Lochgilphead in Argyll and Bute is the administrative town for the council area. It was an 1870s's planned village established as a fishing village. It was the county town for Argyllshire. Forestry remains an important local employer.

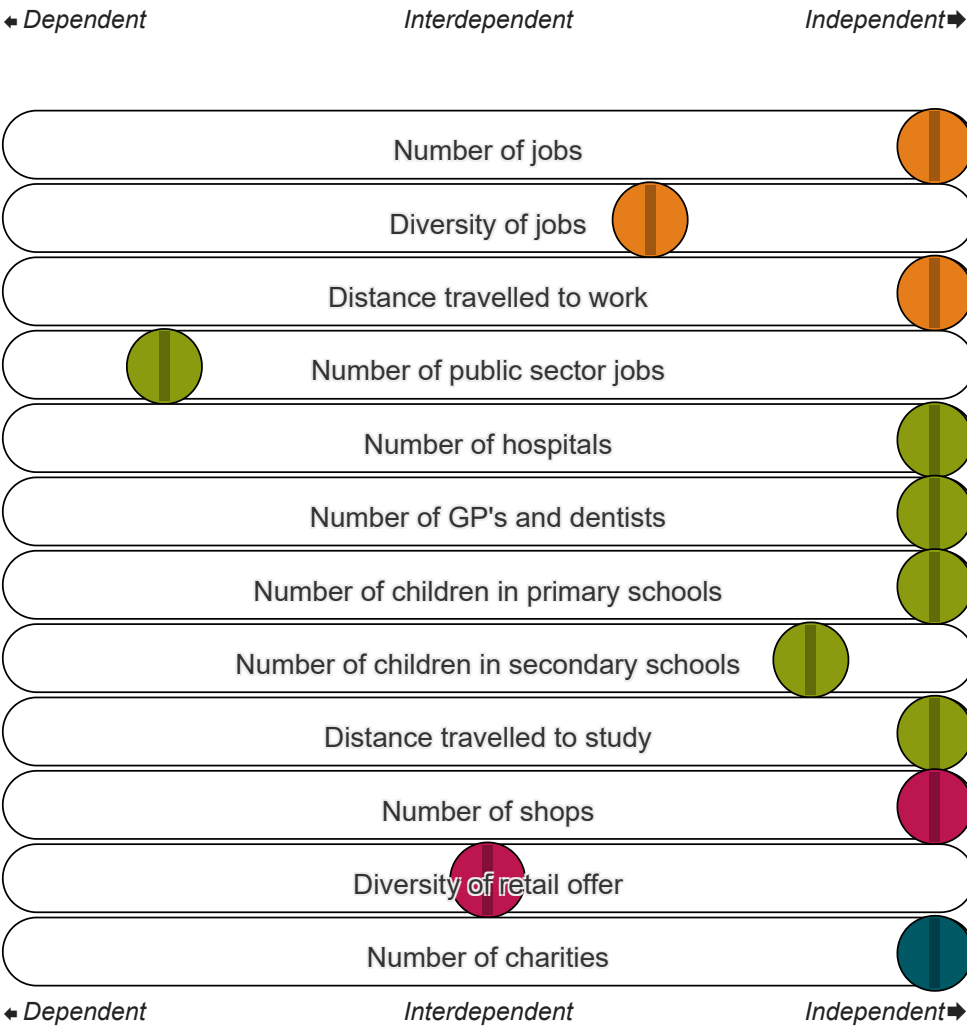
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Lochgilphead is an independent town.

