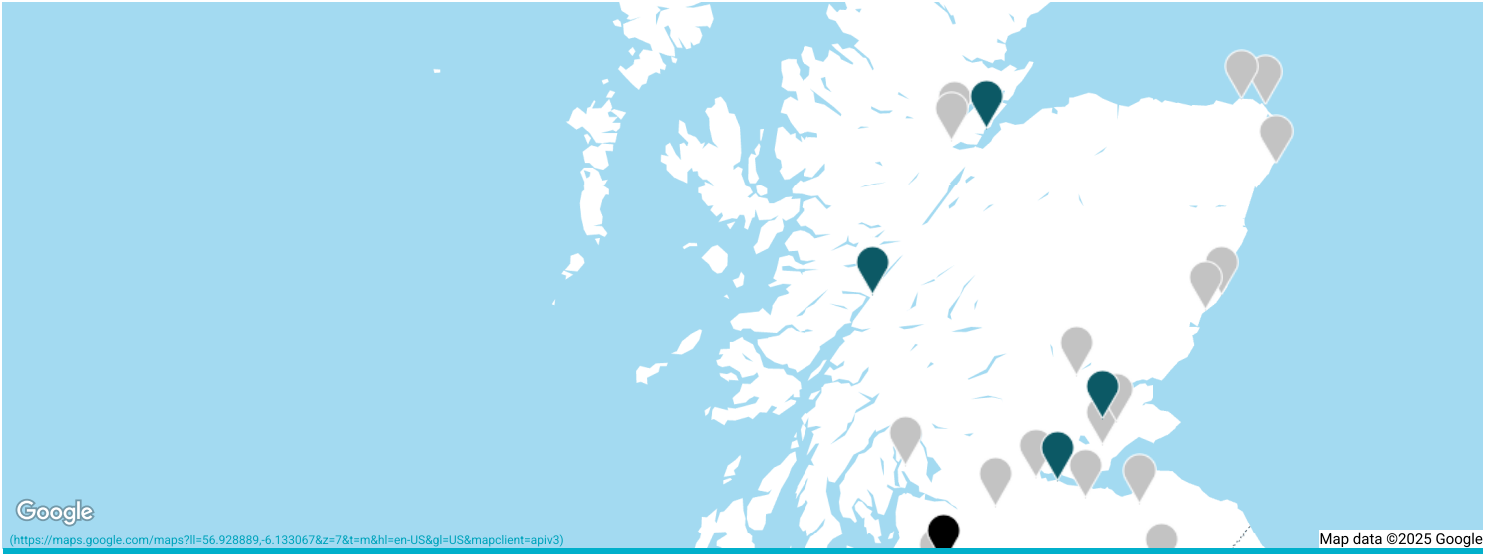




Kilmaurs

kilmaurs is in East Ayrshire. It was historically an industrious town with manufacturers of cutlery, shoes and bonnets. Today it is a local service centre with businesses reflecting the local dairy farming including Dairyflow.

