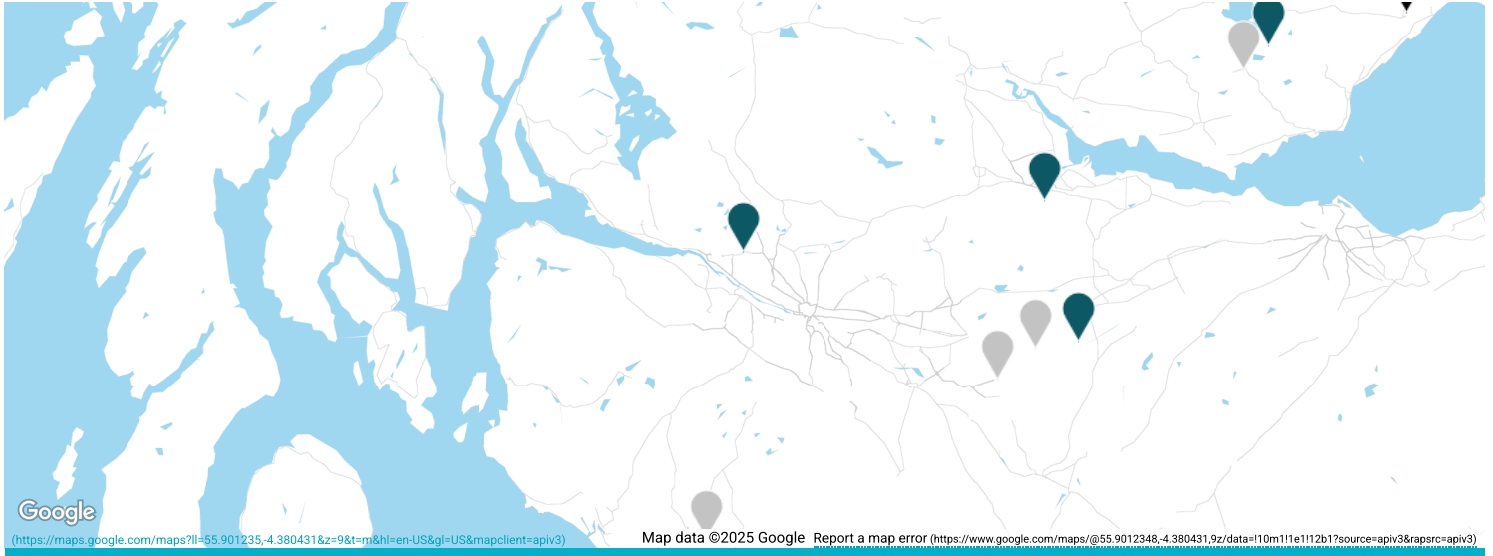

Kennoway is in Fife. The town developed as a weaving village. It grew with trade along the turnpike road. Today industries include haulage and the Cameronbridge distillery.

