Kelty is in Fife. The town was a mining town but the mines which began operating in the 19th century are now closed. Proximity to the motorway has meant that new housing has been built for commuters.


In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Its most similar towns are Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill, Faifley, Fauldhouse, and Hallglen.






Employment type

(% households aged 16-64)










