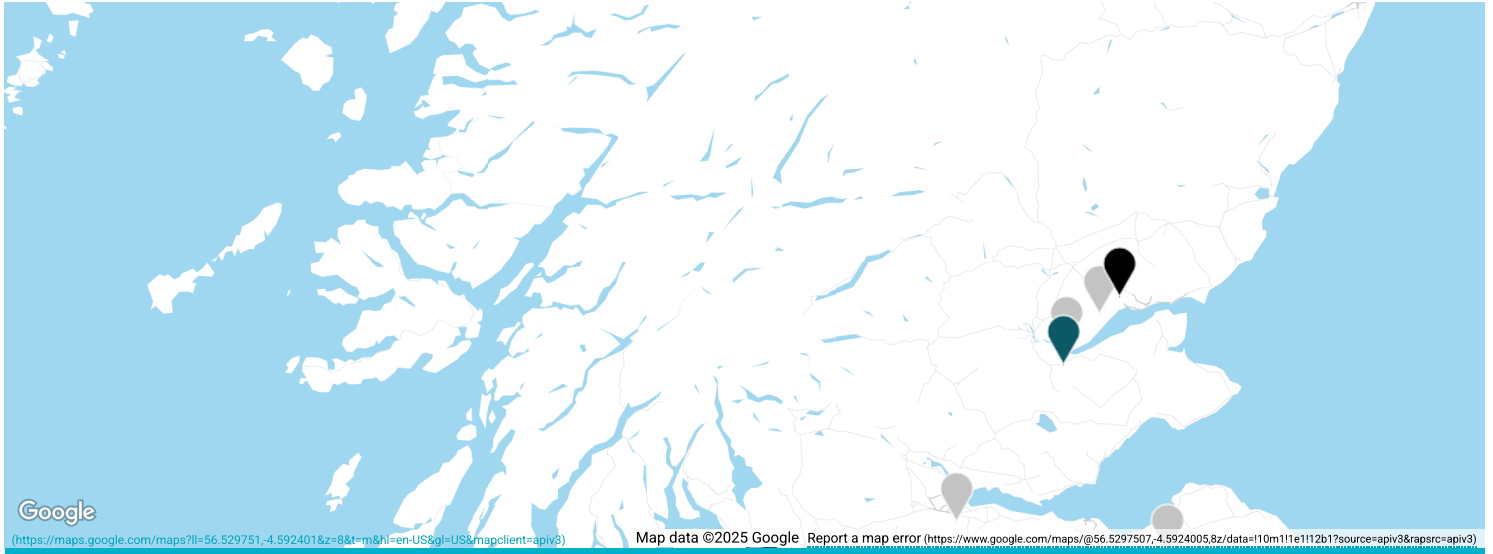




Liff

Liff is in Angus and is an emerging new suburban town for western Dundee. The population of this estate village has doubled since 2011. The Royal Dundee Liff Hospital site became available and has been transformed into new housing.