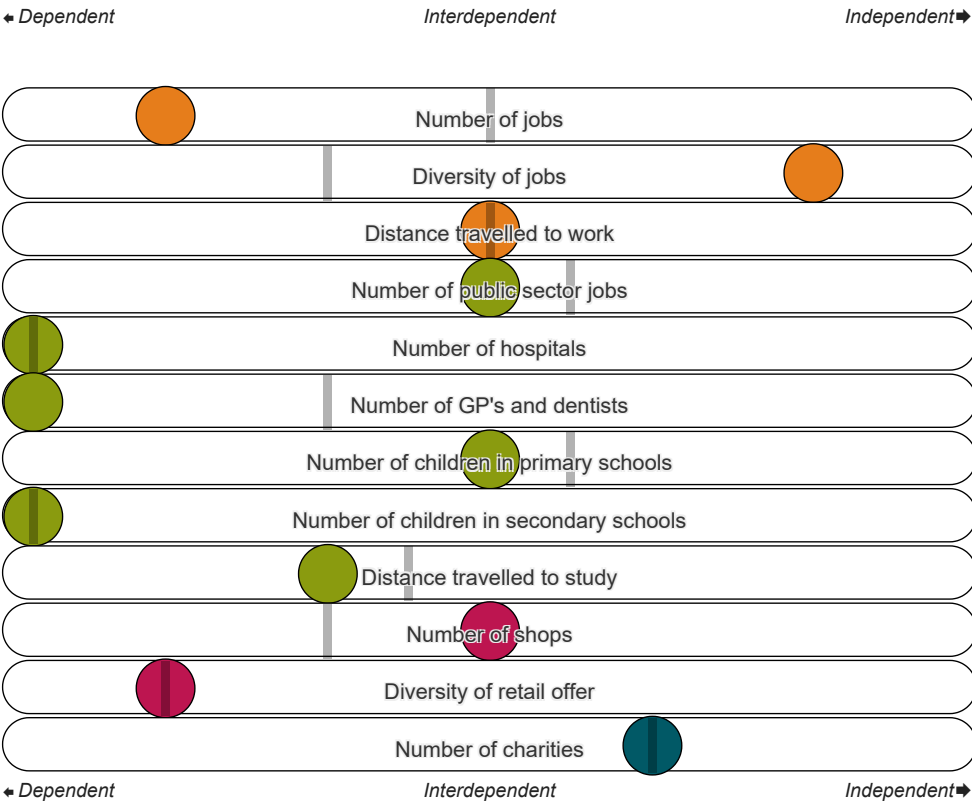
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Kilmaurs is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kilmaurs is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Kilmaurs differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

