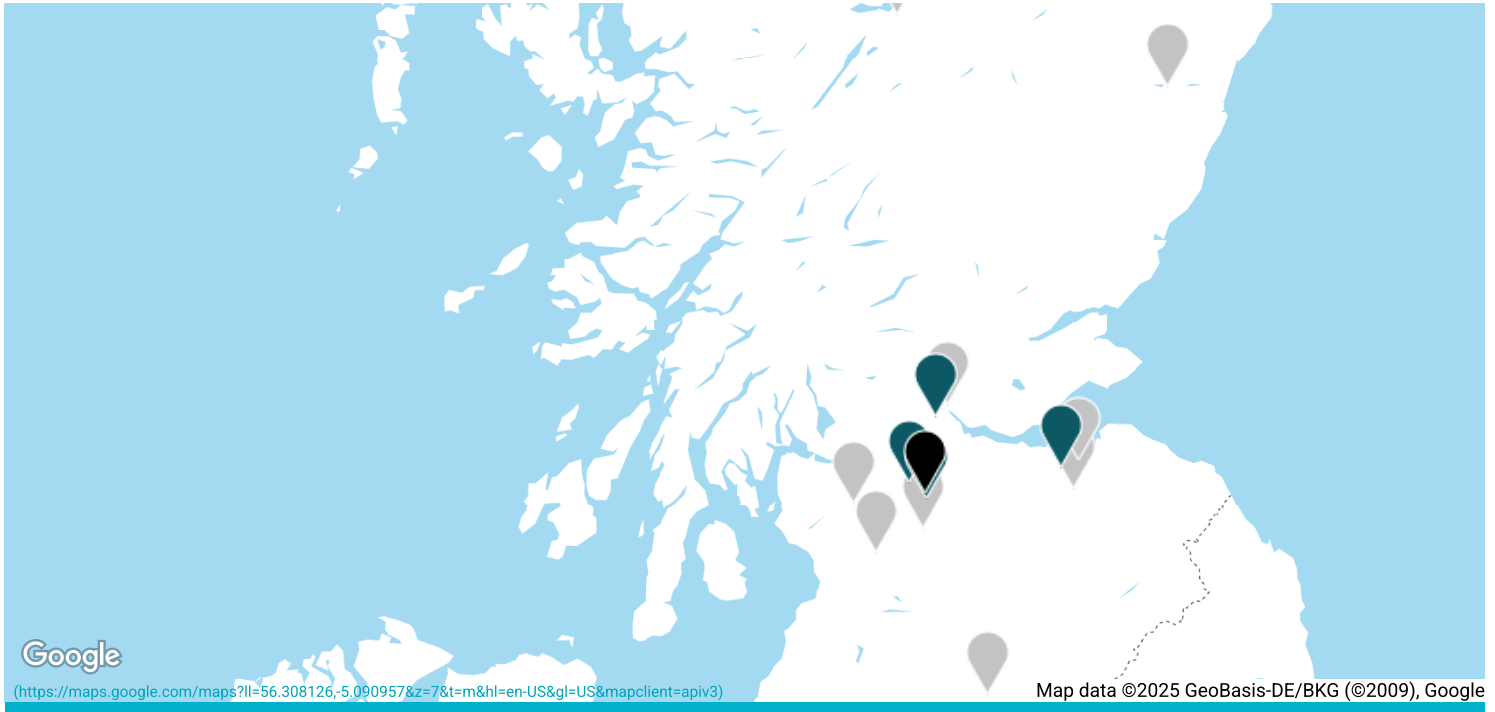




Holytown

Holytown is in North Lanarkshire. It was an 18th century mining town. It struggled to attract alternative industries after the mines closed but has some manufacturing employment (including Honeywell).

