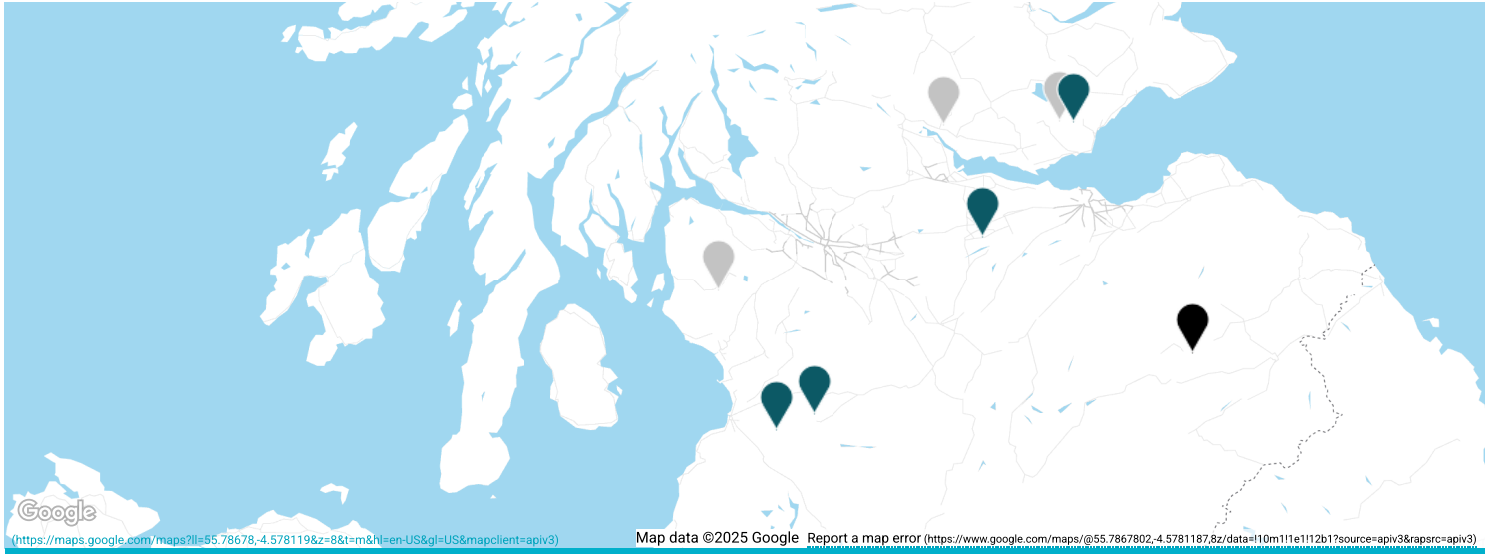




Langlee

Langlee is in Scottish Borders. It is a public housing estate close to Galashiels. Some regeneration is taking place with new rental and low cost housing.

