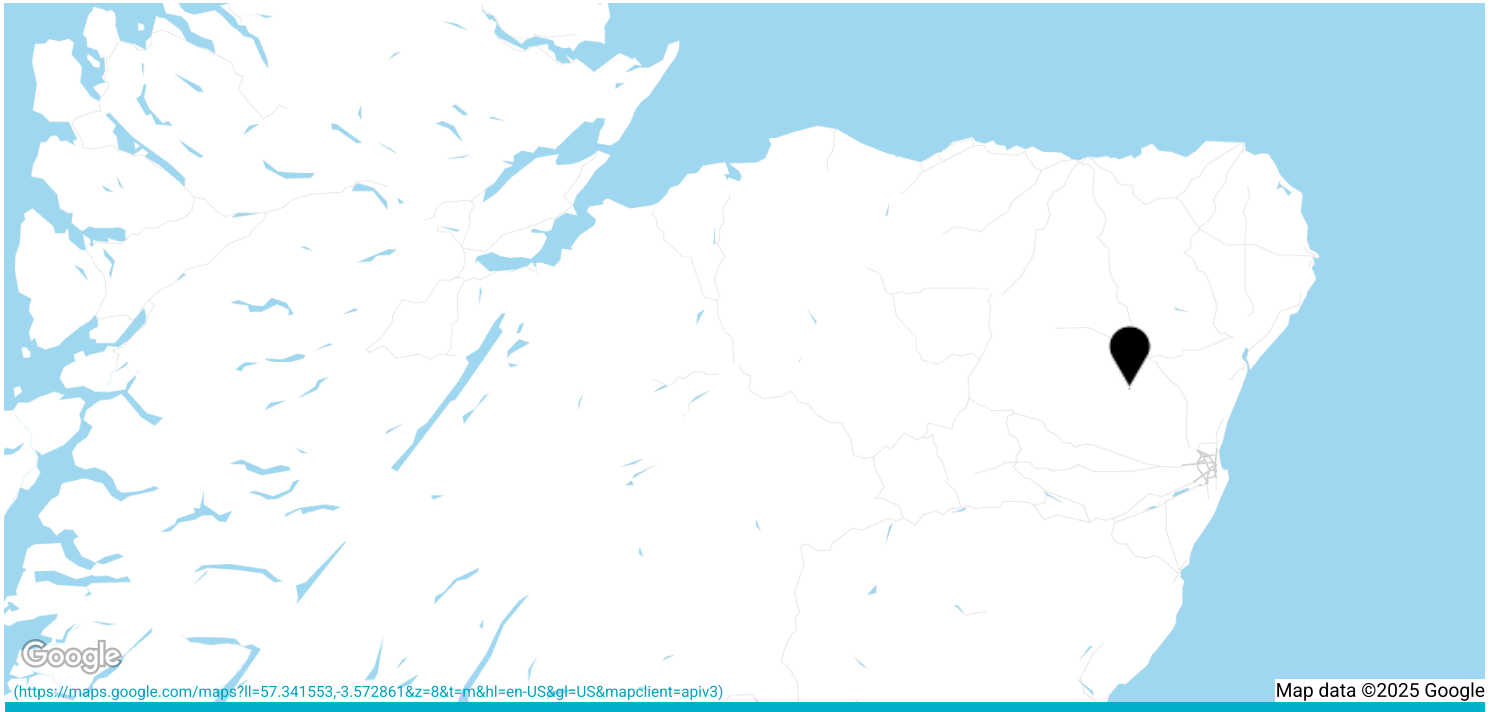




Inverurie

Inverurie is a royal burgh in Aberdeenshire. It developed as a result of the opening of the Elphinstone Canal linking it to Aberdeen Harbour in the 16th century. Between 1900 and 1960 it was known for locomotive engineering. It also had a paper mill which was a key employer but closed in 2009. It retains a manufacturing base and its role as a market town with a livestock market. Increasingly it is a commuter settlement.

