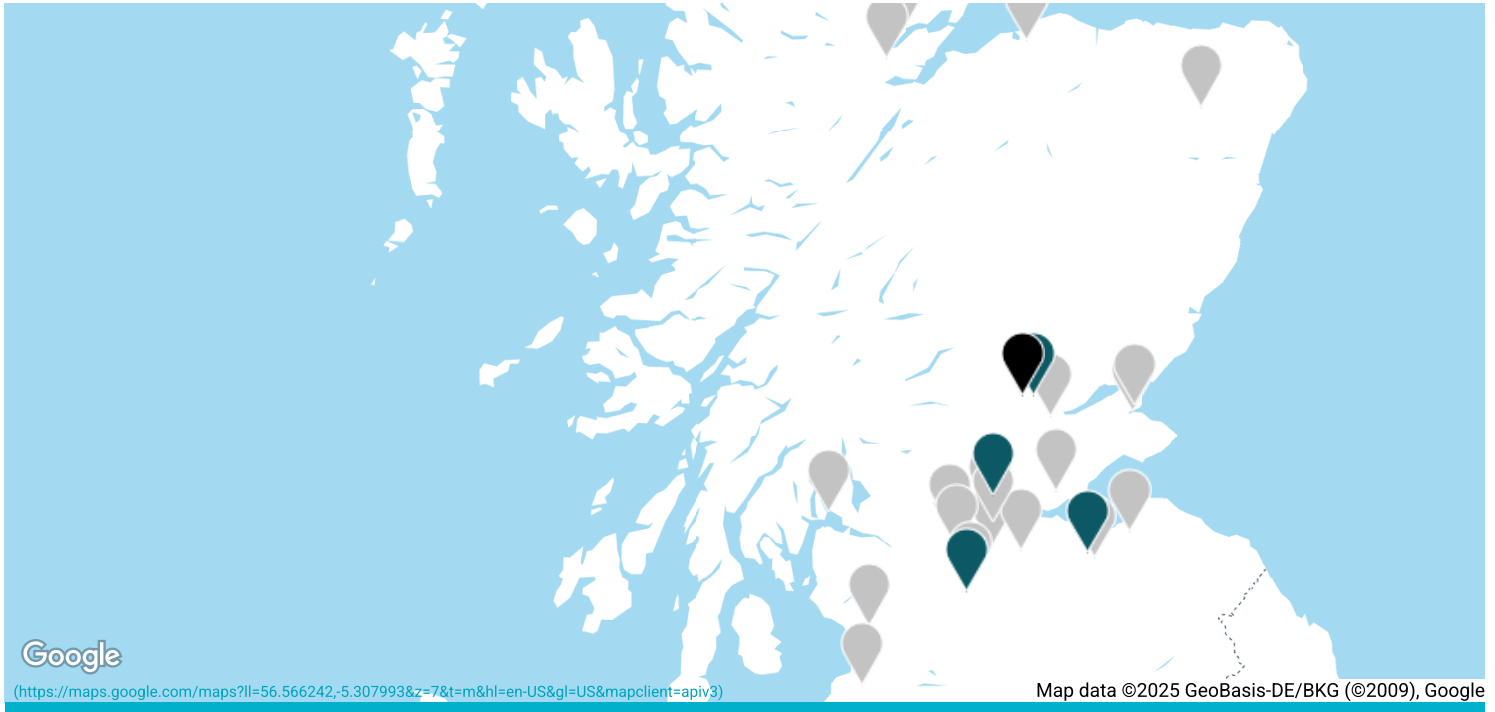




Methven

Methven is in Perth and Kinross. It was a 14th century kirkton and later had jute and linen manufacturing. With easy access to Perth it is now a commuter town.