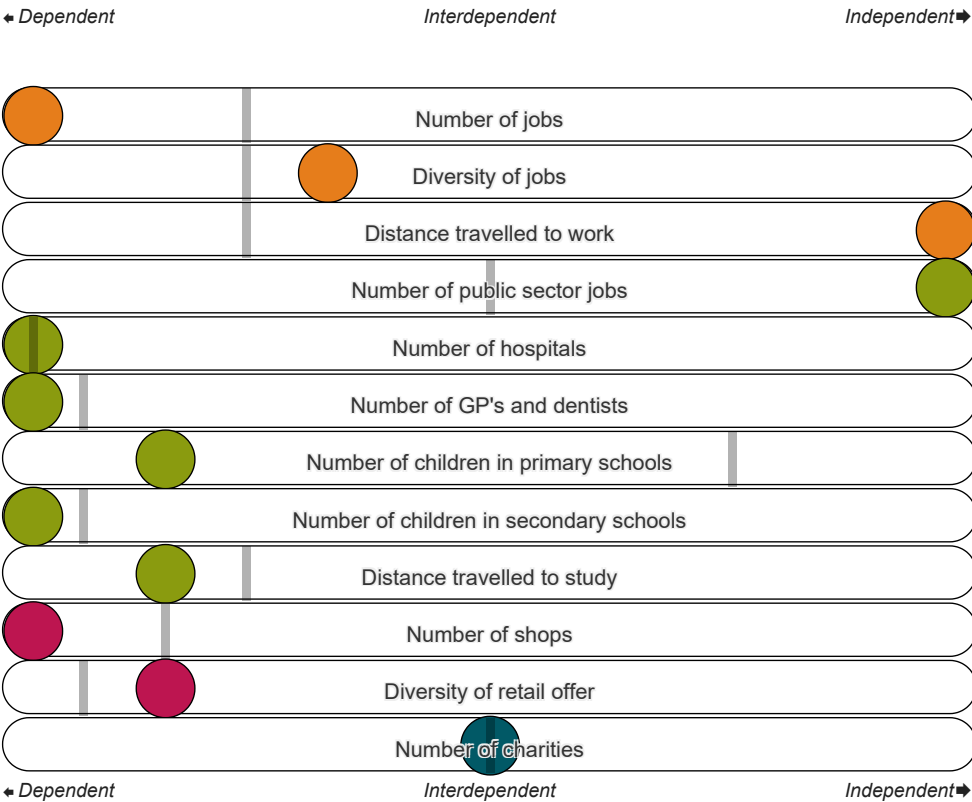
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Liff is a dependent to interdependent town.

Liff is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

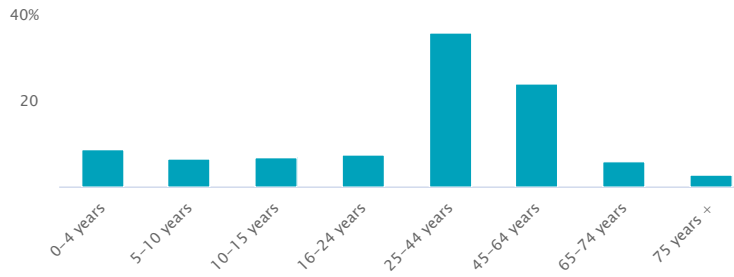
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Liff is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Liff differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools.

