Longforgan is in Perth and Kinross. As a town on the main route from Perth to Dundee and beyond it has several logistics companies. Historically it was a local market town and it still services the adjoining agricultural area. It is also the location of the open prison at Castle Huntly.

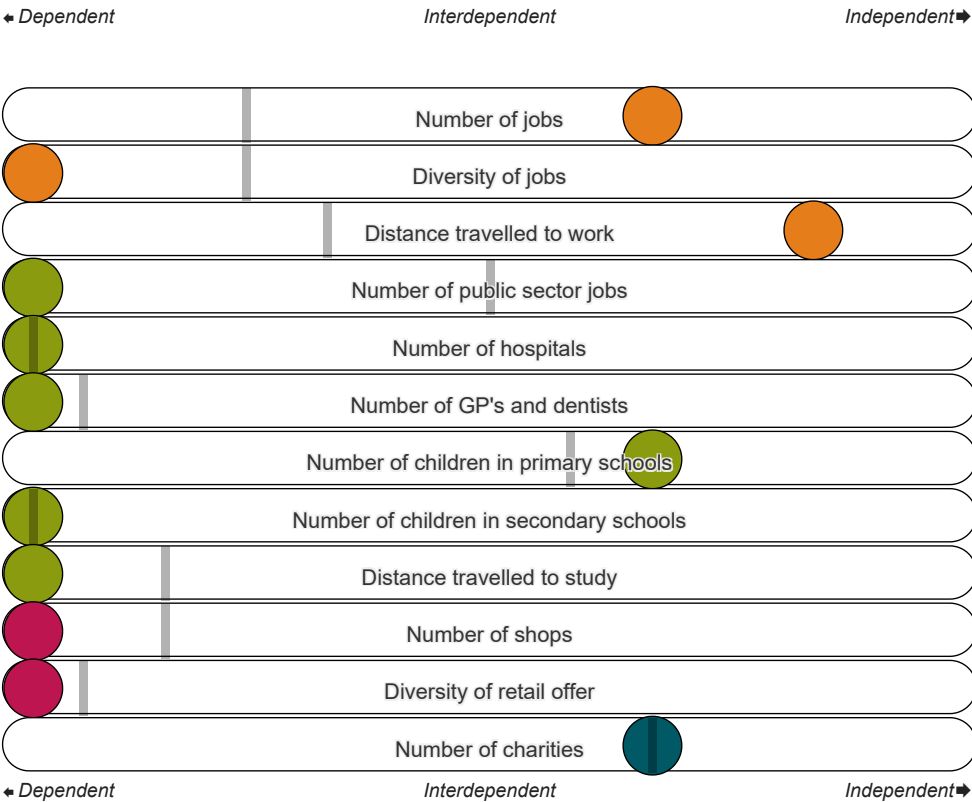
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Longforgan is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

