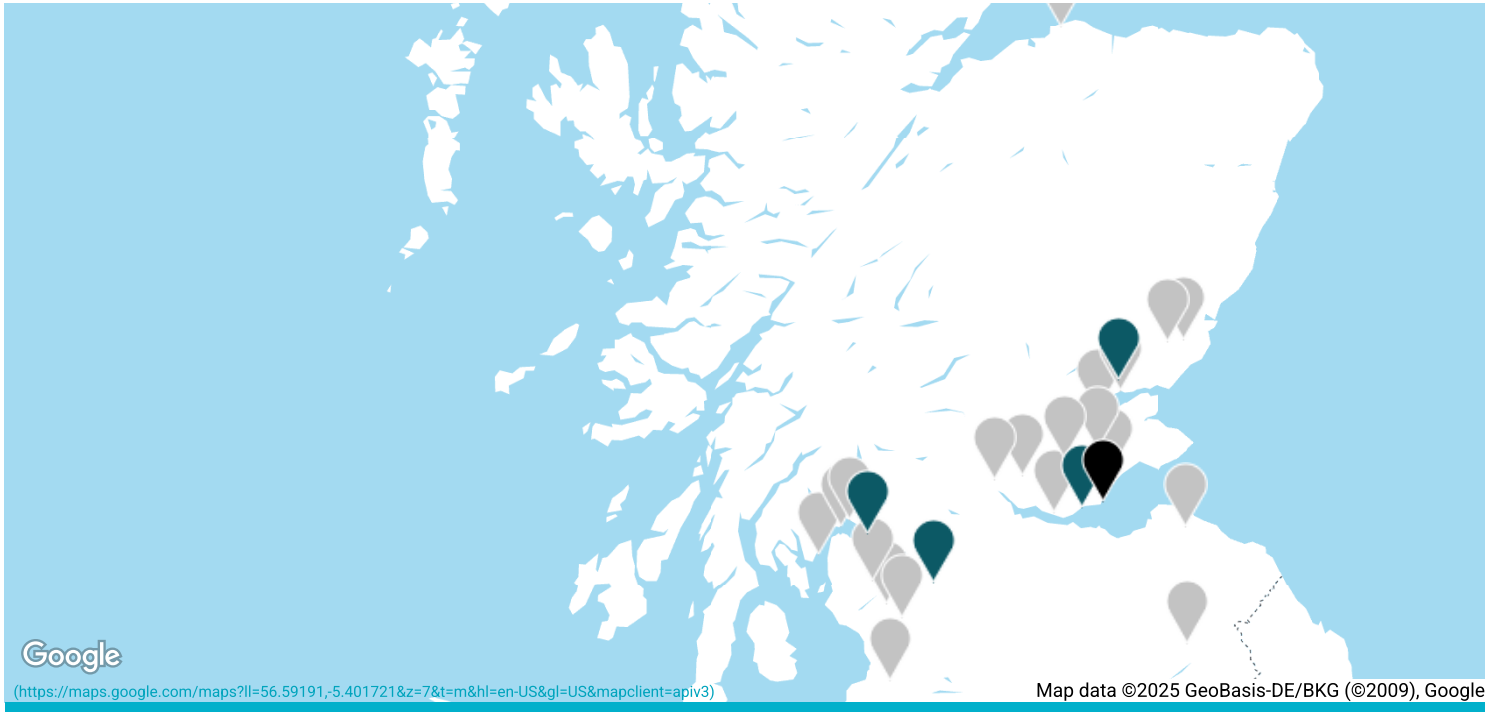

Kinghorn is in Fife. It had a strategic location in historic times. It was a ferry port. It became popular as a weekend resort. It is also popular with commuters.