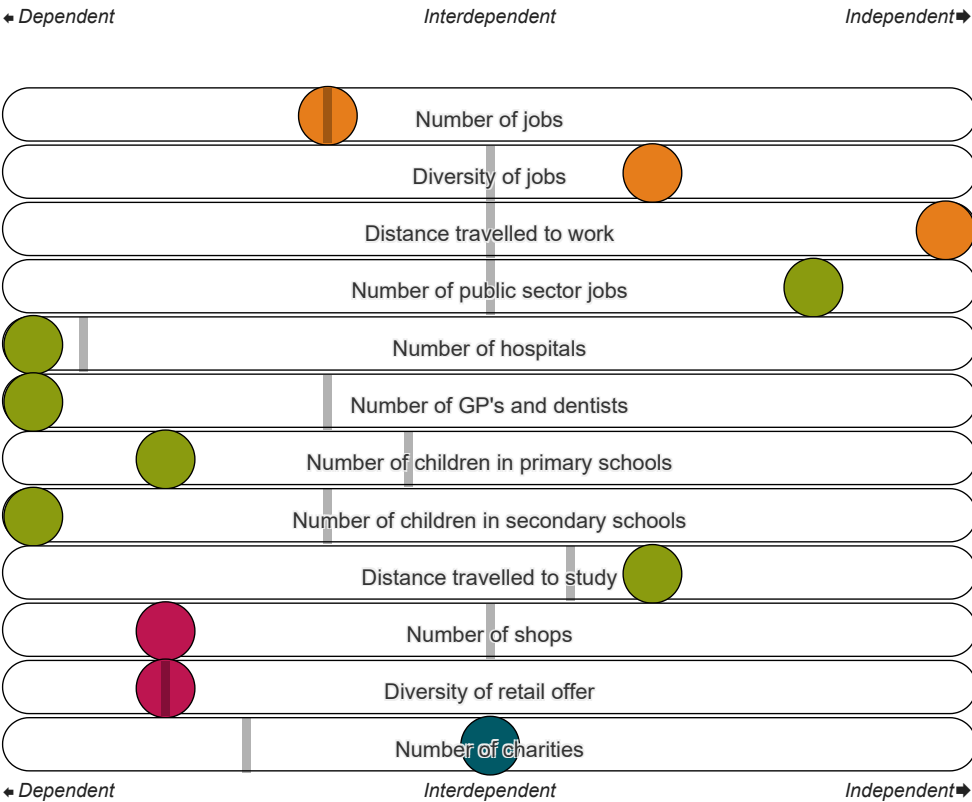
In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Langlee is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

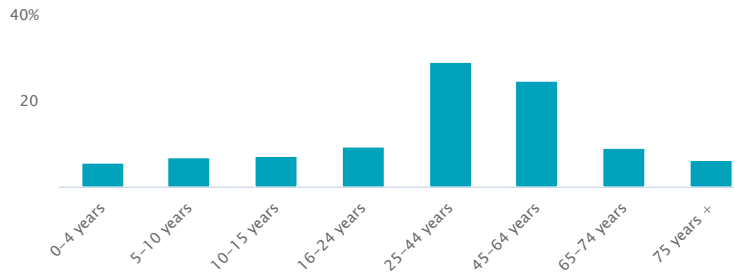
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Langlee is grouped with 7 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, public sector jobs, and shops. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Langlee differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools, and GP's and dentists.

