Greenhill is in Dumfries and Galloway and is one of the Four Royal Towns of Lochmaben founded by King Robert I in the 14th century for his loyal soldiers. Today the local economy is focused on tourism.

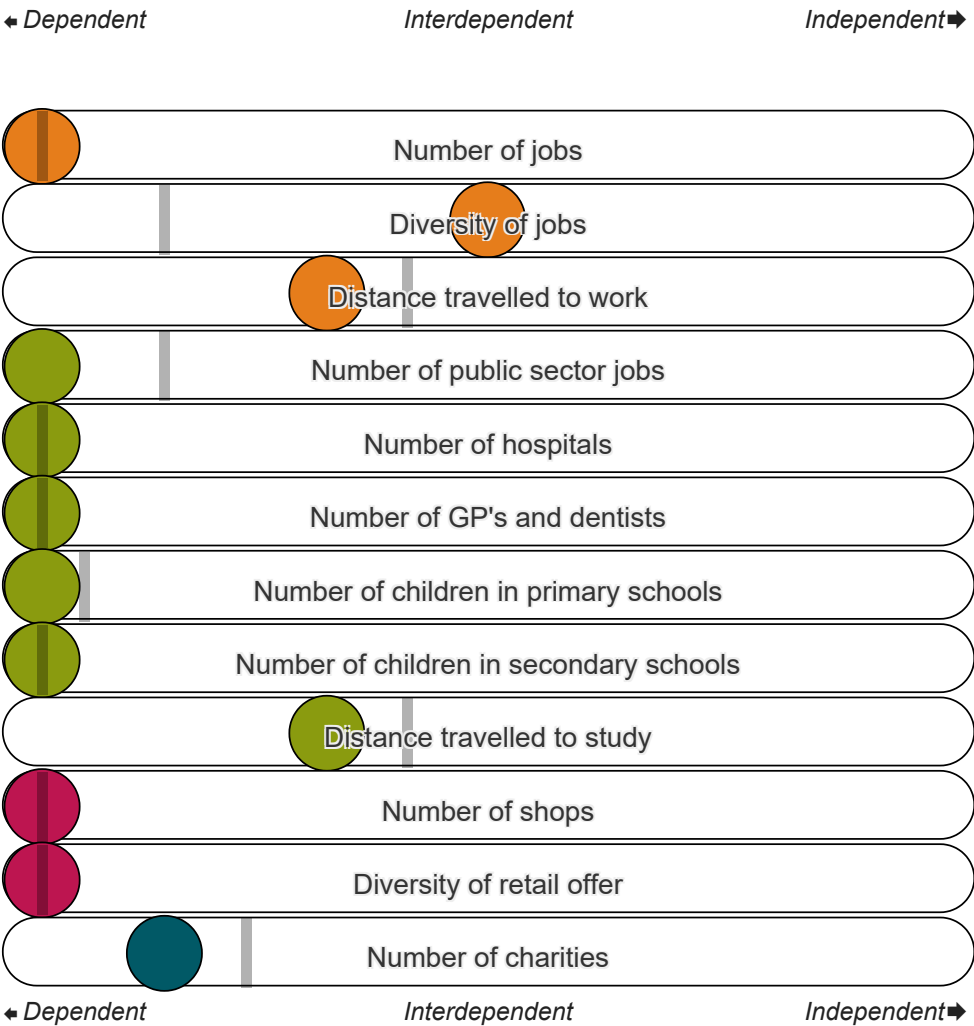
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