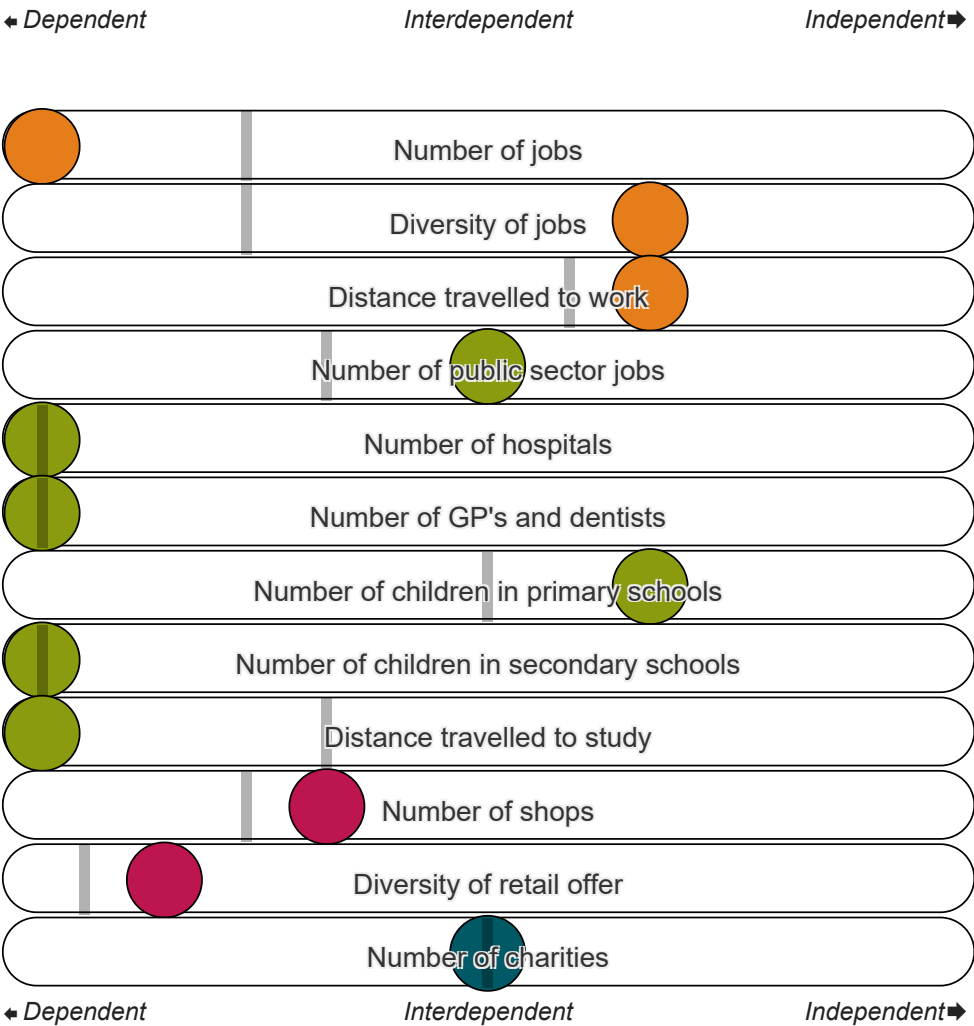
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Methven is a dependent to interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Methven is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Methven is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the diversity of jobs. Methven differs most from its group in the number of jobs; and the distance travelled to study.

