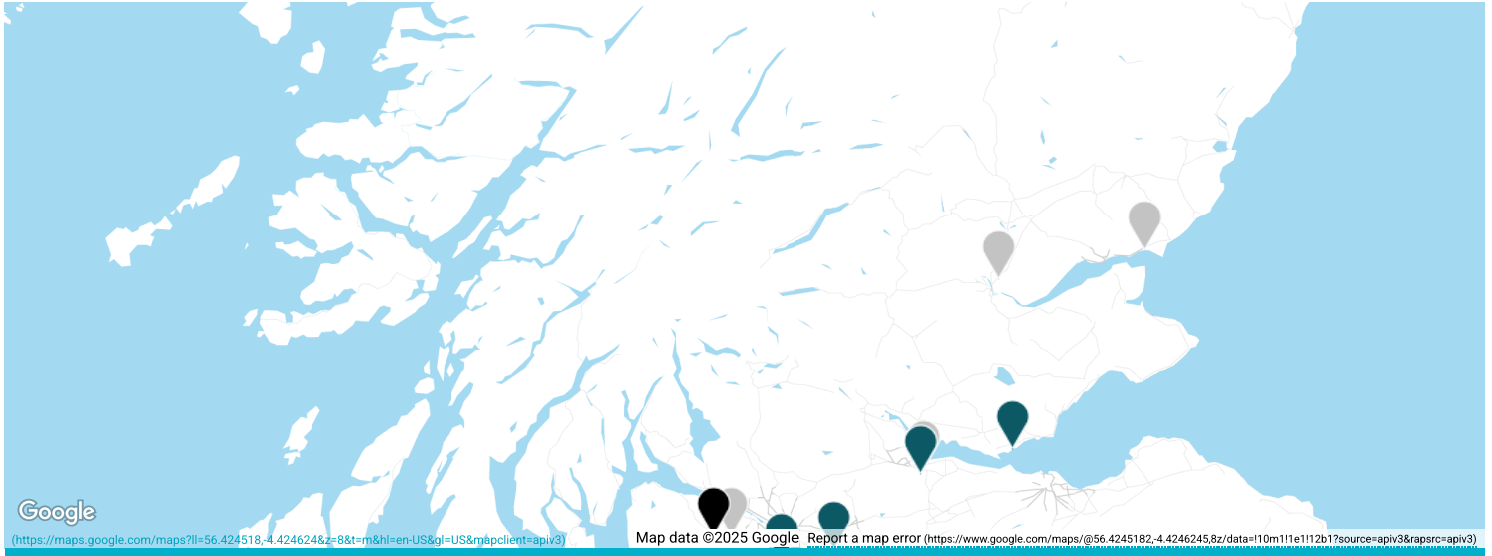




Kilbarchan

Kilbarchan is located in Renfrewshire. A 7th century religious centre and takes its name from St Barchan. It was a centre for handloom weaving. Today it is a commuter settlement and local service centre.

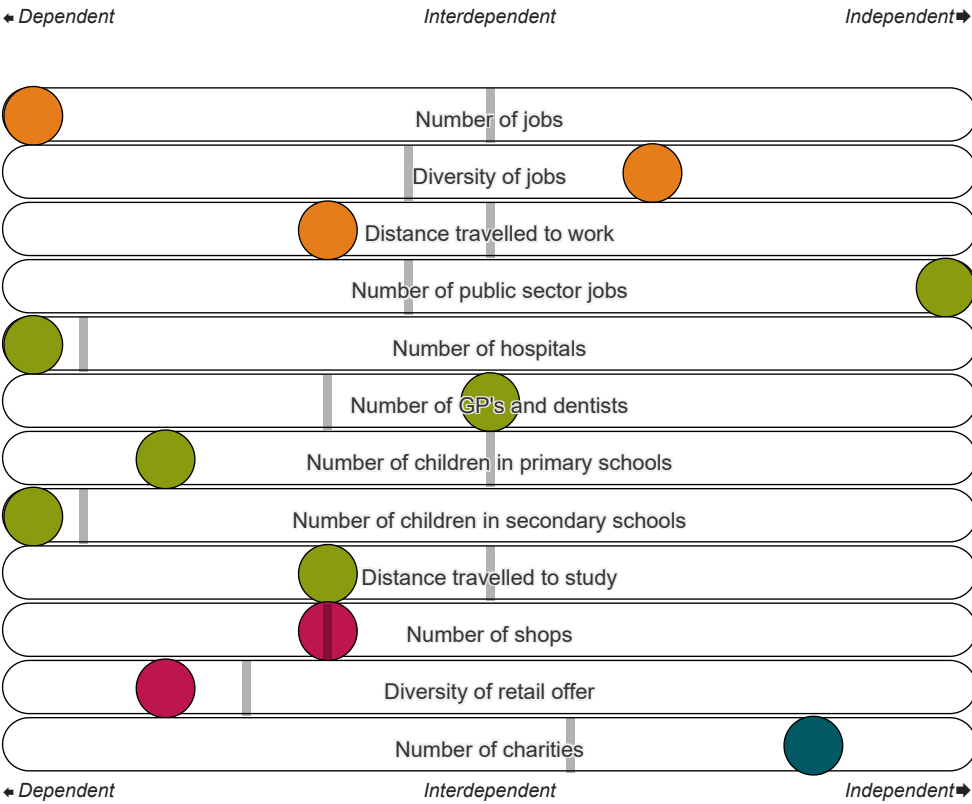
In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Kilbarchan is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kilbarchan is grouped with 10 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, and public sector jobs. Kilbarchan differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

