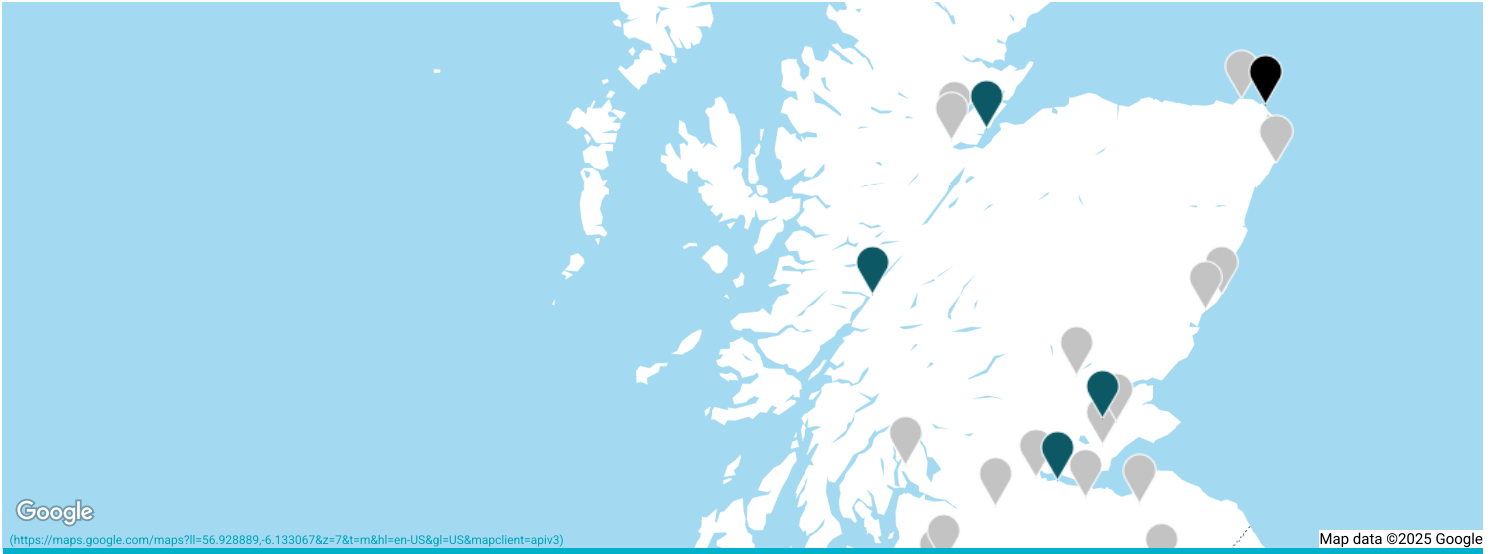




Inverallochy and Cairnbulg

Cairnbulg and Inverallochy are fishing settlements in Aberdeenshire. Following a cholera outbreak in the late 18th century the settlement was rebuilt.