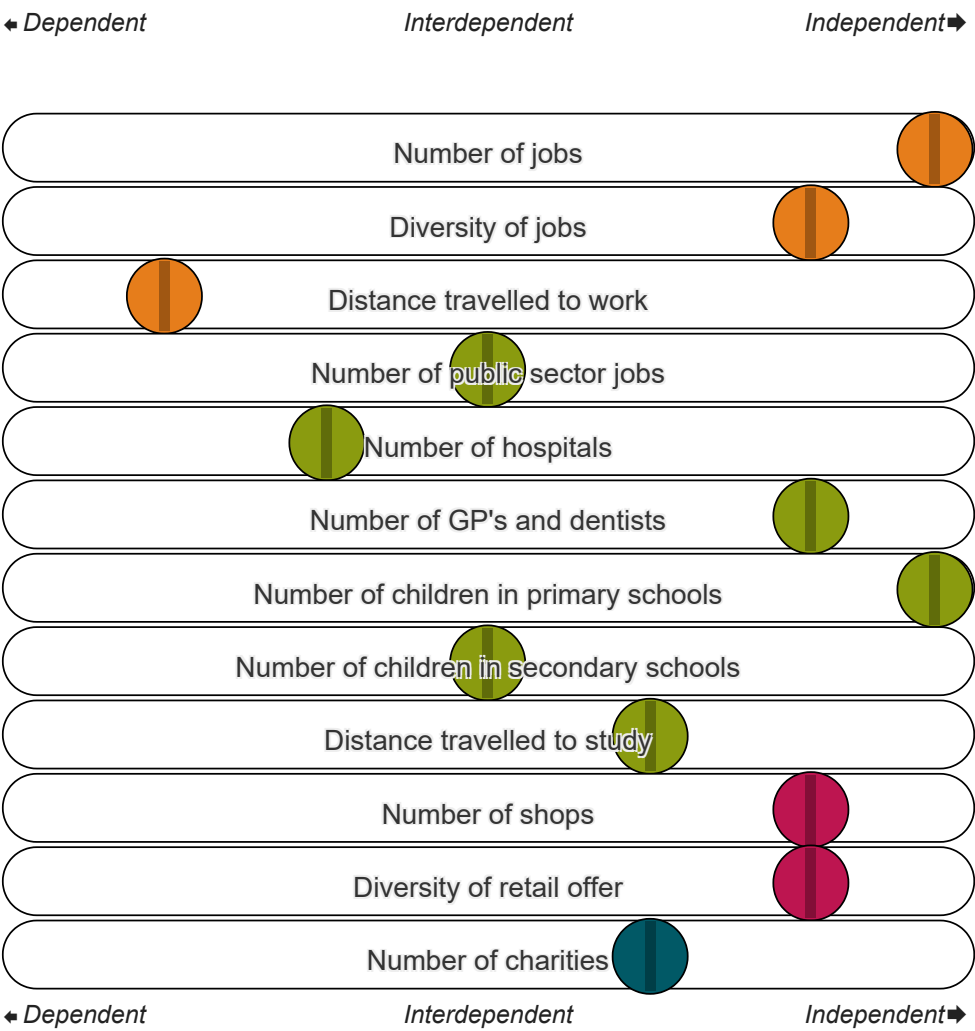
In large towns, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

