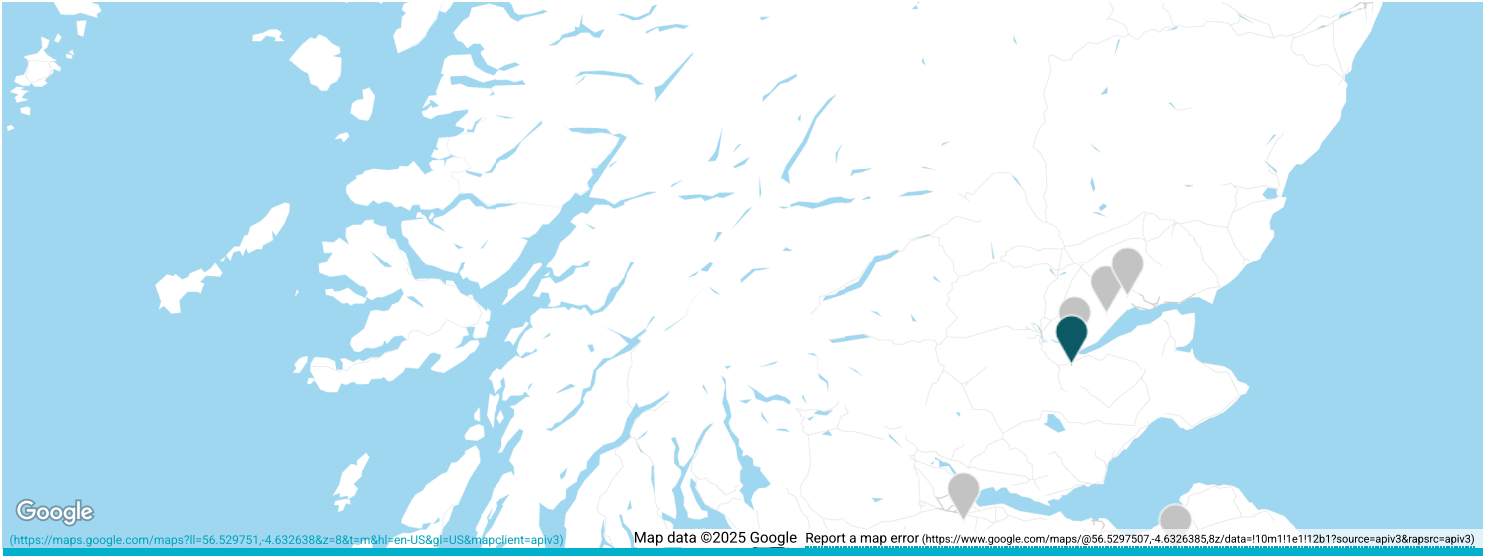




Longside

Longside is in Aberdeenshire. Its history lies in quarrying and the Royal Navy Air base from WWI. It is located in an agricultural setting and is predominantly residential.