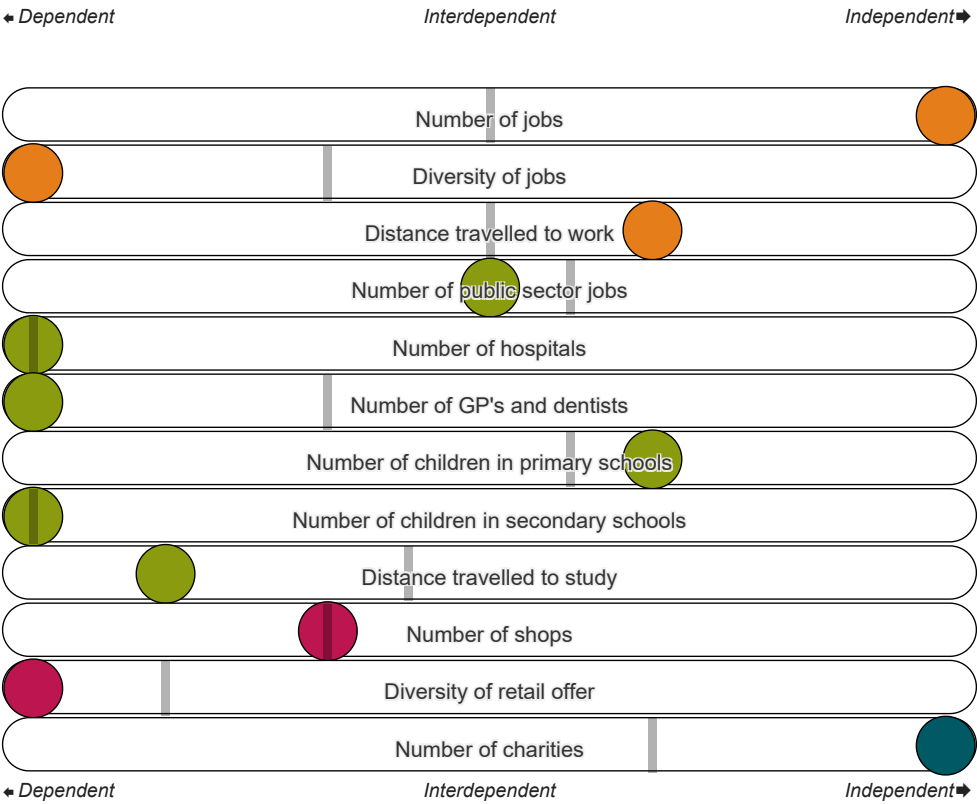
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Inter-relationships



Inverallochy and Cairnbulg is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Inverallochy and Cairnbulg is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and jobs. Inverallochy and Cairnbulg differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists; and the diversity of jobs.

