Langholm or the Muckle Toun is in Dumfries and Galloway. It is a planned town on the Buccleuch estate. Wool was the centre of the town's economy and indeed still provides local employment. Border Fine arts is also based in Langholm.

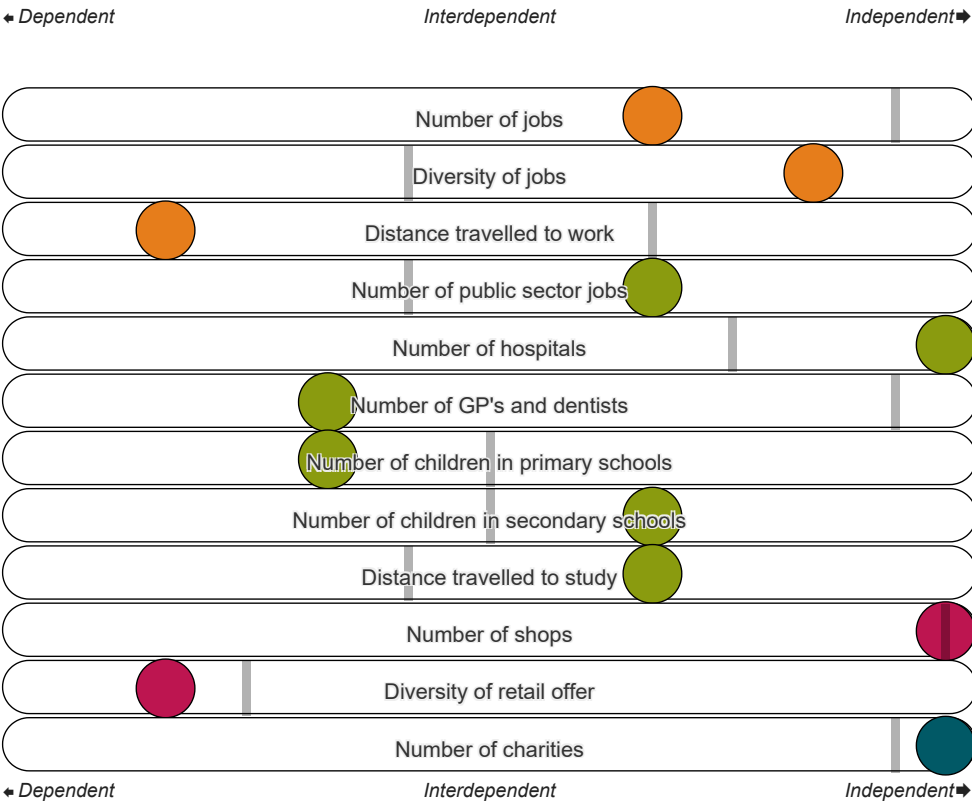
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Langholm is an interdependent to independent town.

Langholm is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Langholm is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of hospitals, public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Langholm differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

