Livingston became Scotland's Silicon Glen with new technology industries (Motorola and NEC). These are now closed and the town relies on employment in also has service sector activities including call centres (BSkyB), the NHS and distribution centres. The town is a major retail centre.


In cities like this, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.


















