





#### POPULATION 12,517

Linlithgow in West Lothian is the administrative centre of the council region. It was a Roman fort and later an historic burgh. As a favourite with royalty (the palace is 12th century) it obtained commercial privileges. These declined after the reformation and the Union of the Crowns. In the 19th and early 20th centuries included the Nobel explosive works, tanneries and a distillery. Since the 1960s redevelopment of the town and new housing have seen its popularity with commuters increase. It remains a local service centre.


In large towns such as this one, the population typically is older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Linlithgow is an interdependent to independent town.

Its most similar towns are Bishopbriggs, Ellon, Giffnock, and Gourock.






#### **Employment type**

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




### Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




#### Distance travelled to work



(% aged 16-74)






