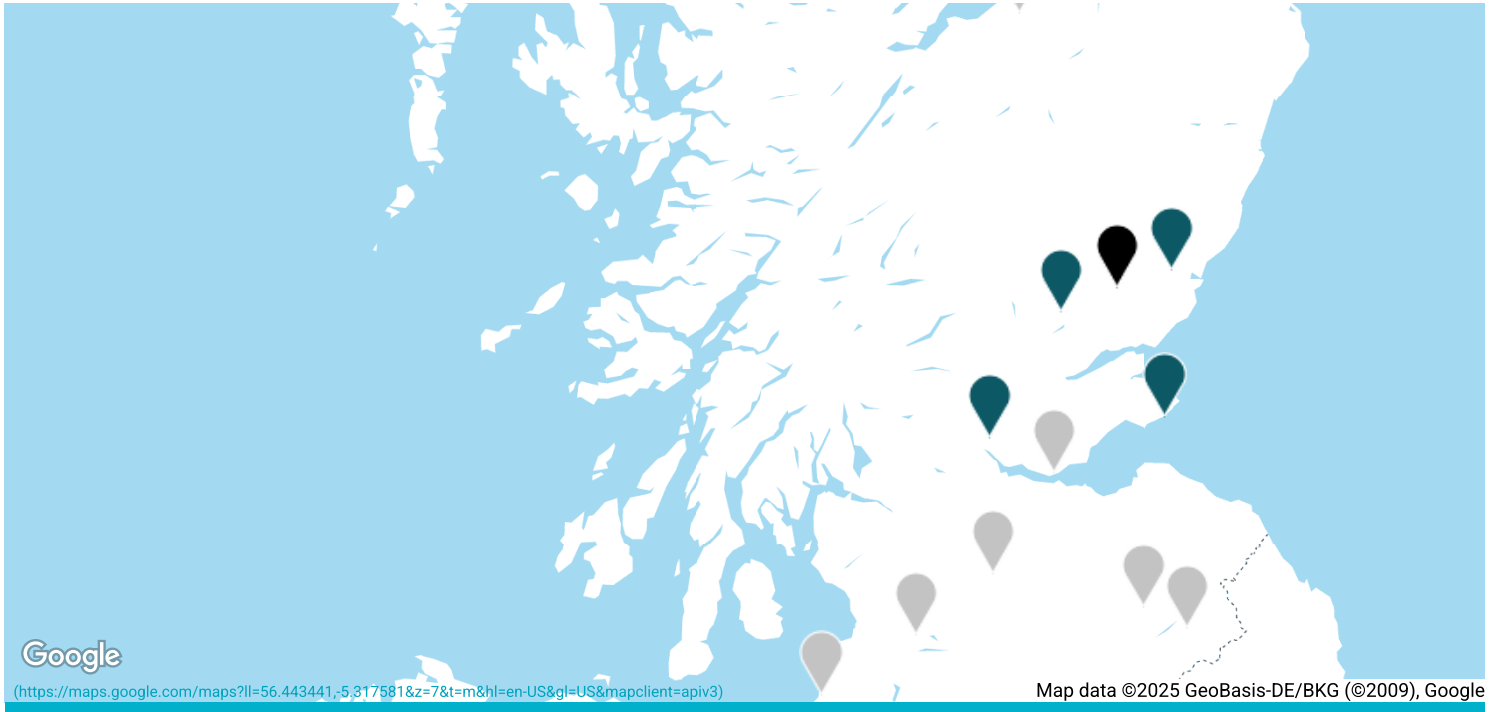

Kirriemuir in Angus is the gateway to the glens. It has long been and still is a local market town with strong ties to the surrounding agricultural area. It is known for its gingerbread.

