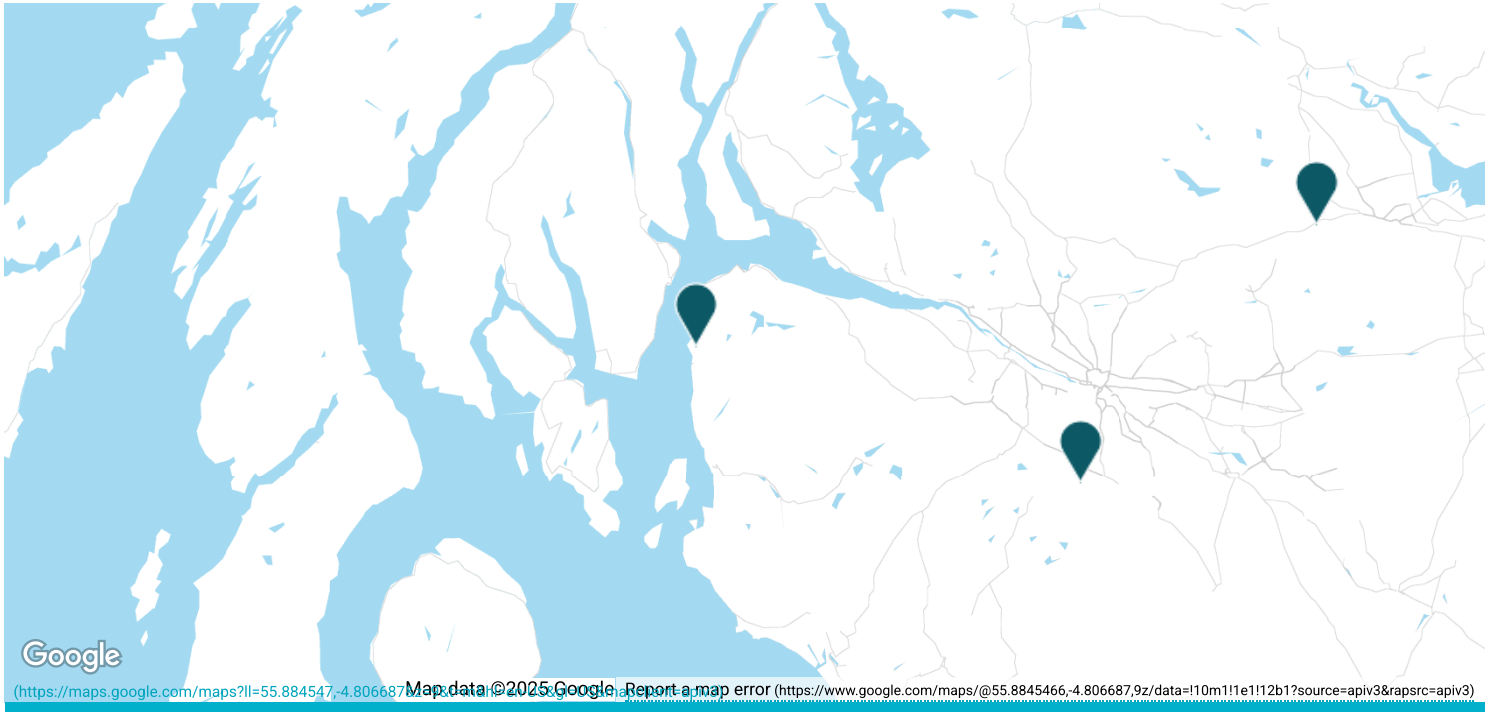




Kirknewton

Kirknewton in West Lothian is a former oil shale and mining settlement. Today it is a commuter town.

