Laurieston (originally Lawrencetown) is in Falkirk. It was a hamlet on the droving road to the Falkirk Tryst and had trades to meet the needs of drovers (blacksmiths and cartwrights). It was also known for making handkerchiefs. Nowadays it is a suburb of Falkirk.

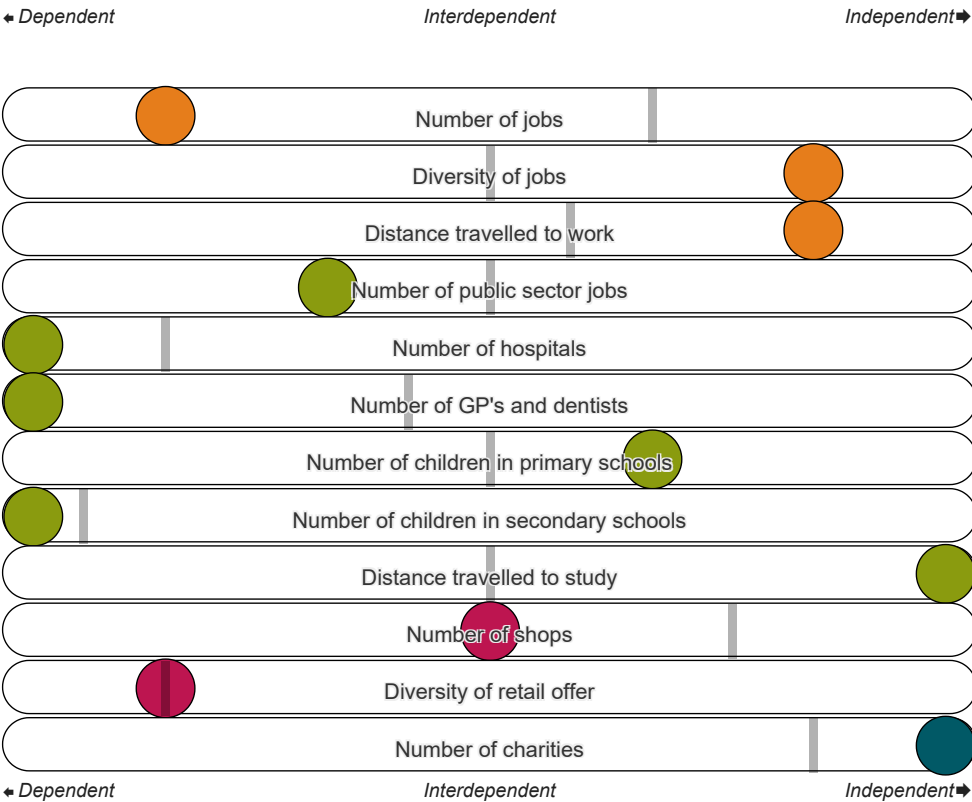
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Laurieston is an interdependent town.

Laurieston is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Laurieston is grouped with 11 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs, and shops. It also differs in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Laurieston differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