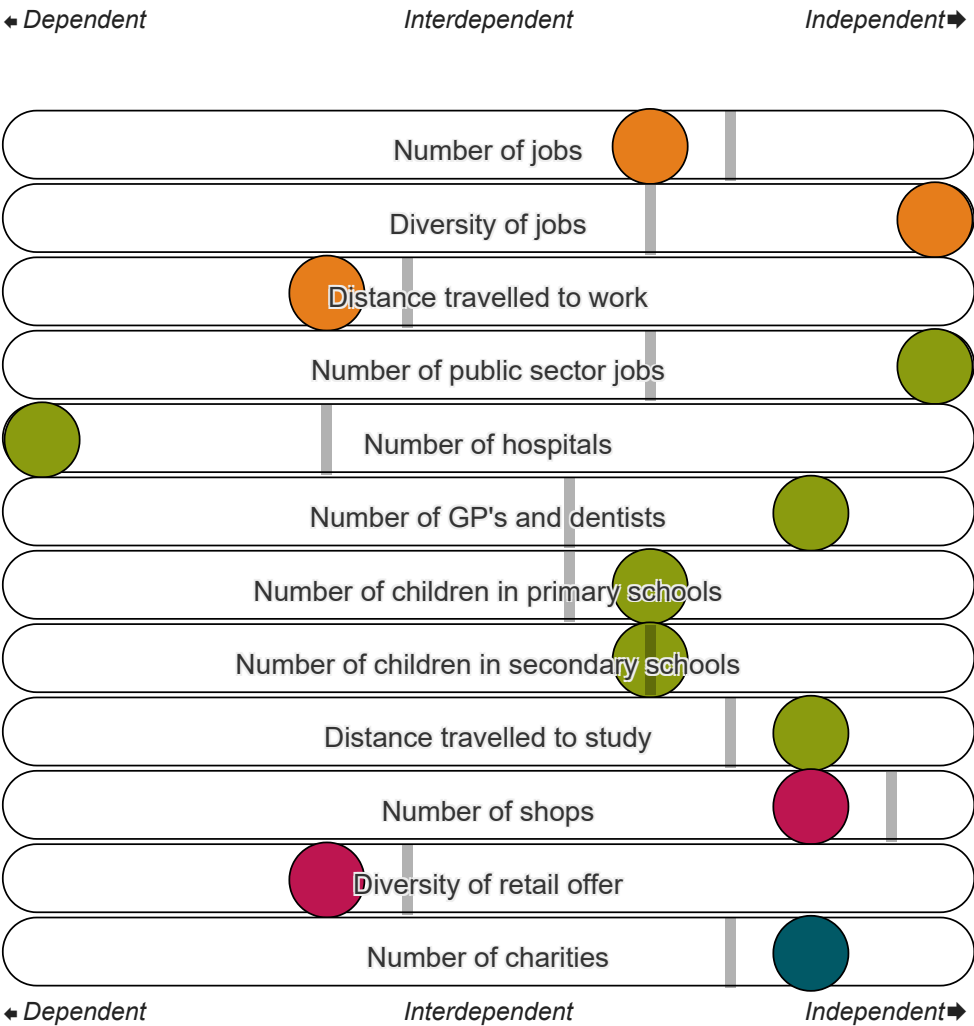
In this medium town, population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Kirriemuir is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Kirriemuir is grouped with 11 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Kirriemuir differs most from its group in the number of hospitals.