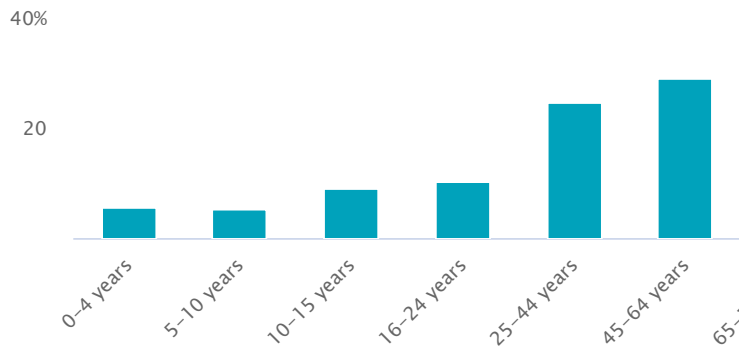

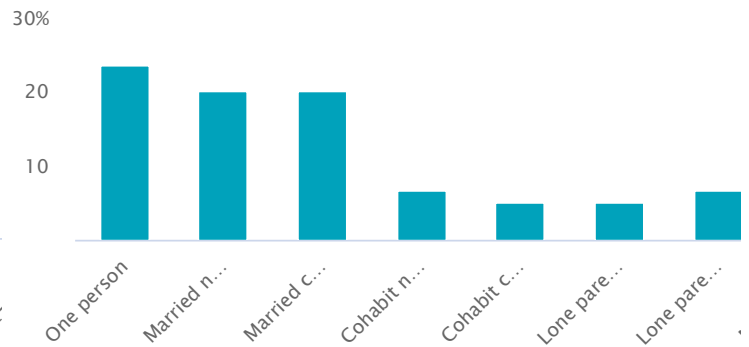

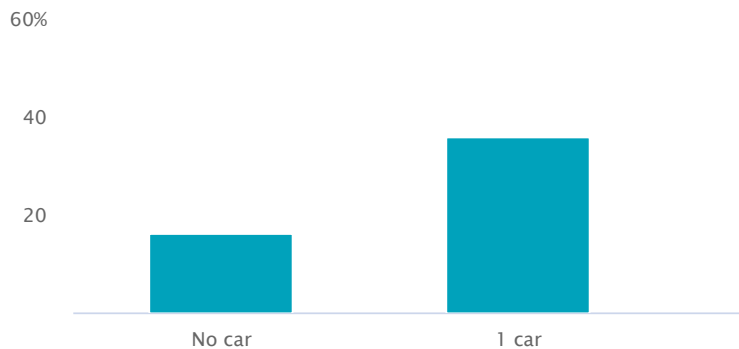

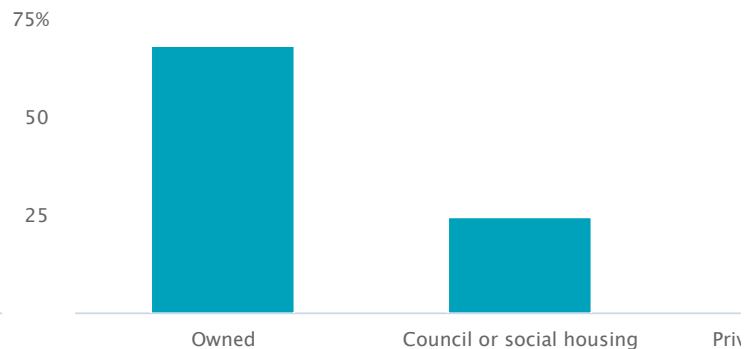

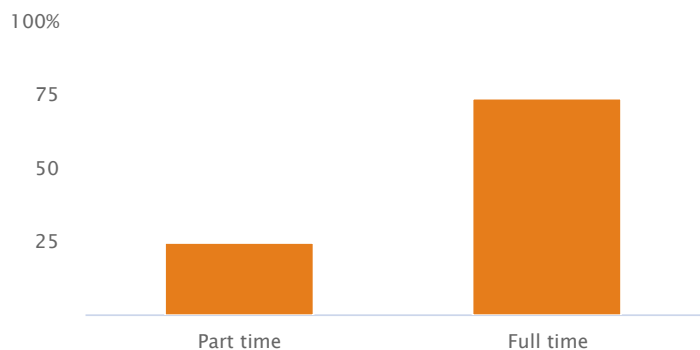

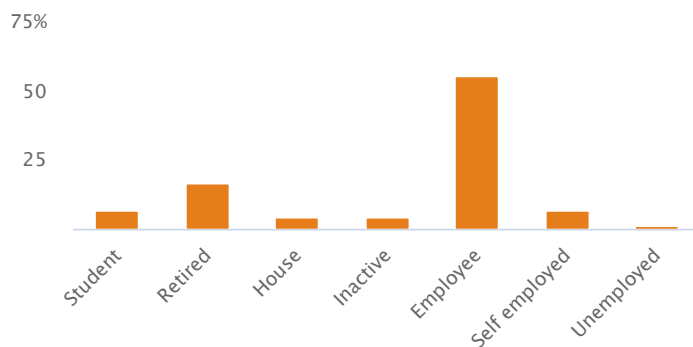
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