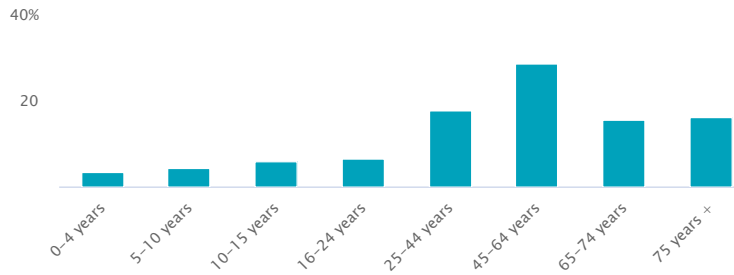

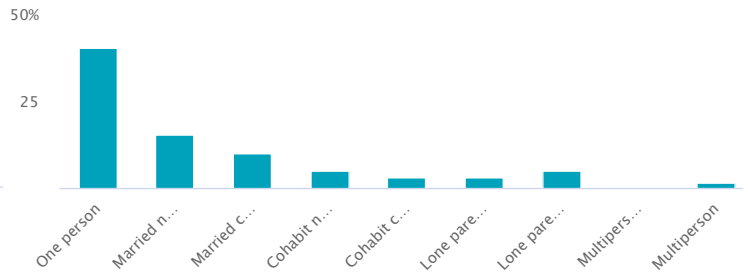

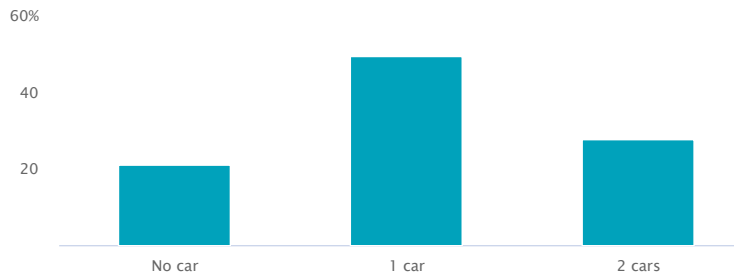

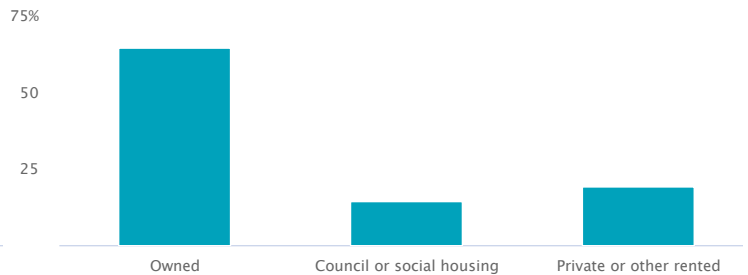
Household composition

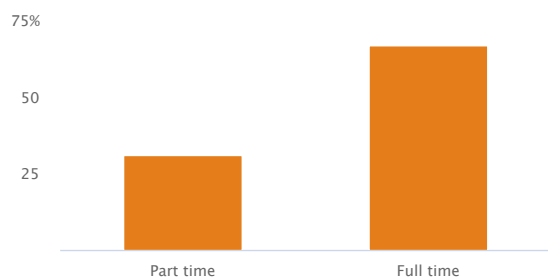

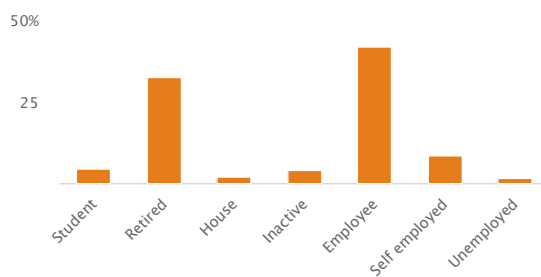
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



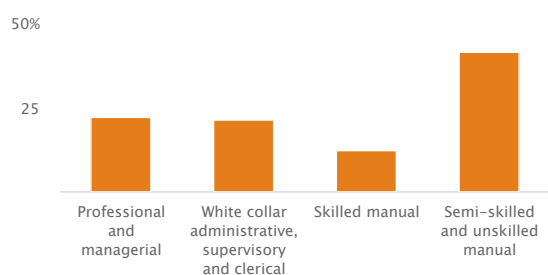
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

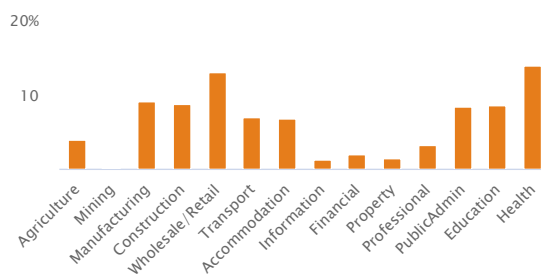

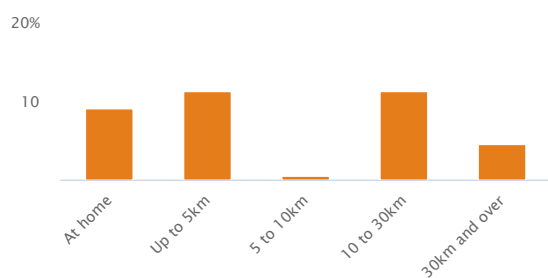
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

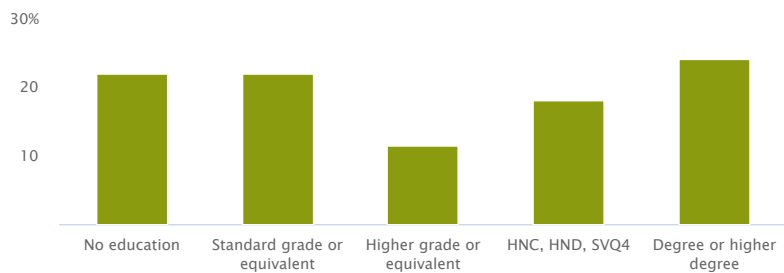


Distance travelled to work

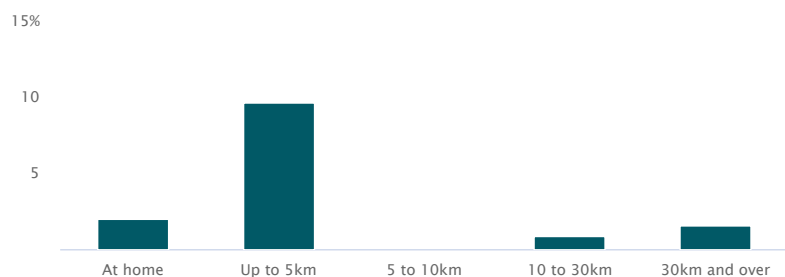
