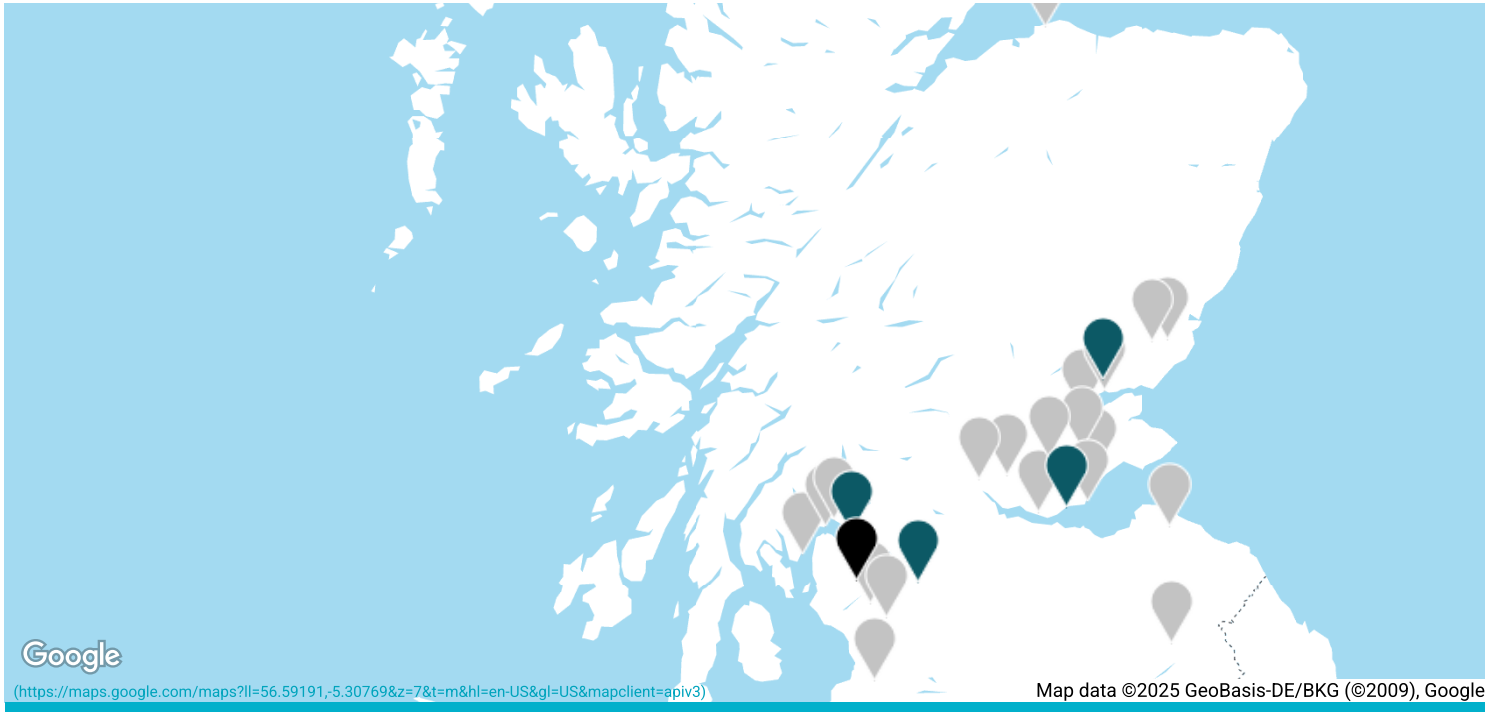




Lochwinnoch

Lochwinnoch is in Renfrewshire. Long settled the site became a textile village. In the 19th century it was famed for furniture making, particularly for ships. A barites mine operated nearby but closed in the 1960s. it has grown to be a residential and commuting settlement, the lochs with their bird reserve creating an attractive setting.

