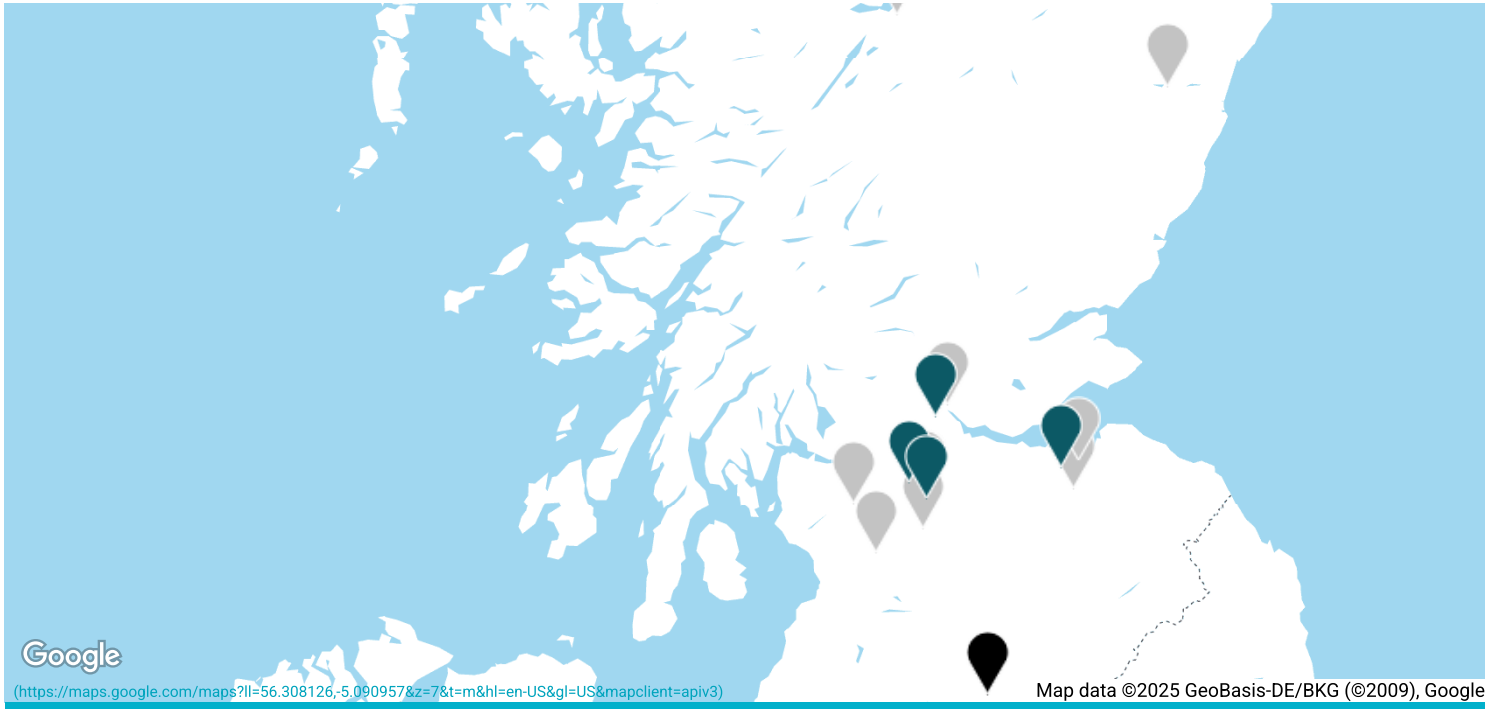




Locharbriggs

Locharbriggs is located in Dumfries and Galloway. It was built on land reclaimed in the 19th century. It is known for its sandstone which has been exported across the world. Today it is a suburb of Dumfries.

