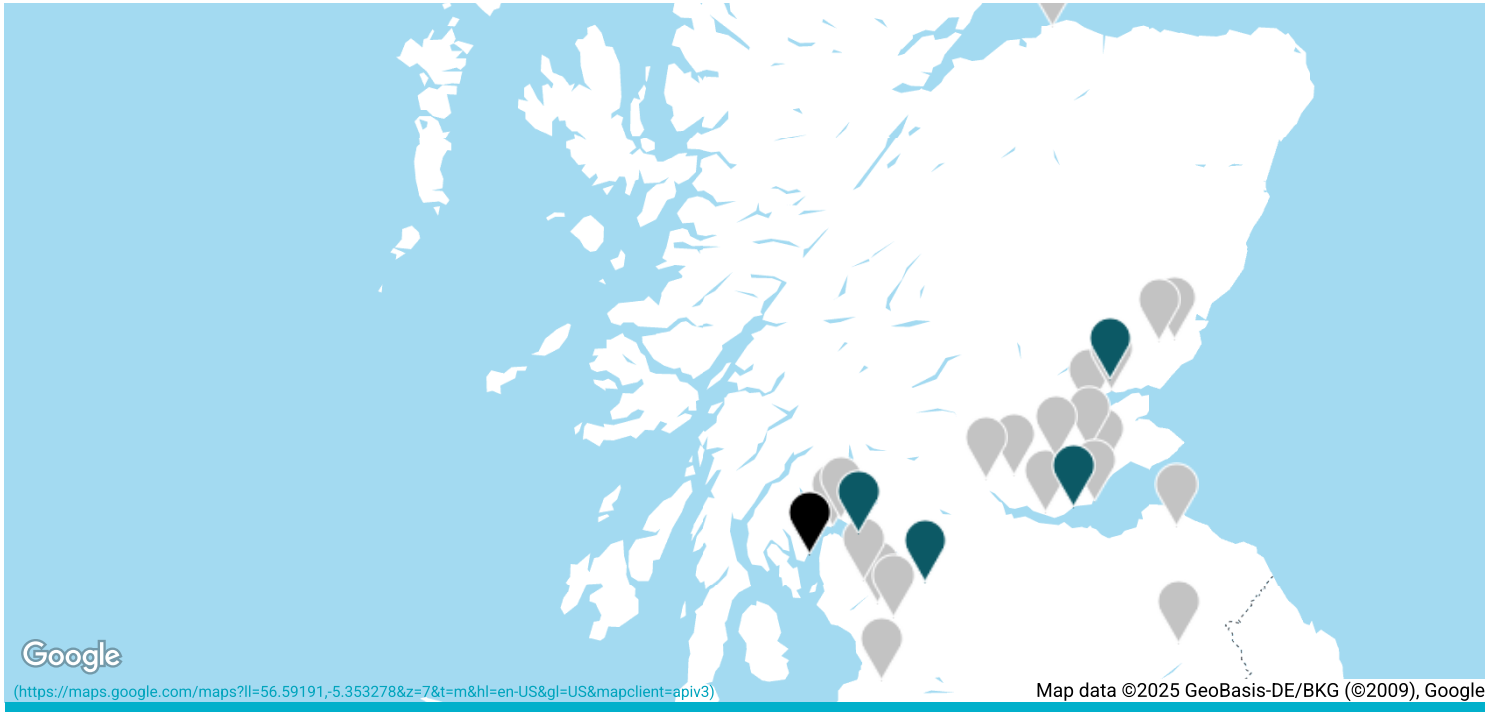




Innellan

Innellan is situated on the Cowal Peninsula in Argyll and Bute. It emerged as a Victorian tourist resort. Although tourism declined to Innellan with the demise of steamers on the Clyde it is reclaiming its role as a tourist resort.

