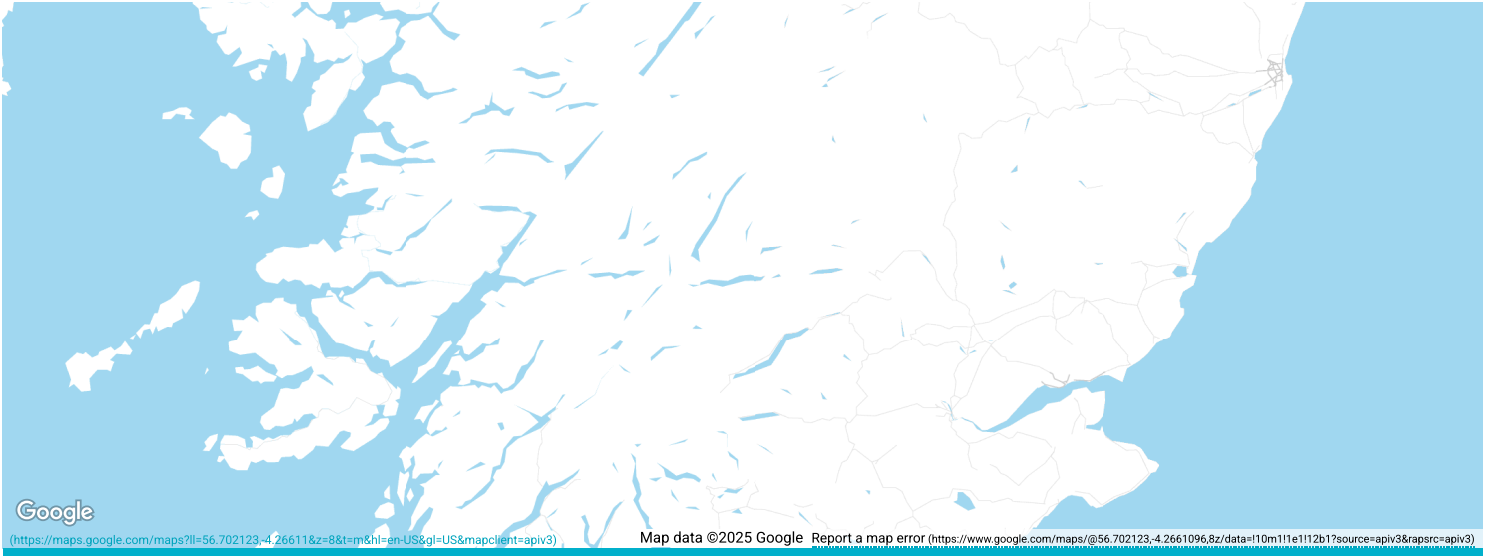




Methlick

Methlick is a rural village in Aberdeenshire. It serves the local agricultural community. Recently additional affordable/social housing has been built.