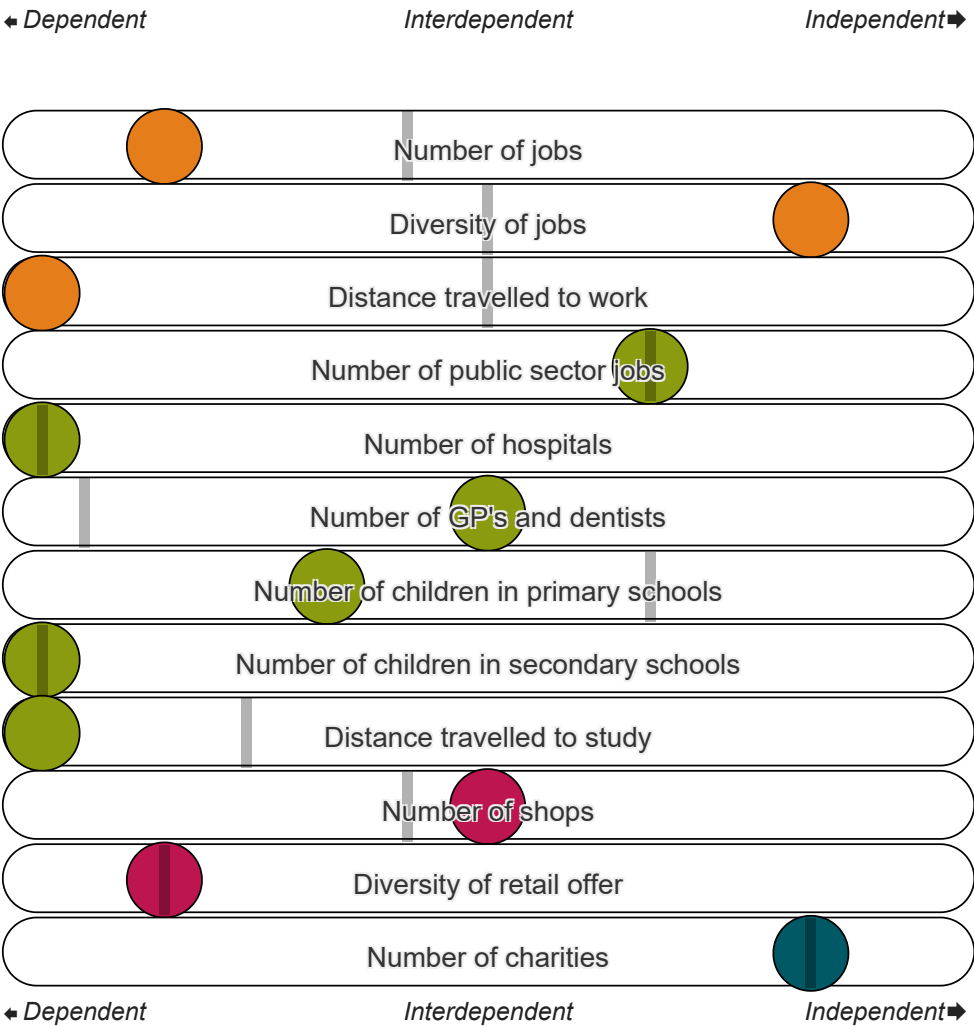
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Lochwinnoch is an interdependent to dependent town.

Lochwinnoch is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Lochwinnoch is grouped with 24 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Lochwinnoch differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

