Head of Muir is in Falkirk Council It is a local service centre.

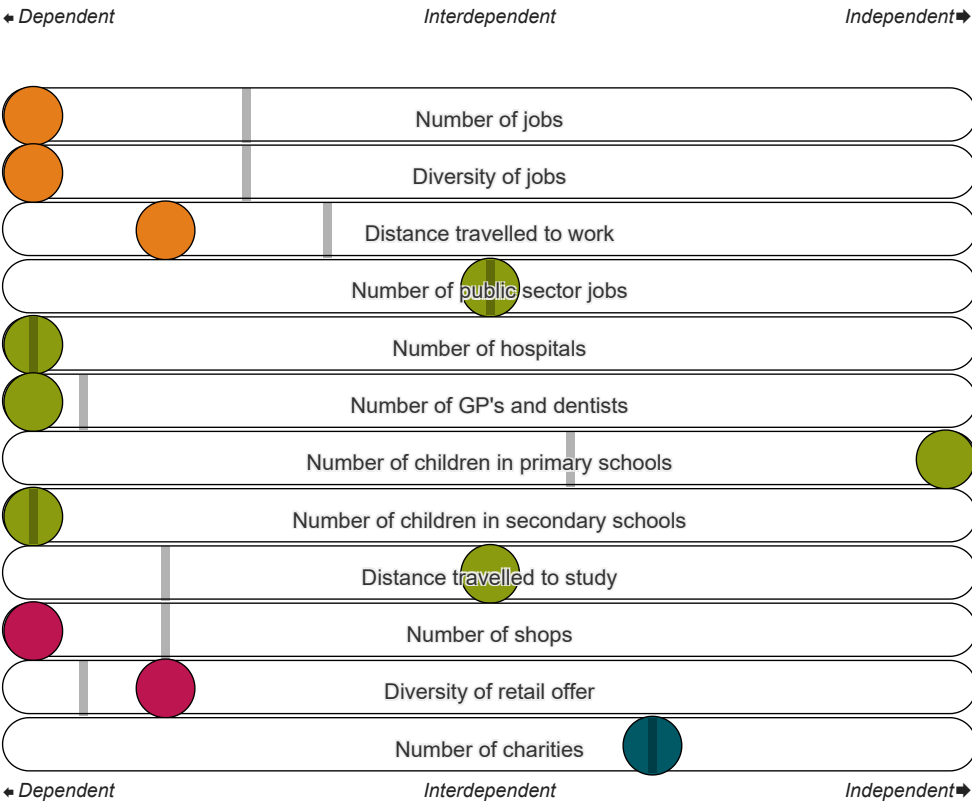
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Head of Muir is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Head of Muir is grouped with 19 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Head of Muir differs most from its group in the number of jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

