Law is in South Lanarkshire. It was a mining town but is now largely residential with local service provision. It is becoming attractive to commuters and there have been discussions about re-opening the station..


In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.


