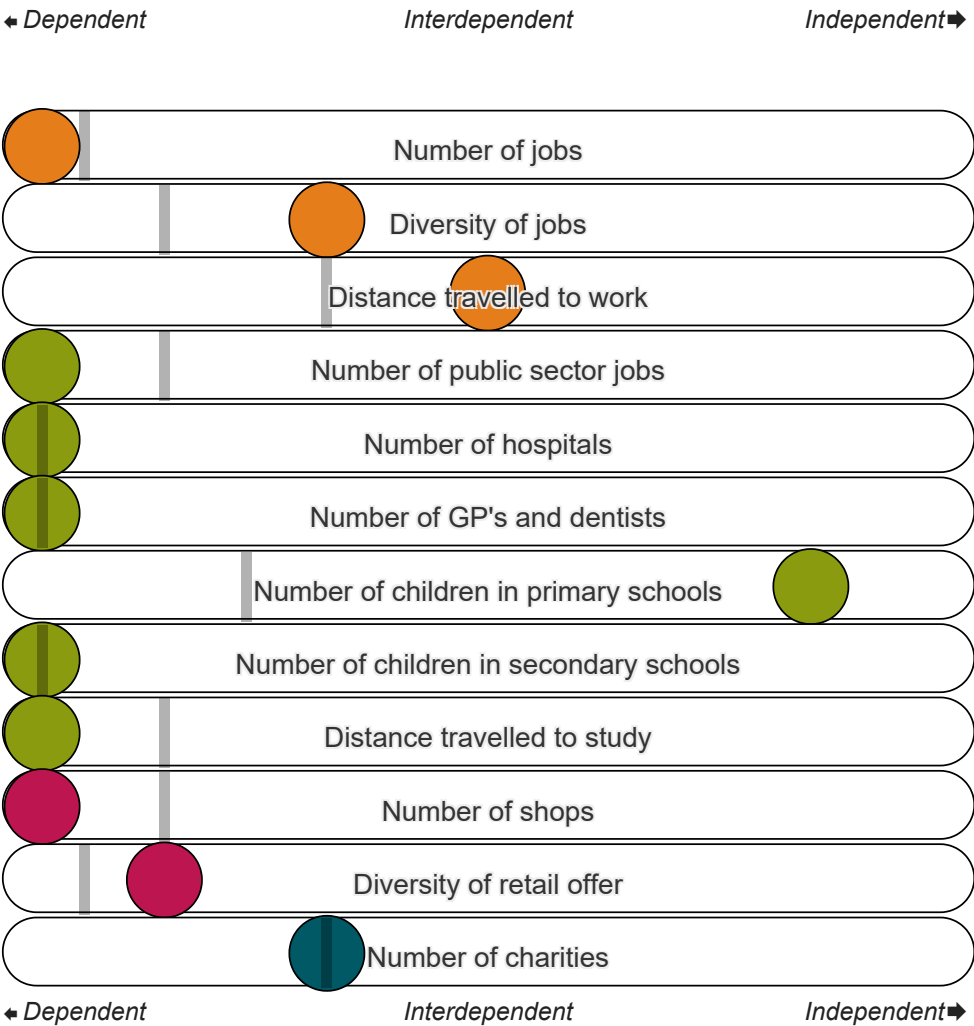
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Kirknewton is a **dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kirknewton is grouped with 3 other towns. 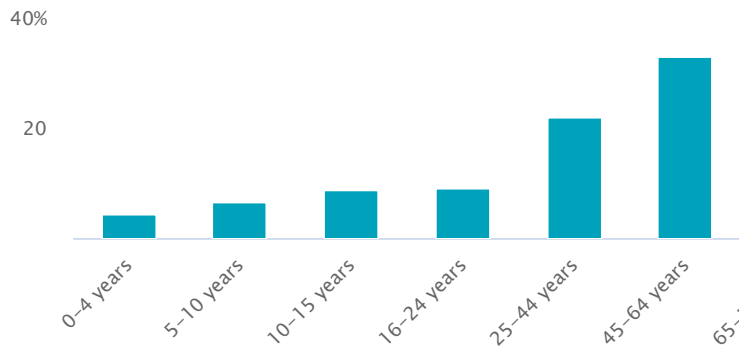

