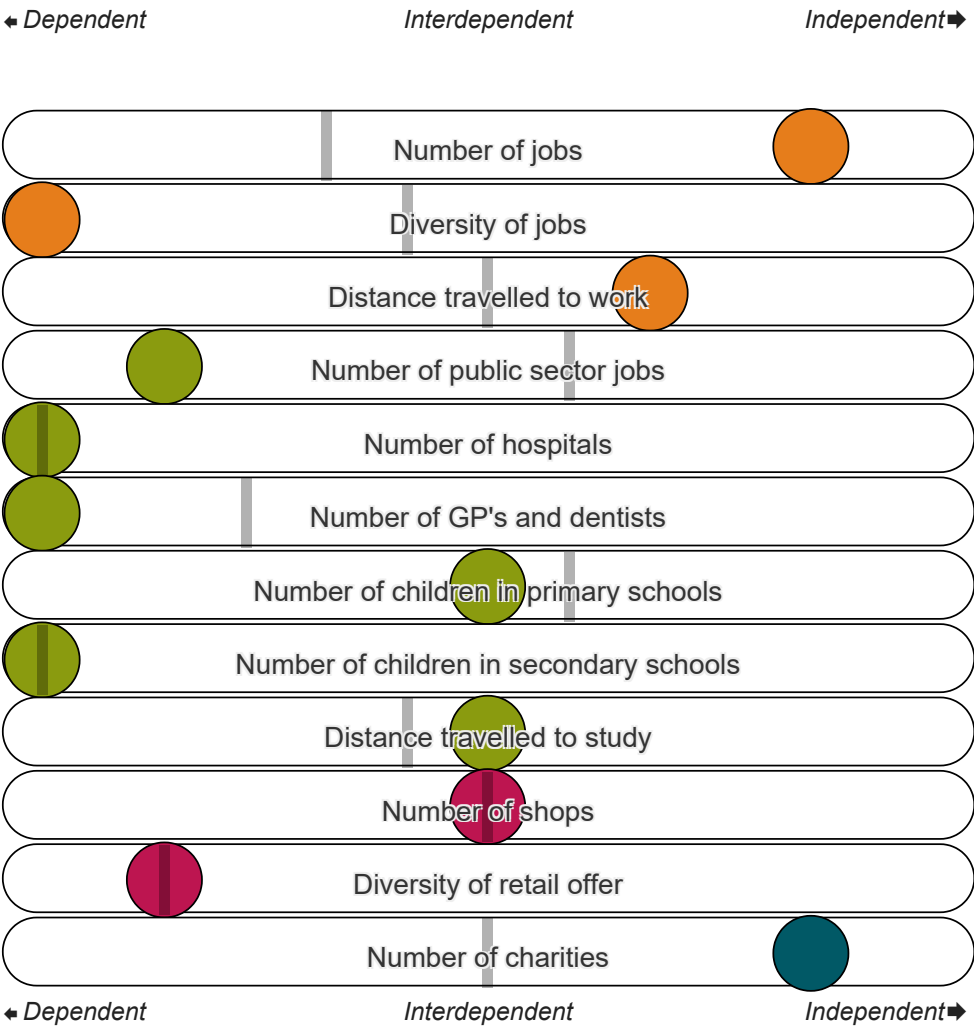




DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY

Inter-relationships



Kirkconnel and Kelloholm is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kirkconnel and Kelloholm is grouped with 13 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, jobs, and public sector jobs. Kirkconnel and Kelloholm differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs.