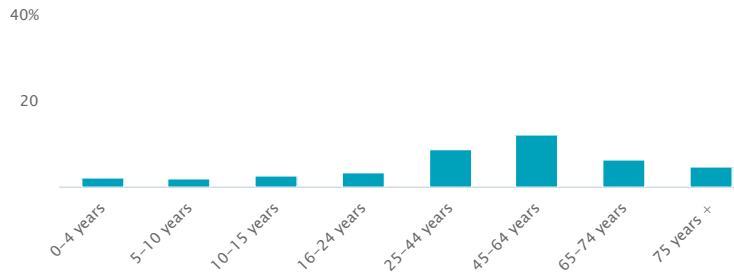

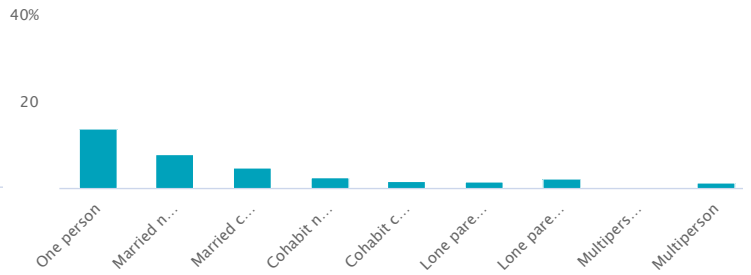

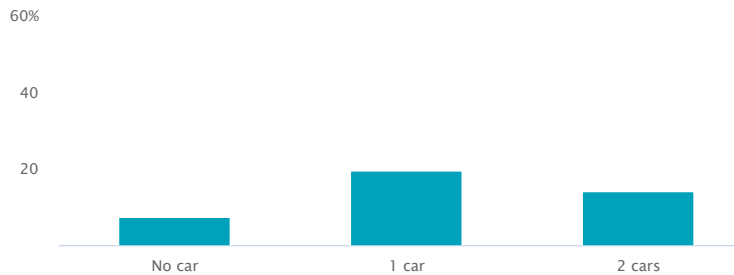

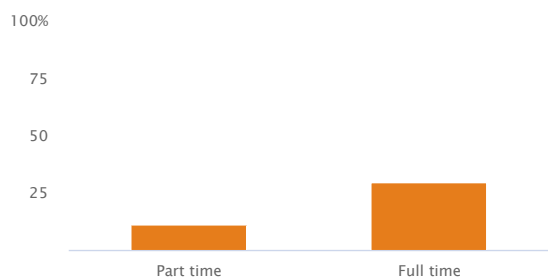

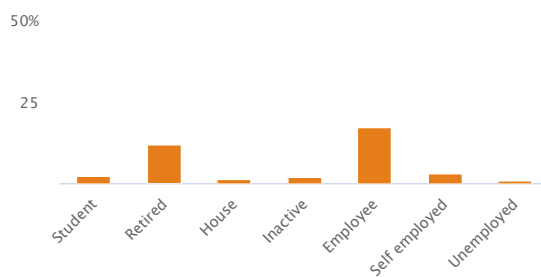
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



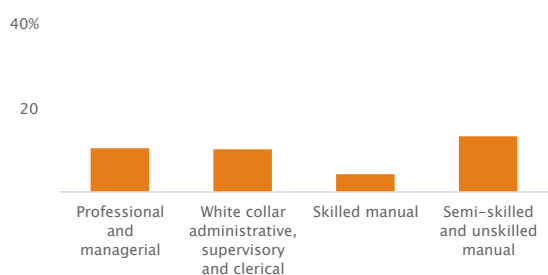
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

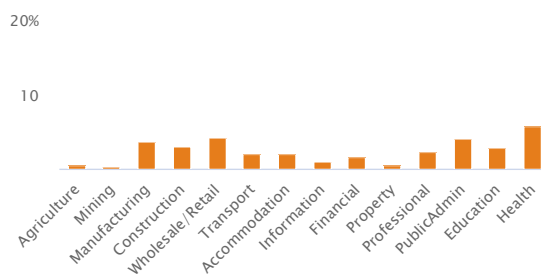


Social Grade

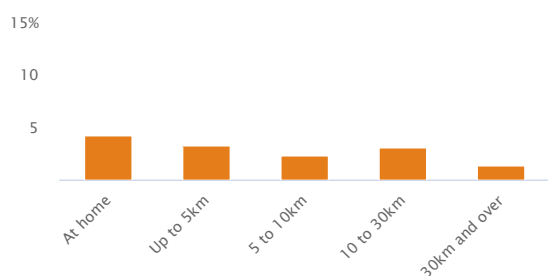
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

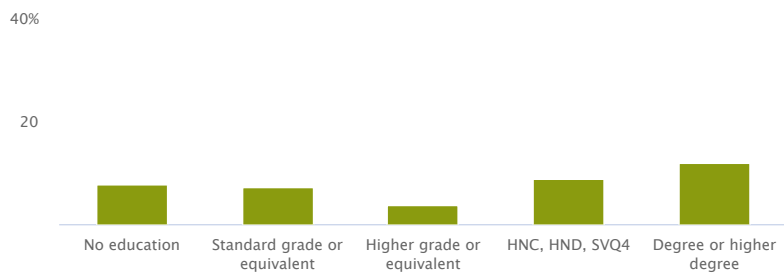


Distance travelled to work

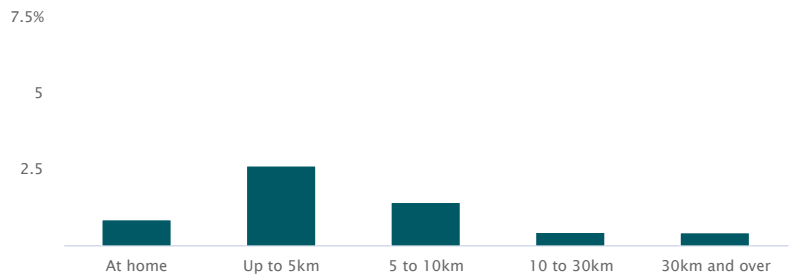