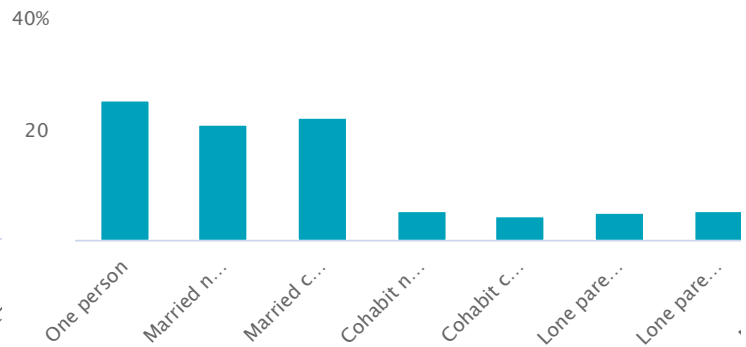

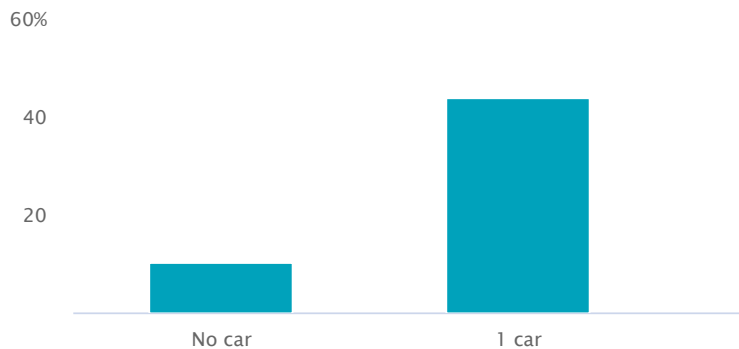

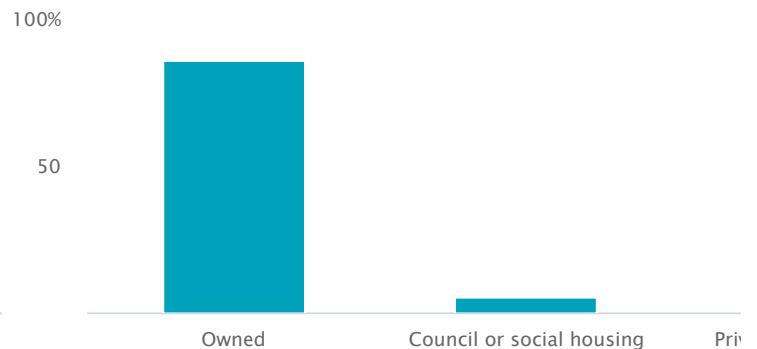
Household composition

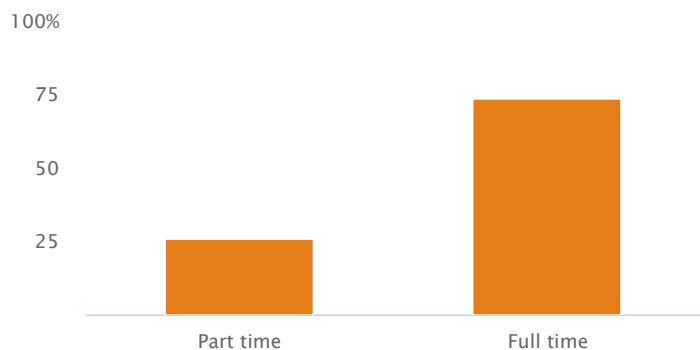

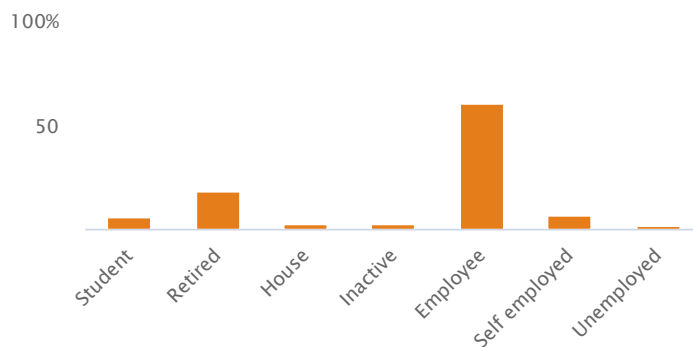
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



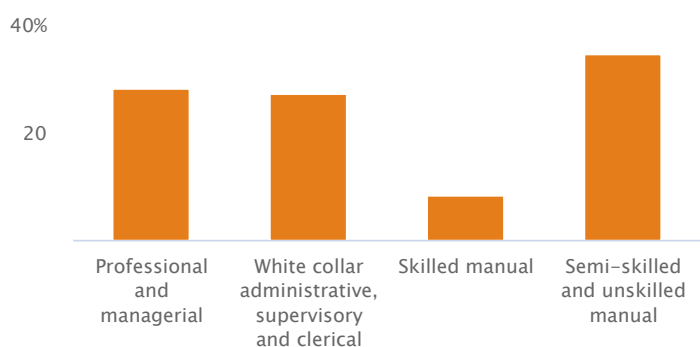
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