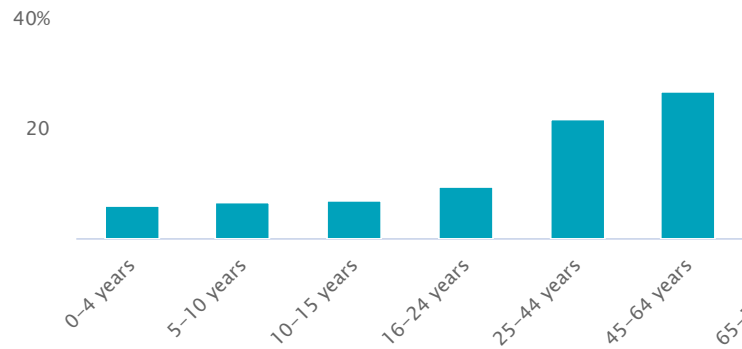
Population change 2011 to 2022

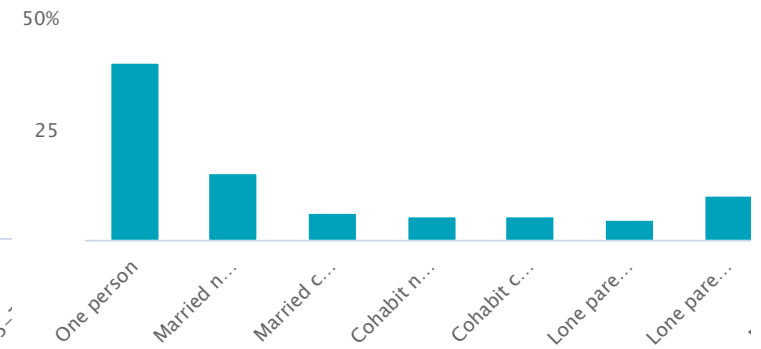

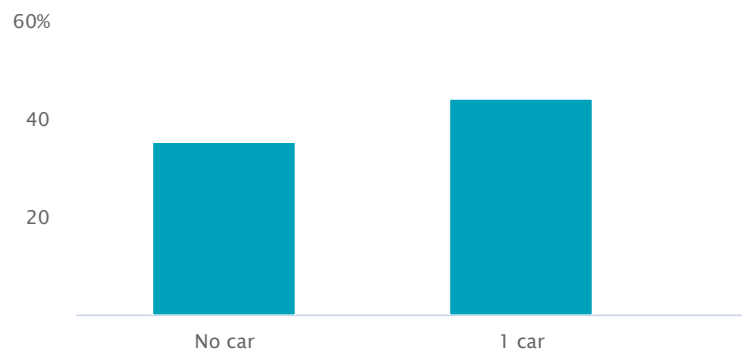

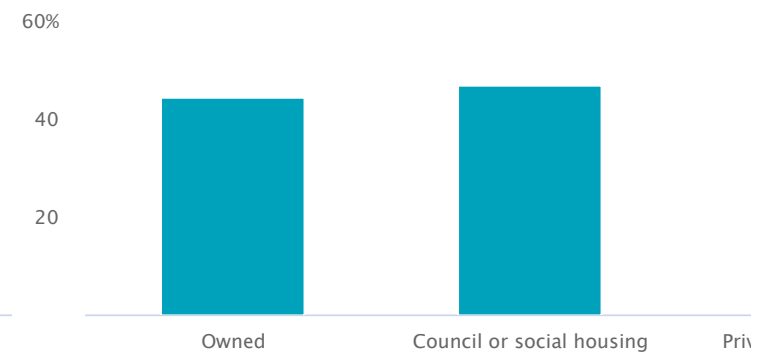

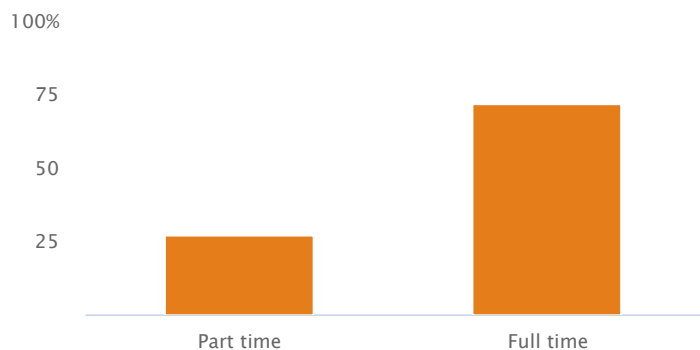

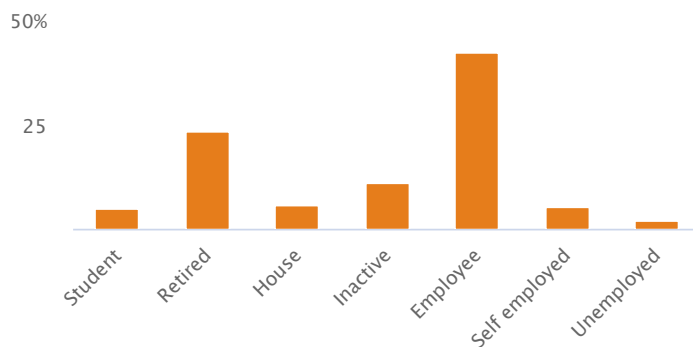
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



