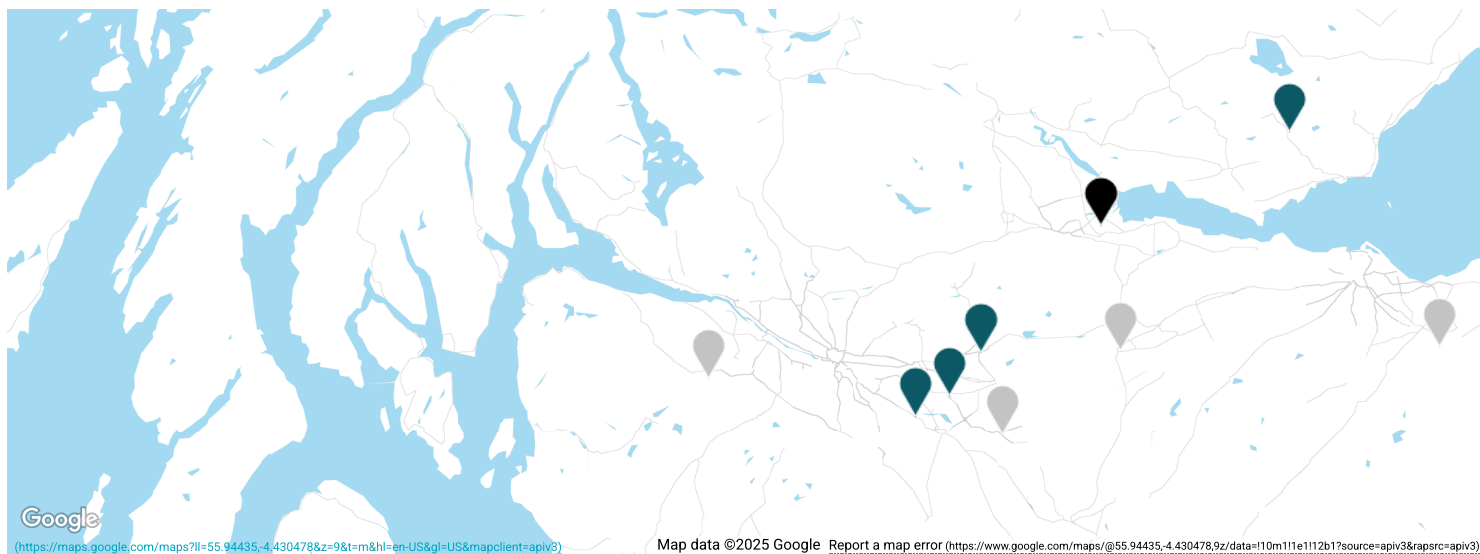




Grangemouth

Grangemouth in Falkirk Council is an industrial settlement was dominated by the petrochemical and oil refining works which has now closed. It has a deep water jetty for oil tankers. Even in the 19th century the petrochemicals of the time - glycerine, soap and dyes were manufactured in Grangemouth.