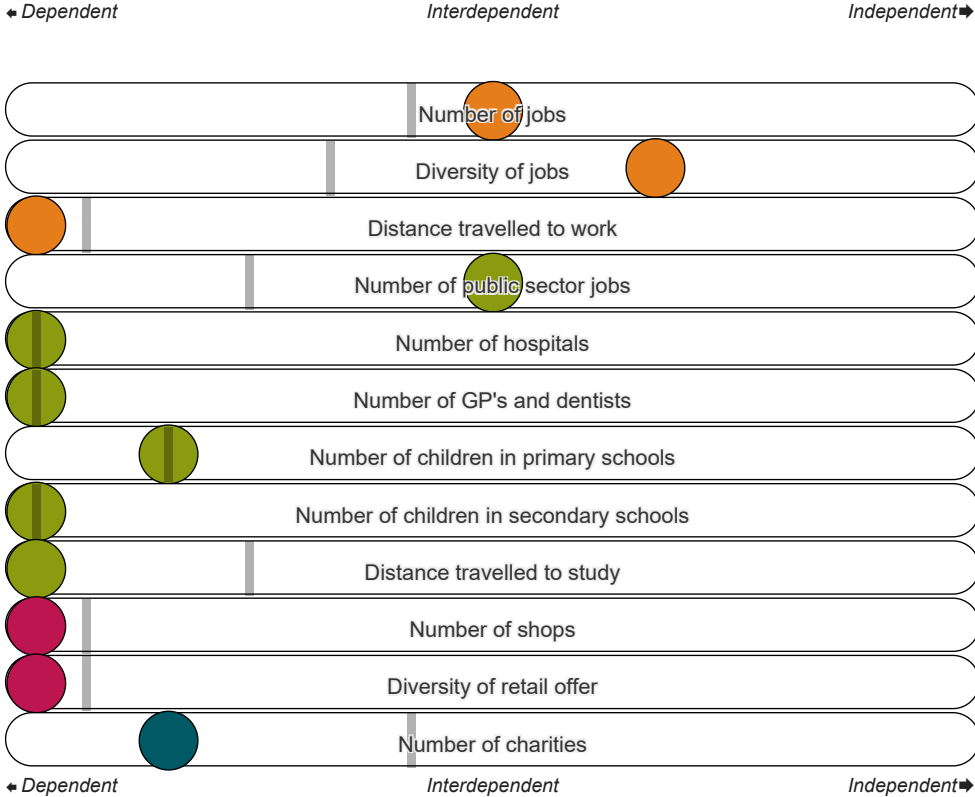
In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Methlick is a **dependent** town.

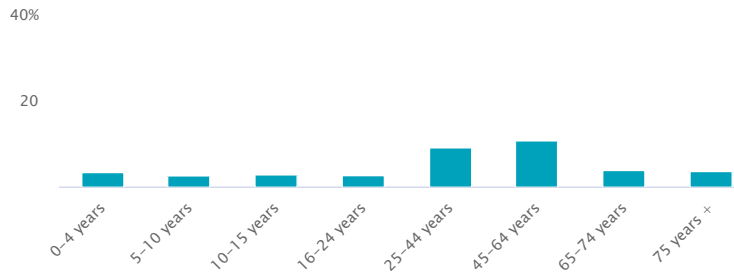

It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of charities, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Methlick differs most from its group in the distance travelled to study.