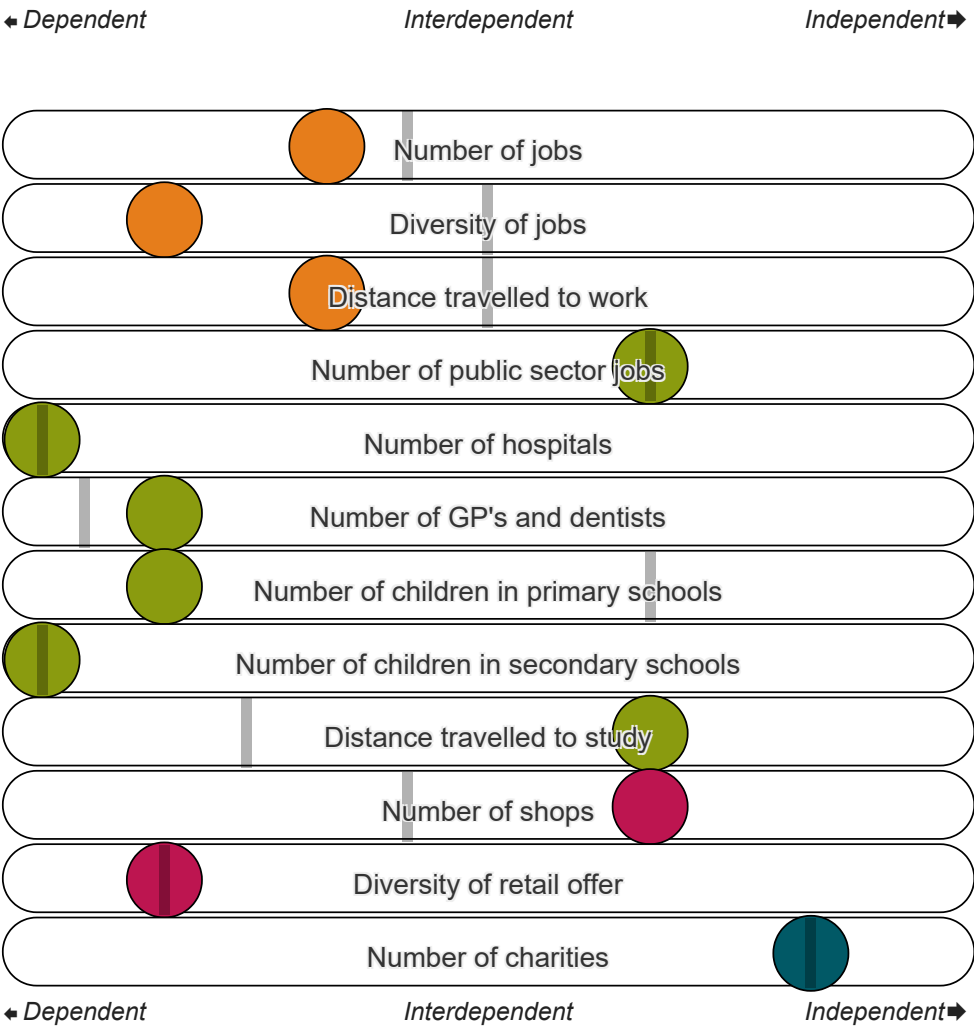
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Kinghorn is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kinghorn is grouped with 24 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of shops. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Kinghorn differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools; and the diversity of jobs.

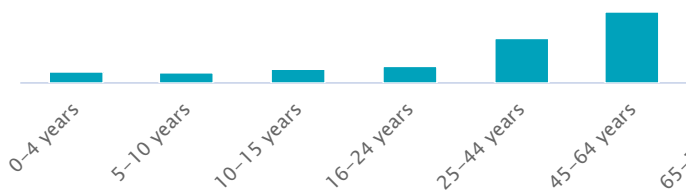

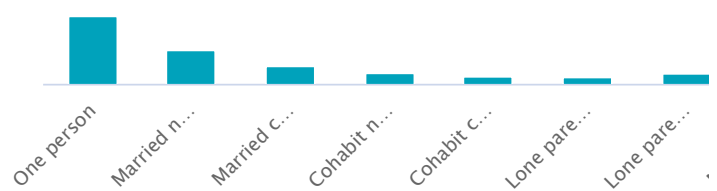

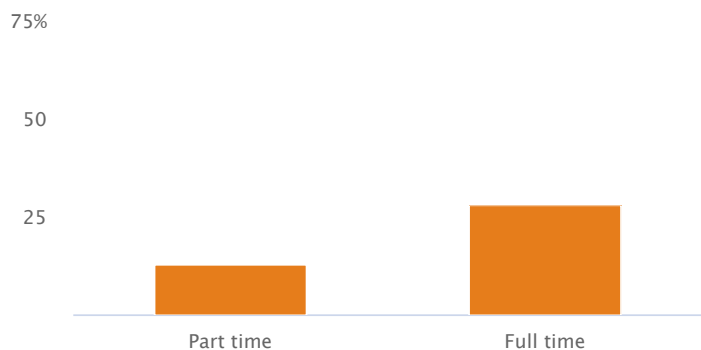

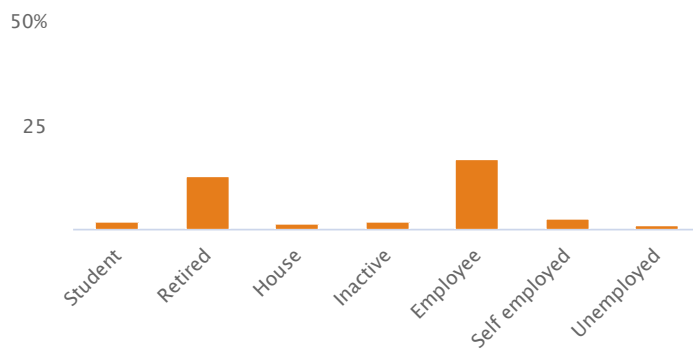
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



