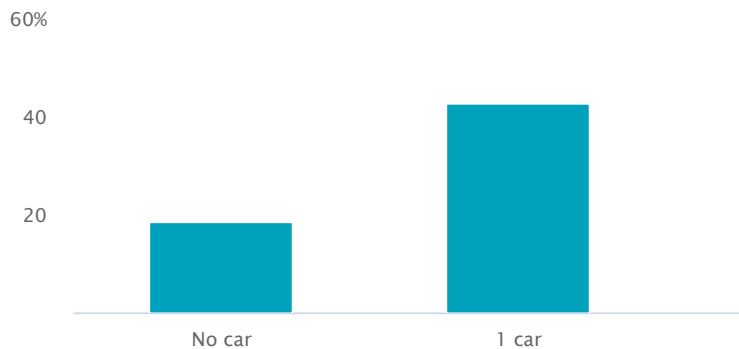

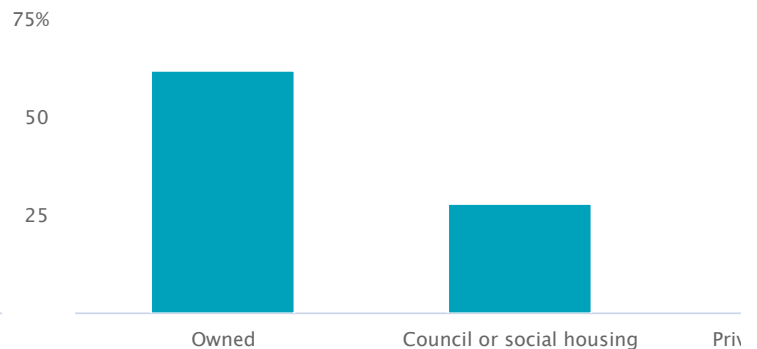
Household composition

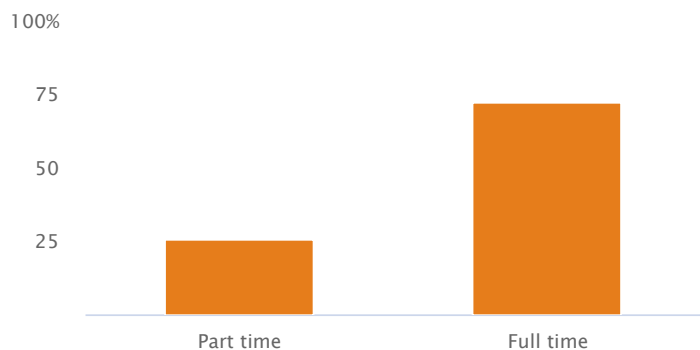

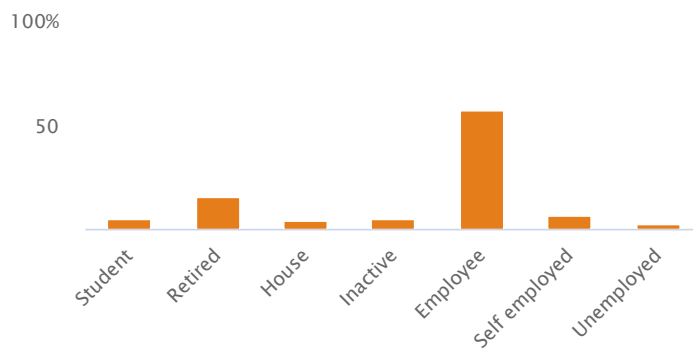
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



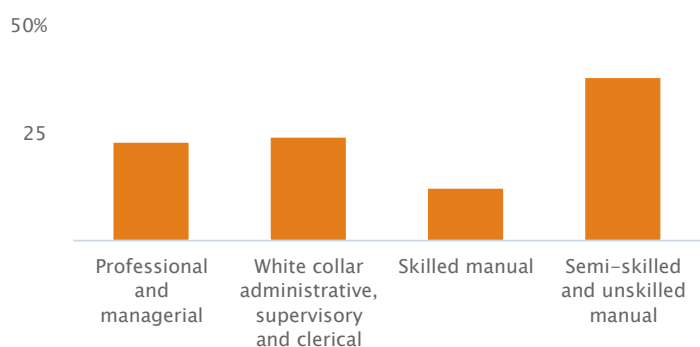
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

