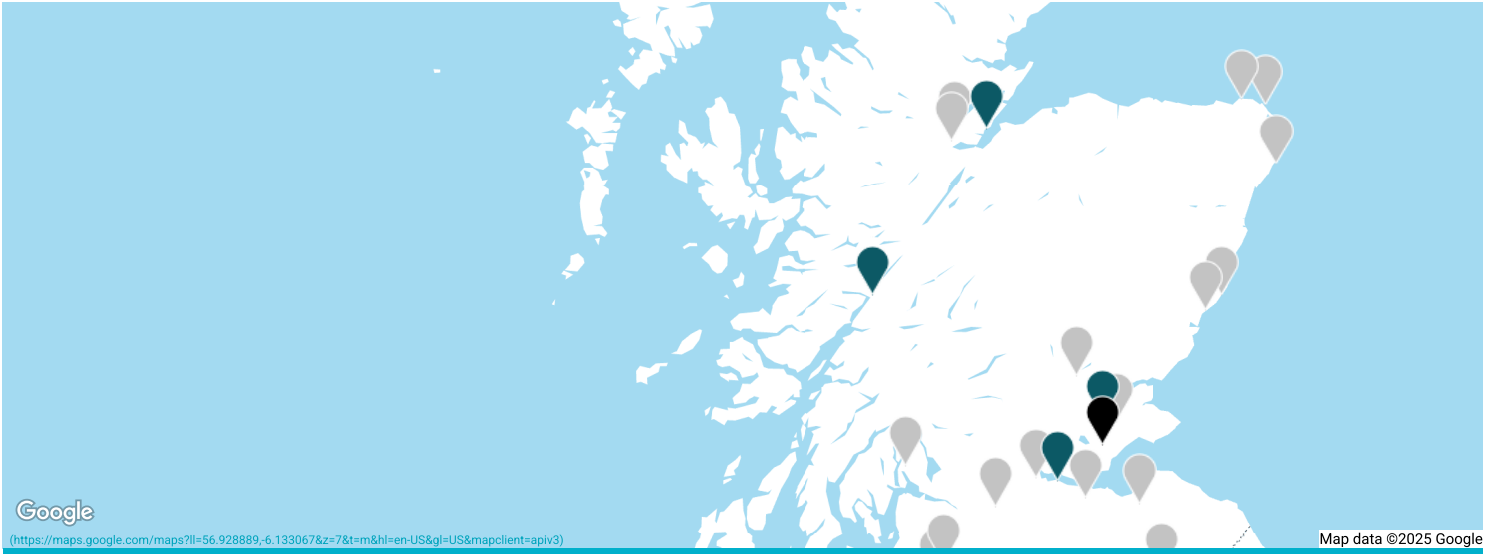

Kinglassie is in Fife. It is a former mining town. Other activities include quarrying.