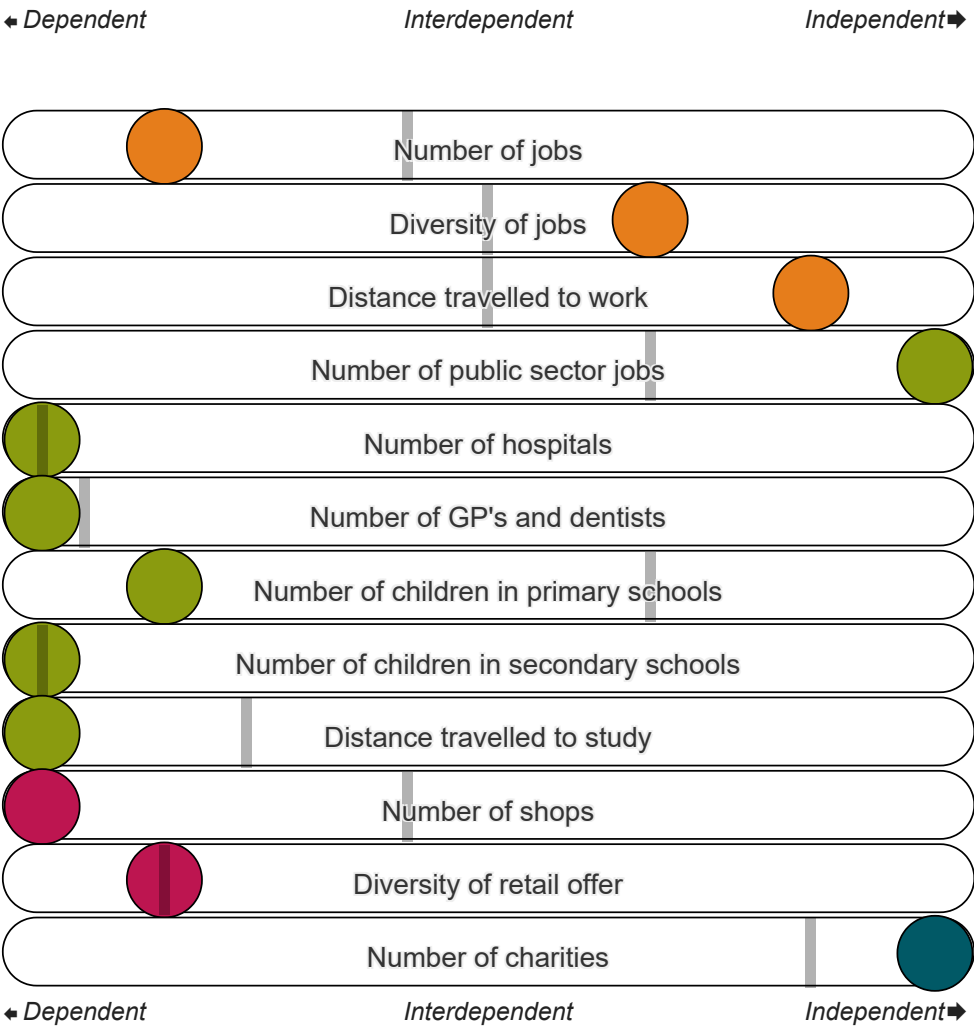
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Innellan is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Innellan is grouped with 24 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Innellan differs most from its group in the number of shops.

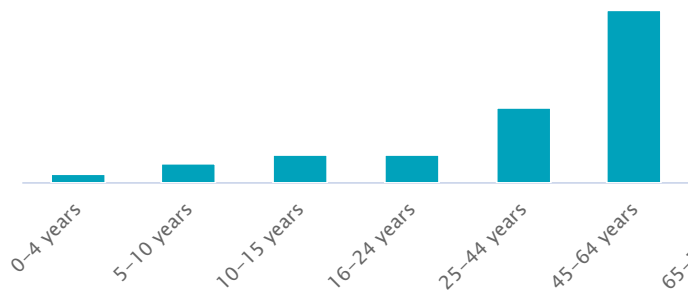

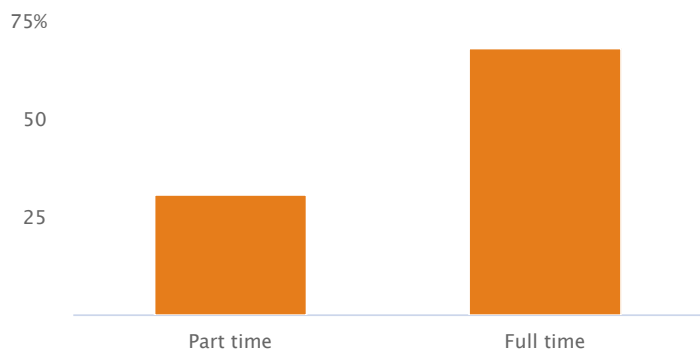

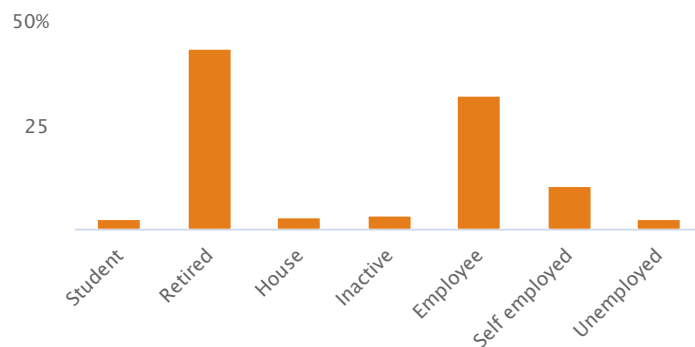
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



