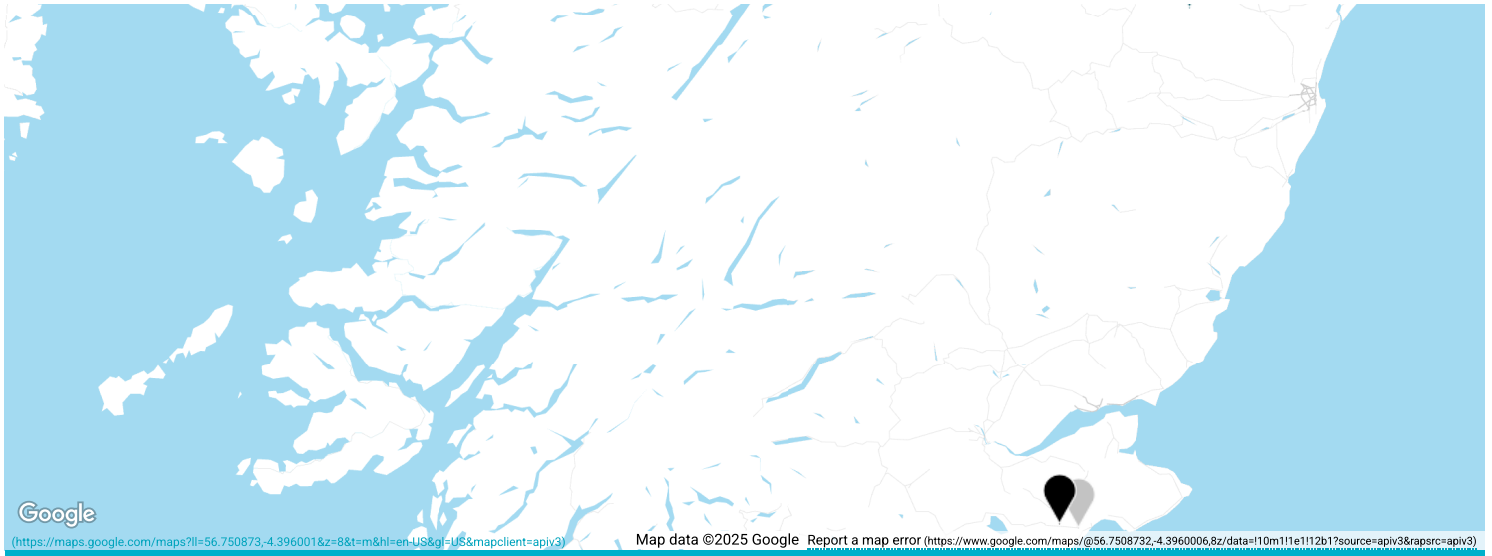

Markinch is in Fife. The settlement dates from Pictish times. It was a medieval burgh then called Dalgynch. In the industrial revolution mills were built and spinning and weaving were developed. Paper making was also started, an industry which continued until the closure of Tullis Russell in 2015. Haigs whisky distillers had a plant here before the company was taken over by Diageo who operate at Cameronbridge. Today it is a suburb of Glenrothes.