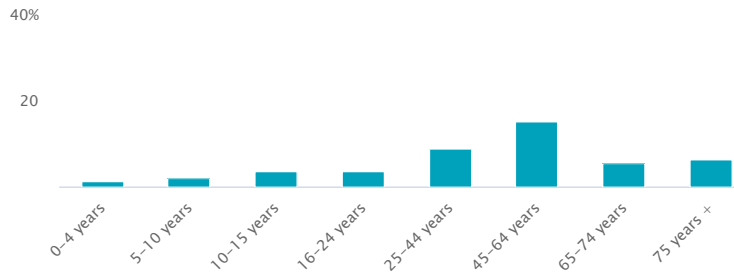

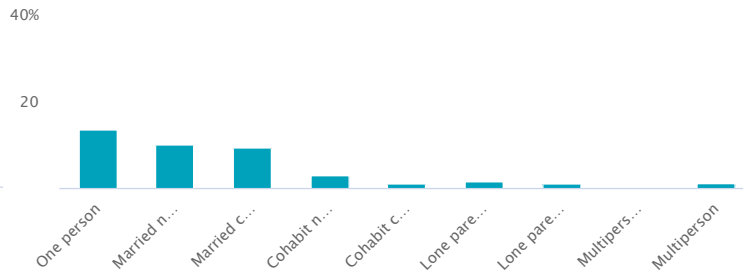

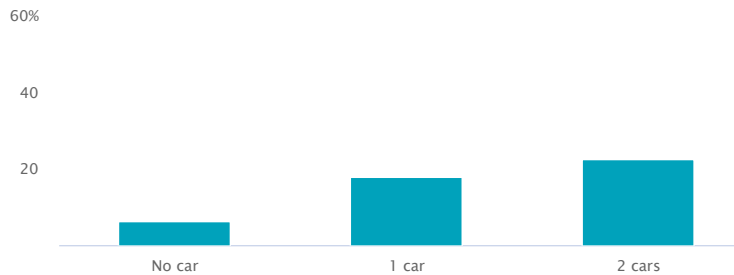

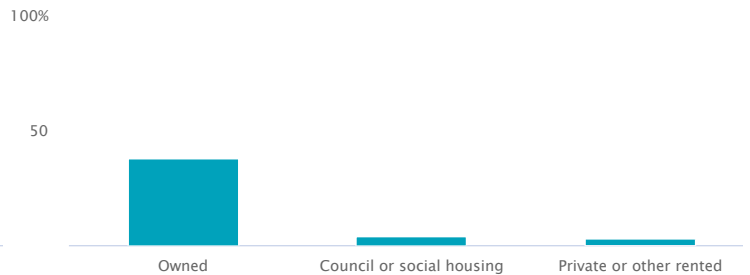
Household composition

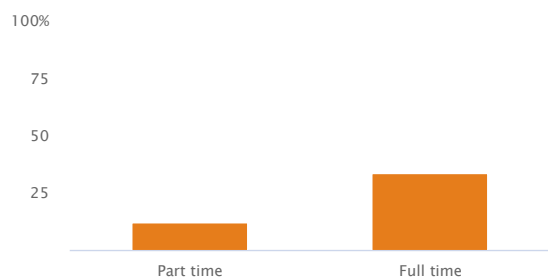

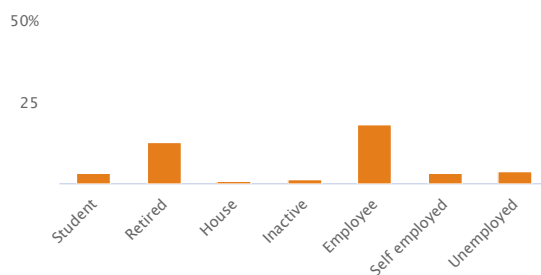
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



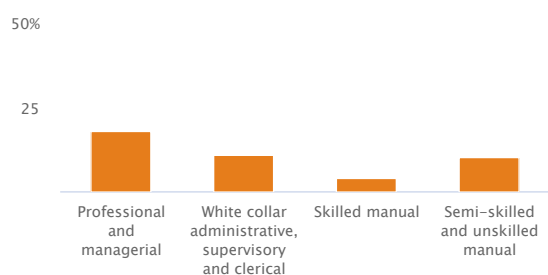
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

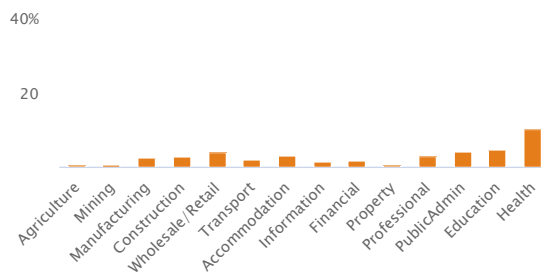

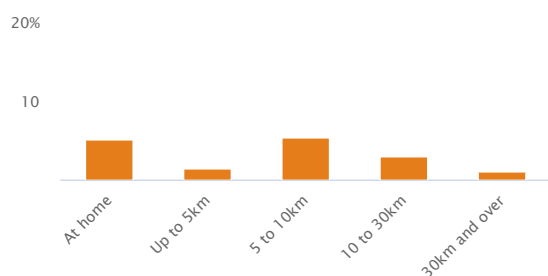
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

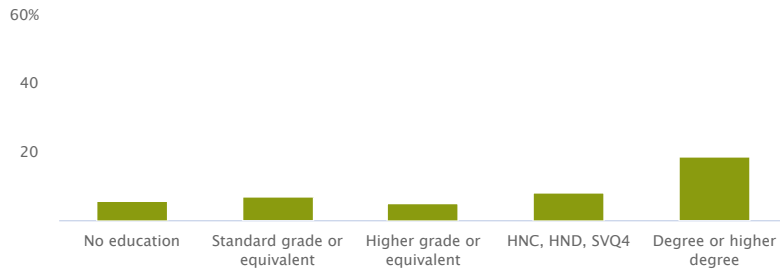


Distance travelled to work

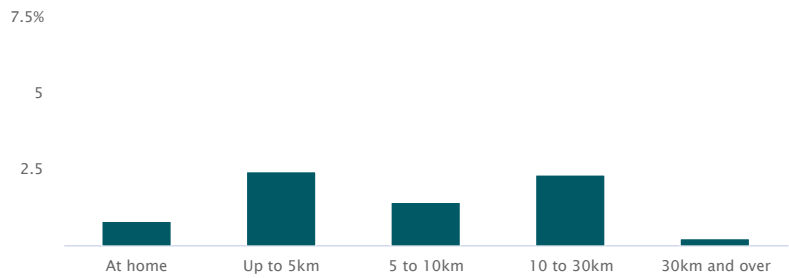
