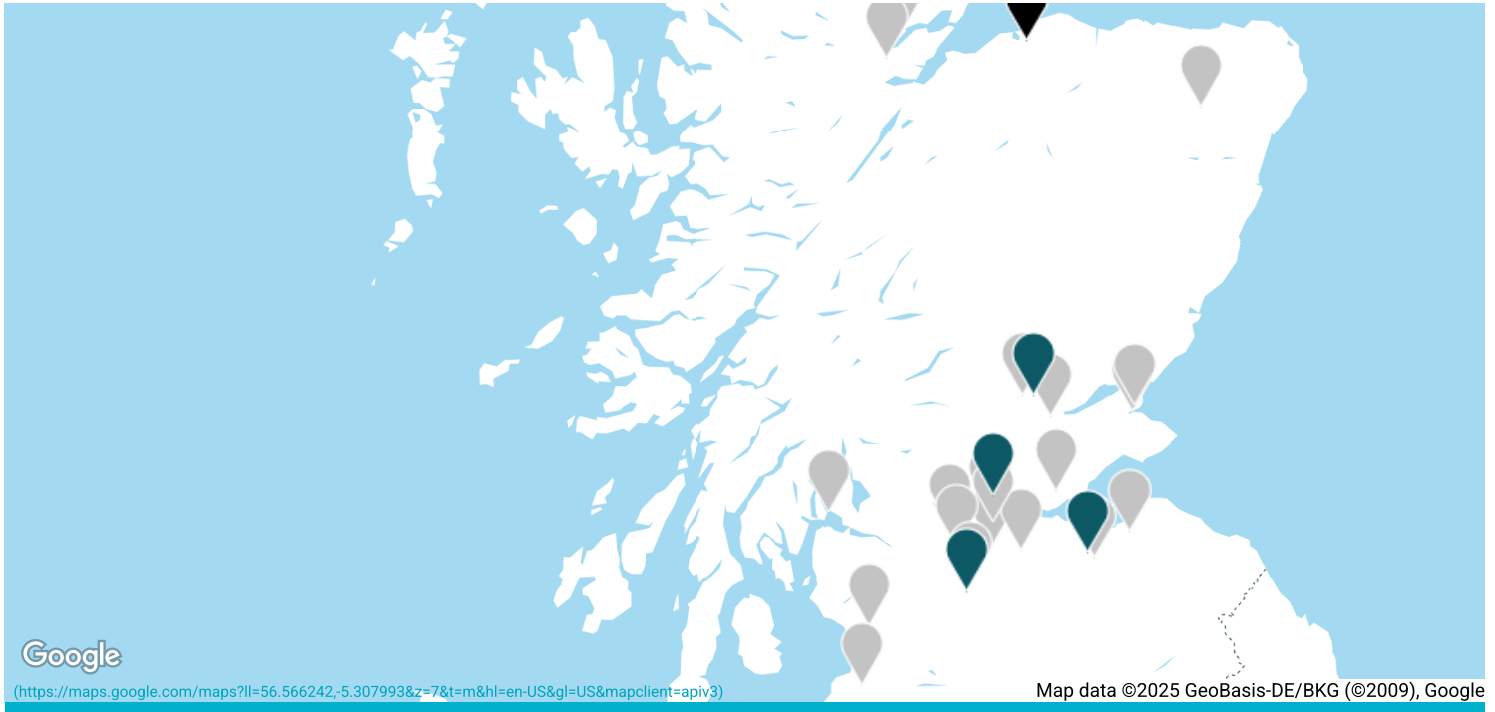

Kinloss is in located in Moray. It is best known as an RAF base (established in 1939) but the based closed in 2012. Many of the former workers on the base have set up local micro businesses.

