Inchinnan is in Renfrewshire. It is a kirkton named after St Inan. It developed as a manufacturing town . Famous names associated with Inchinnan include Beardmore Engineering and India Tyres. Both companies built housing to accommodate workers. A range of manufacturers making components operate in Inchinnan.

In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

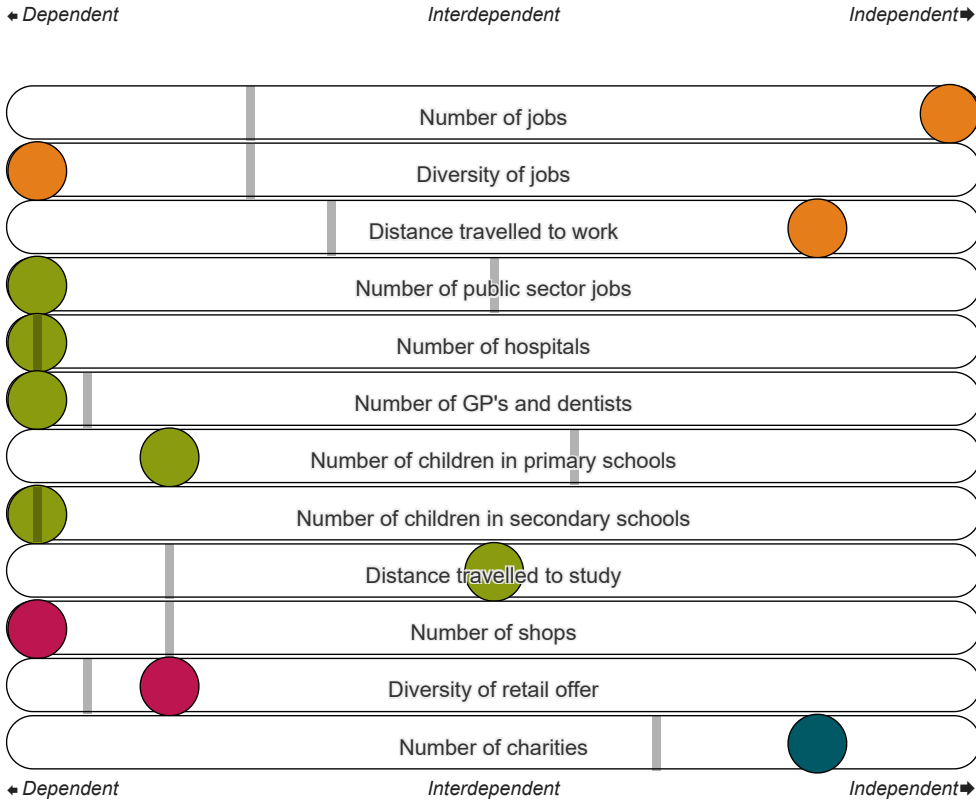
Inchinnan is a dependent to interdependent town.

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## Inter-relationships



Inchinnan is a **dependent interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Inchinnan is grouped with 19 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Inchinnan differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

