





# <u>Kincardine</u>

#### POPULATION 2,882

Kincardine is located in Fife. It was an historic port on the Forth estuary trading in salt and with a shipbuilding industry. In the 20th century the Longannet Colliery and the Kincardine Power Station operated close to the town. These are both now closed. The Scottish Police College is located just outside the town.


In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Kincardine is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Aberchirder, Carnwath, Eastriggs, and Mosstodloch.

# **Inter-relationships**



Kincardine is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kincardine is grouped with 6 other towns. 








#### Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




#### **Occupation**

(% aged 16-74)