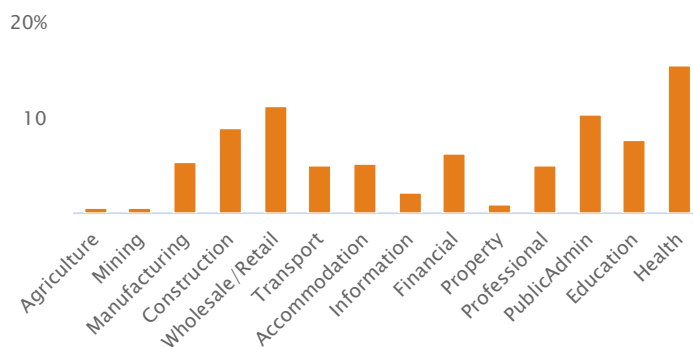

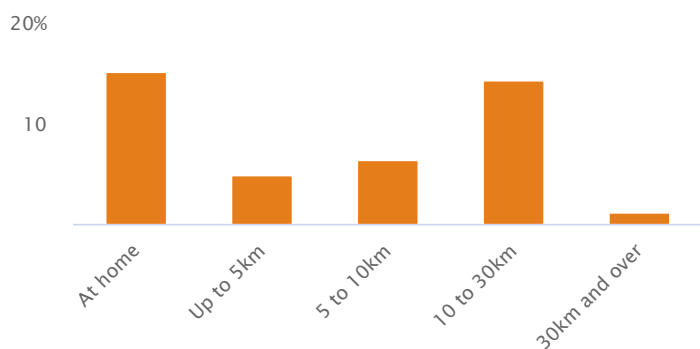
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

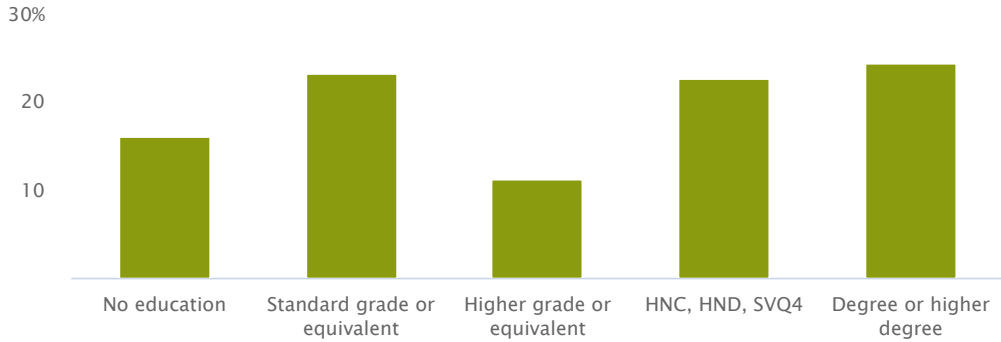


Distance travelled to work

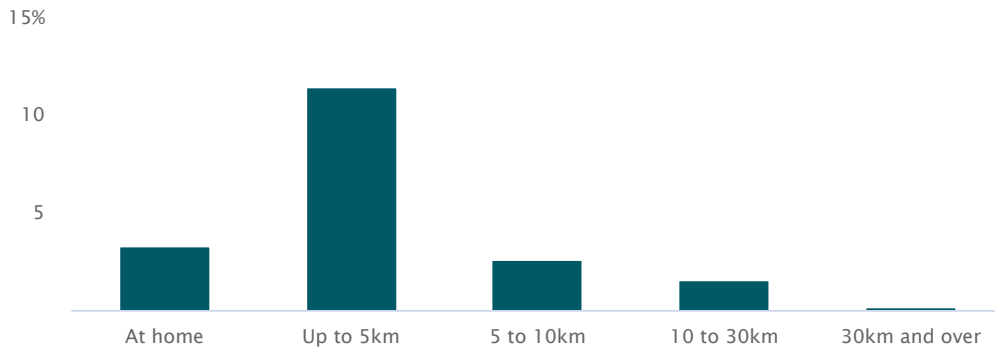