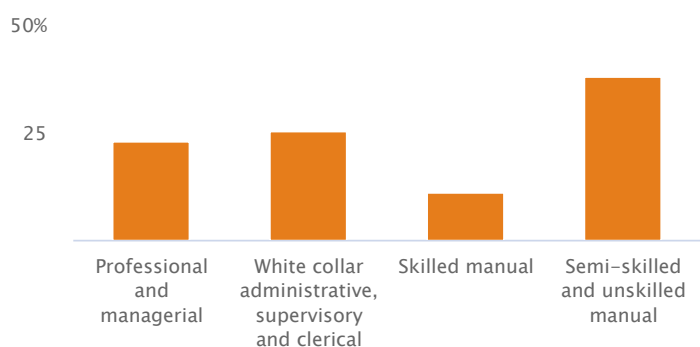
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

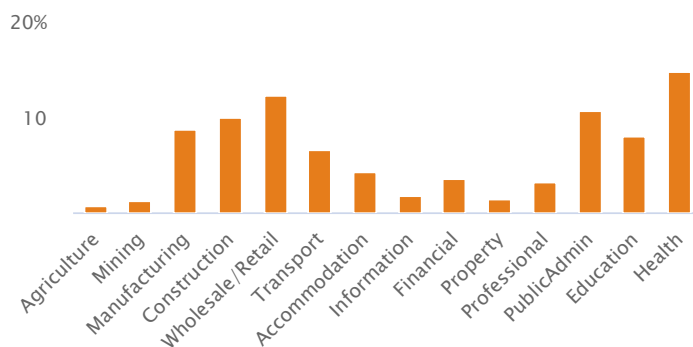

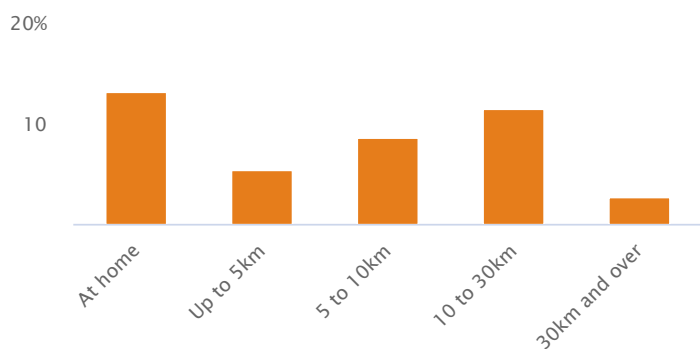
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

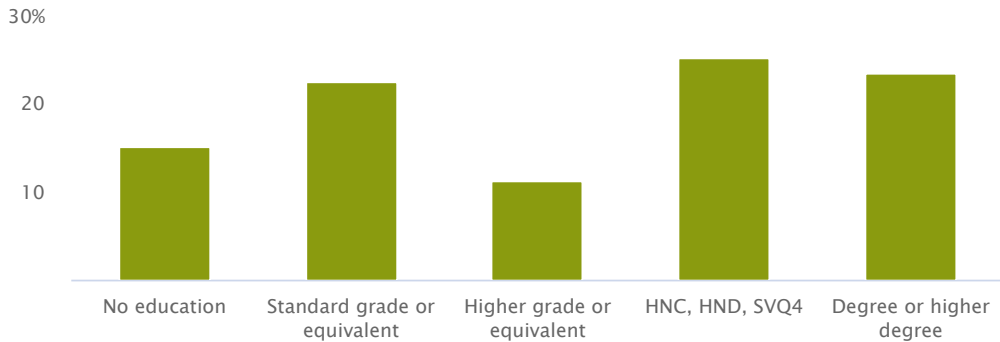


Distance travelled to work

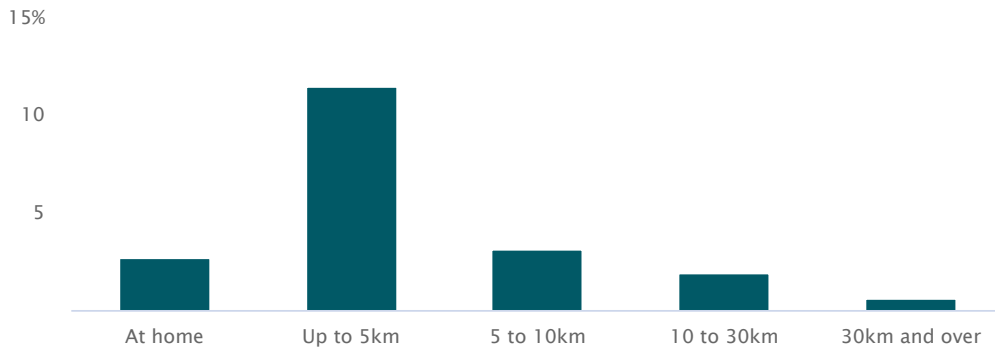