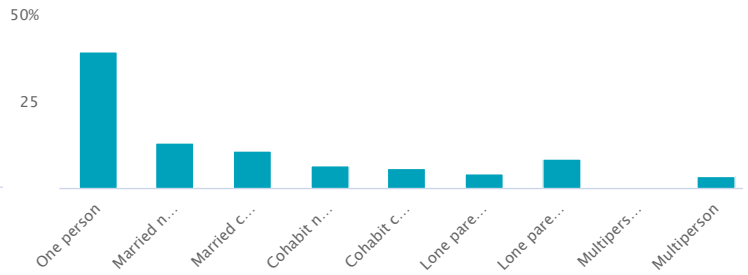

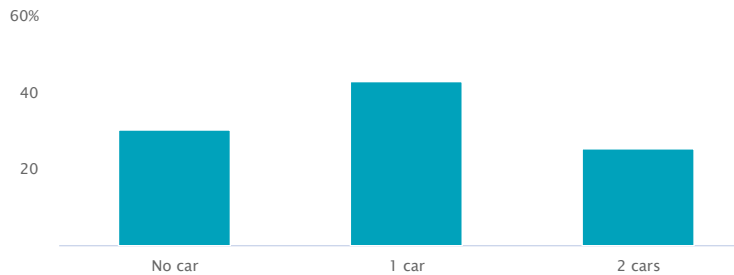

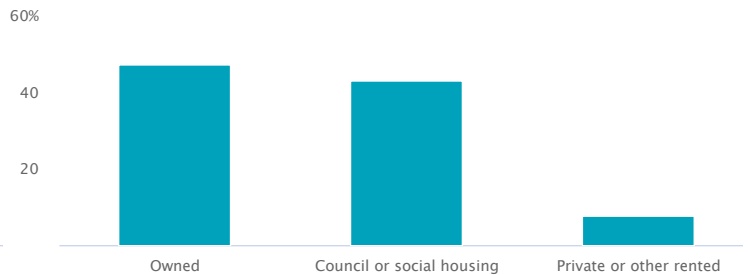
Household composition

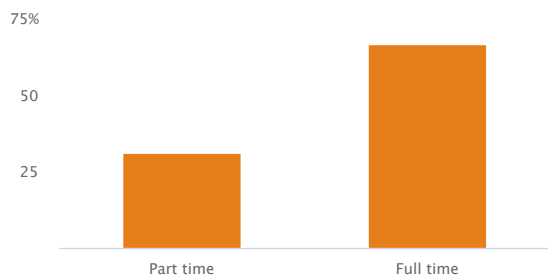

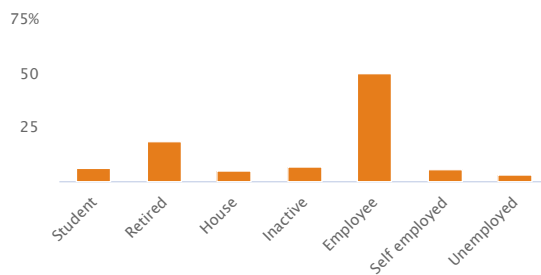
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



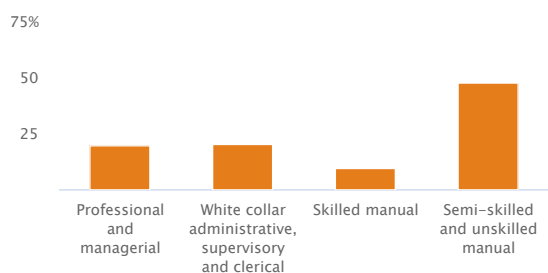
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

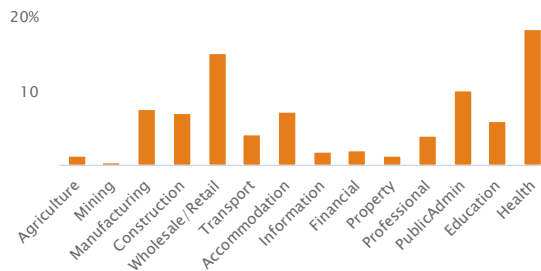

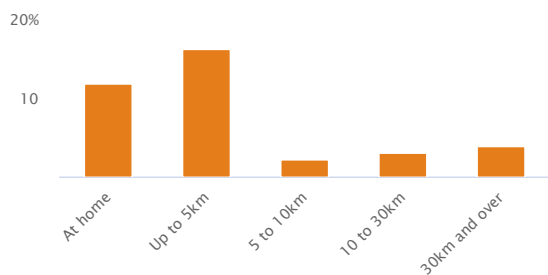
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

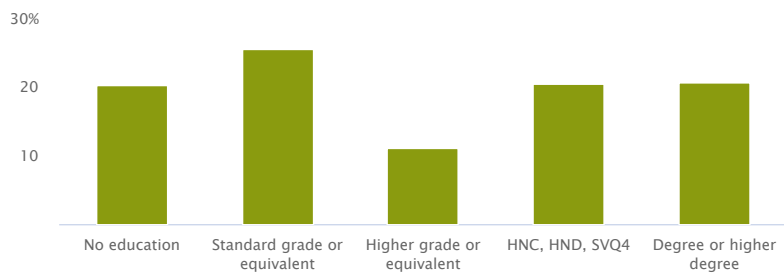


Distance travelled to work

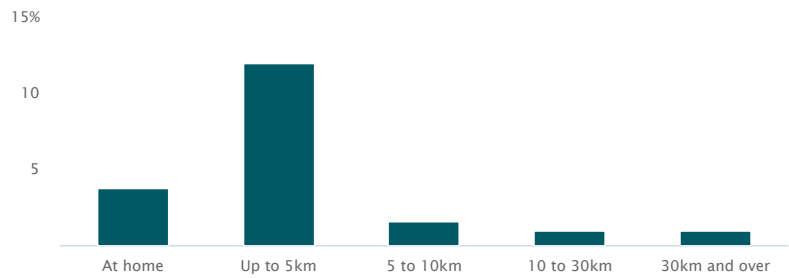