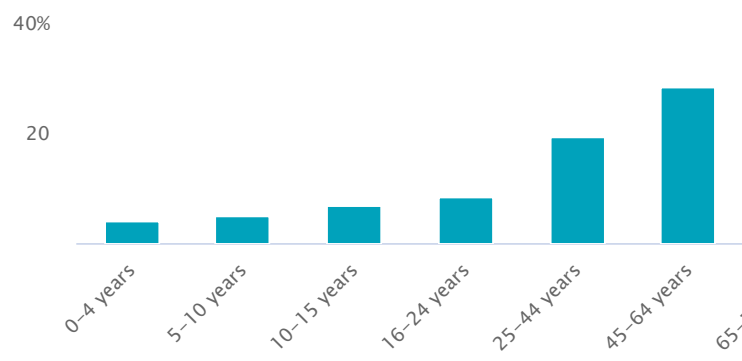

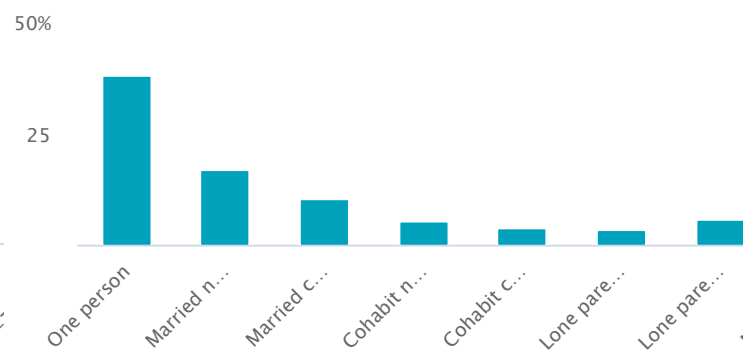

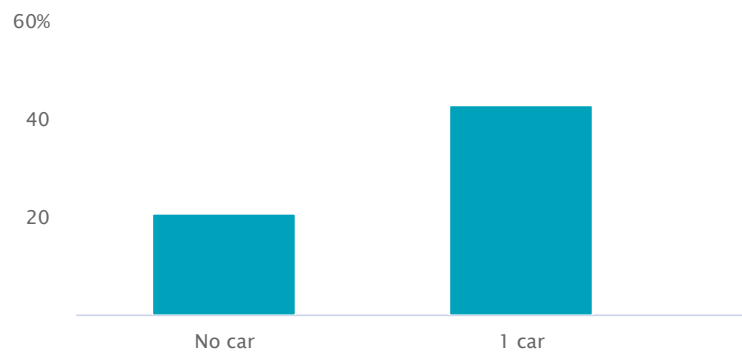

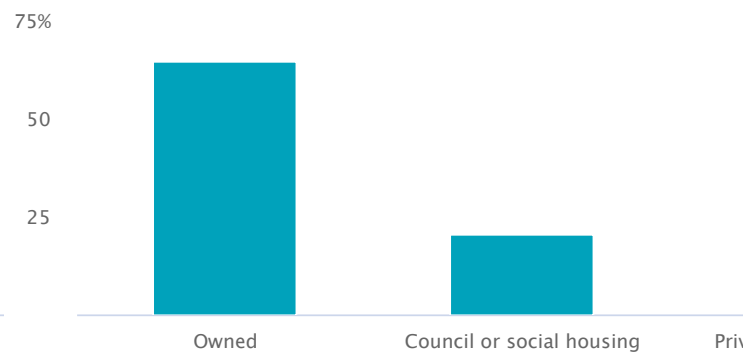

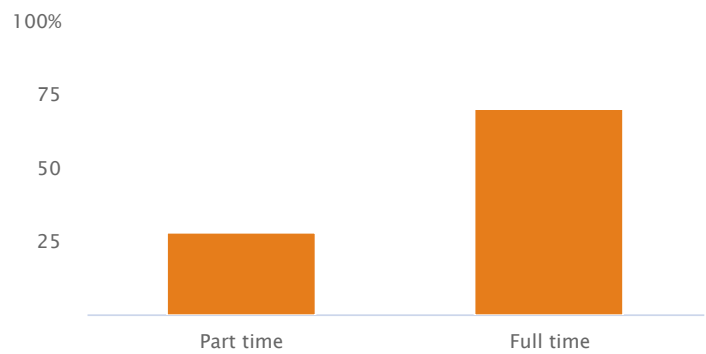

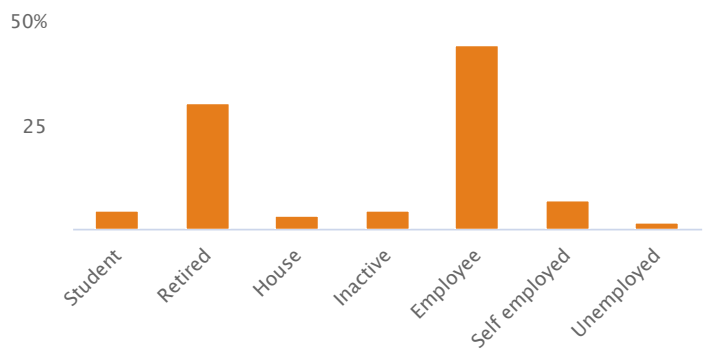
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



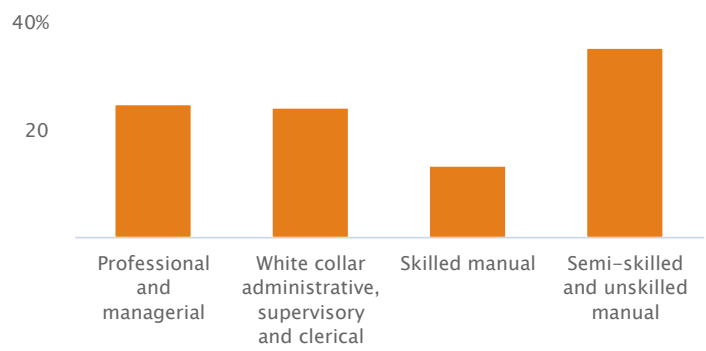
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

