Hallglen in Falkirk Council is an estate which acts as a suburb of Falkirk dating from the 1970s.


In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Its most similar towns are Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill, Faifley, Fauldhouse, and Hurlford and Crookedholm.

## Population change 2011 to 2022






#### **Employment type**

(% households aged 16-64)