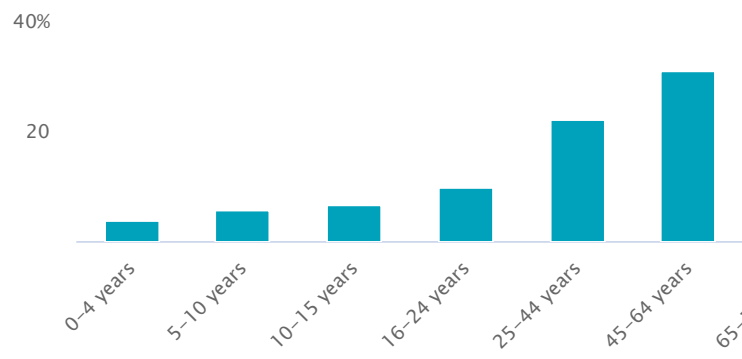

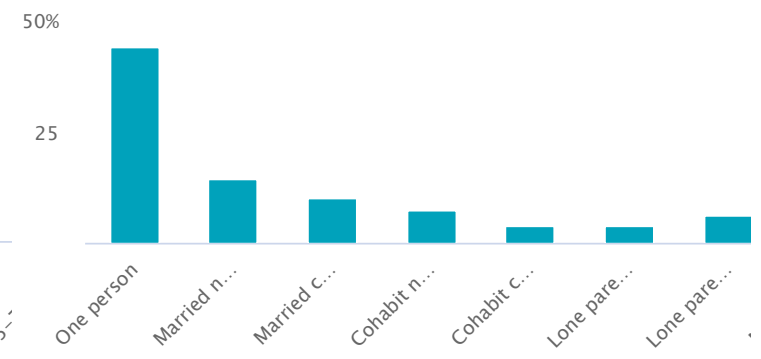

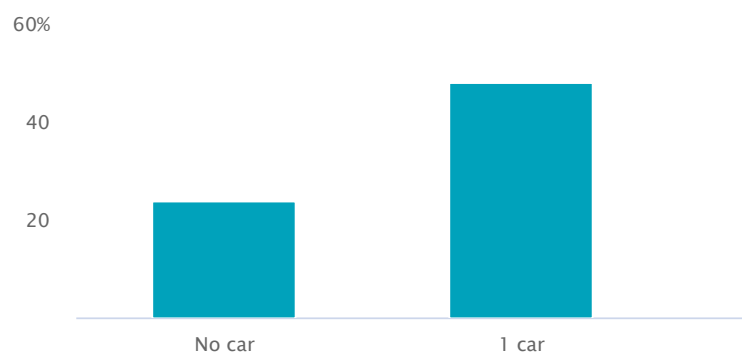

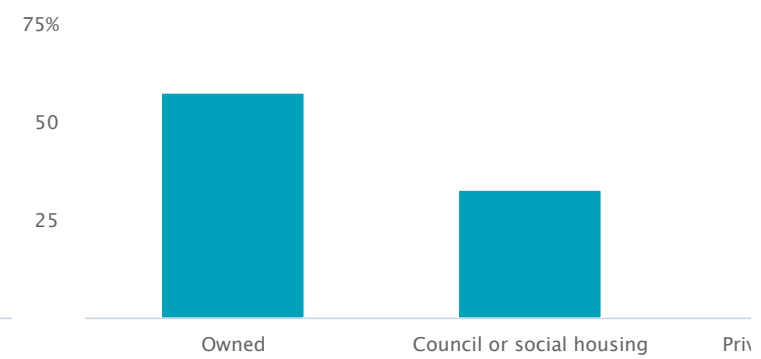

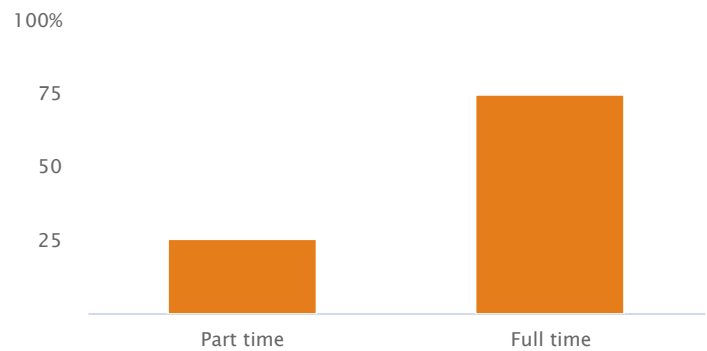

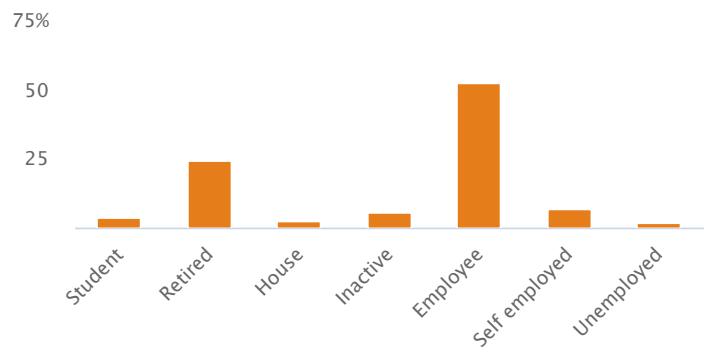
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