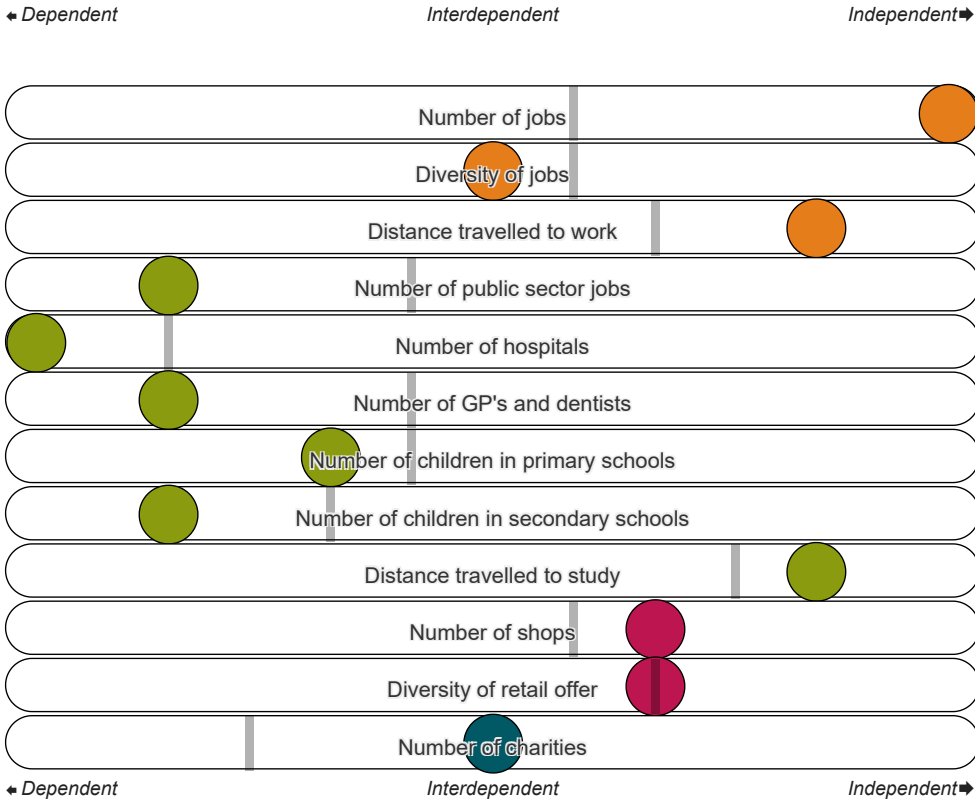
In large towns, people in this group experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Grangemouth is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Grangemouth is grouped with 8 other towns. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