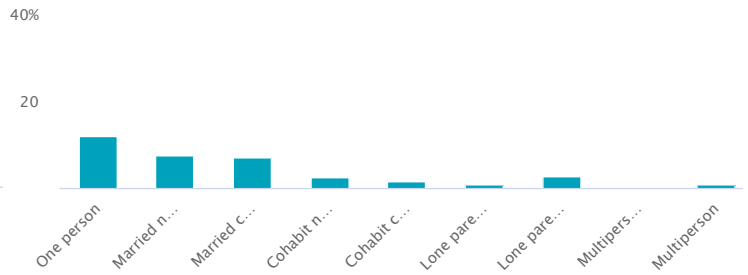

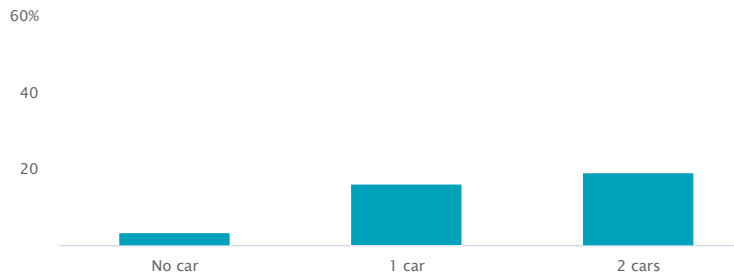

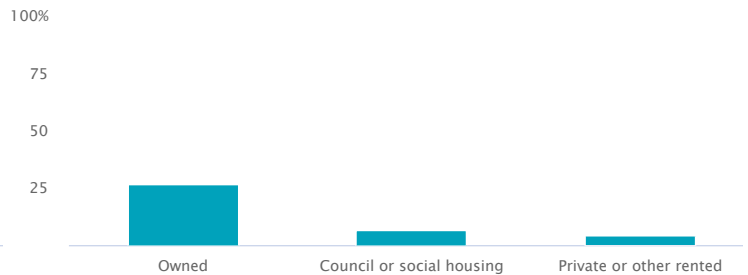
Household composition

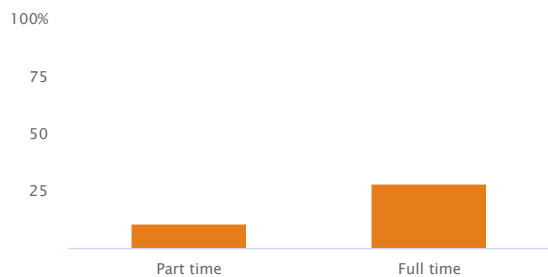

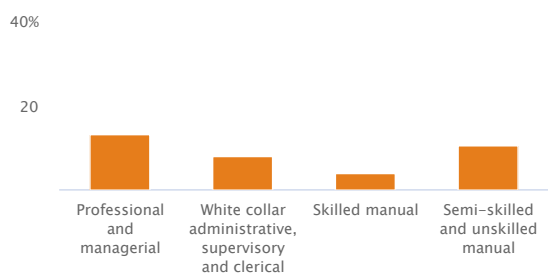
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



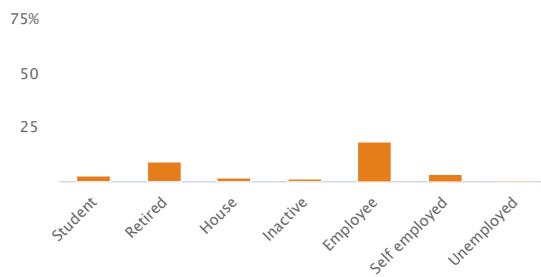
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)

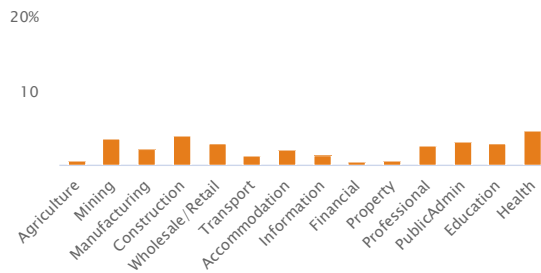

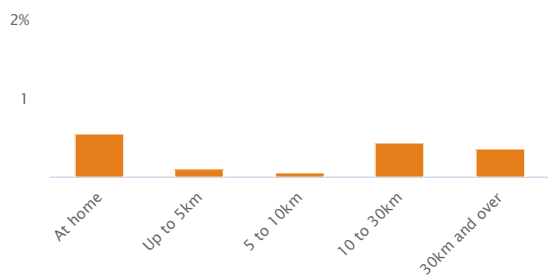

Sector Diversity

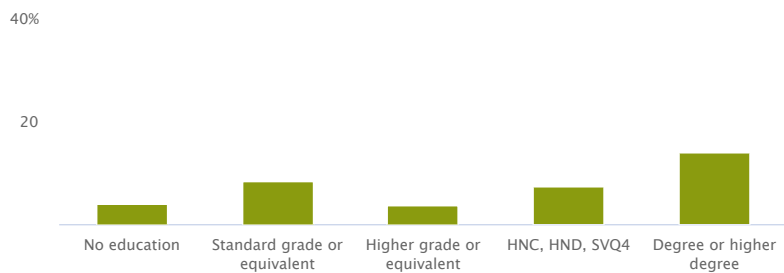


Distance travelled to work

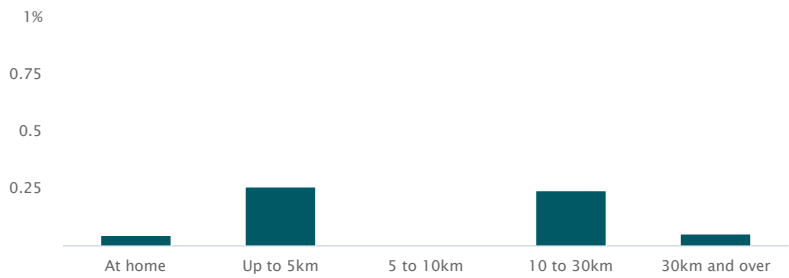
Number of people per shop