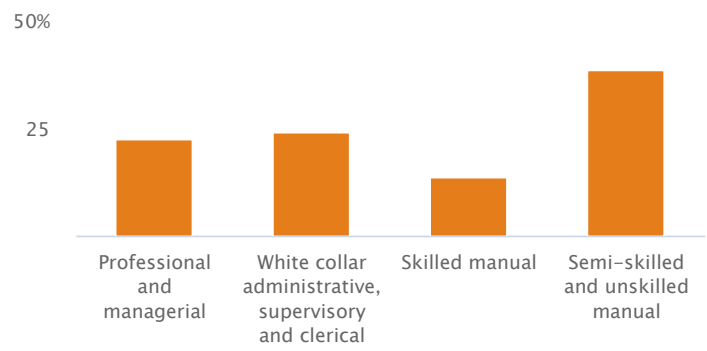
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

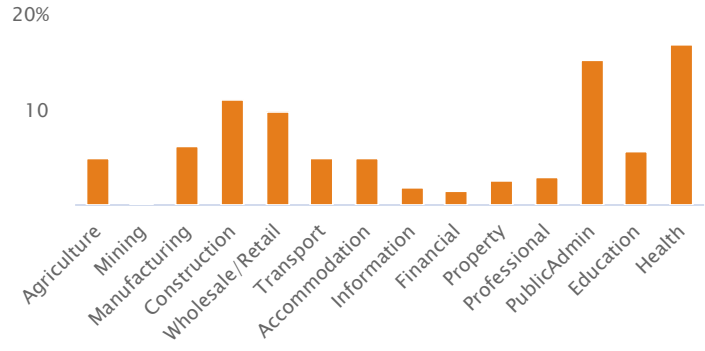

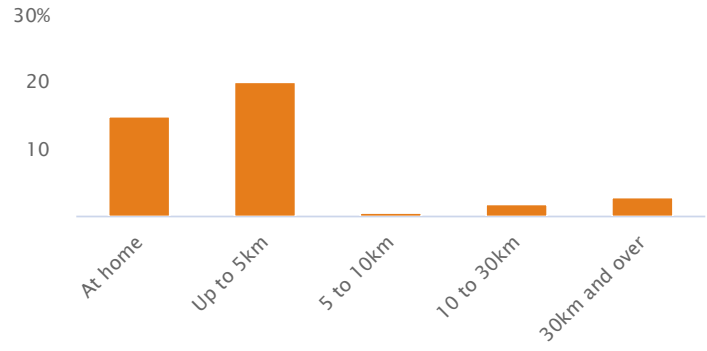
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

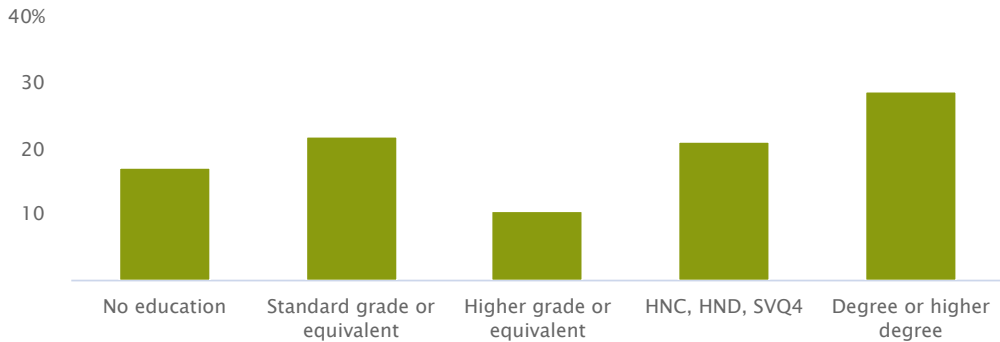


Distance travelled to work

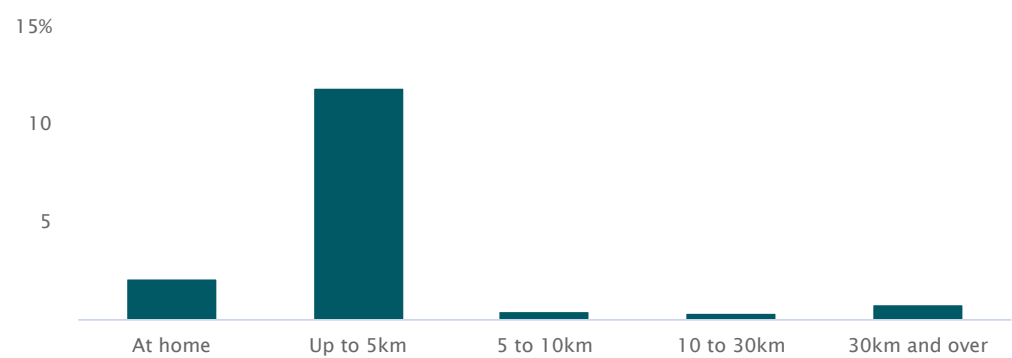