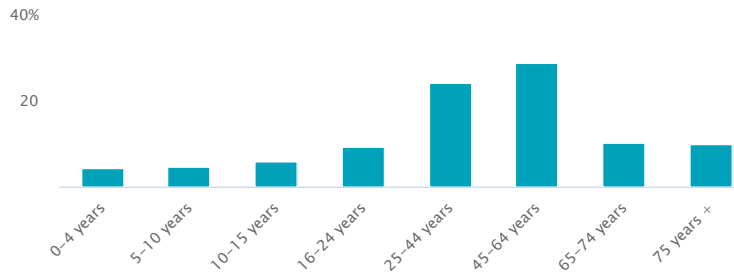

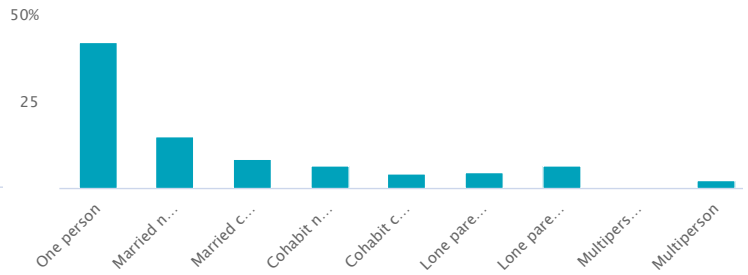

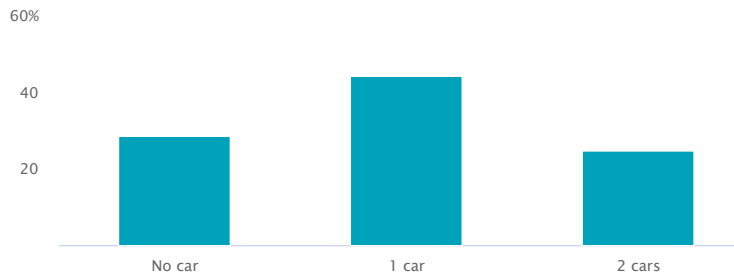

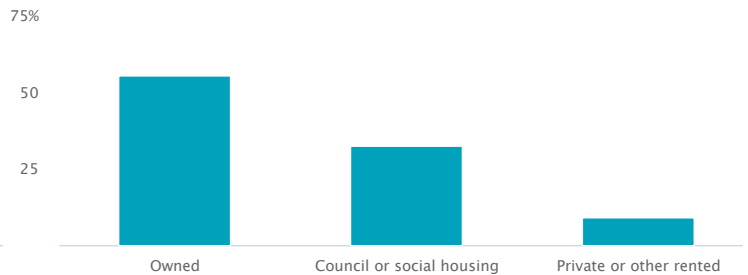

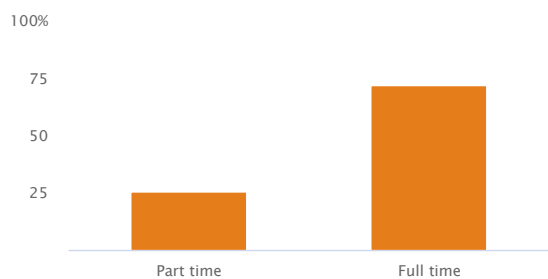

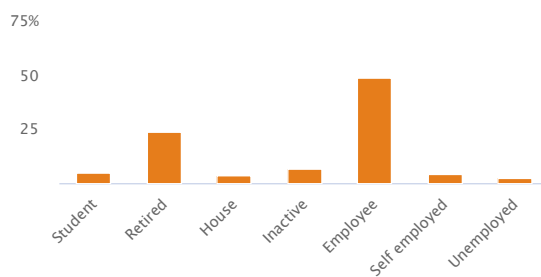
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



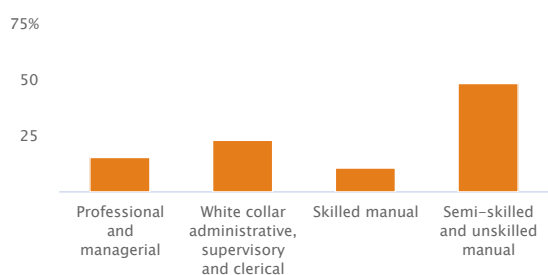
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

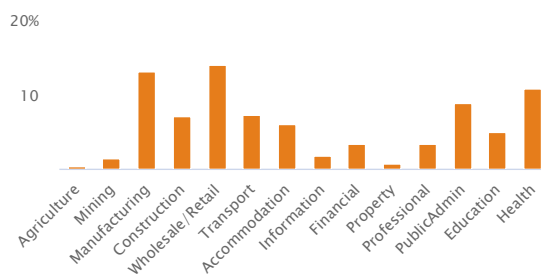


Social Grade

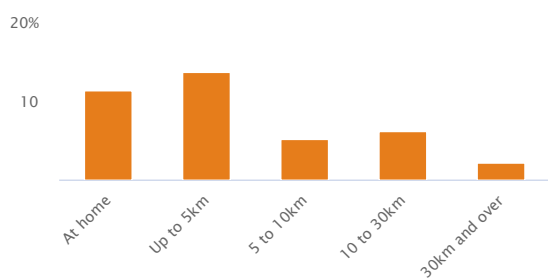
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

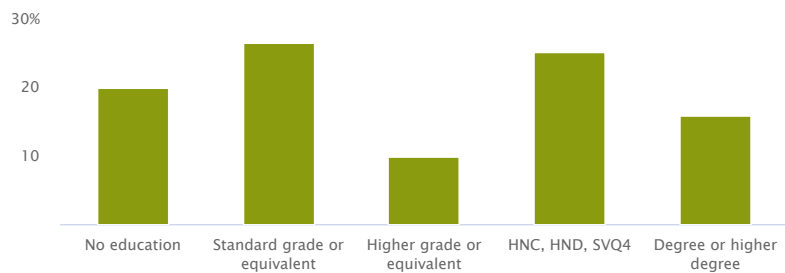


Distance travelled to work

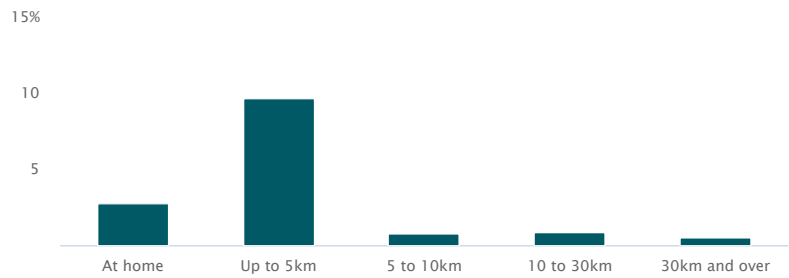