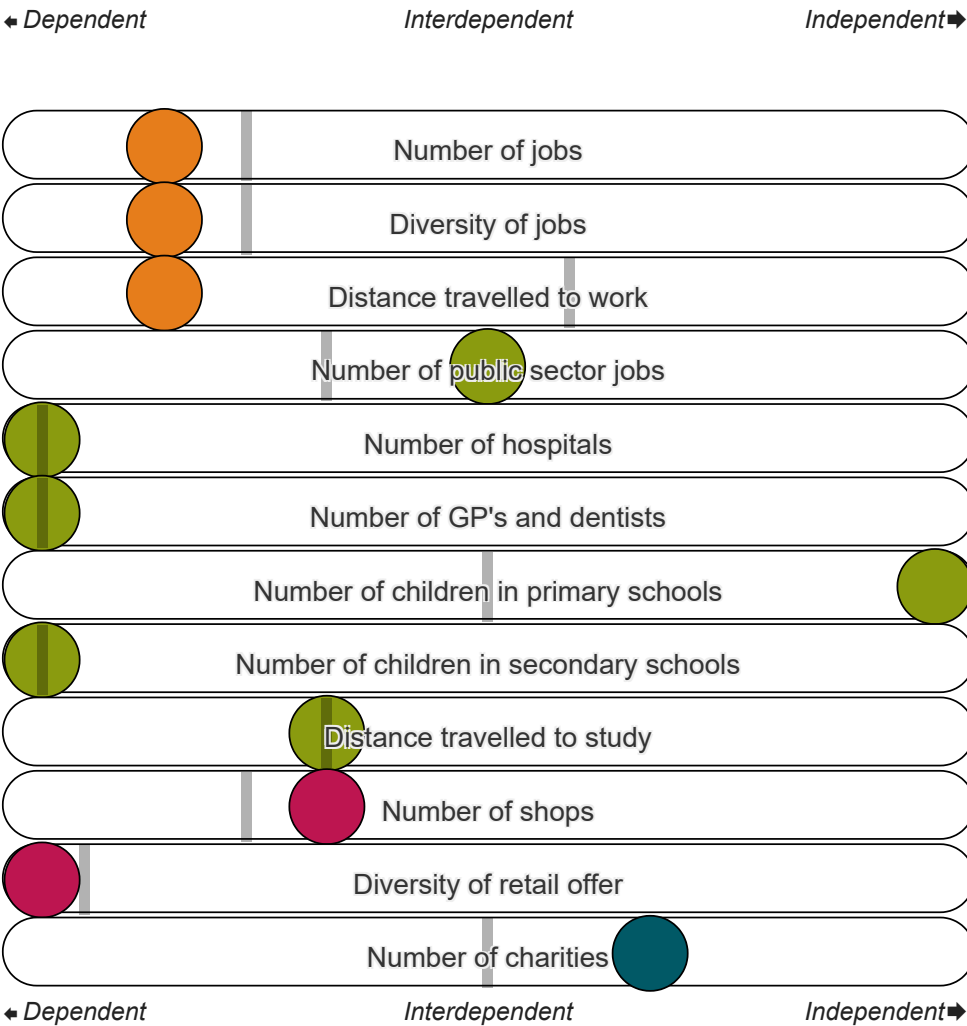
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Kinloss is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kinloss is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools. Kinloss differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