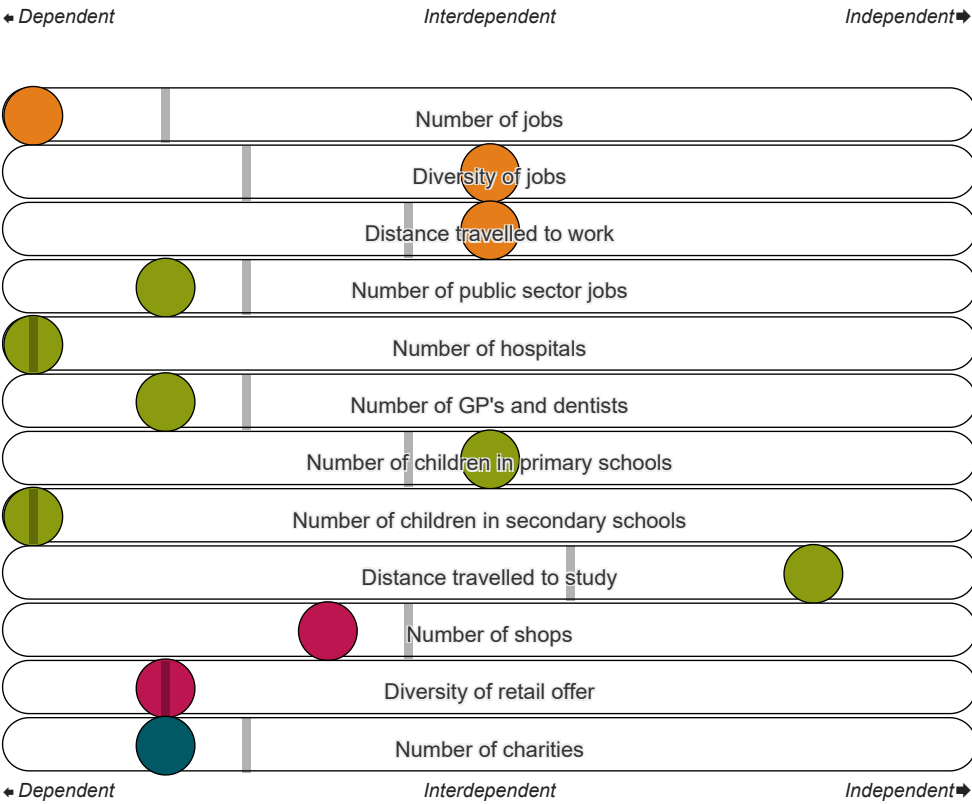
In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Kennoway is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

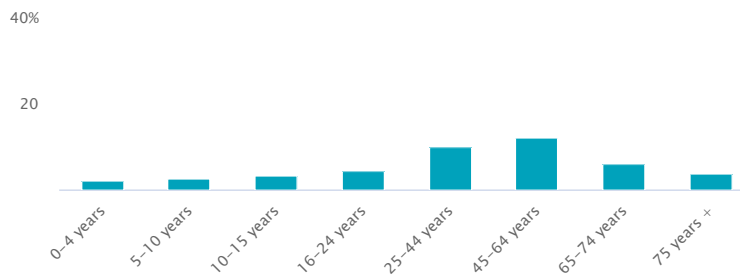
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kennoway is grouped with 8 other towns. It differs in terms of the distance travelled to study. Kennoway differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs.