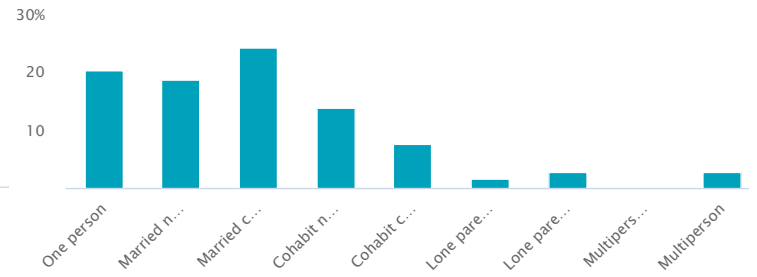

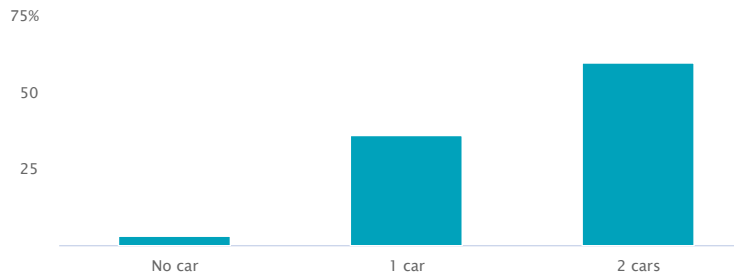
Age

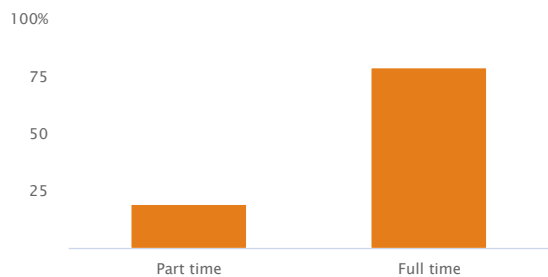

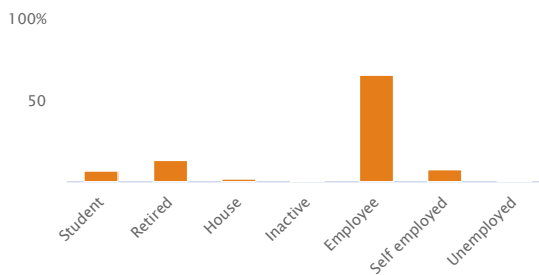
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



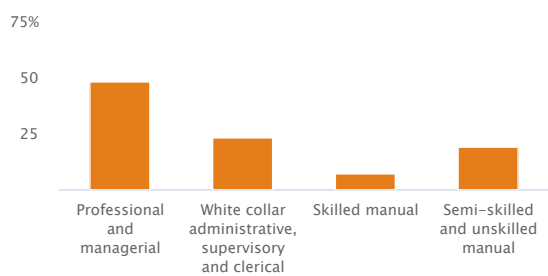
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

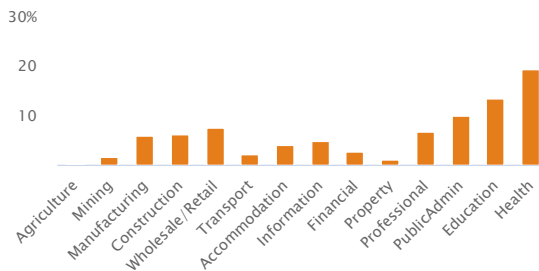


Social Grade

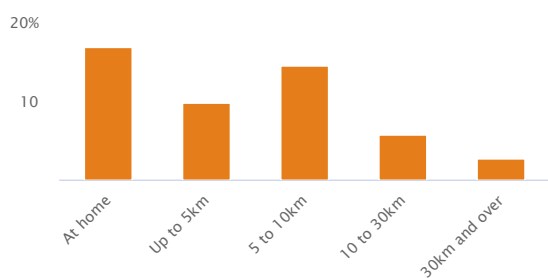
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

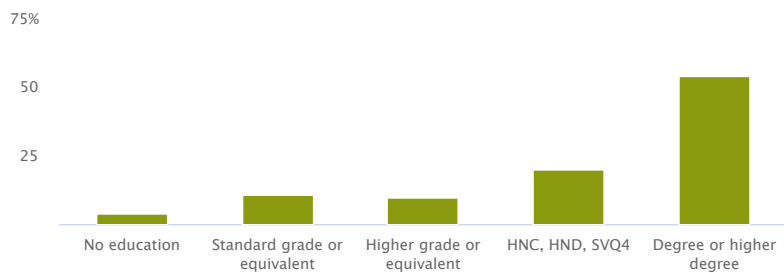


Distance travelled to work

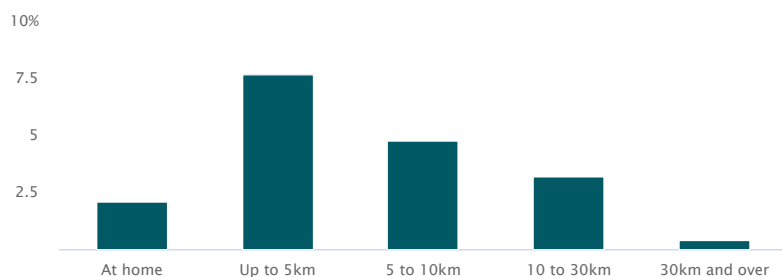