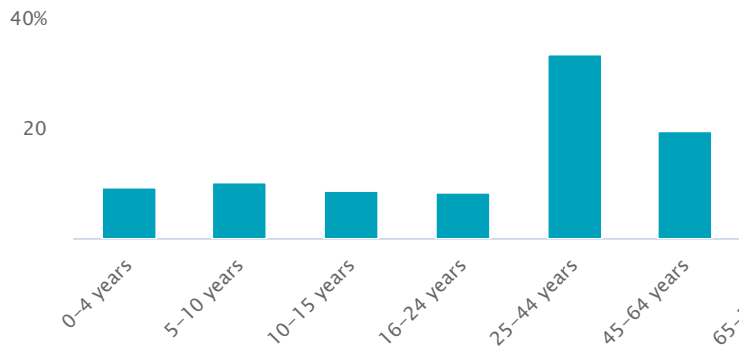

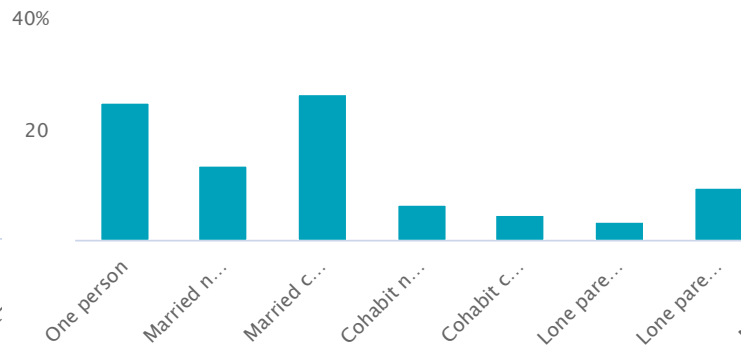

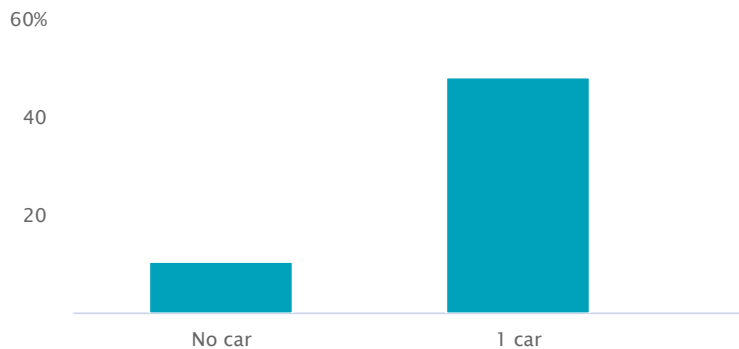

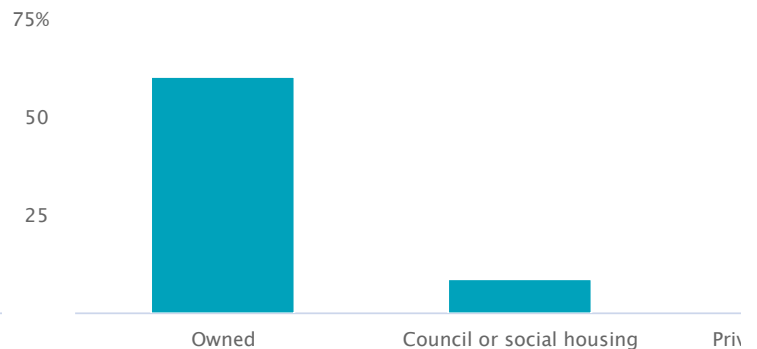

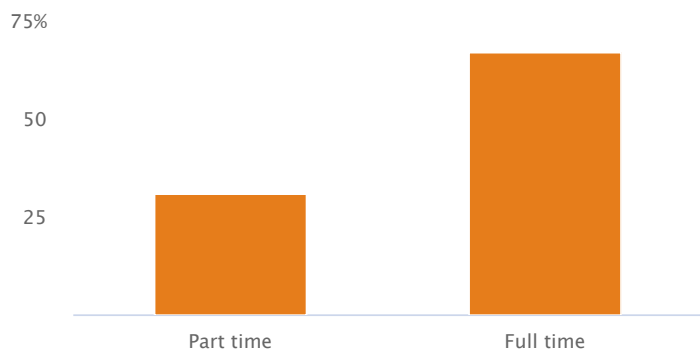

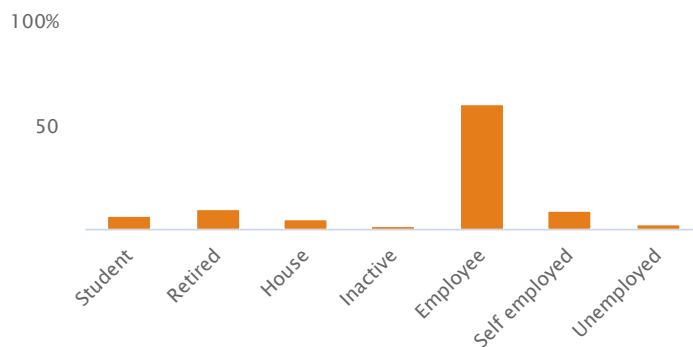
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



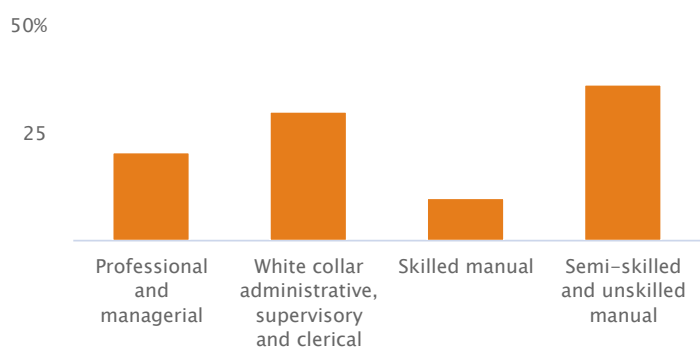
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