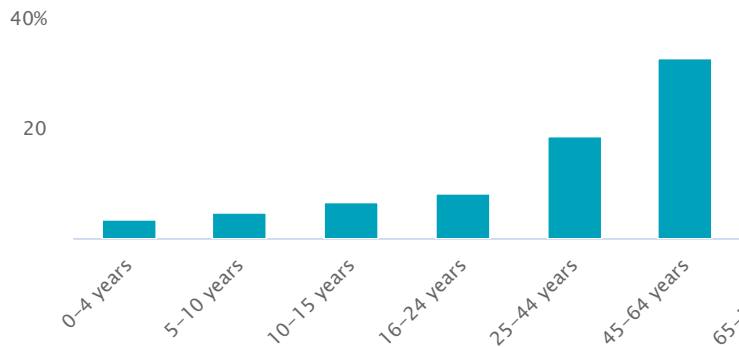

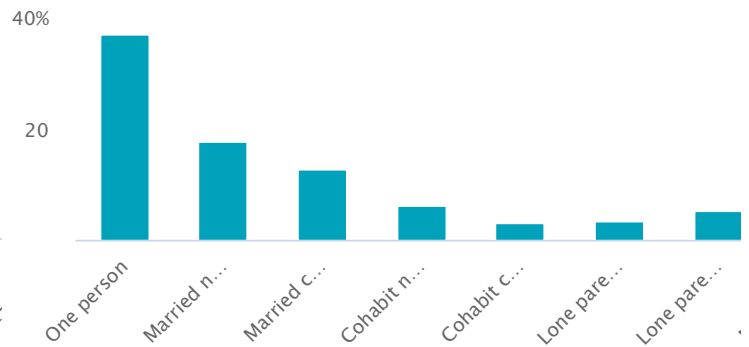

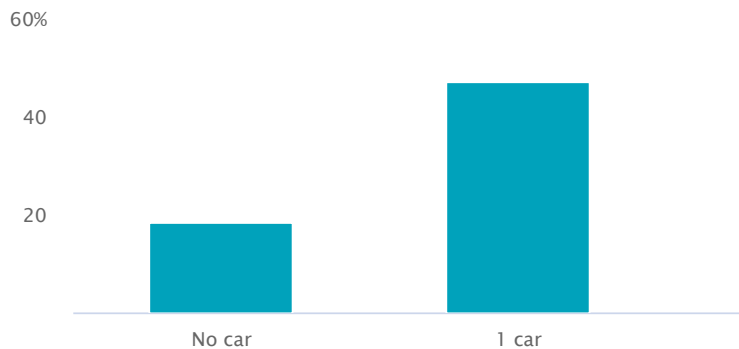

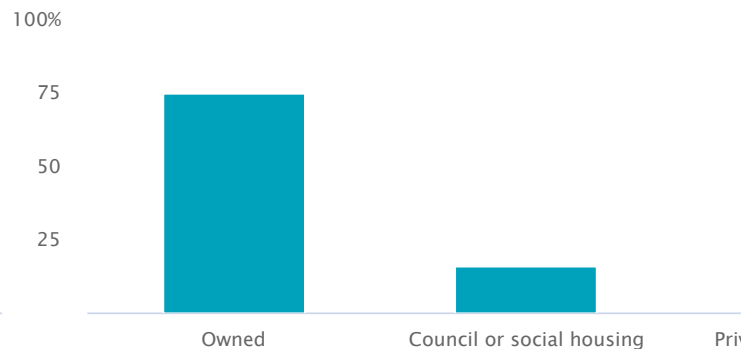

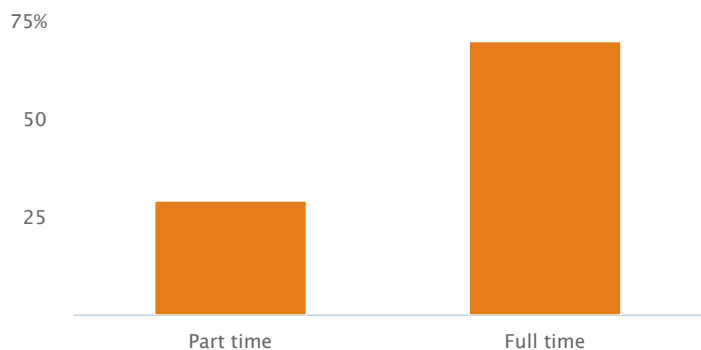

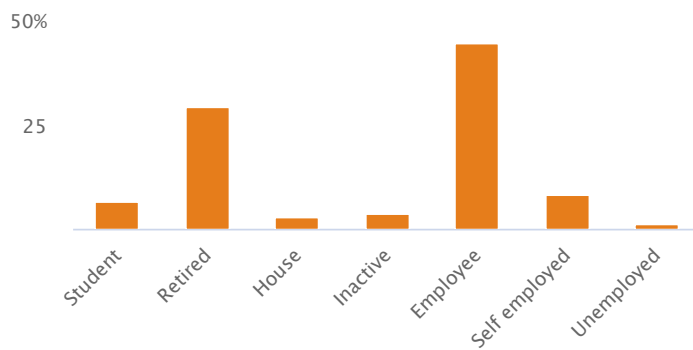
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



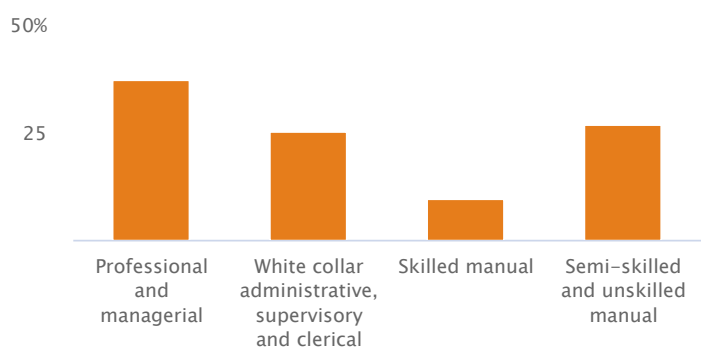
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