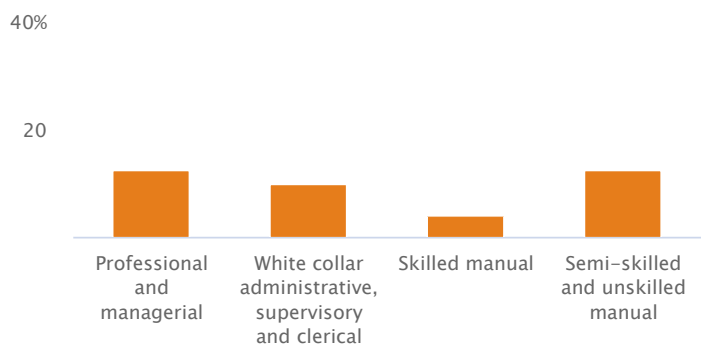
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

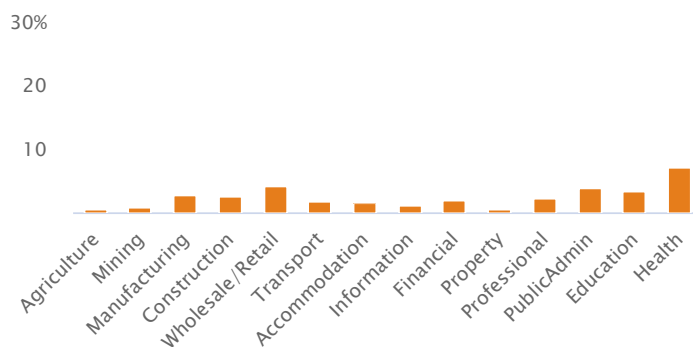


Social Grade

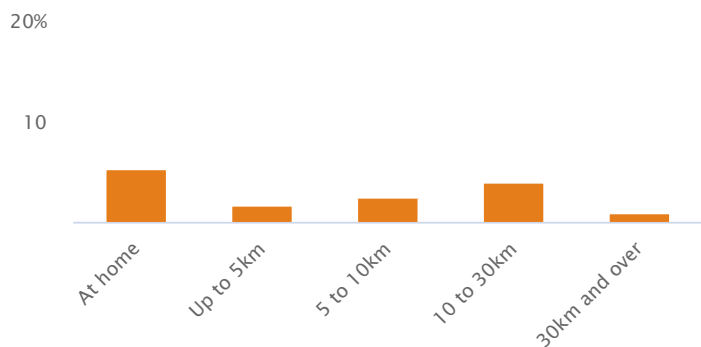
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

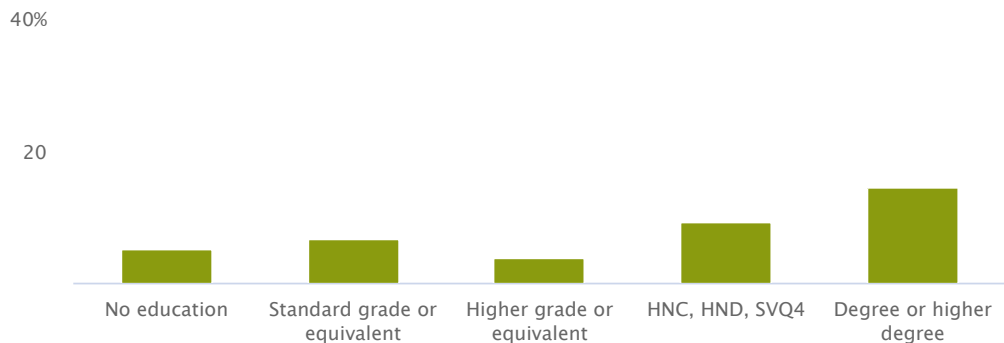


Distance travelled to work

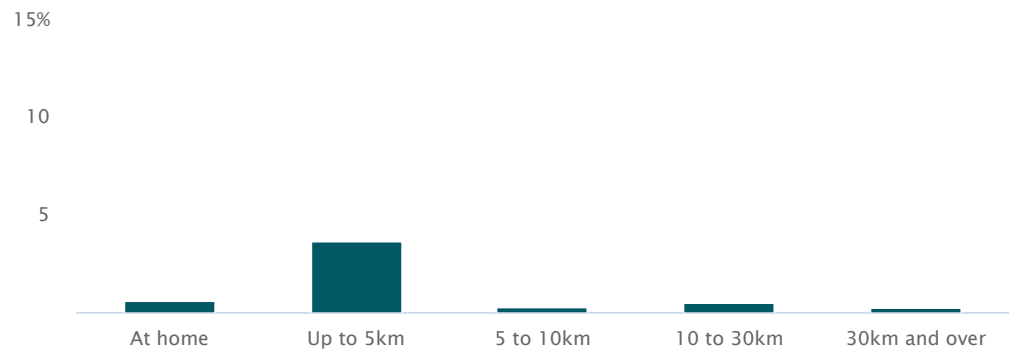