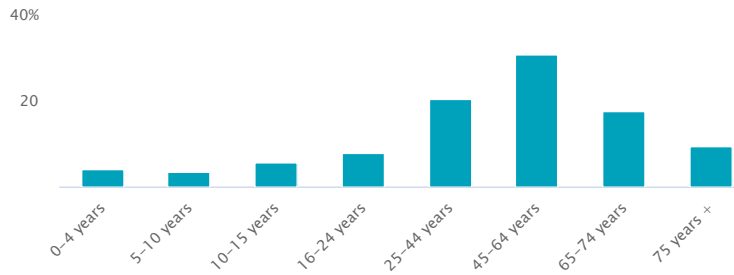

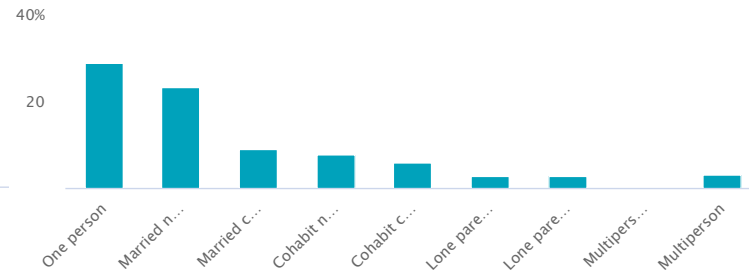

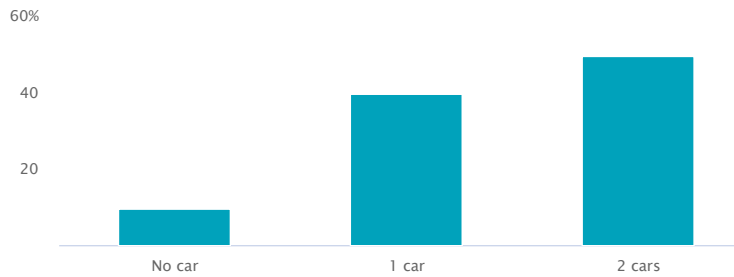

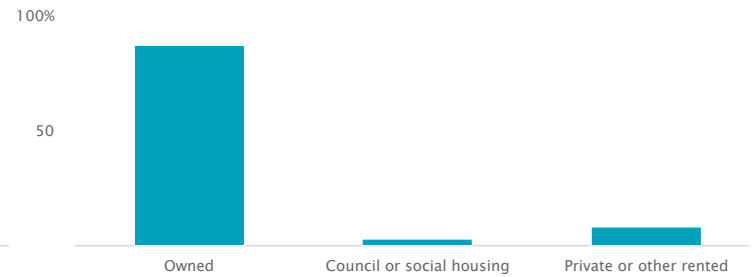

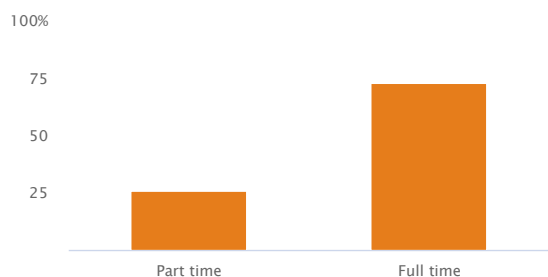

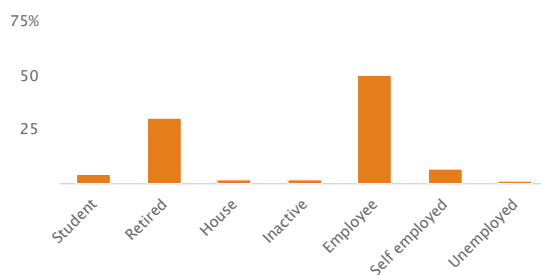
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



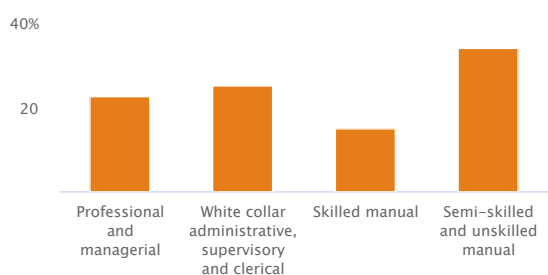
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

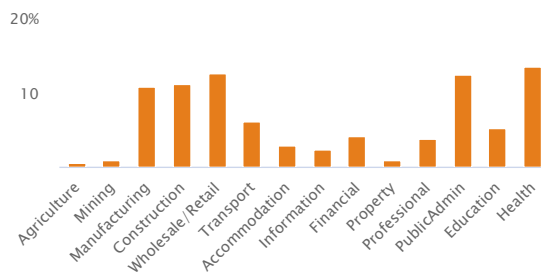

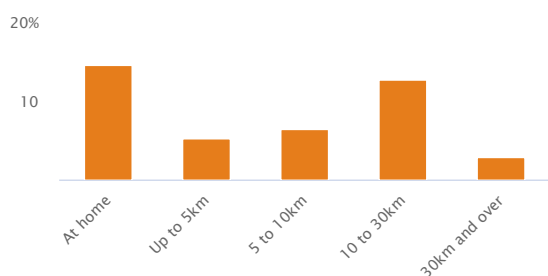
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

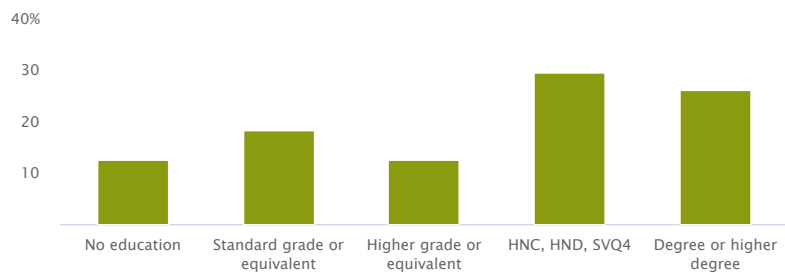


Distance travelled to work

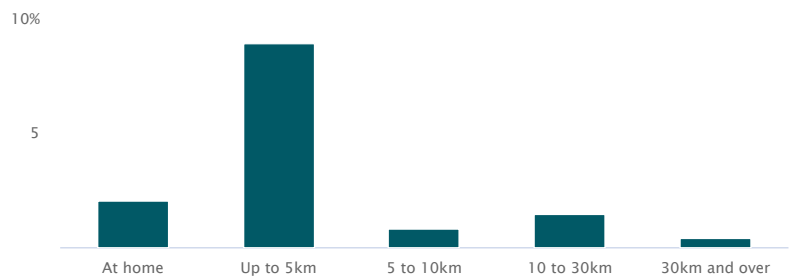