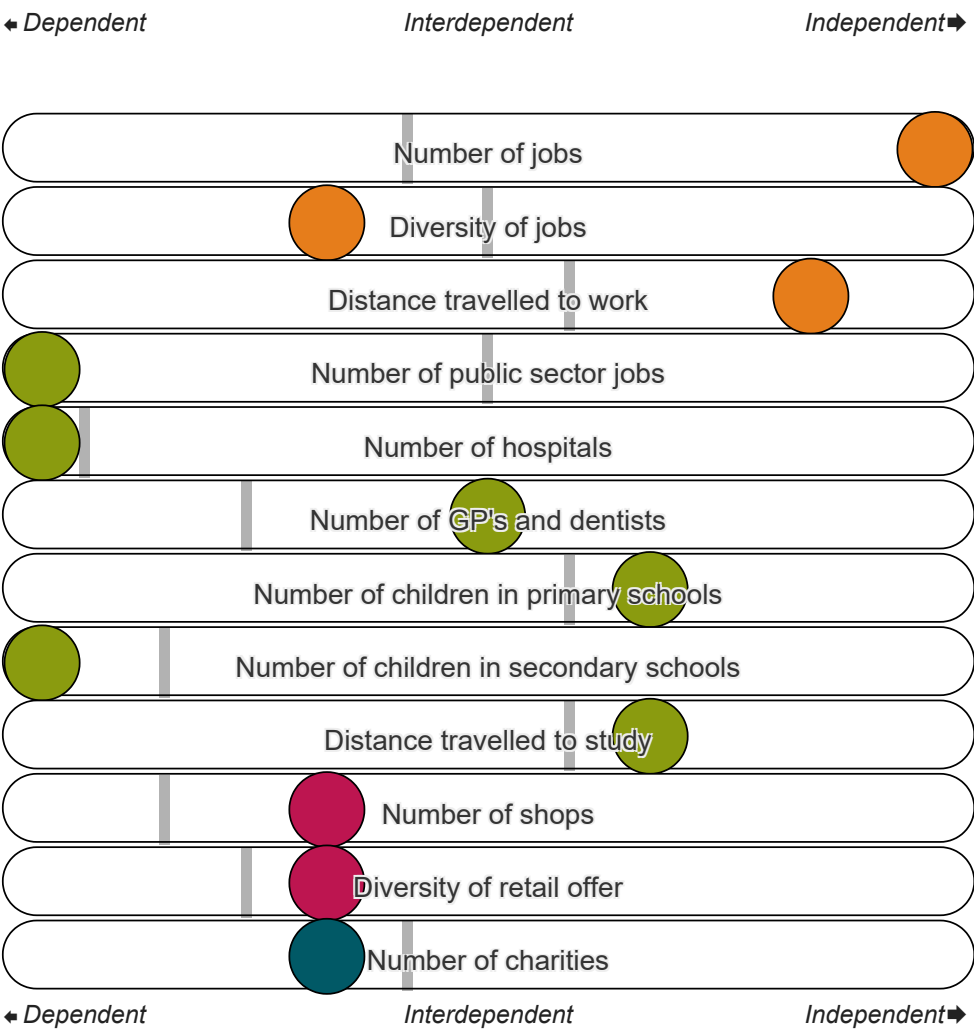
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Holytown is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Holytown is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. Holytown differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs.

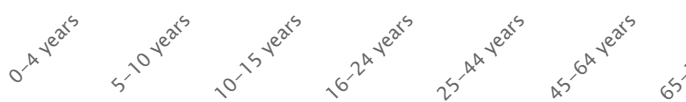

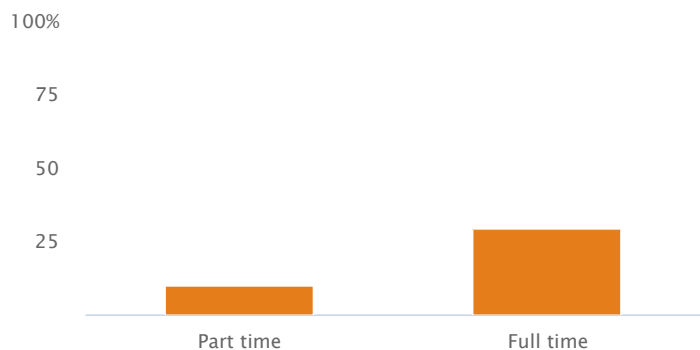

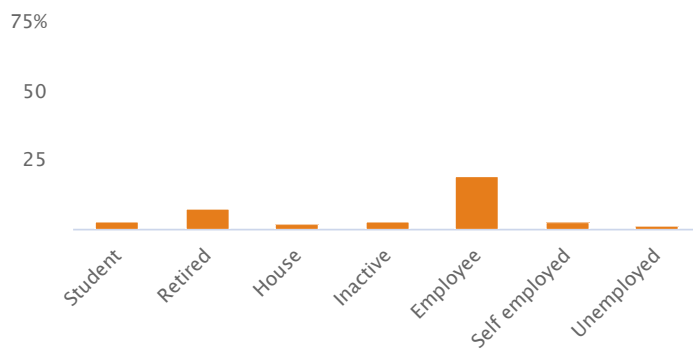
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