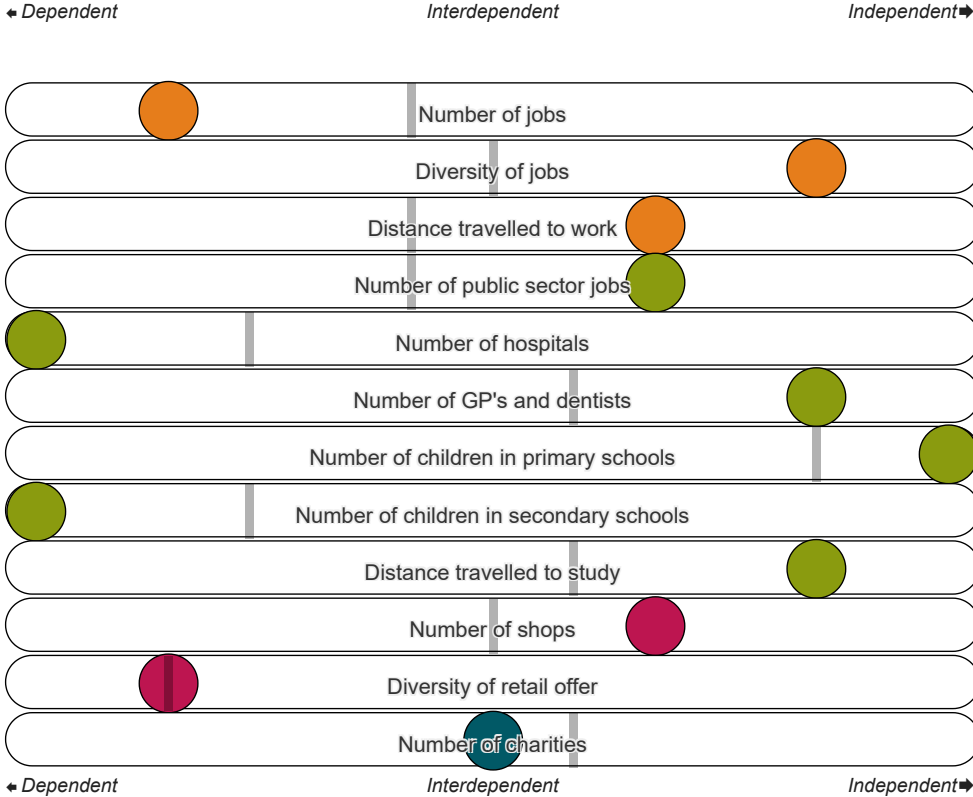
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

