Lennoxtown is in East Dunbartonshire. It was a village set up by the Lennox family in the 18th century. Calico was produced and a nail factory was opened. For many years Lennox Castle mental hospital was a major employer. More recently a spring water bottling plant was opened and Celtic developed the former hospital site as their training facility.


In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Lennoxtown is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Chapelhall, Cleland, Cockenzie, and Glenboig.




Household change 2011 to 2022




Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)








