Maddiston (Maud's Toun) is in Falkirk. Stone quarrying and stone working were important early trades. Growth of Maddiston was due to the discovery of coal. The Carron Mining Company operated until the 1960s. After this it became a commuting town and the mine workings have been landscaped.


In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Maddiston is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Chapelhall, Cleland, Cockenzie, and Glenboig.

Population change 2011 to 2022




Household change 2011 to 2022








Occupation

(% households aged 16-64)