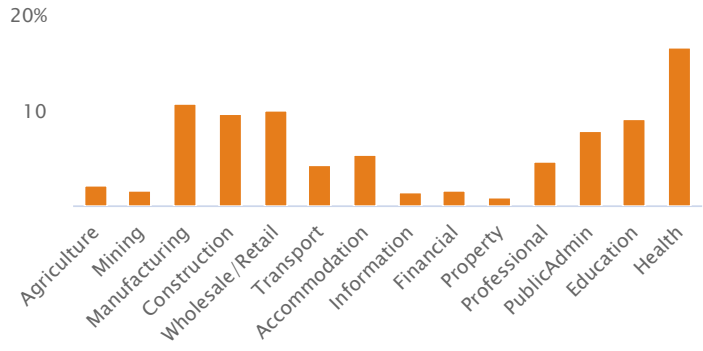

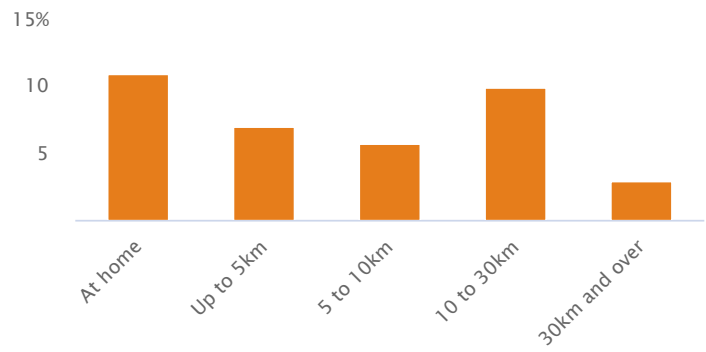
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

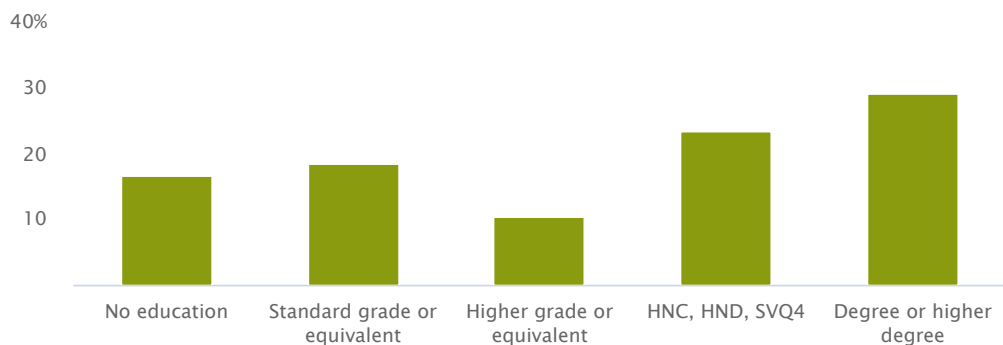


Distance travelled to work

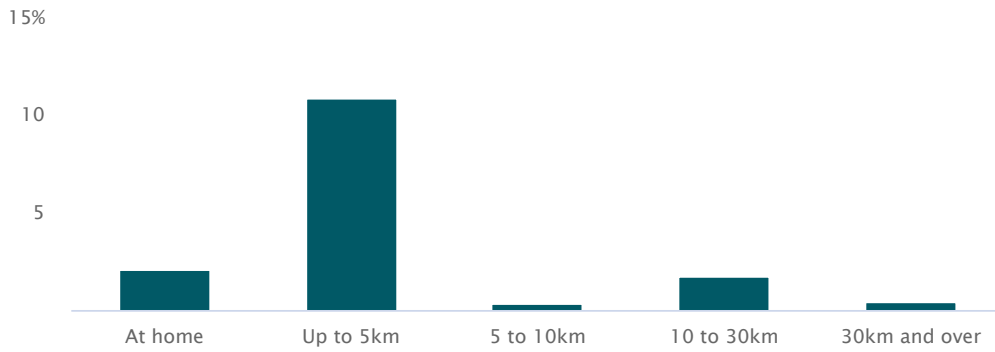
