Loanhead is in Midlothian. It is a former shale, coal mining and paper making settlement. Burghlee Colliery closed in the mid 1960s but was redeveloped as Bilston Glen, a super colliery until 1989. Ramsay Colliery also operated. A large industrial estate provides local employment today.

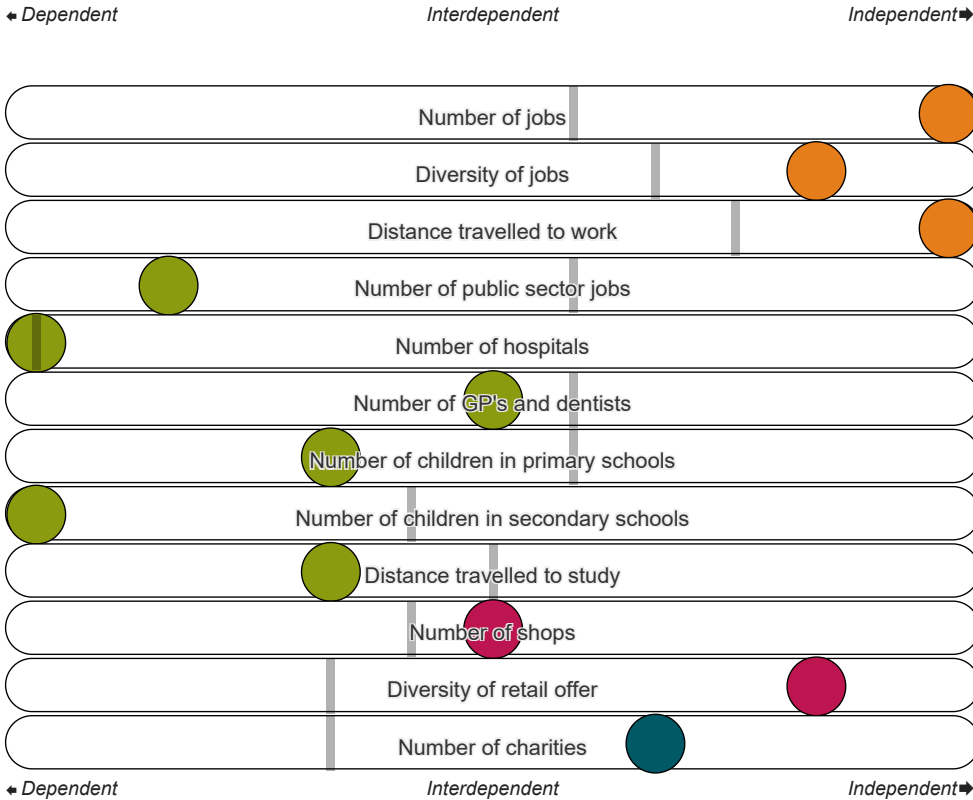
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Loanhead is an interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Loanhead is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Loanhead is grouped with 6 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, shops, and GP's and dentists. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, children in primary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Loanhead differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools.