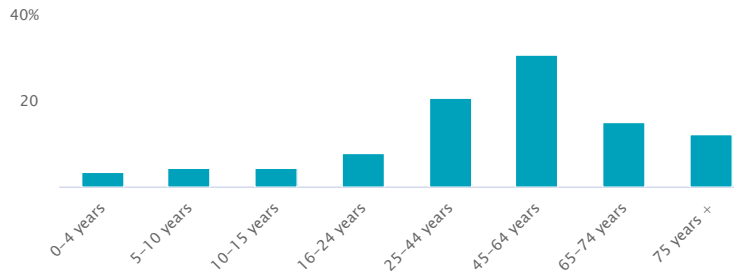

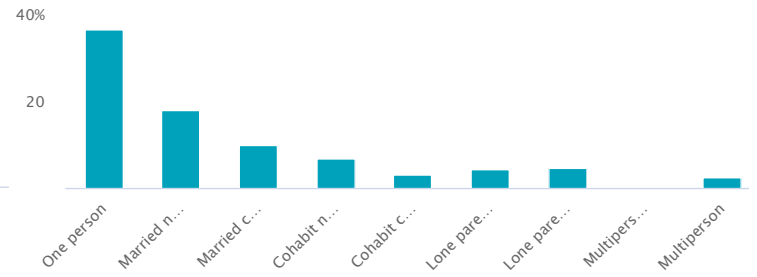

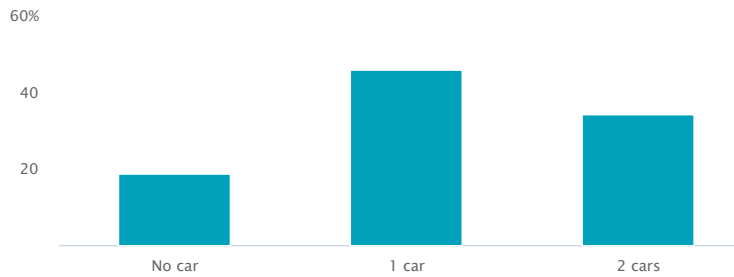

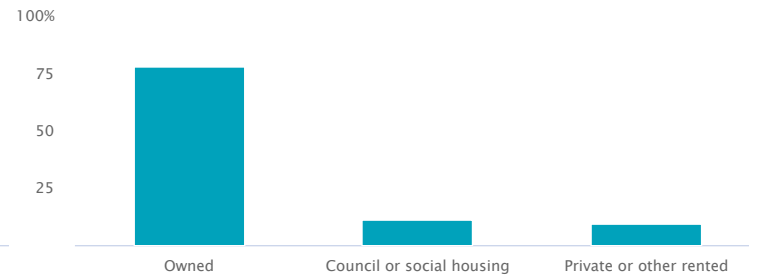

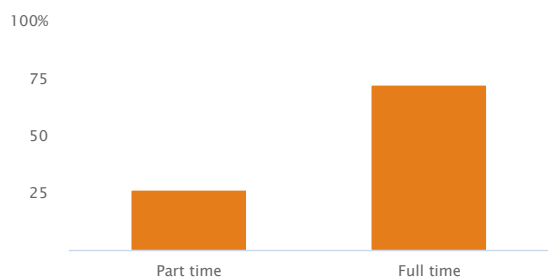

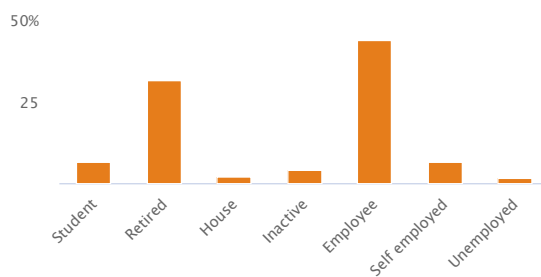
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