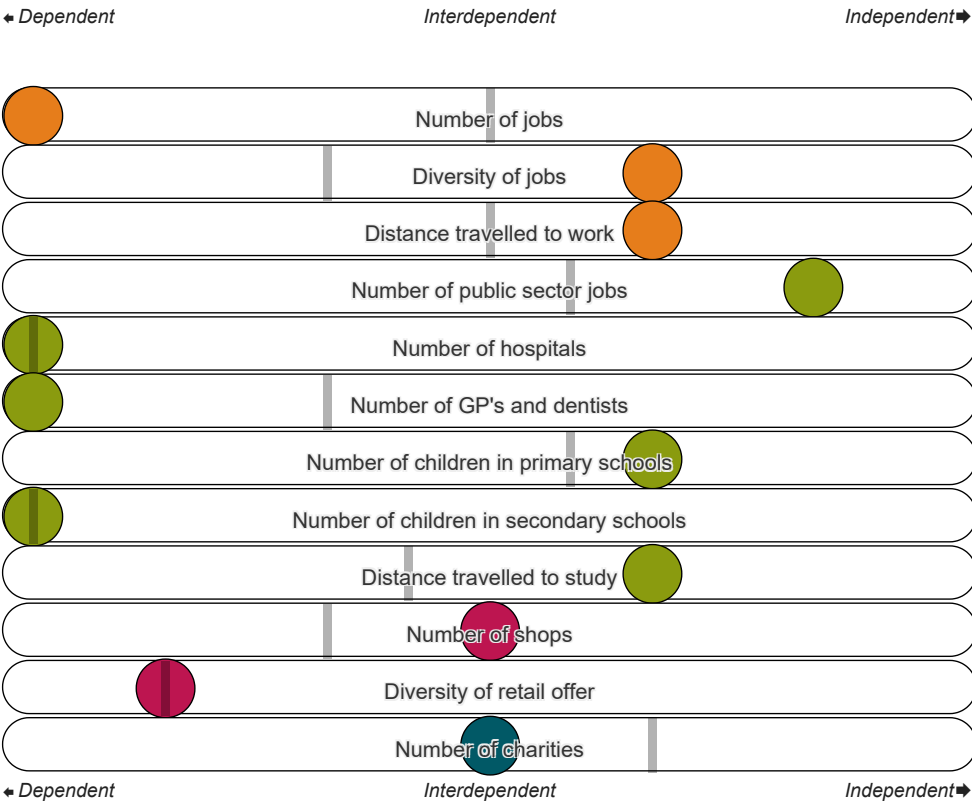
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Kinglassie is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kinglassie is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study. Kinglassie differs most from its group in the number of jobs, and GP's and dentists.