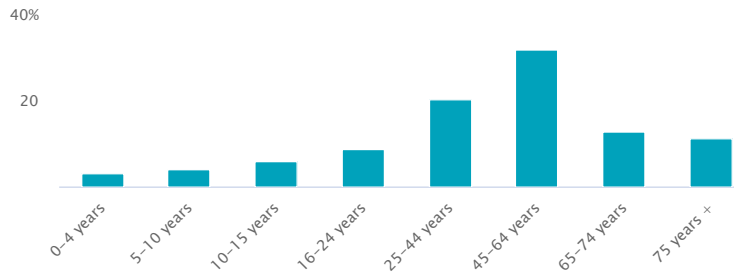

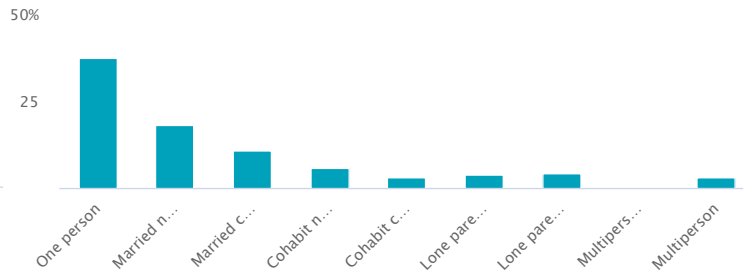

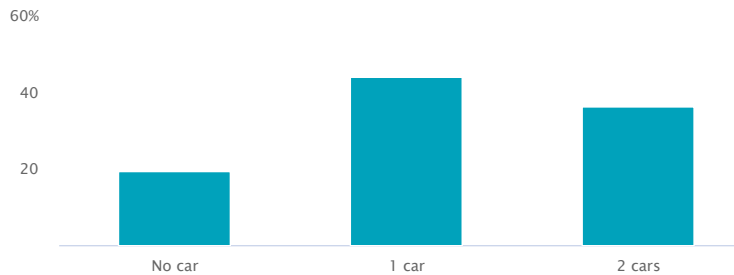

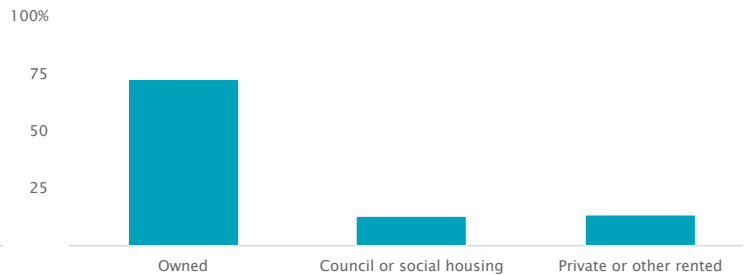
Household composition

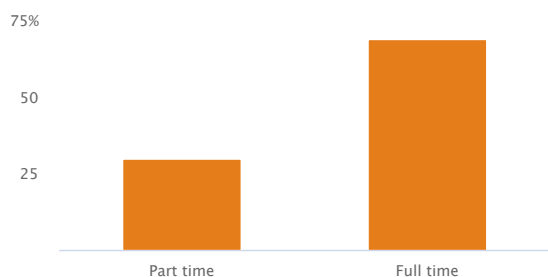

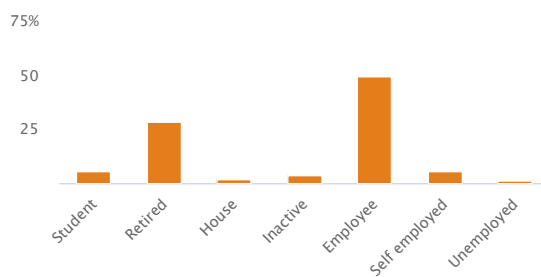
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



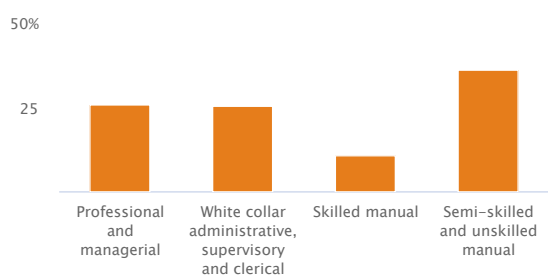
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

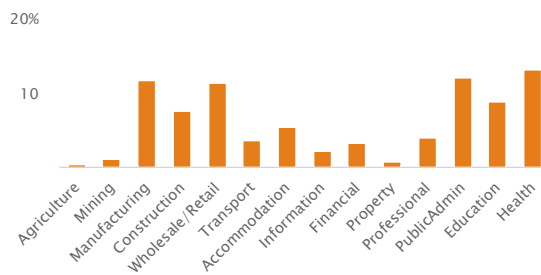

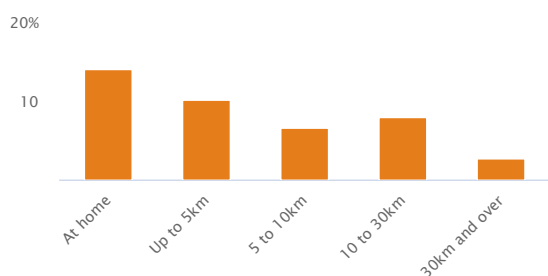
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

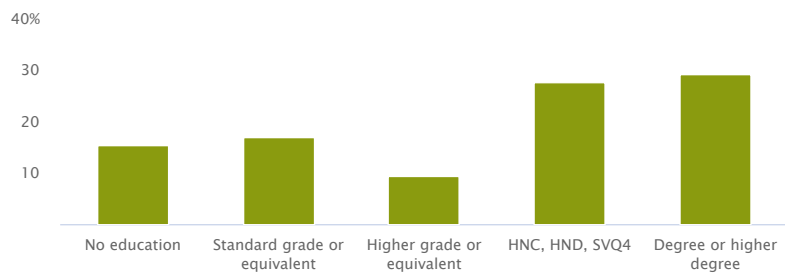


Distance travelled to work

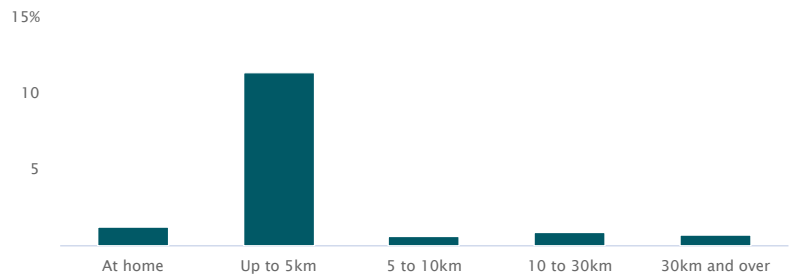
