Lochgelly and Lumphinnans is in Fife. Originally a small market town mining led to the expansion of the town. By the 1960s the mines had closed. Local industries today include sawmilling, animal feeds, rubber goods and supply of building materials. The town gave its name to the 'Lochgelly', a school tawse



A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Its most similar towns are Auchinleck, Blackburn (West Lothian), Cardenden and Auchterderran, and Drongan.




Population change 2011 to 2022




Employment type

(% households aged 16-64)