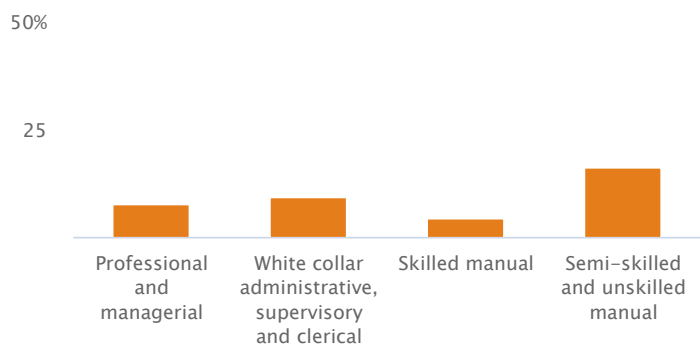
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

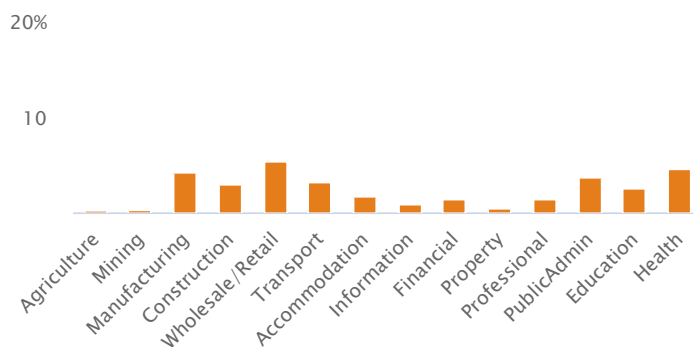

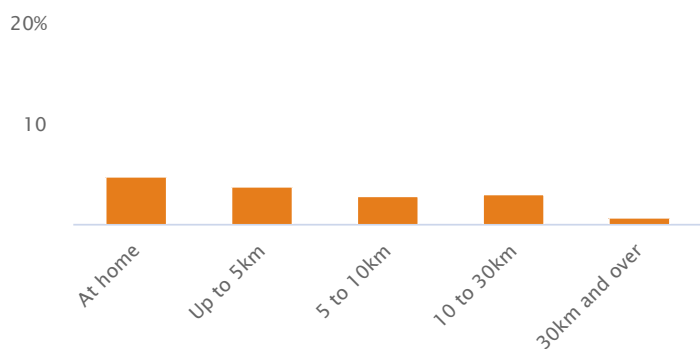
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

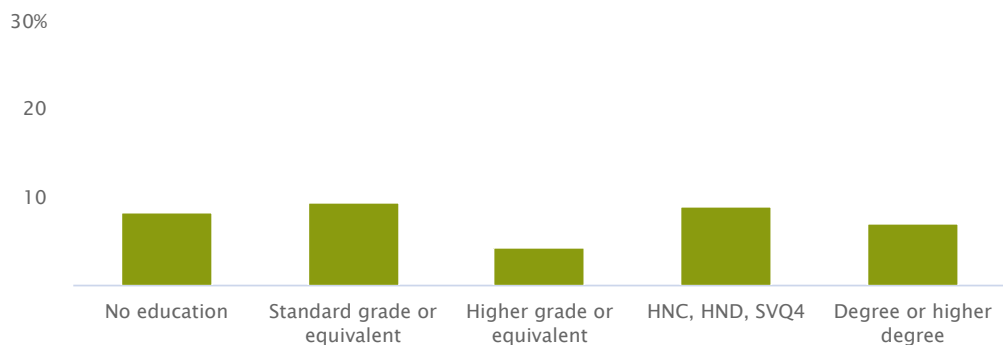


Distance travelled to work

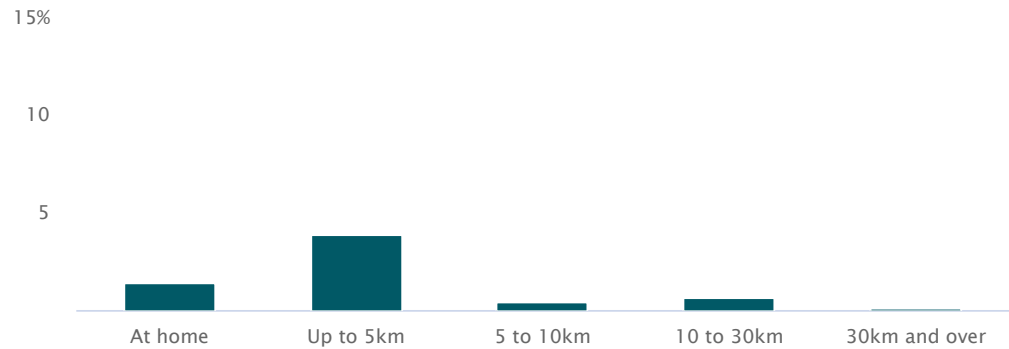