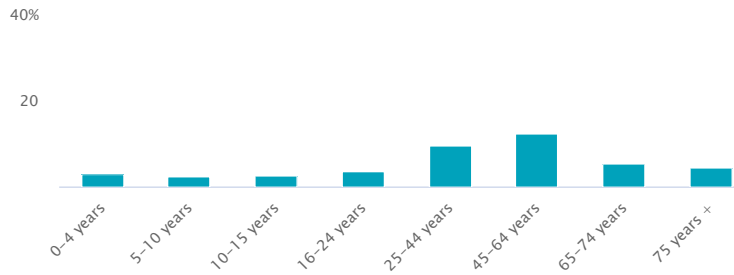

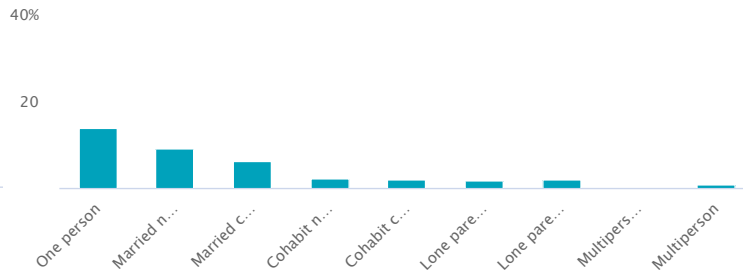

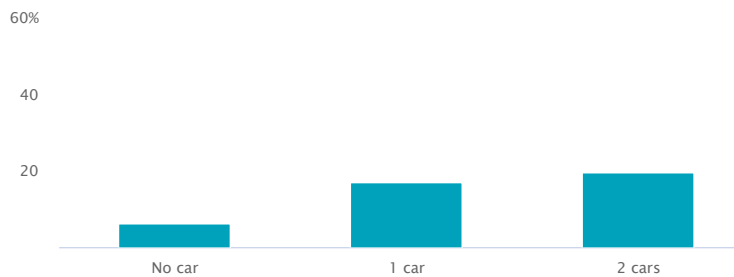

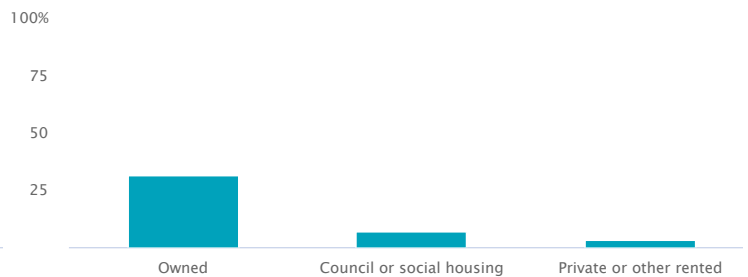

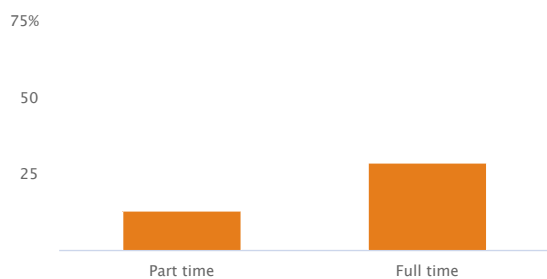

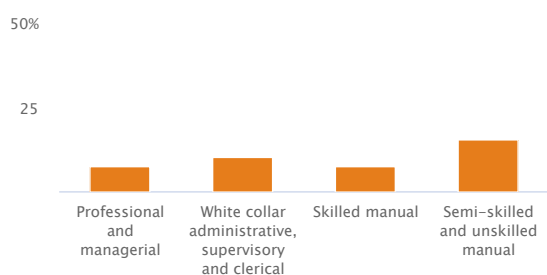
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



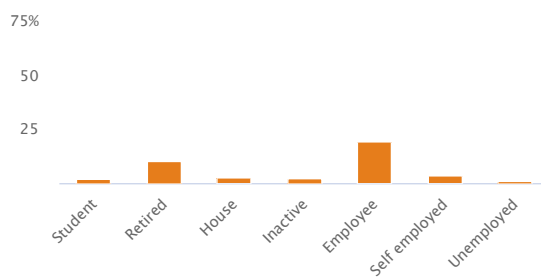
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)

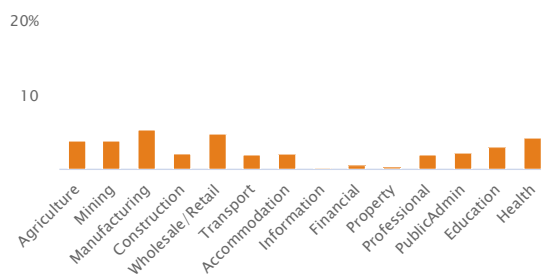

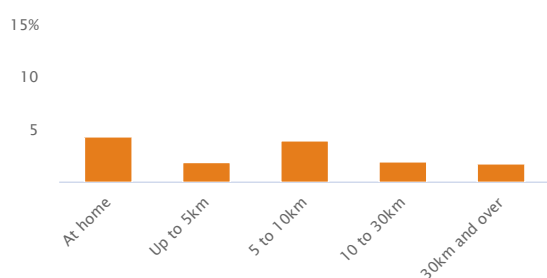

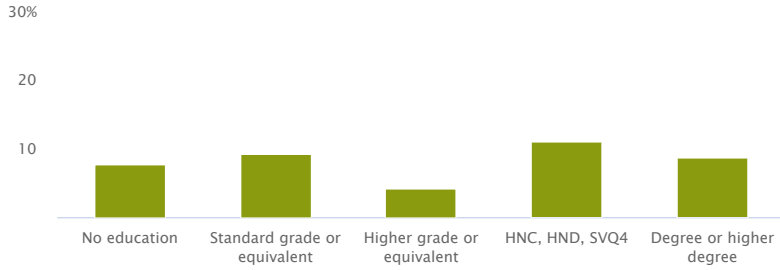
Sector Diversity

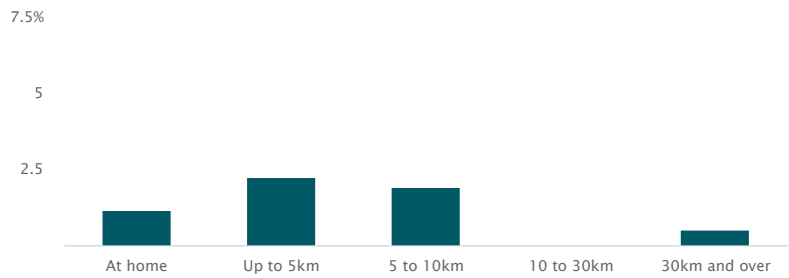