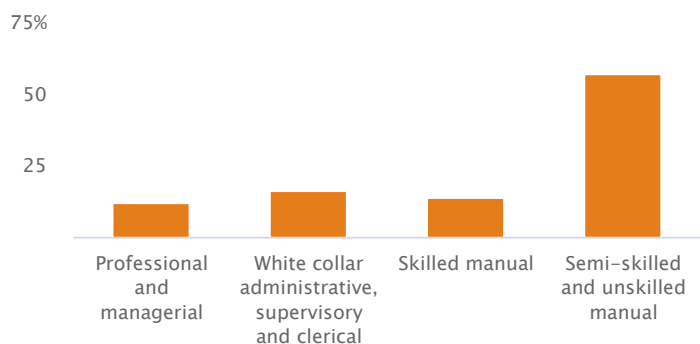
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

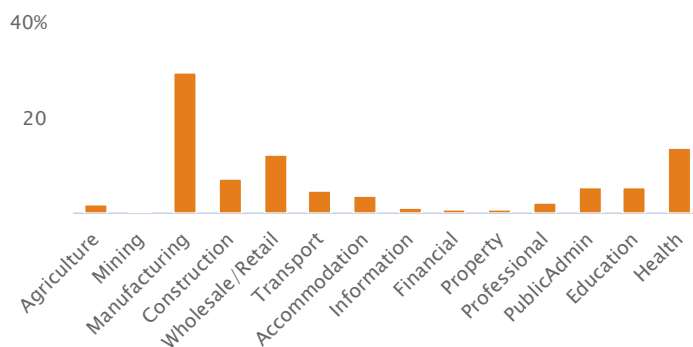

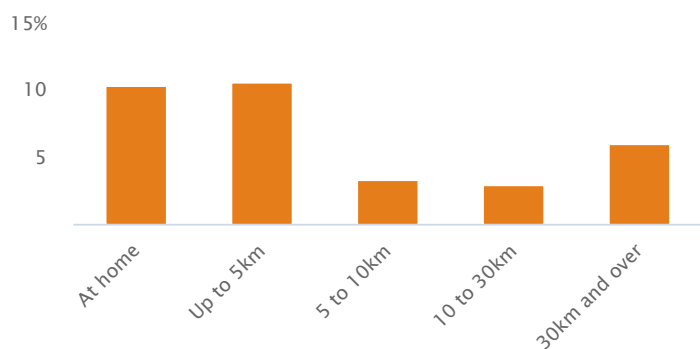
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

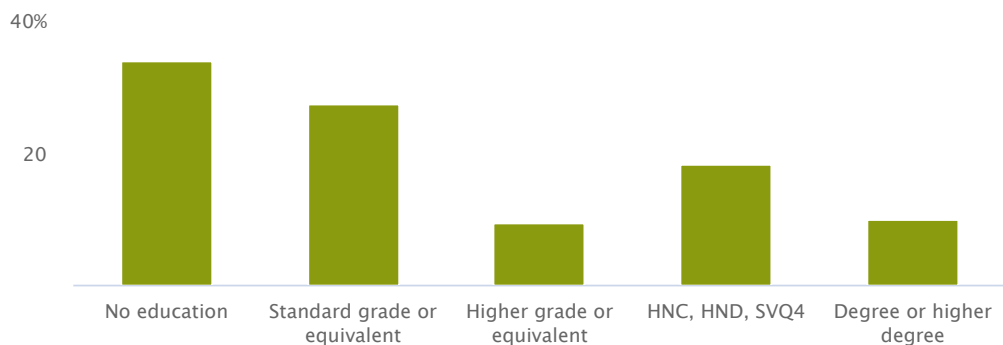


Distance travelled to work

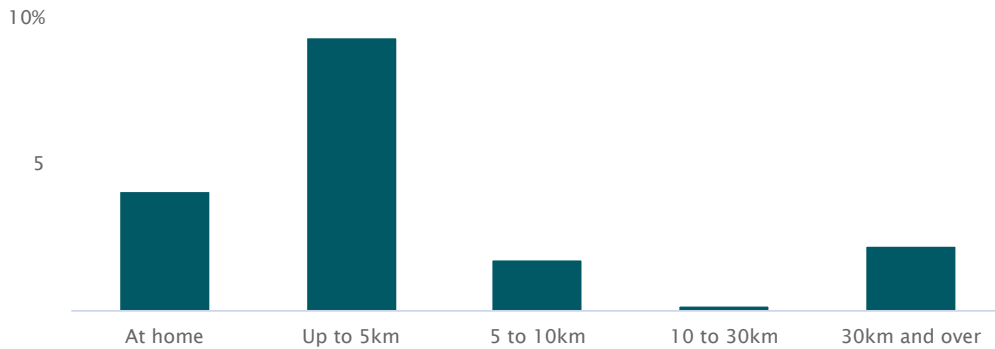