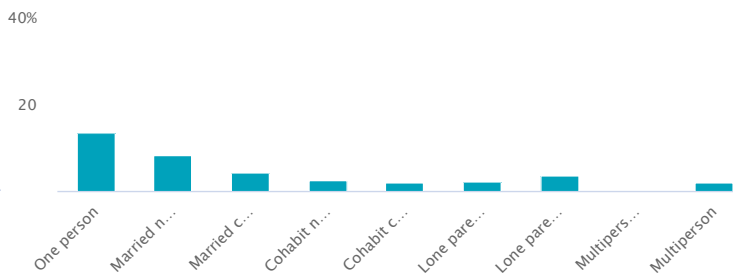

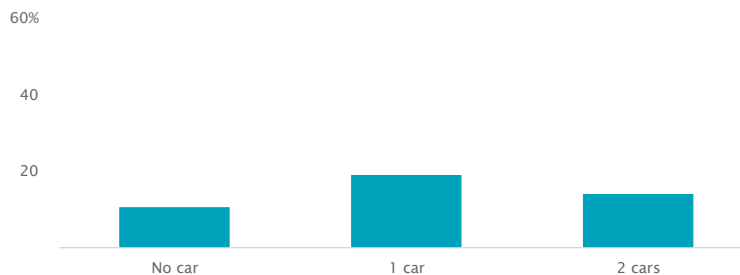
Age

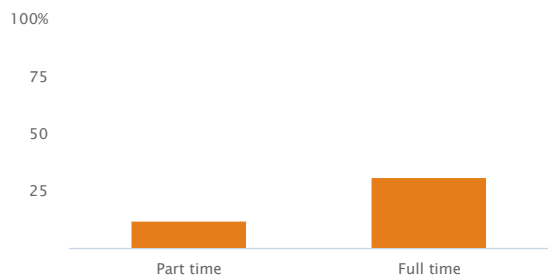

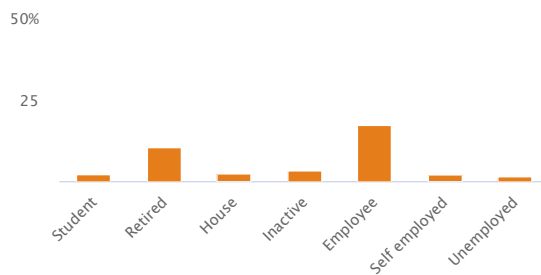
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



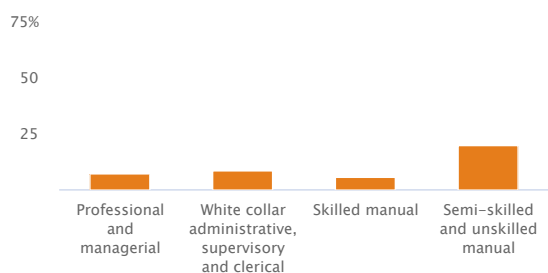
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

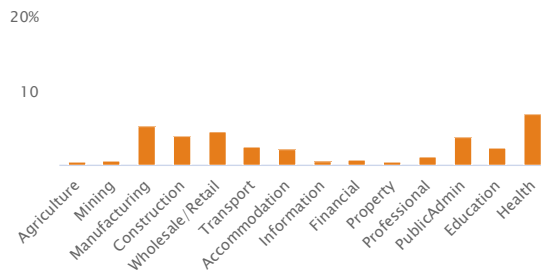

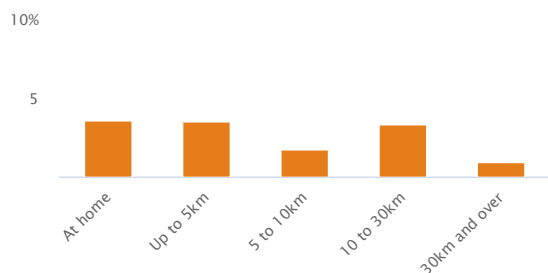
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

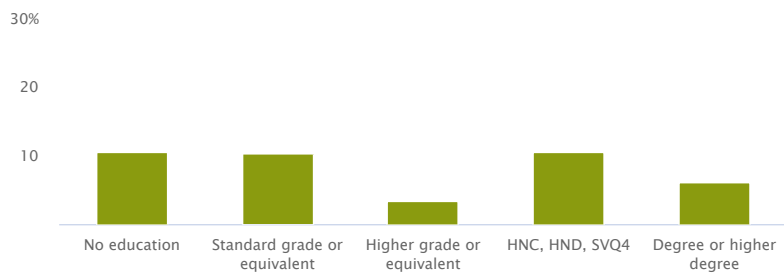


Distance travelled to work

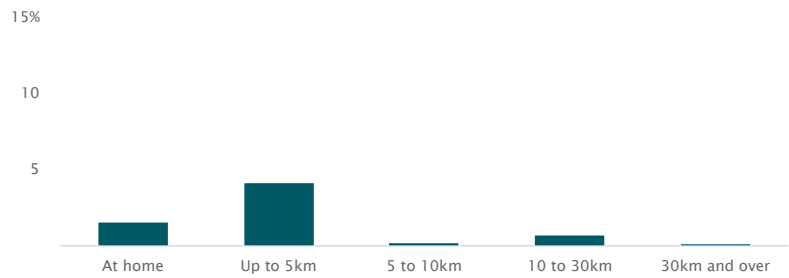