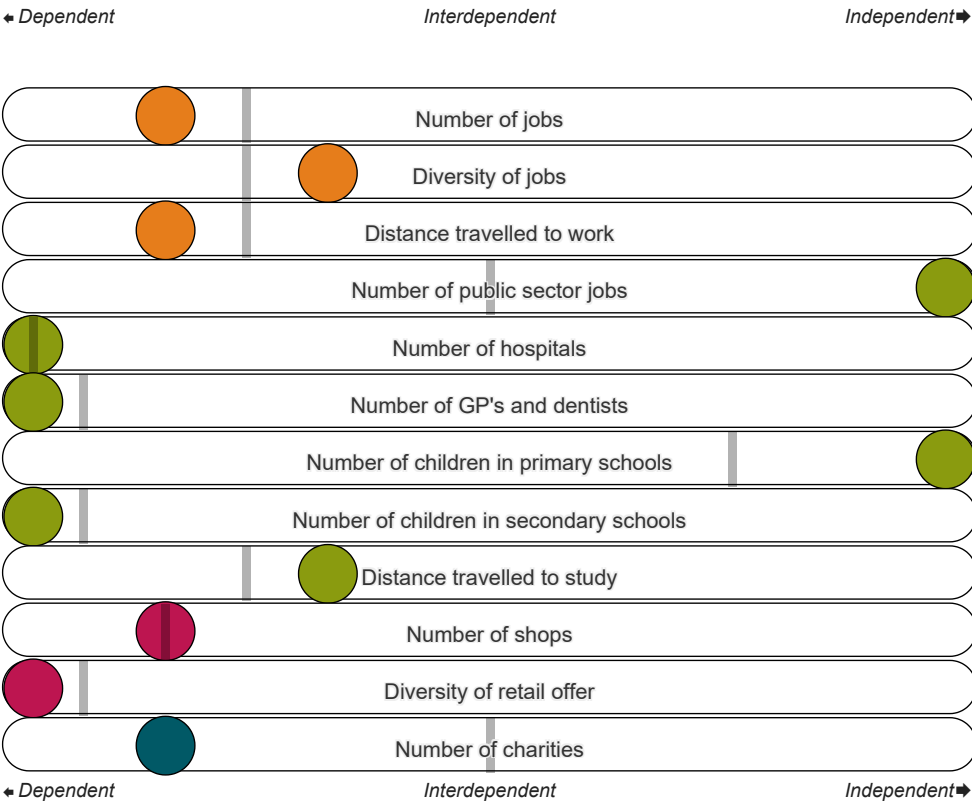
In this small town, this population is characterised by older working age families with teenagers. They are more highly educated and have higher social grades than some other groups. 2 car ownership is higher than in other groups.

Longside is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

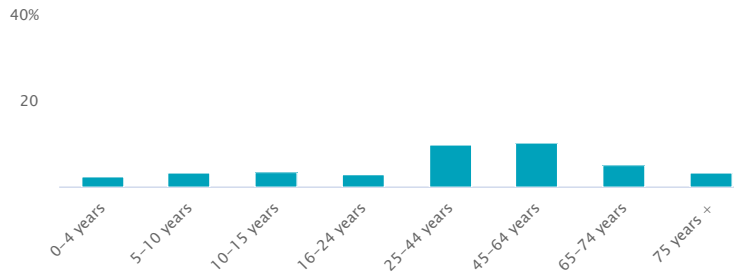
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Longside is grouped with 14 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs. Longside differs most from its group in the number of charities.