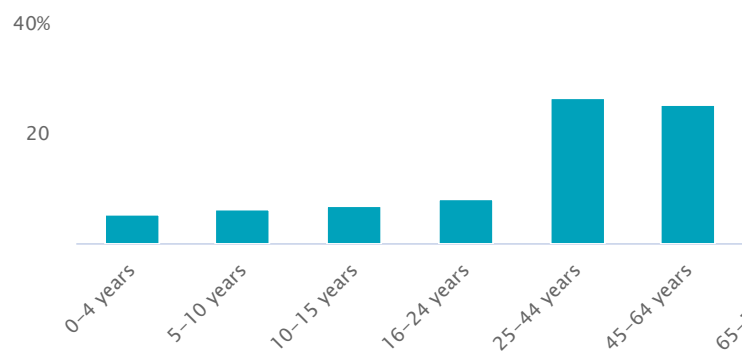

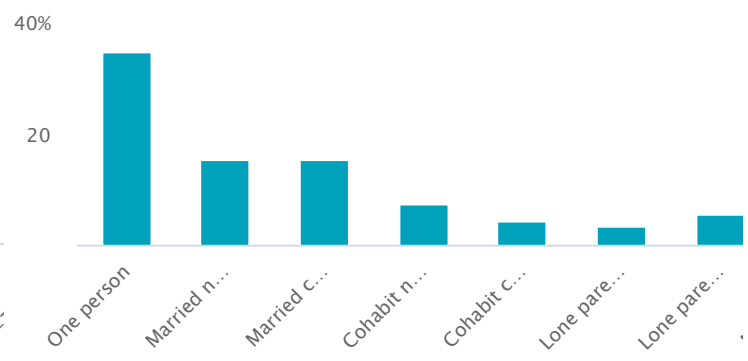

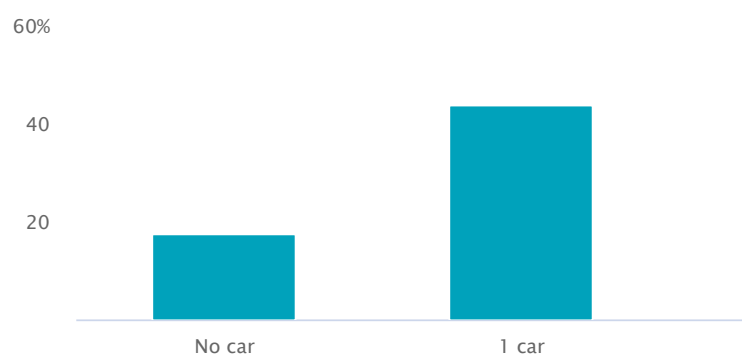

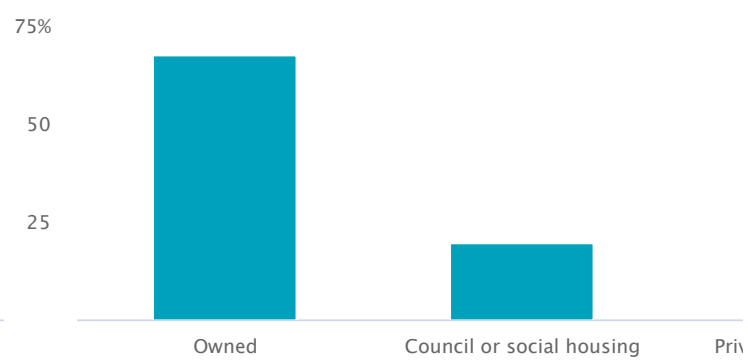

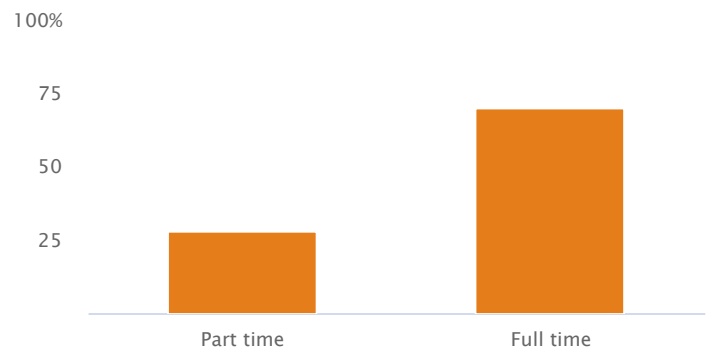

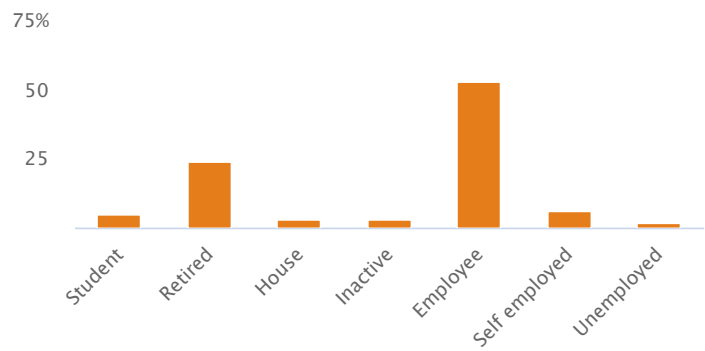
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



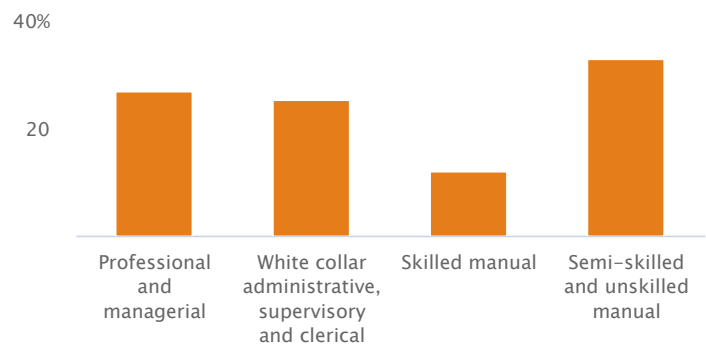
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