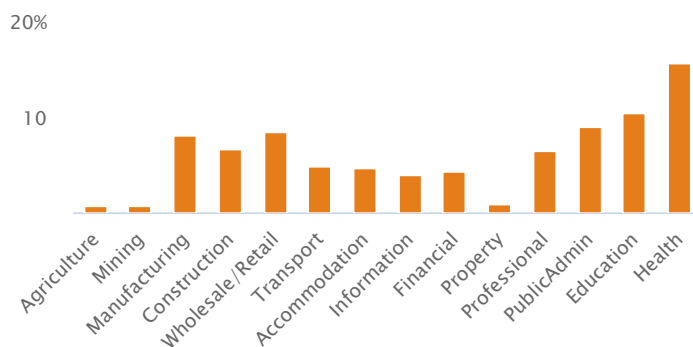


Social Grade

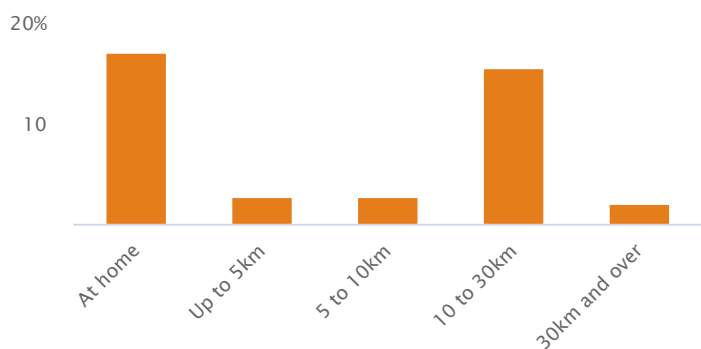
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

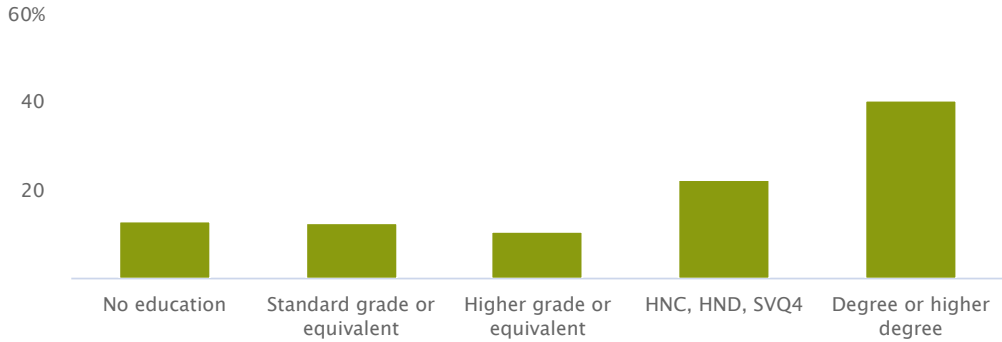


Distance travelled to work

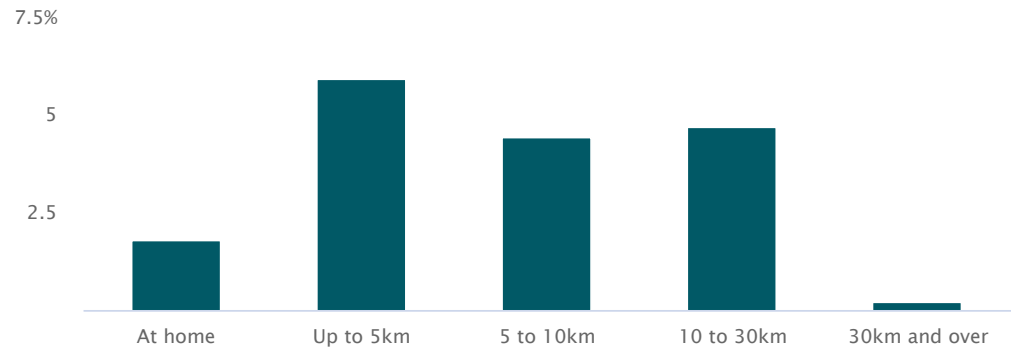