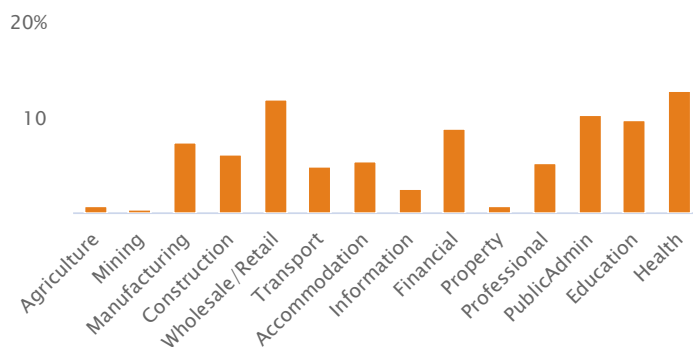

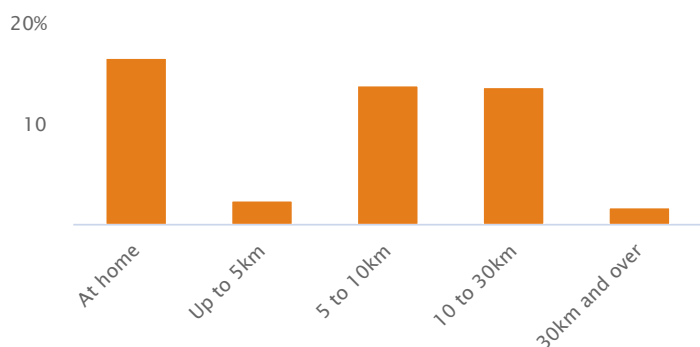
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

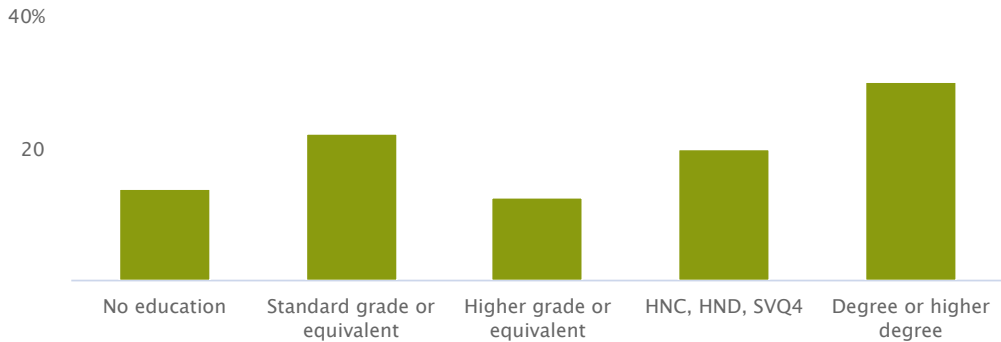


Distance travelled to work

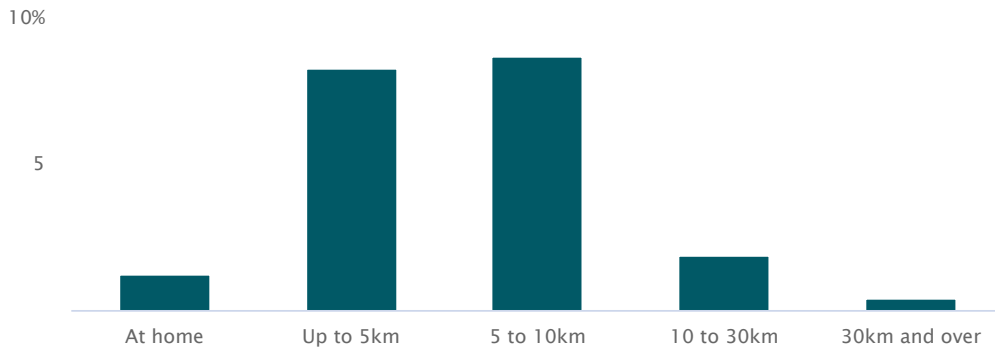