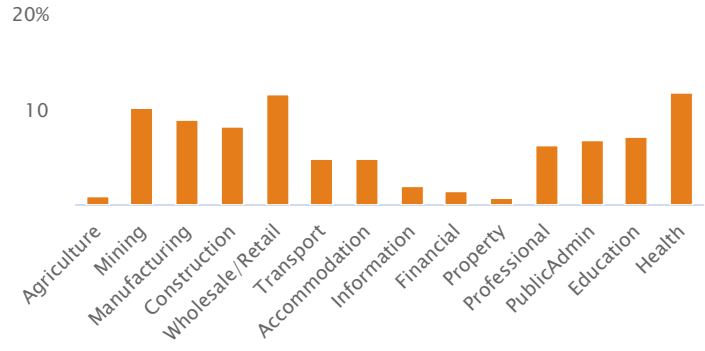

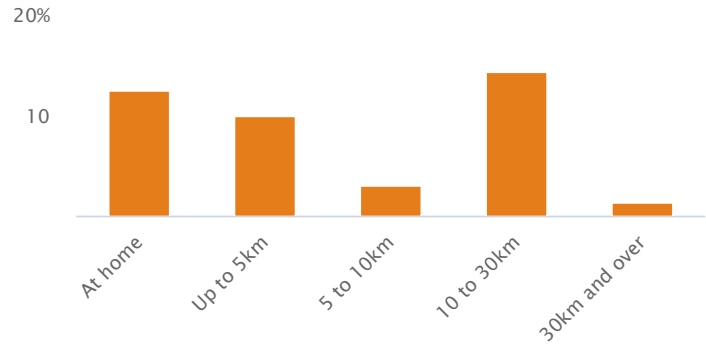
(% households aged 16-64)

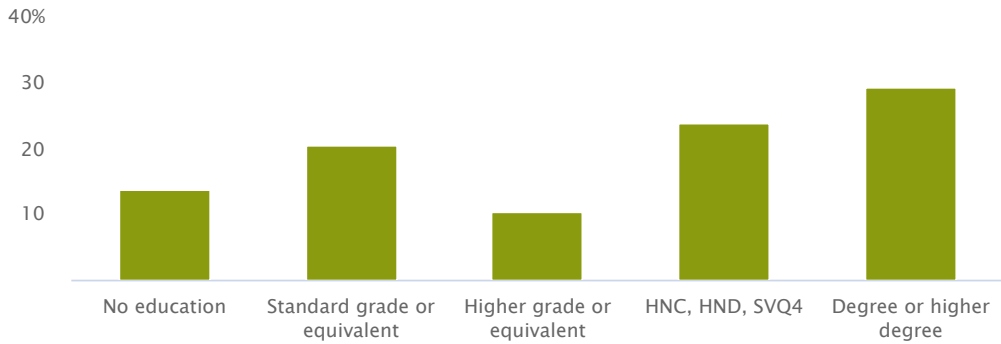


Distance travelled to work

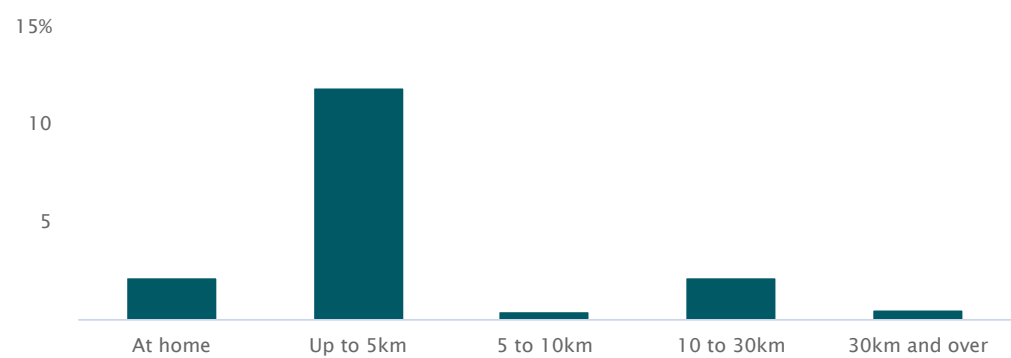