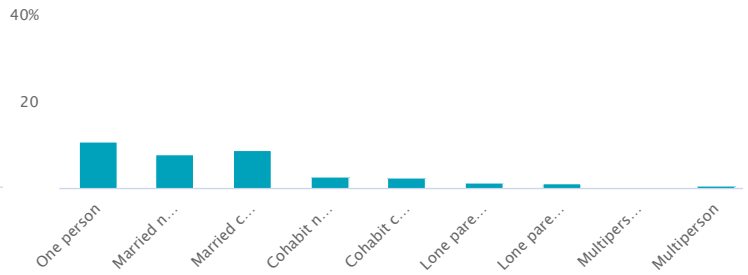

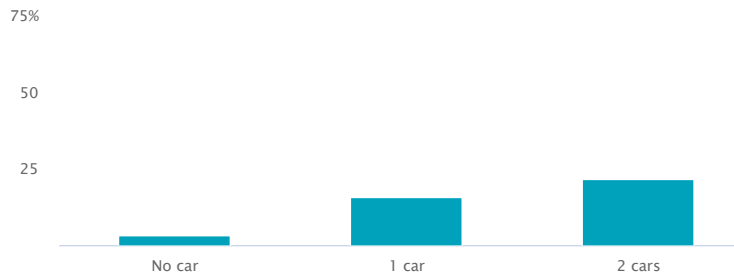

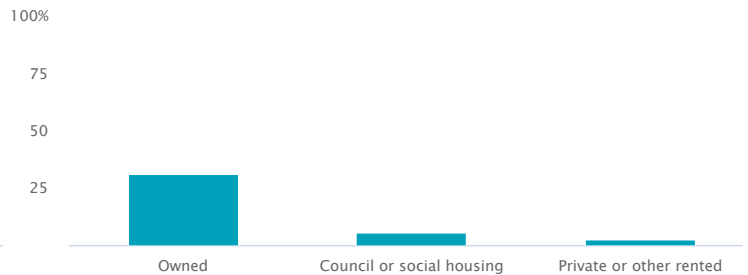
Household composition

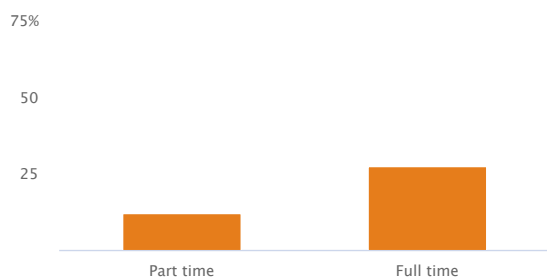

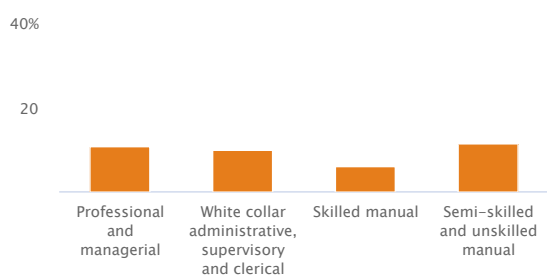
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



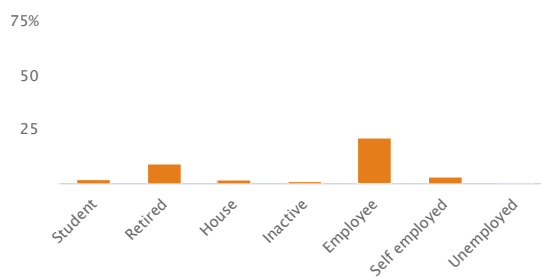
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)

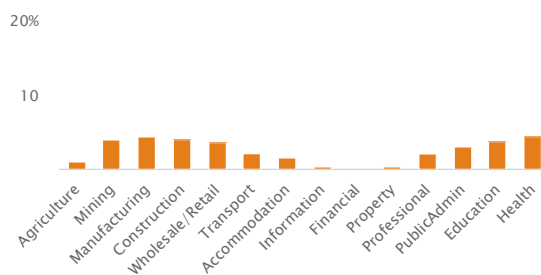

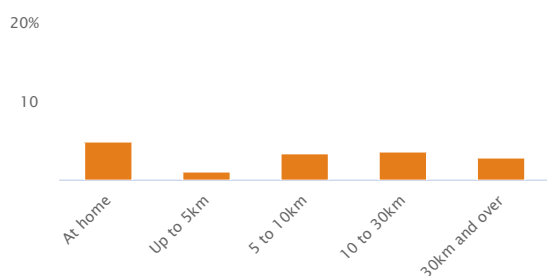

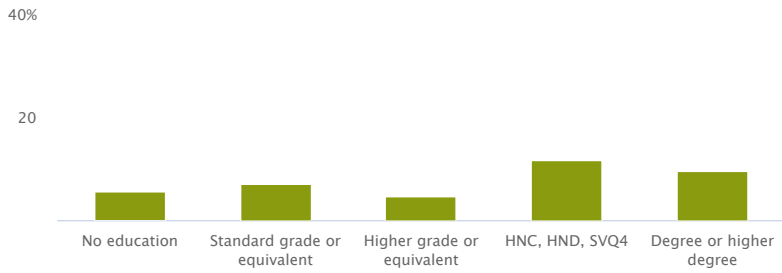
Sector Diversity

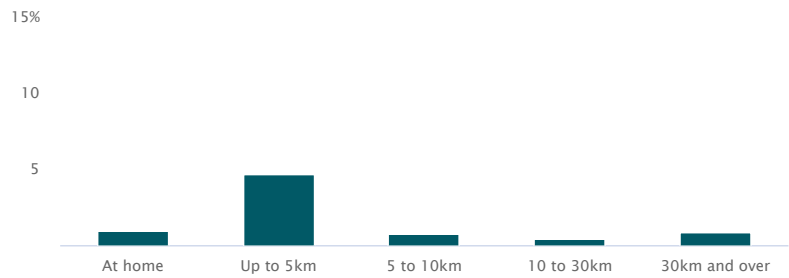