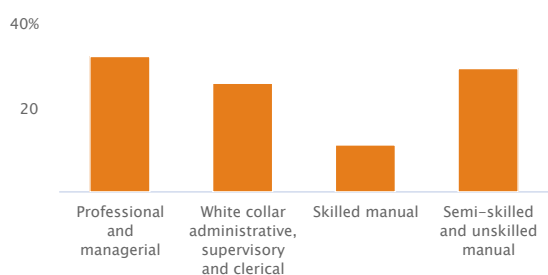
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

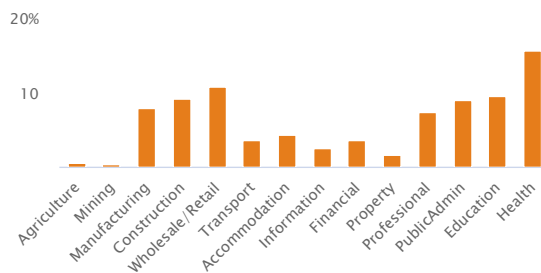

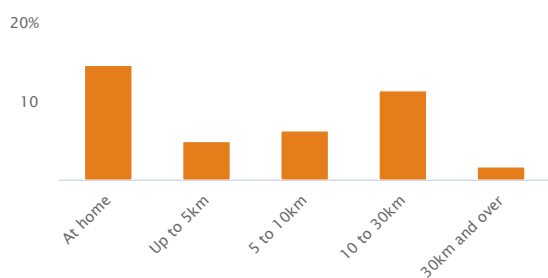

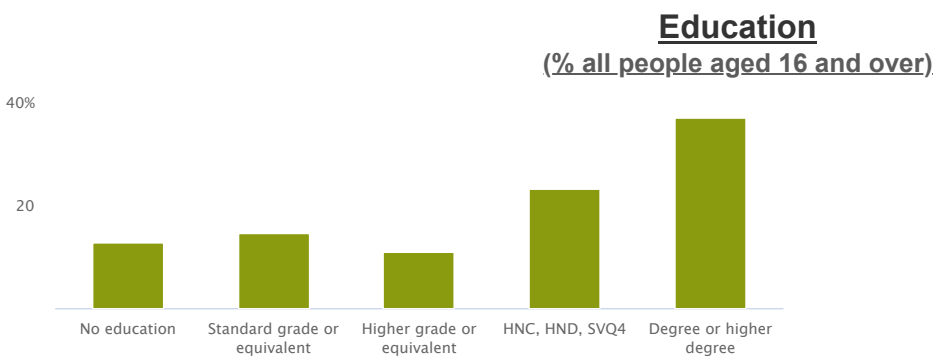


Sector Diversity

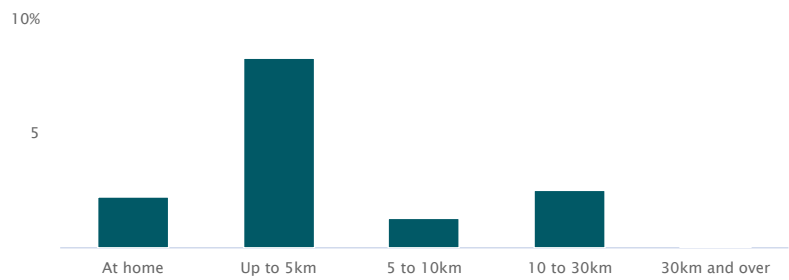
