Helensburgh is in Argyll and Bute. Helensburgh was founded in 1776 by Colquhoun of Luss as a spa and who named it after his wife. The town developed as a tourist centre. The steamer trade and the railway made it accessible to Glaswegians enjoying a day trip. The town was also popular with wealthy businessmen in the VIctorian era. Today it is a commuter town.


In large towns such as this one, the population typically is older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Helensburgh is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Carnoustie, South Queensferry, and Troon.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