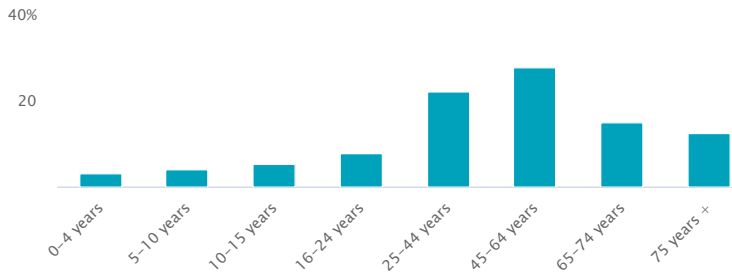

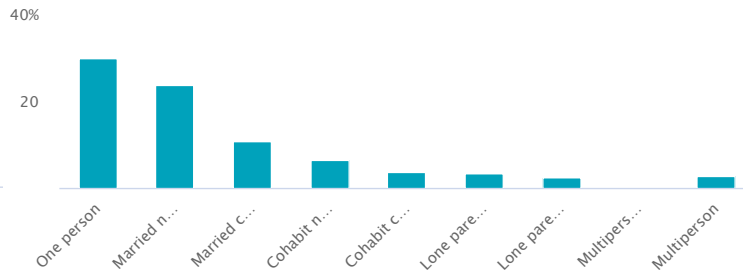

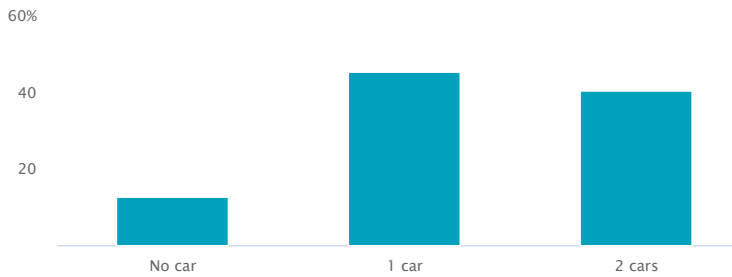

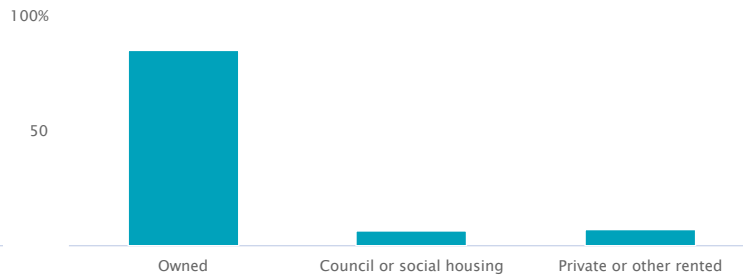

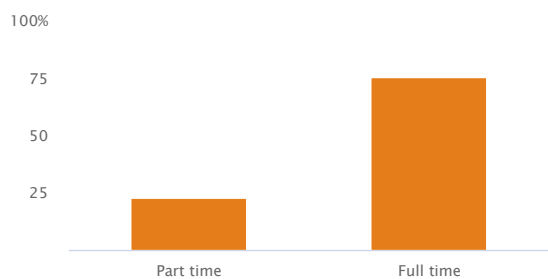

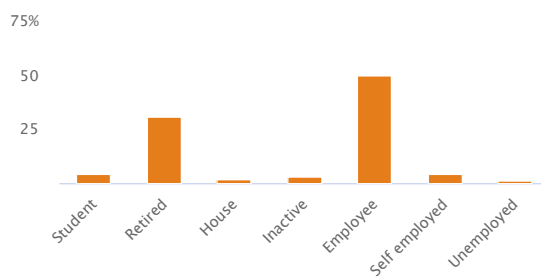
## Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



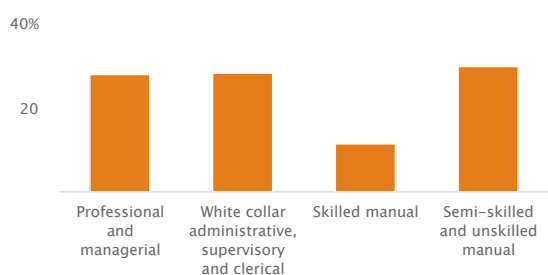
## Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

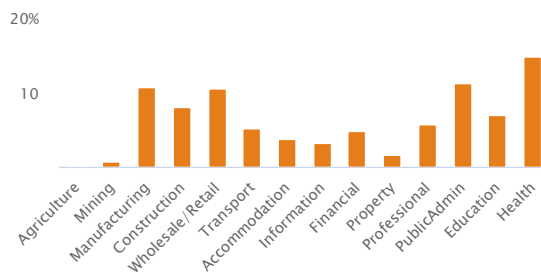


## Social Grade

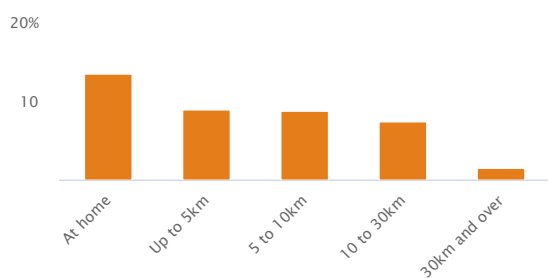
(% households aged 16-64)

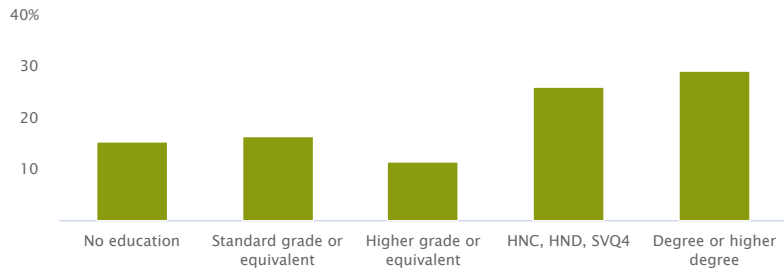

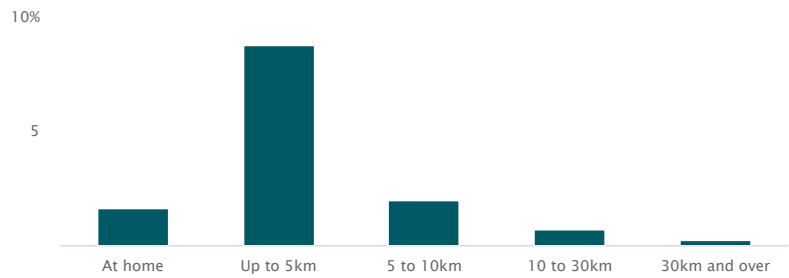
