Kirkconnel is in Dumfries and Galloway. Until the discovery of coal it was a rural hamlet. It was a mining settlement associated with the Fauldhead Colliery. The pit closed in the 1980s but open cast mining until recently but the lack of employment saw many people leave the town.


In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Kirkconnel and Kelloholm is an interdependent to dependent town.

Its most similar towns are Ardersier, Calderbank, Cowie, and Douglas.




Population change 2011 to 2022








Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)




Social Grade


(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity




Distance travelled to work