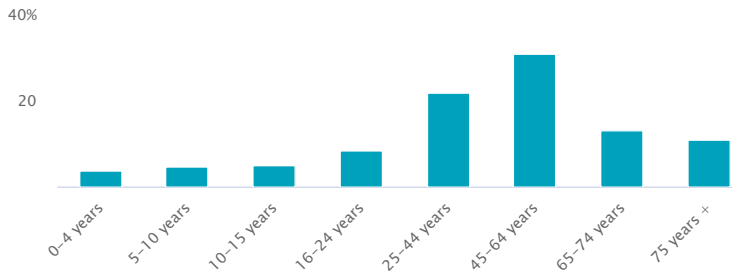

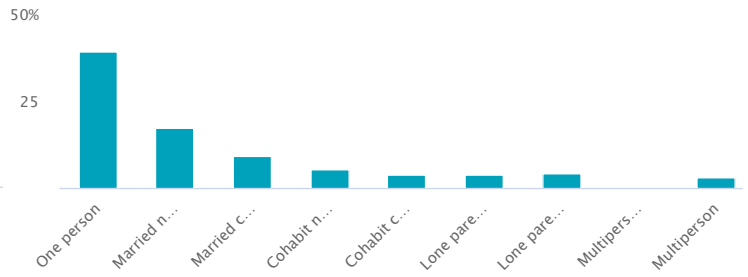

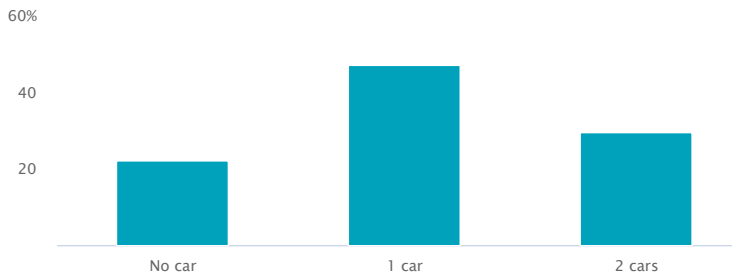

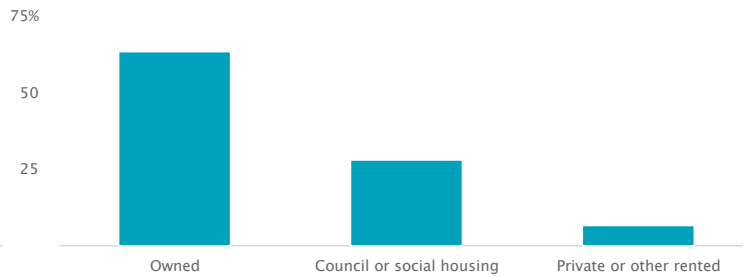

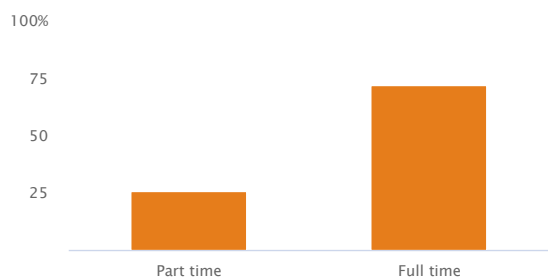

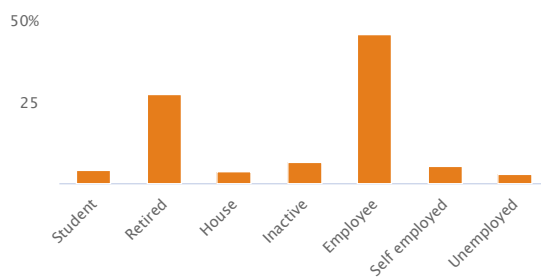
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



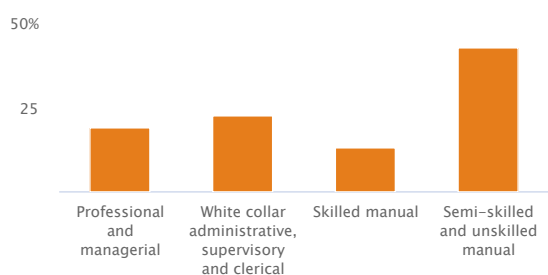
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

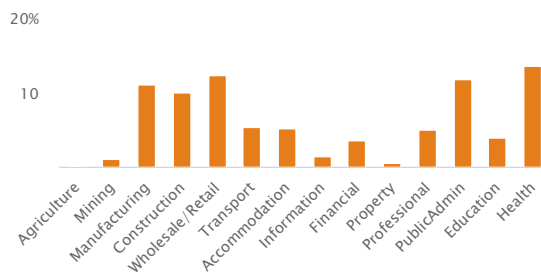

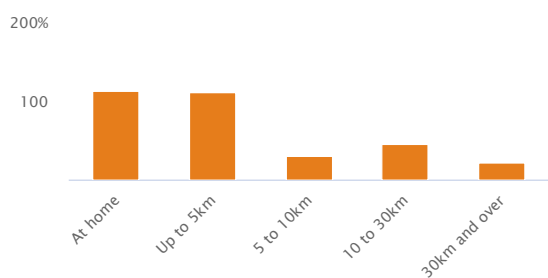
(% households aged 16-64)



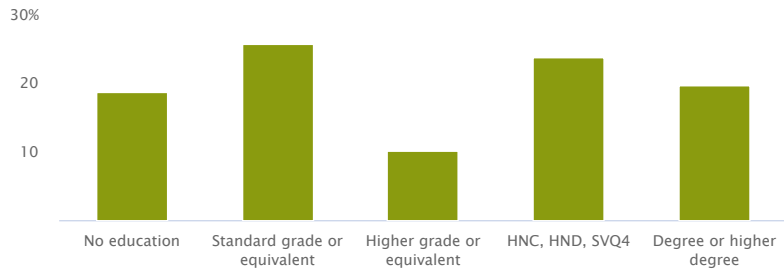
Sector Diversity

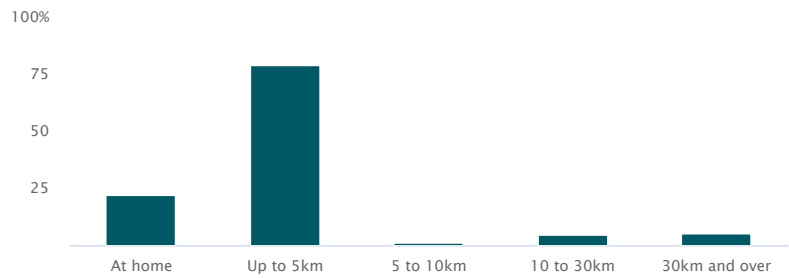