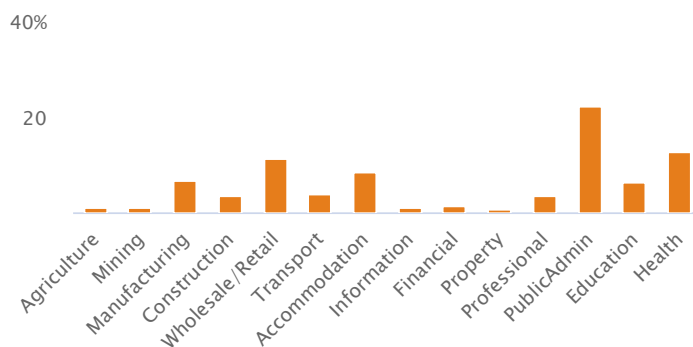


Social Grade

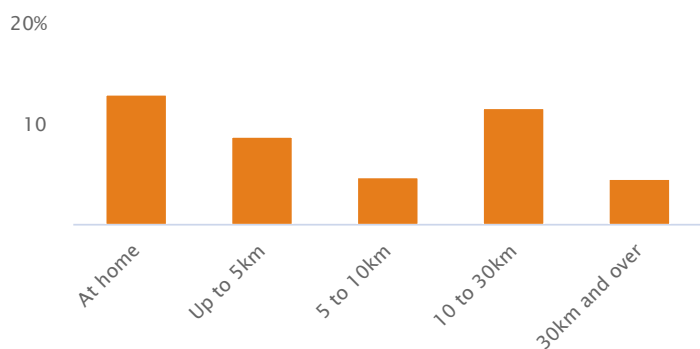
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

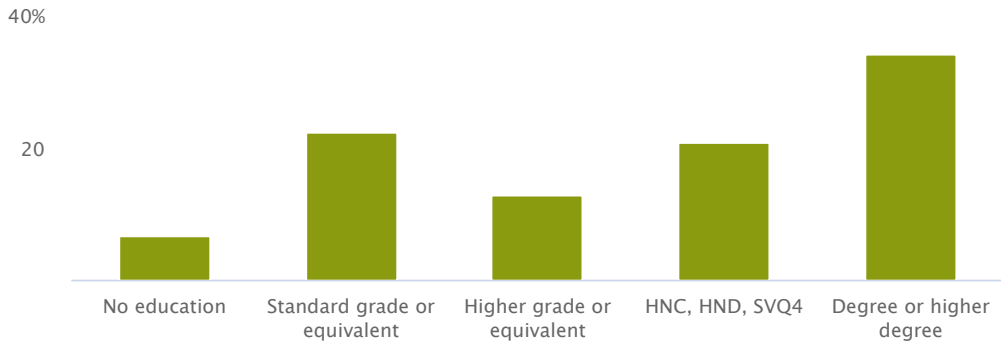


Distance travelled to work

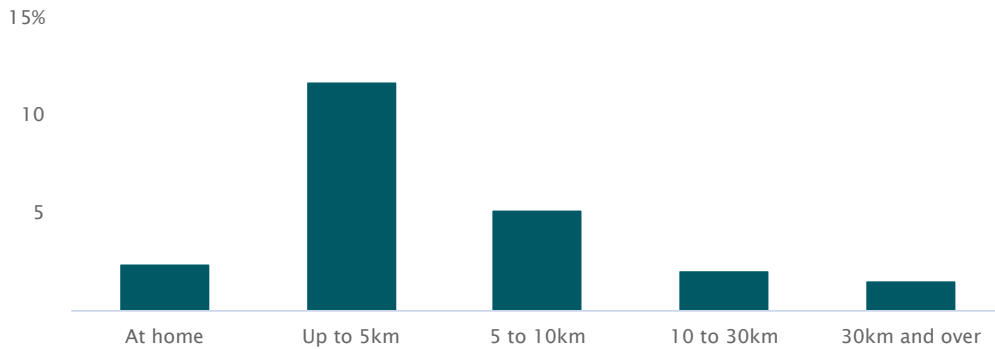