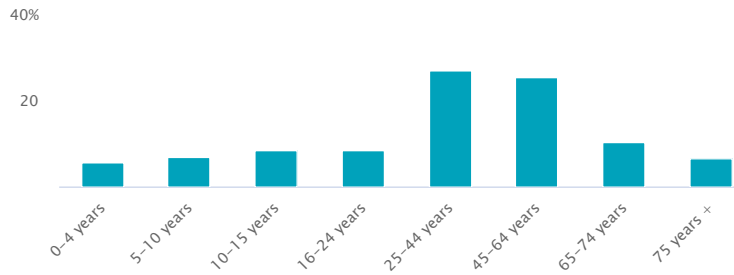

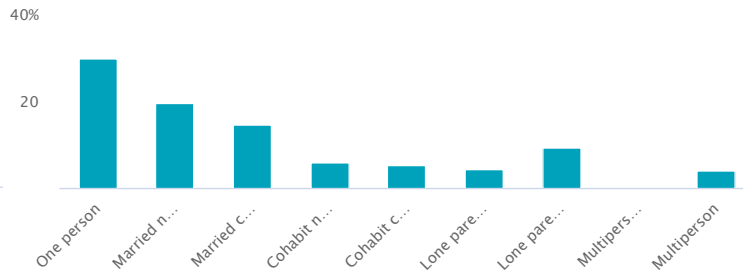

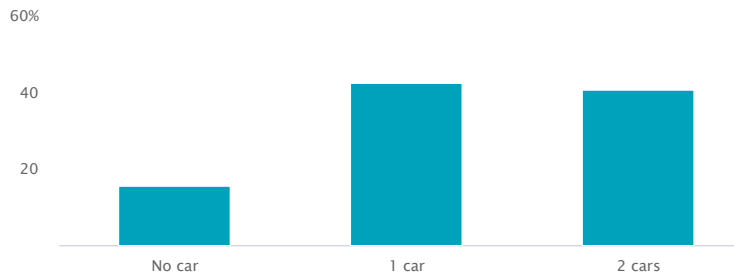

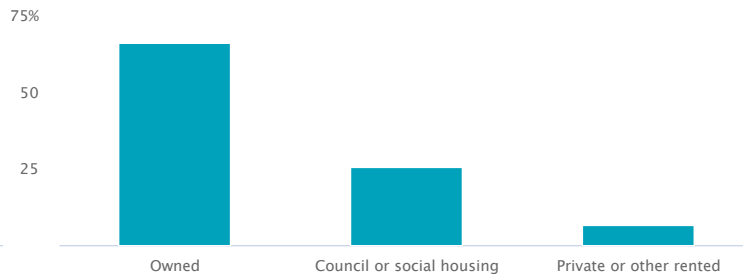

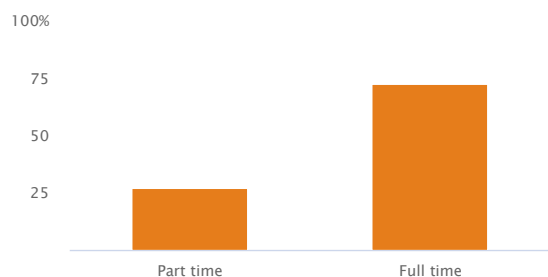

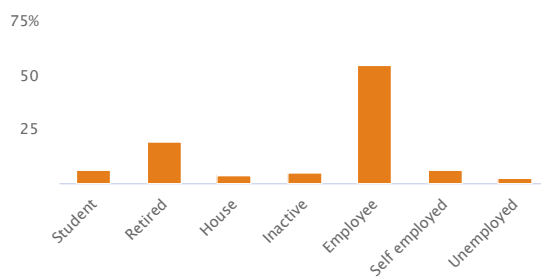
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



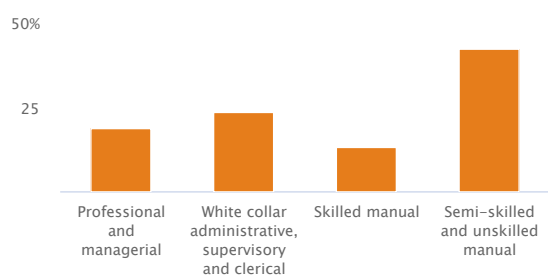
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

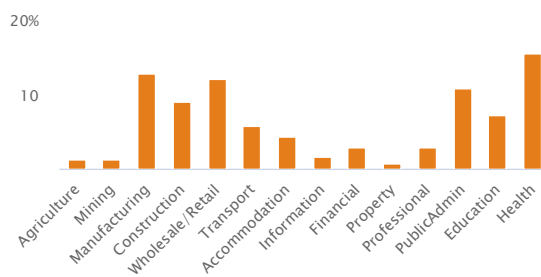


Social Grade

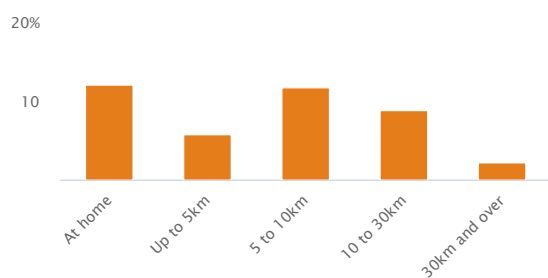
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

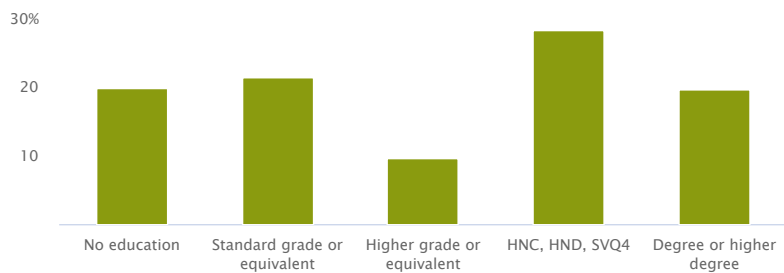


Distance travelled to work

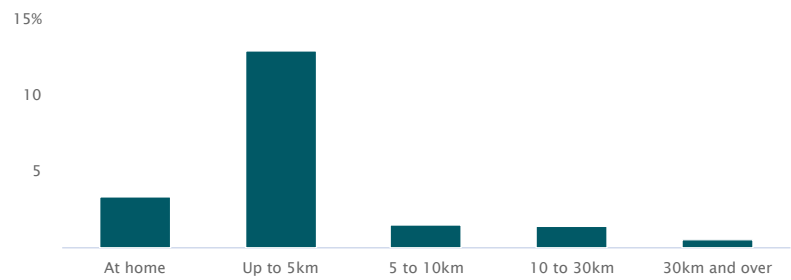