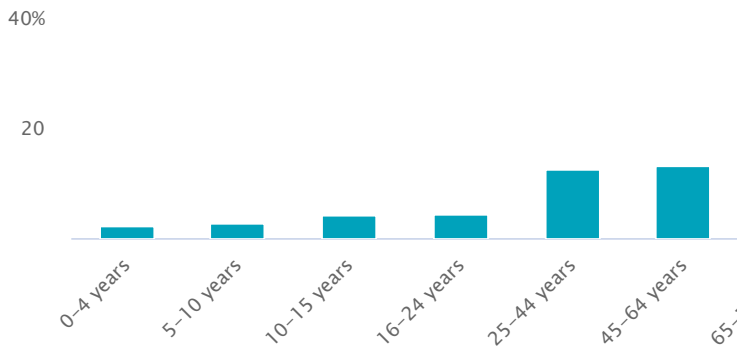

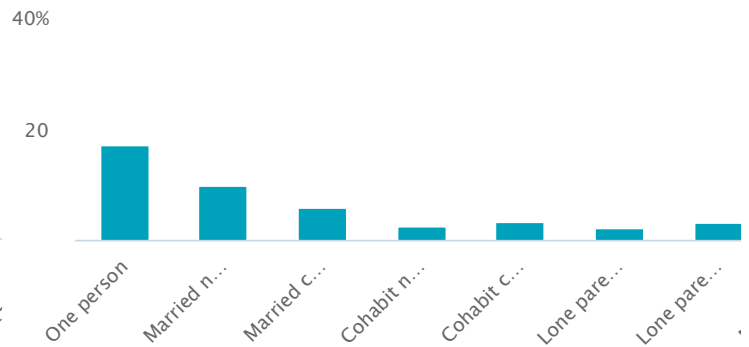

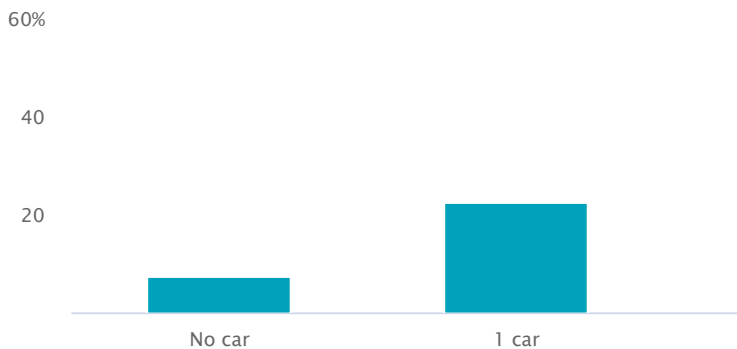

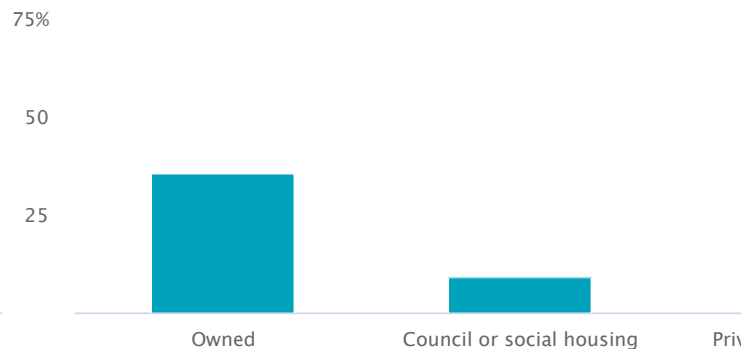

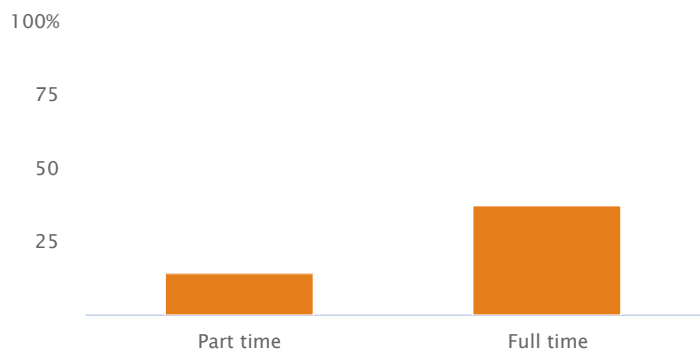

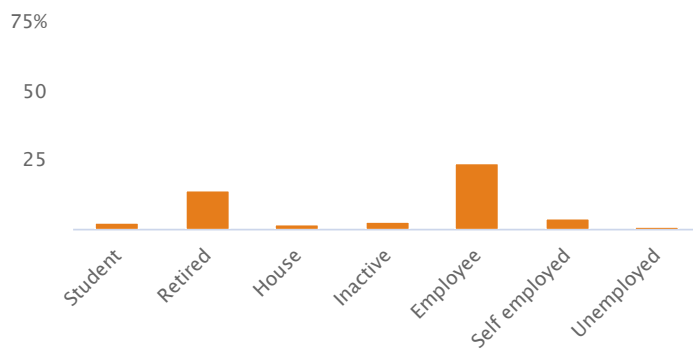
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



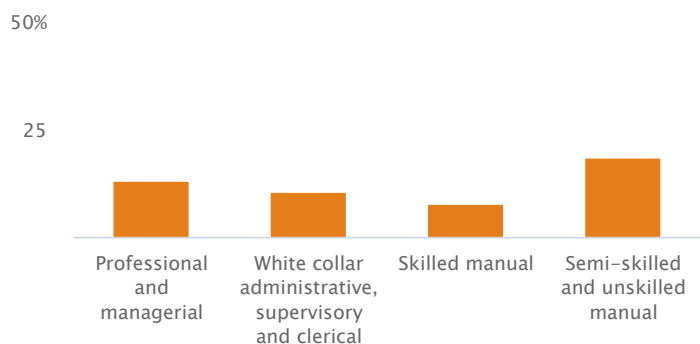
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