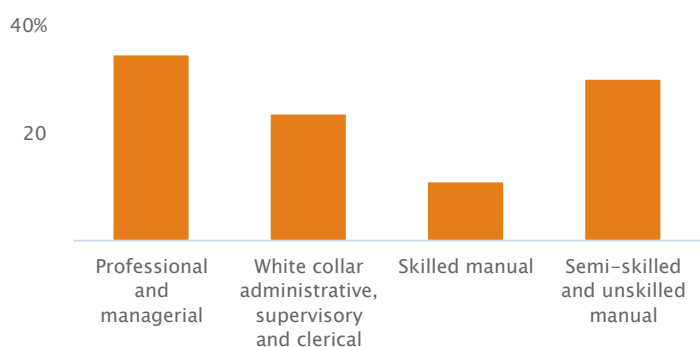
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

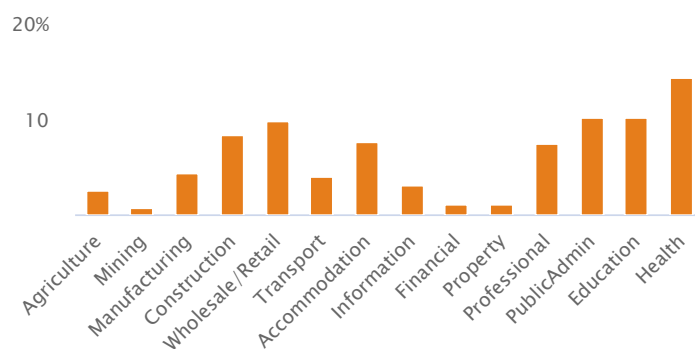


Social Grade

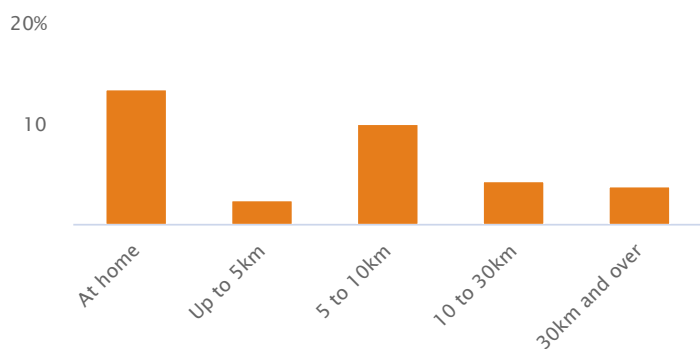
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

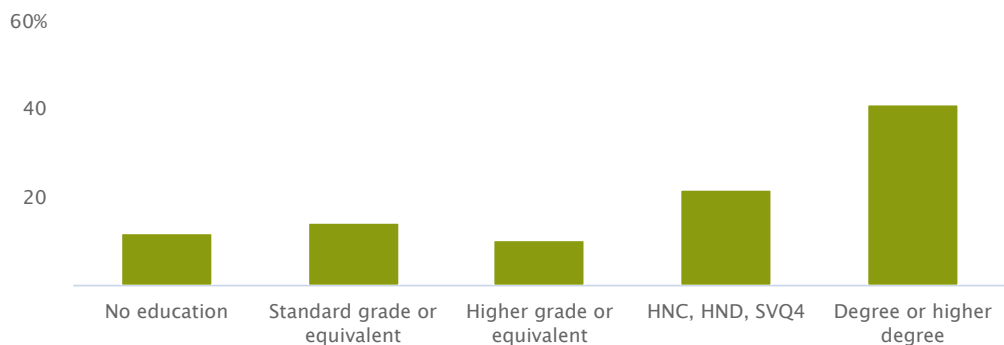


Distance travelled to work

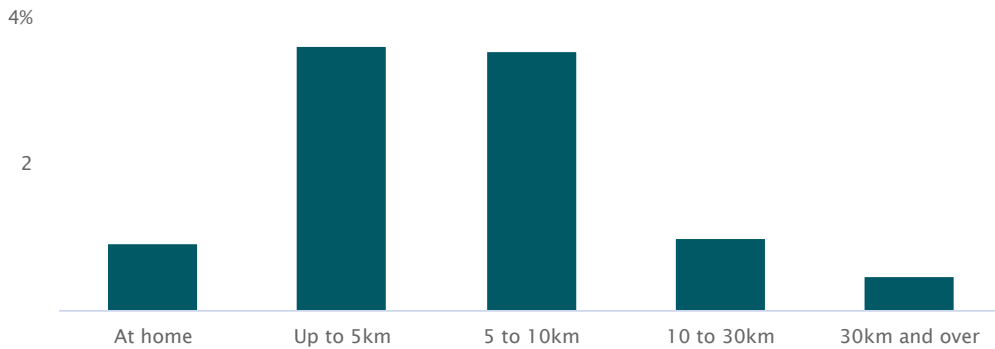