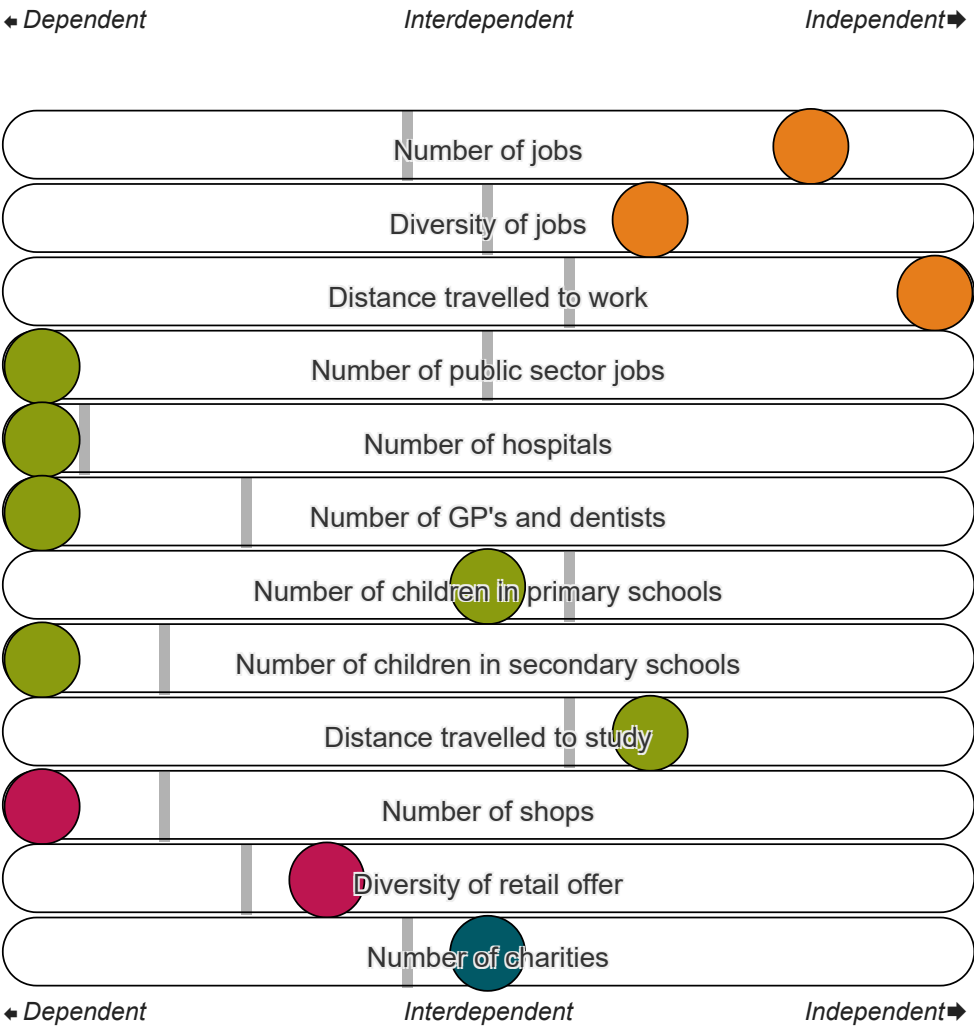
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Locharbriggs is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Locharbriggs is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Locharbriggs differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists.

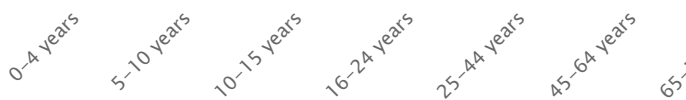

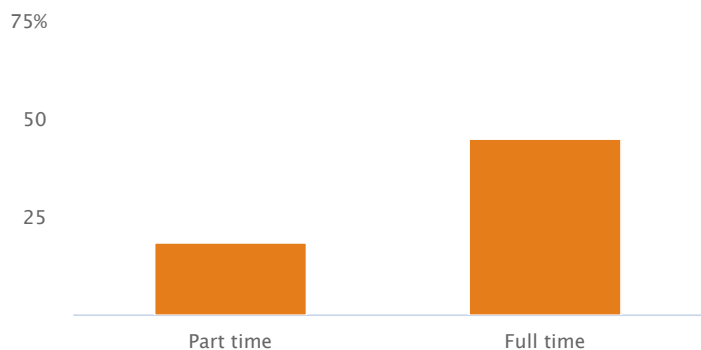

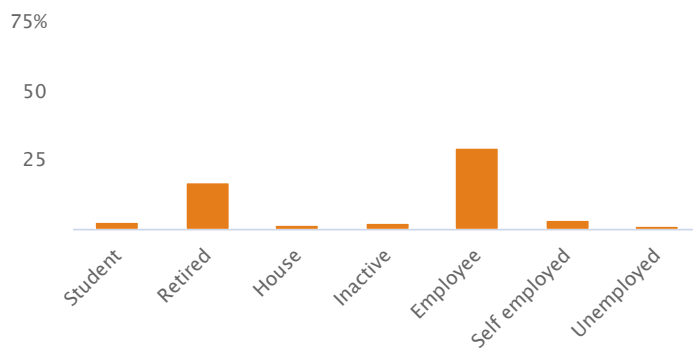
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