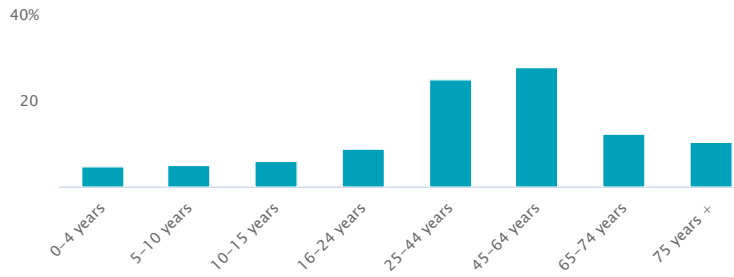

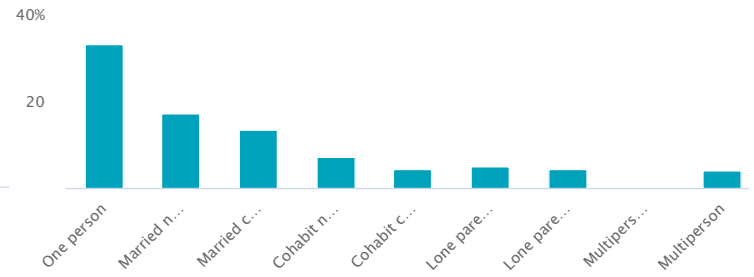

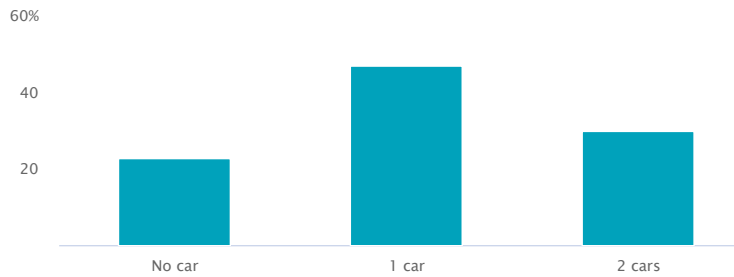

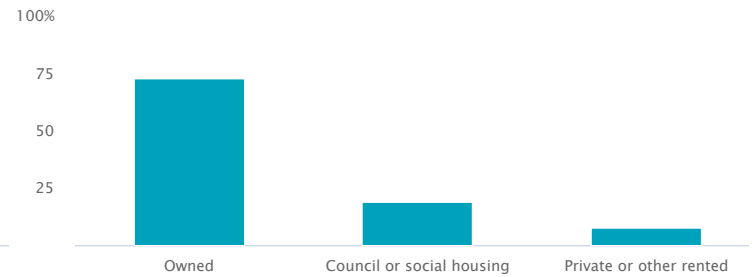

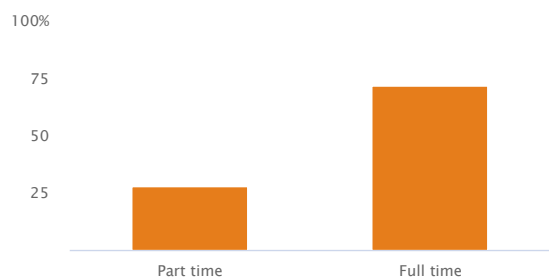

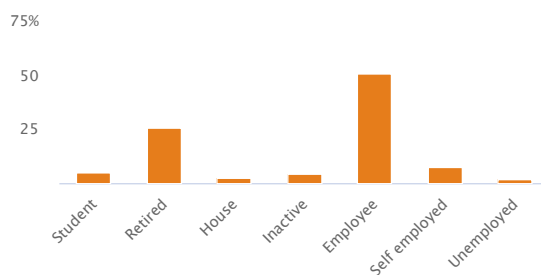
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



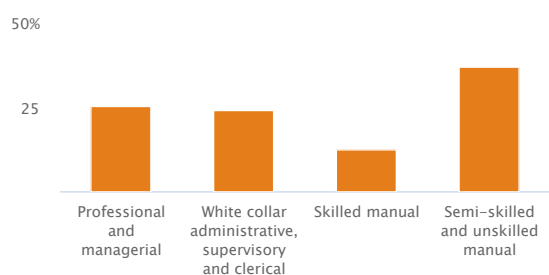
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

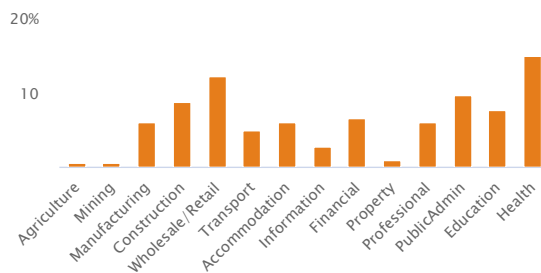

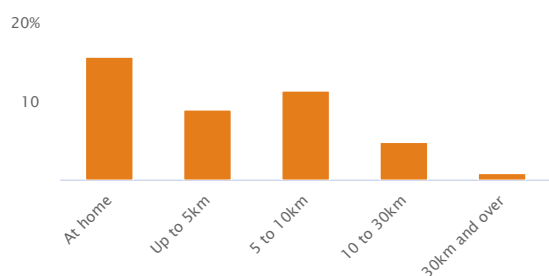
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

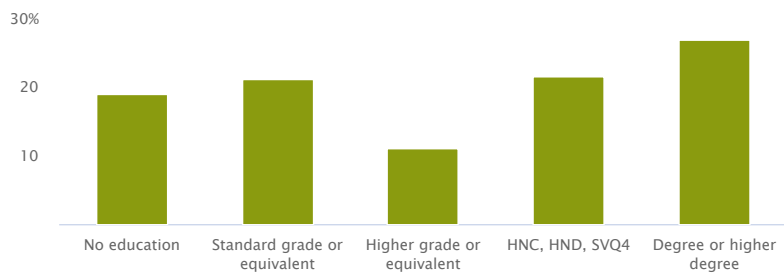


Distance travelled to work

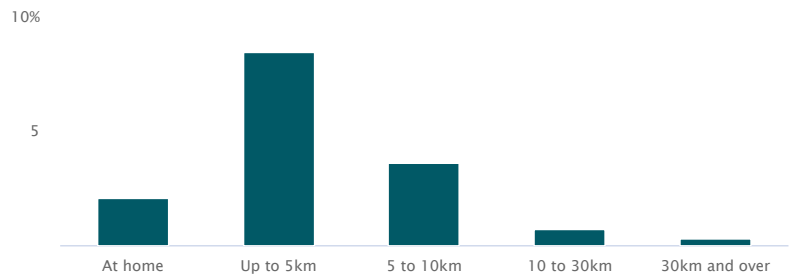