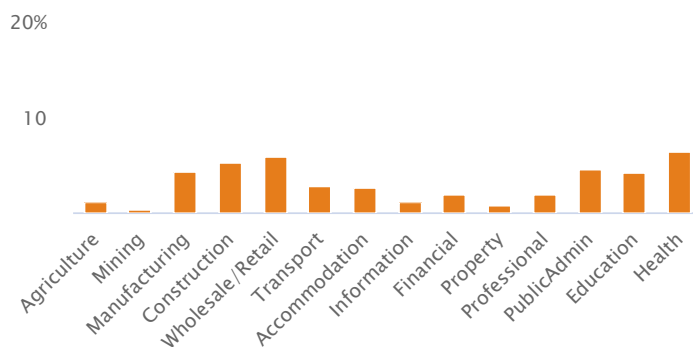

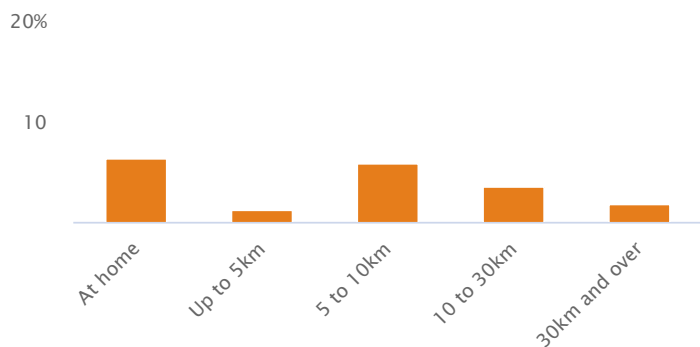
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

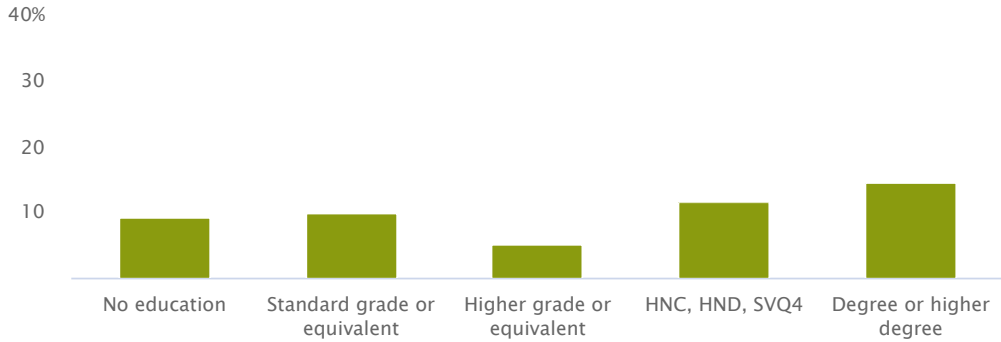


Distance travelled to work

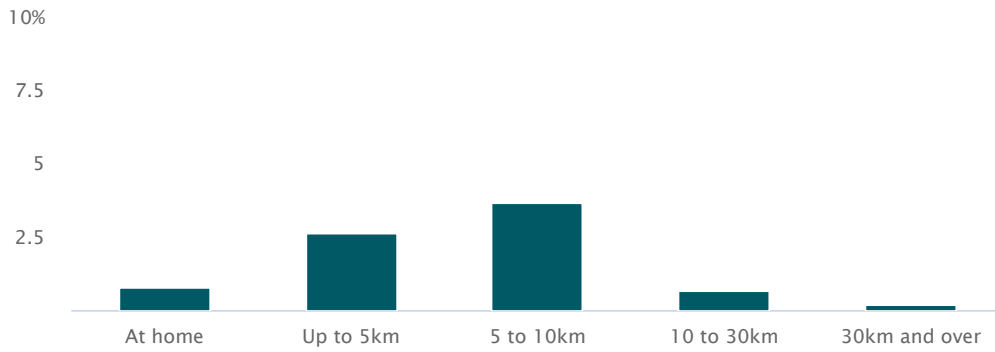