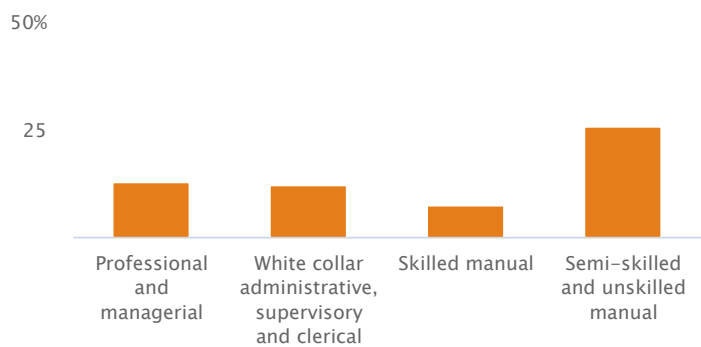
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

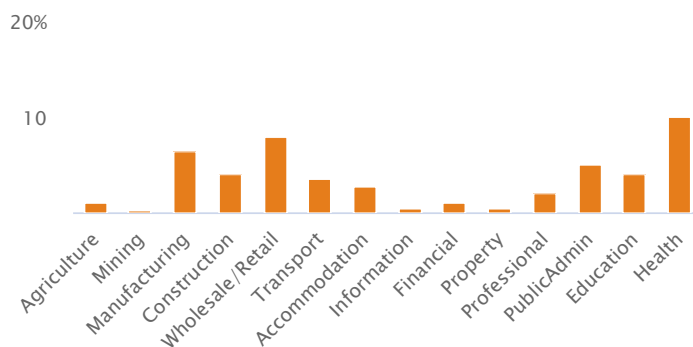

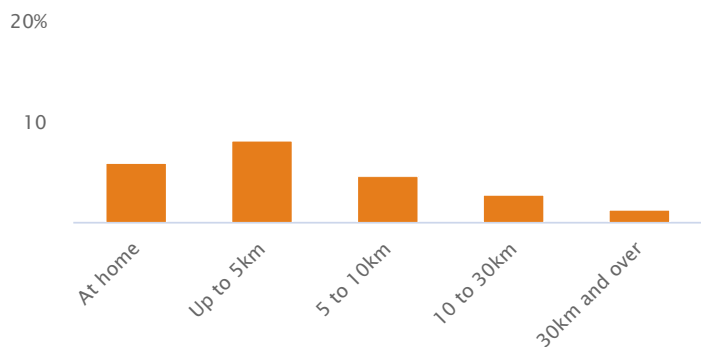
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

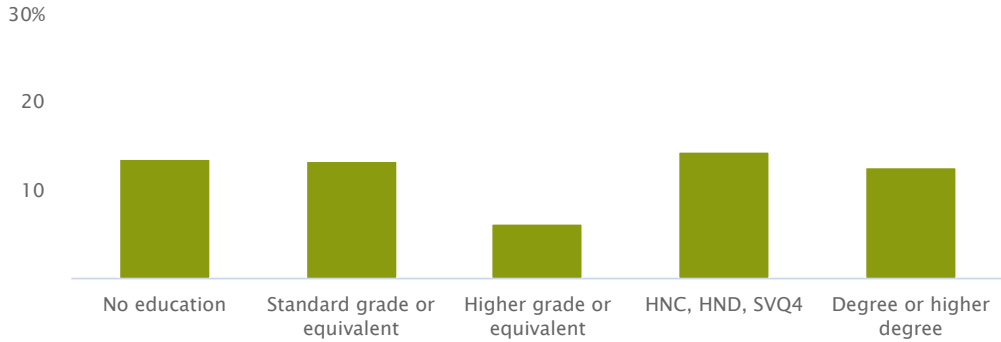


Distance travelled to work

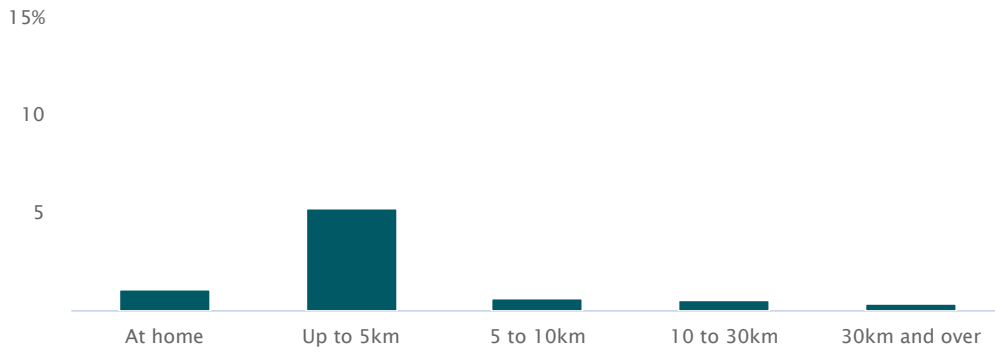
